DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view thereof including the top, front, and one side of a lighter showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

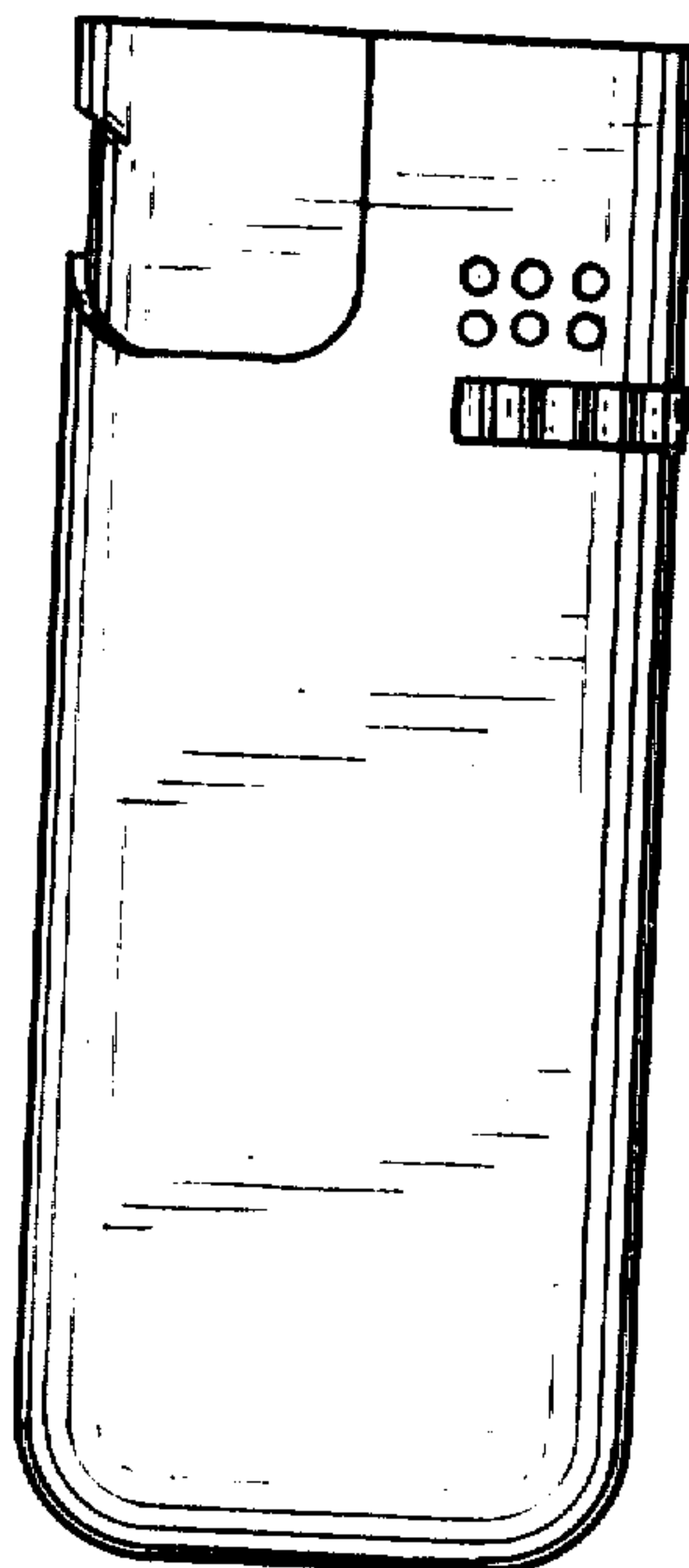

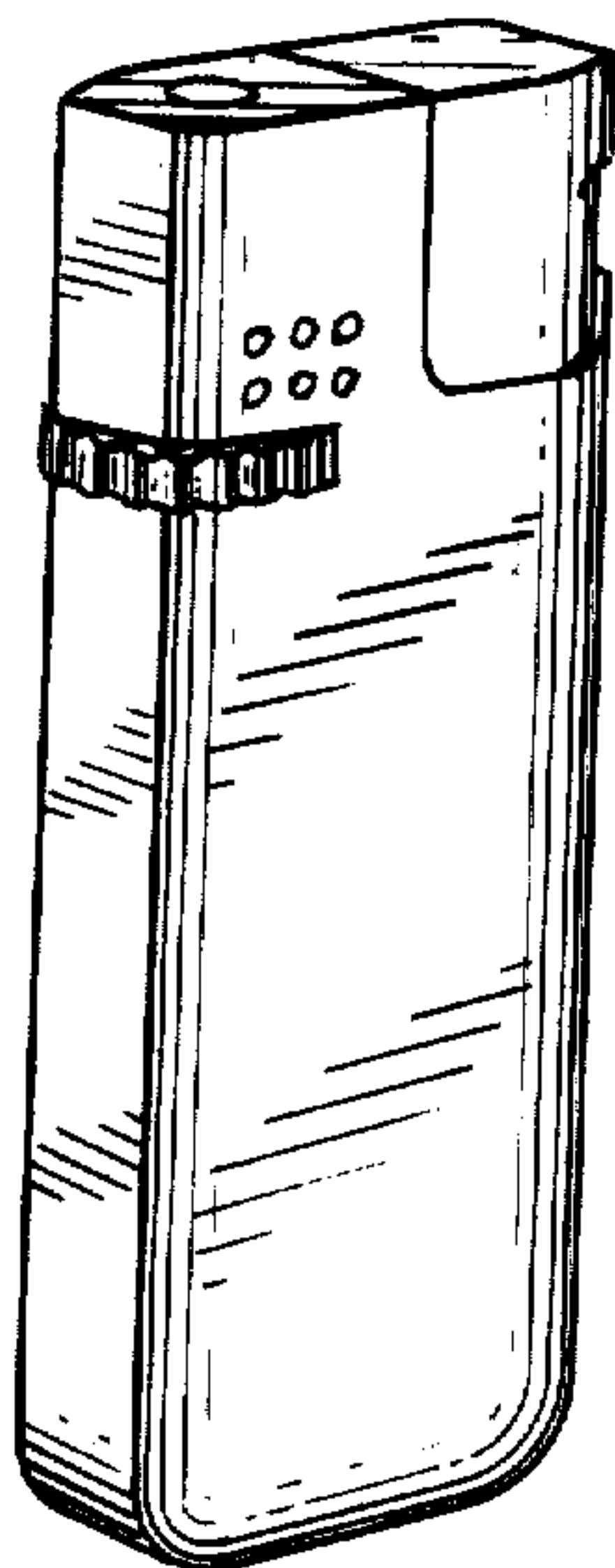

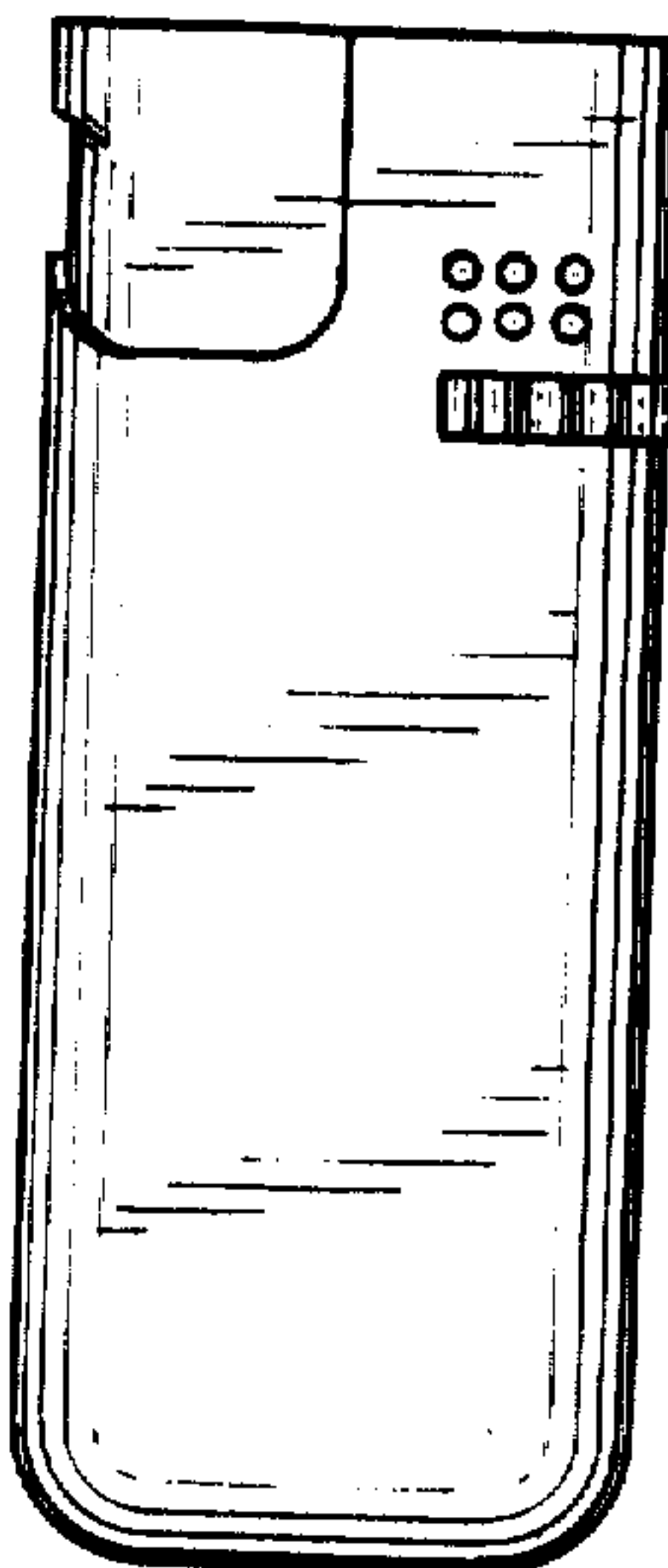

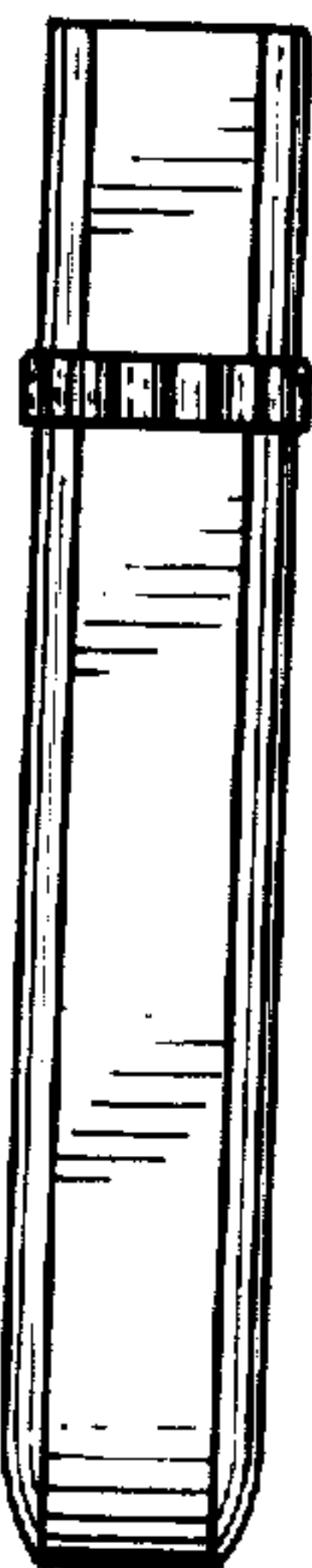

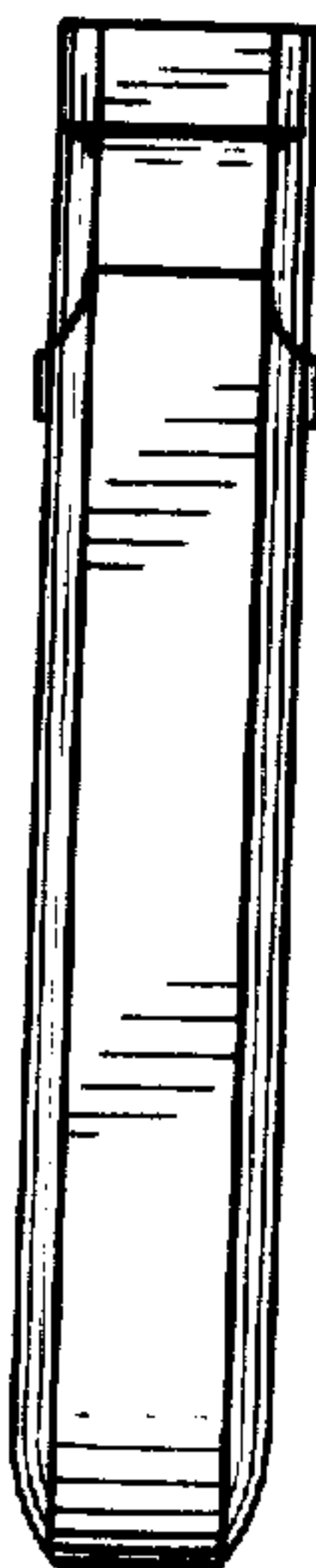
