FIG. 6 is a top, front perspective view thereof.

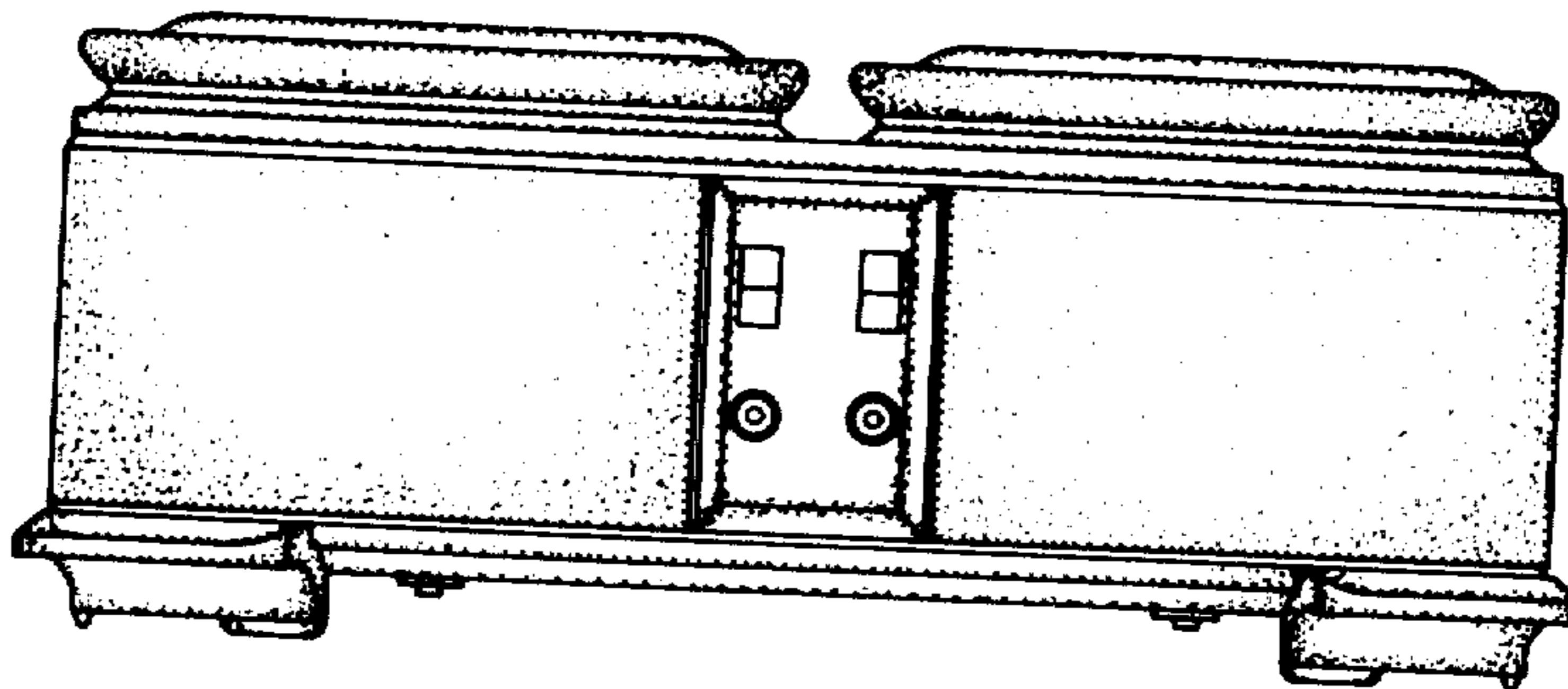

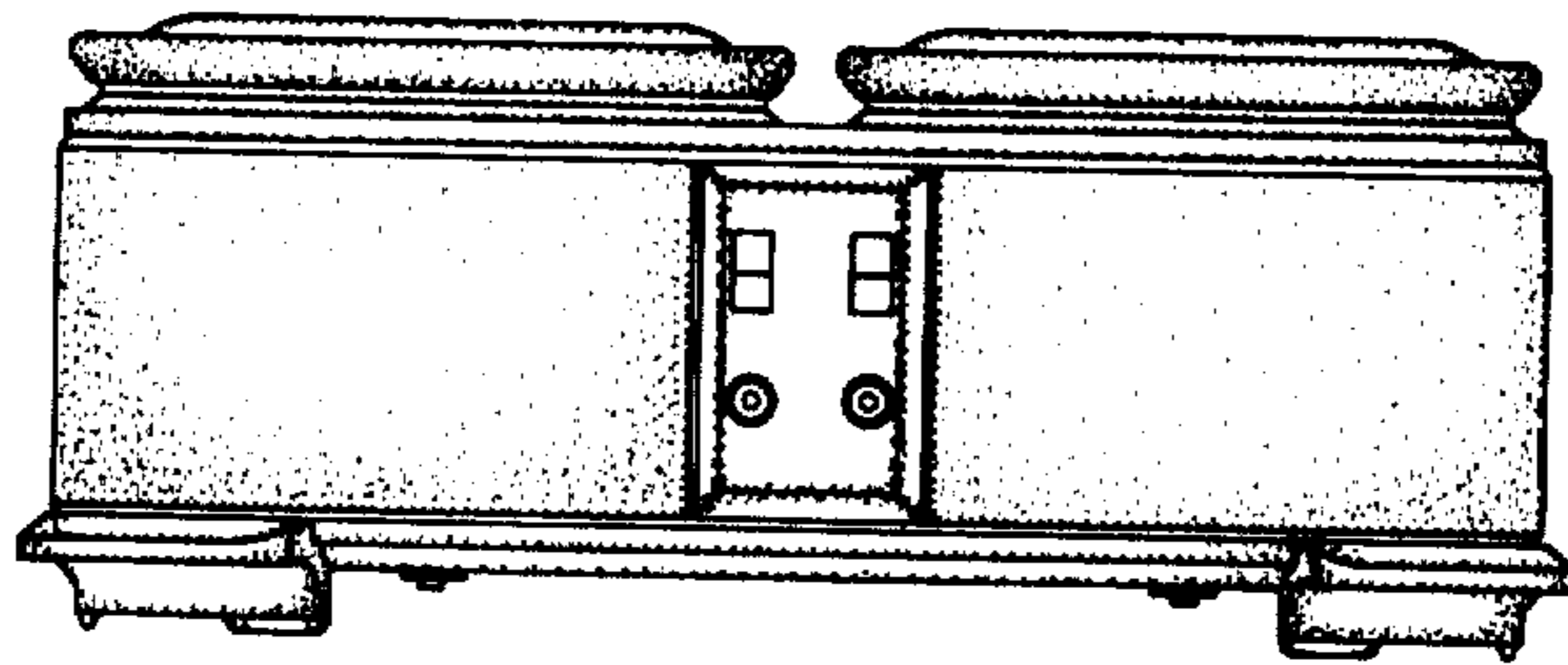

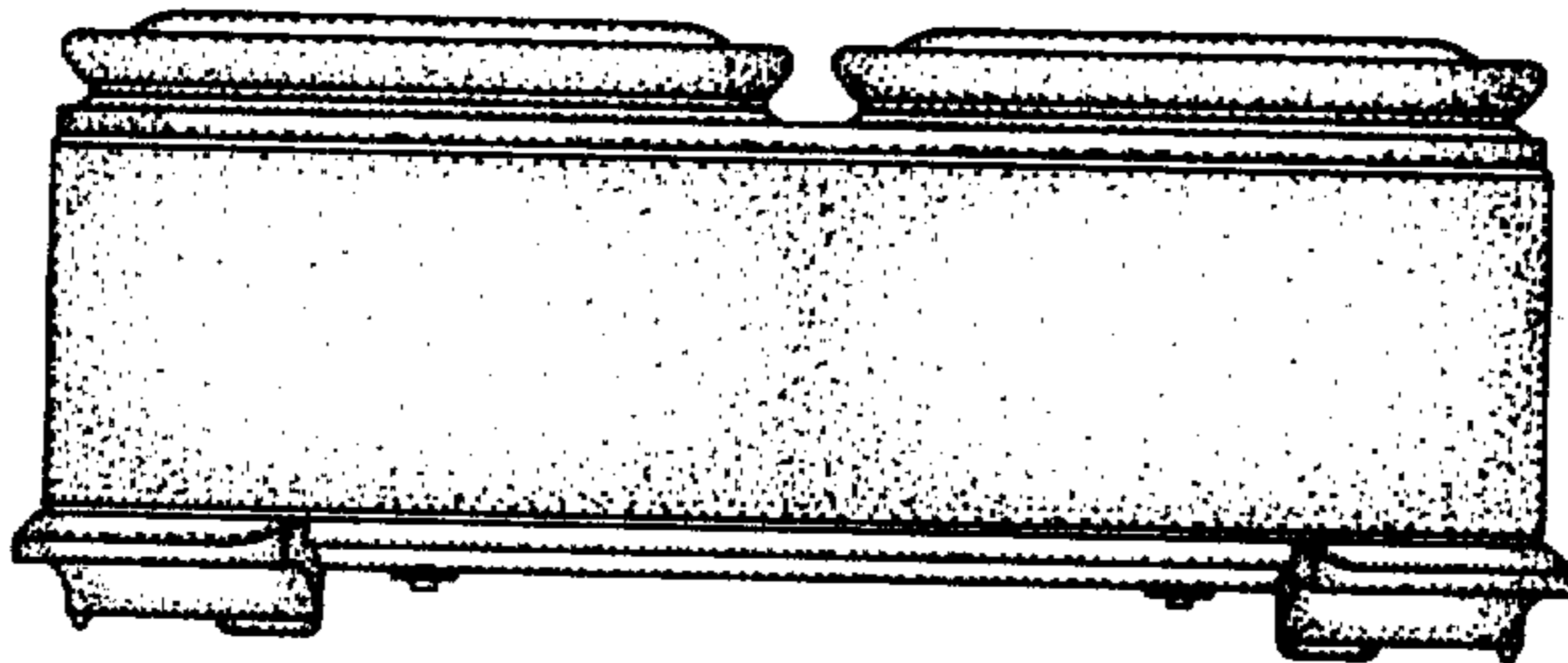

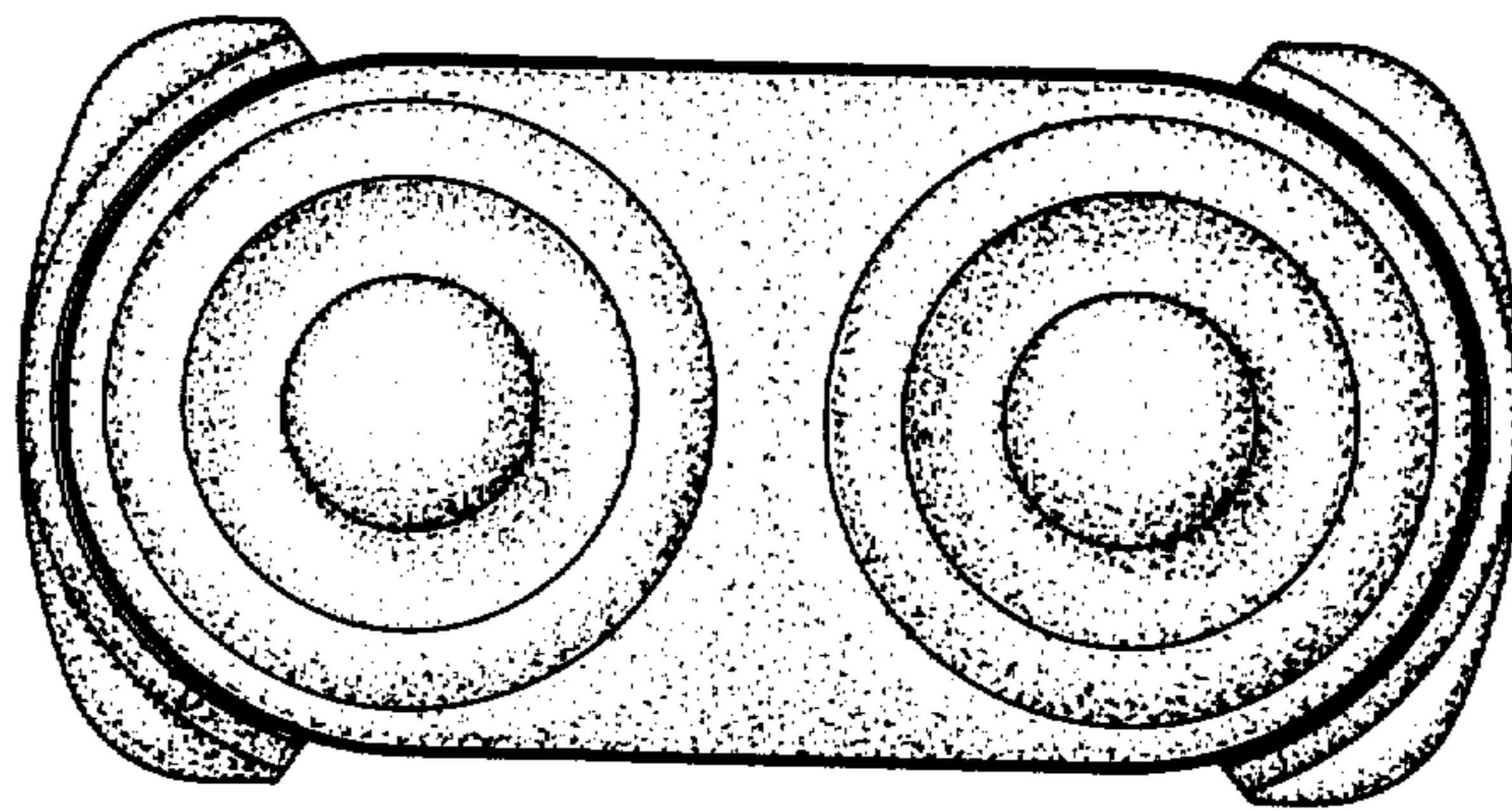

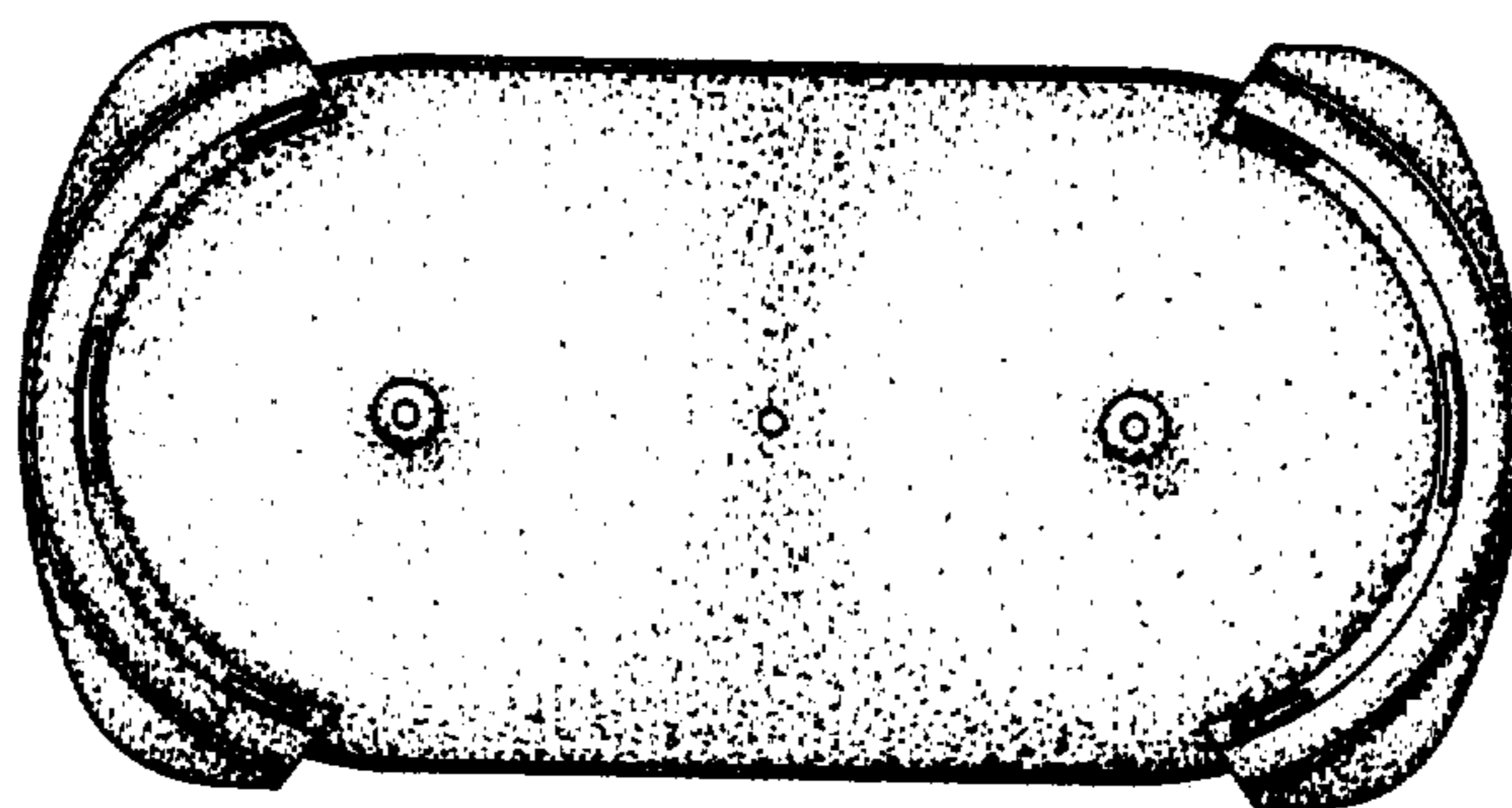

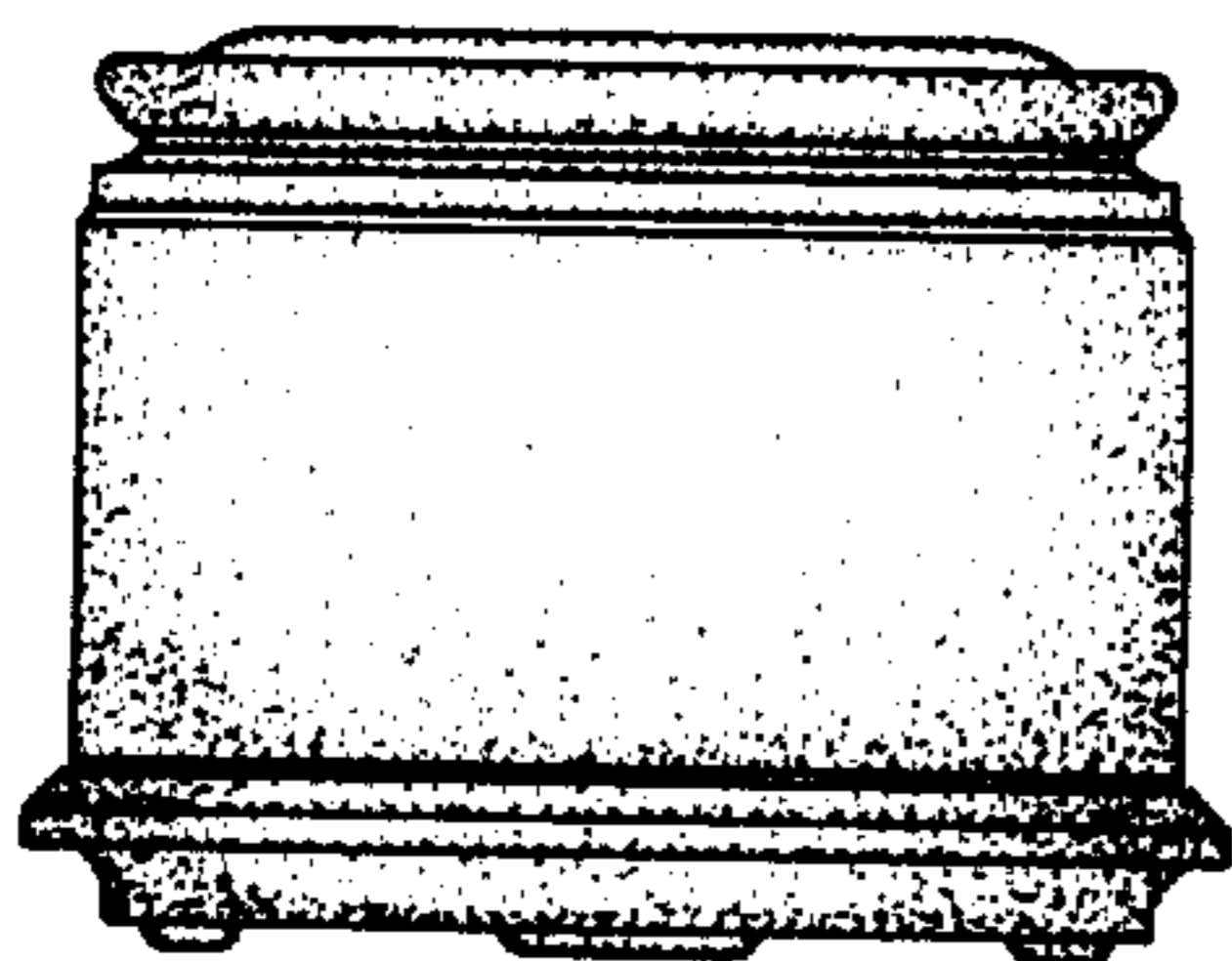
