FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.

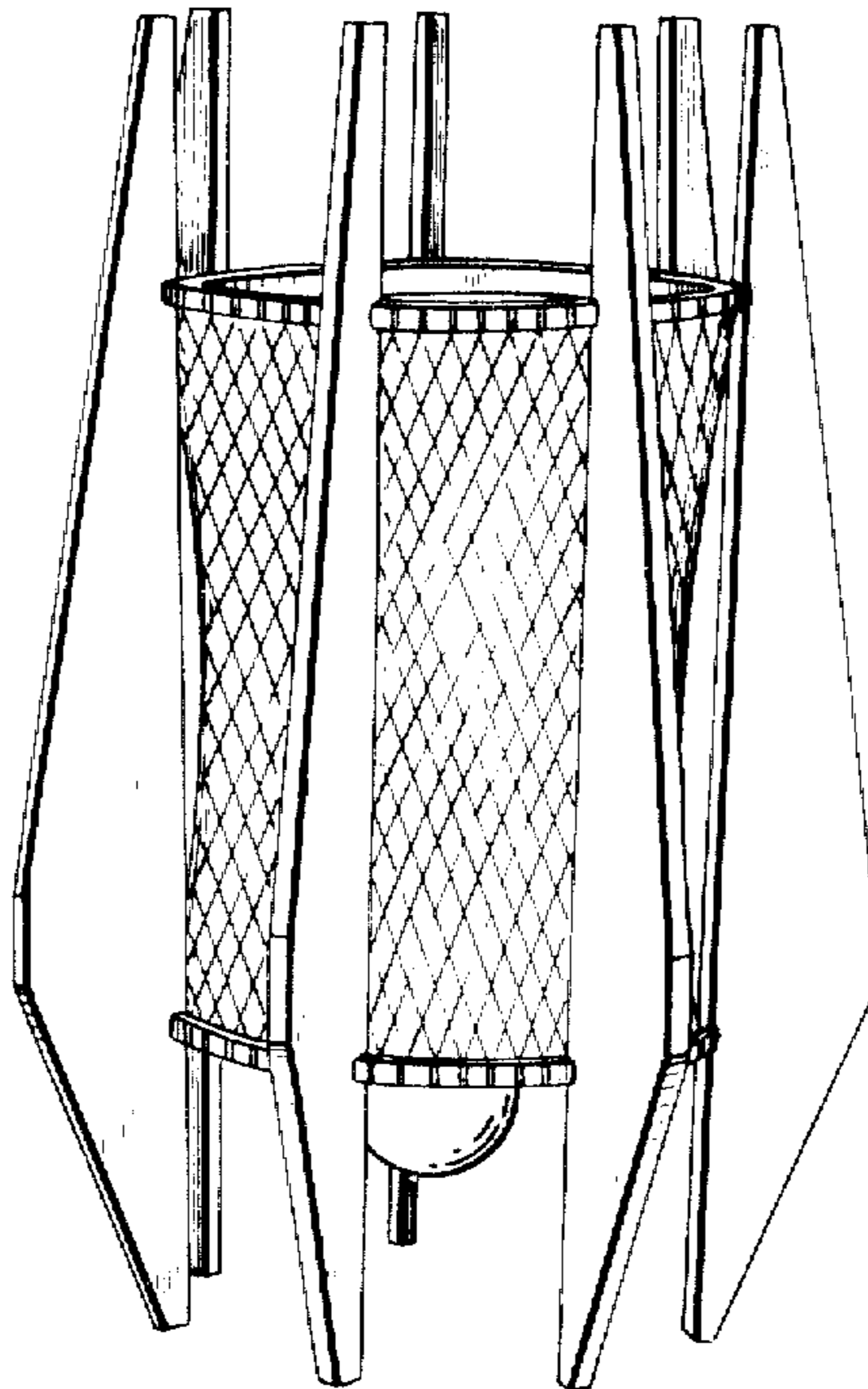

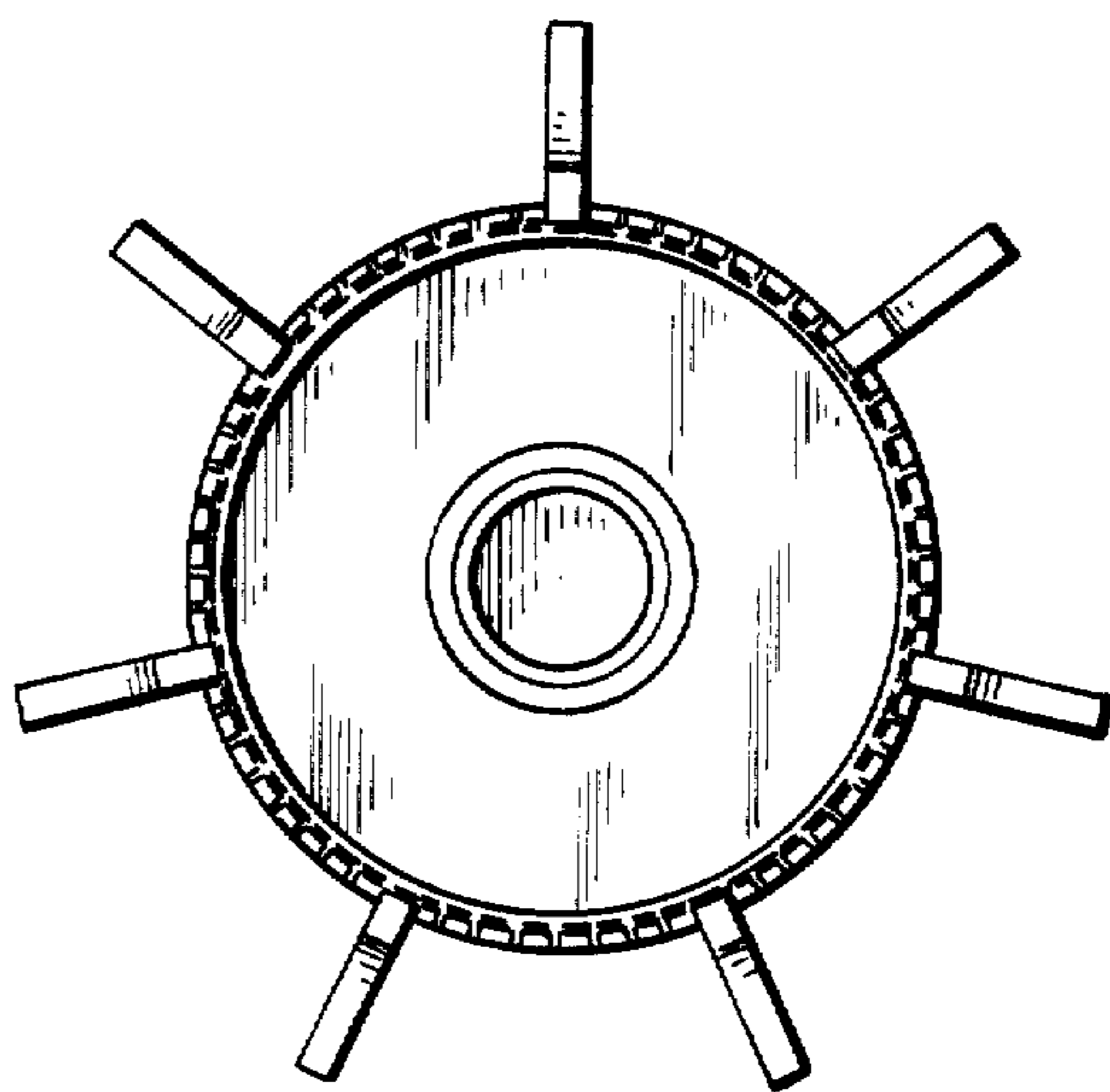
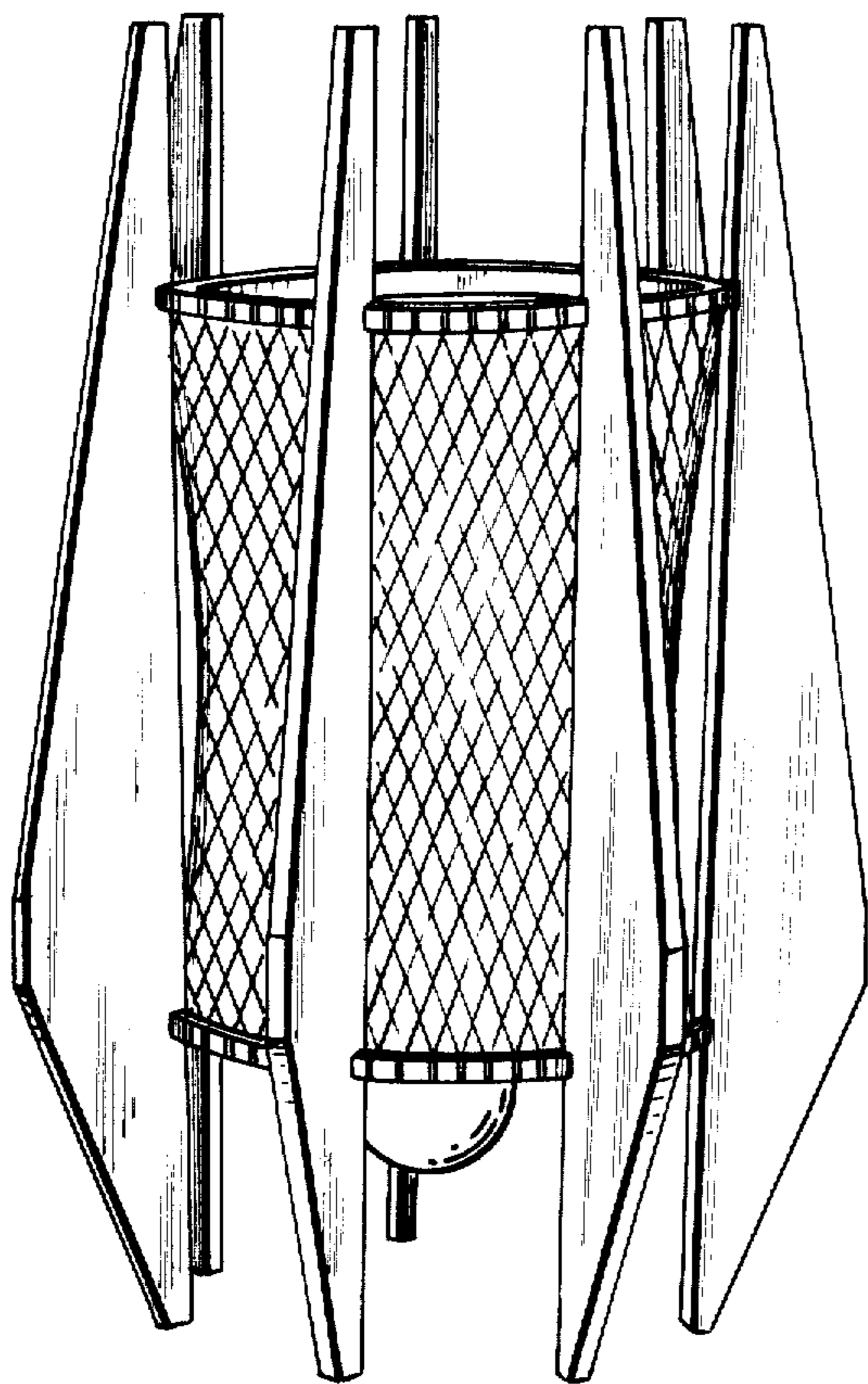

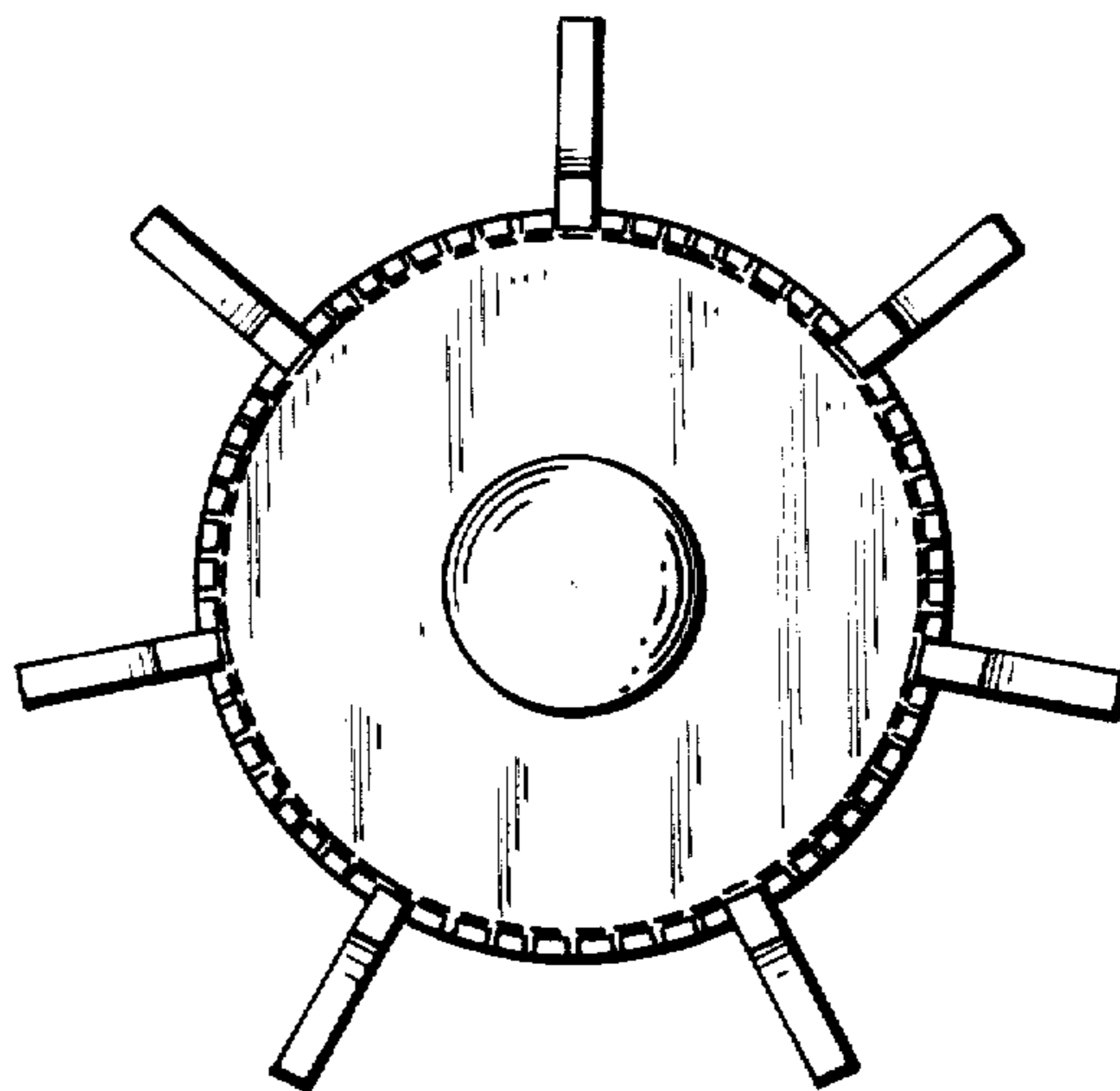
