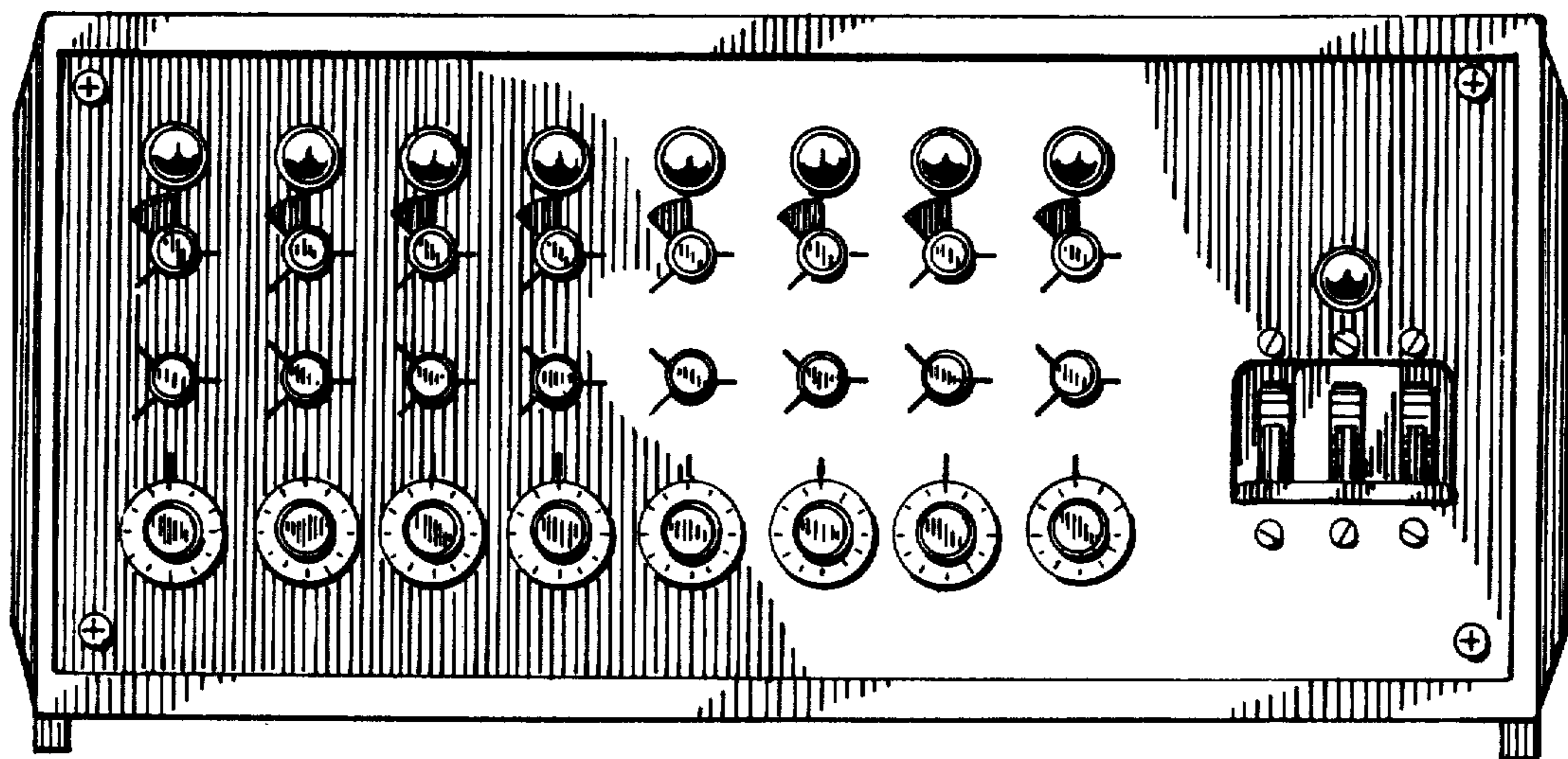
DESCRIPTION

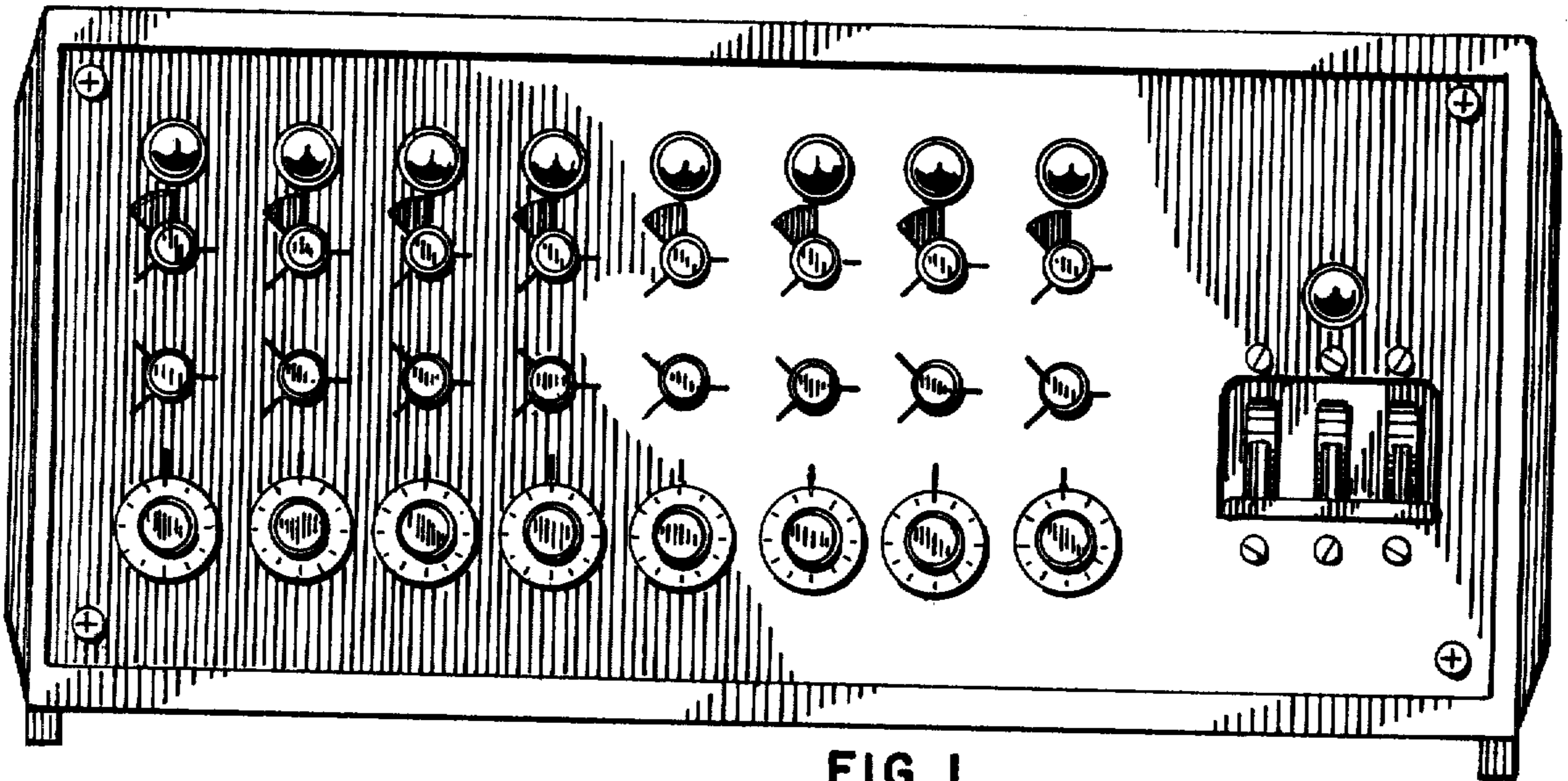

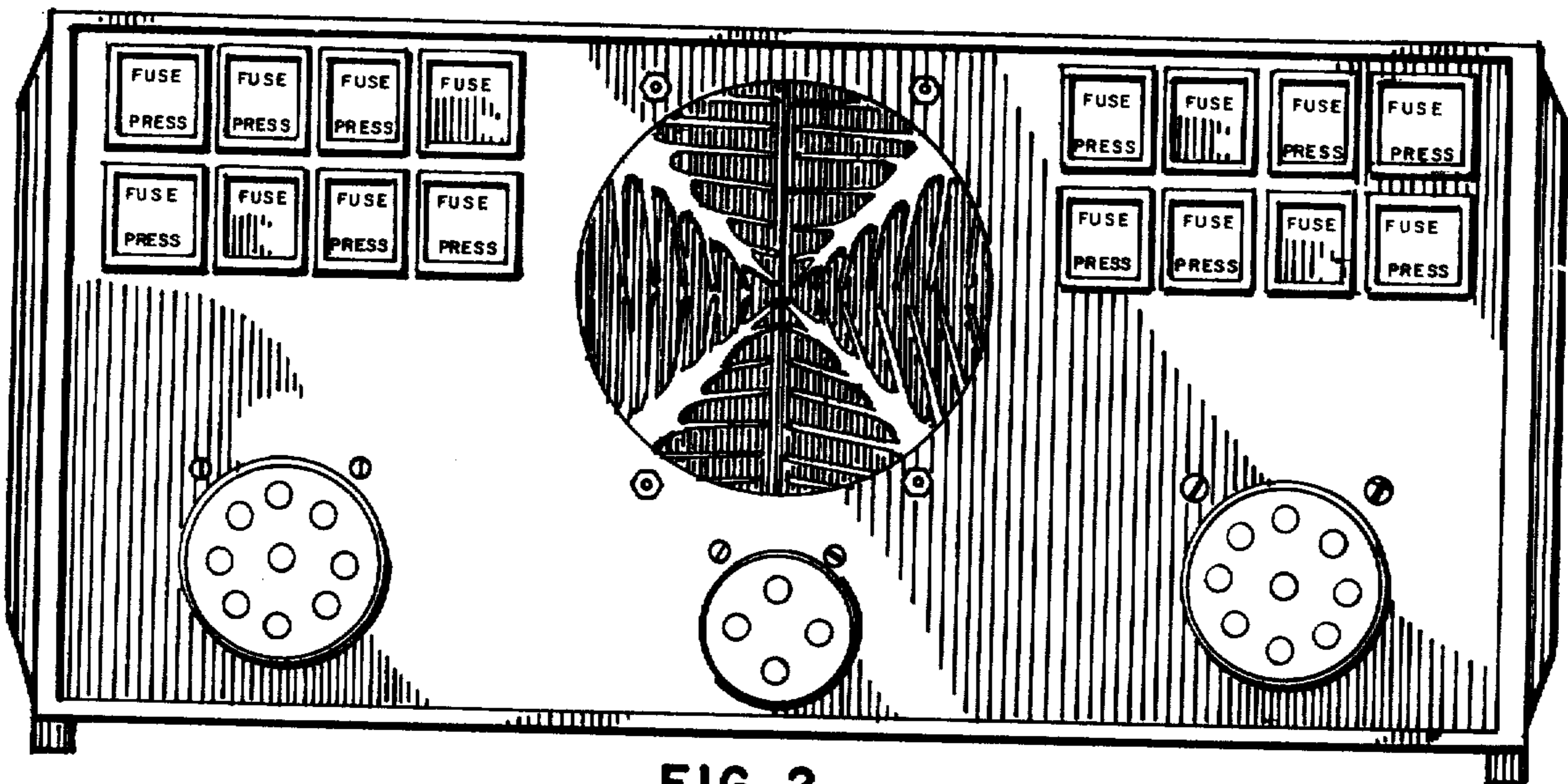

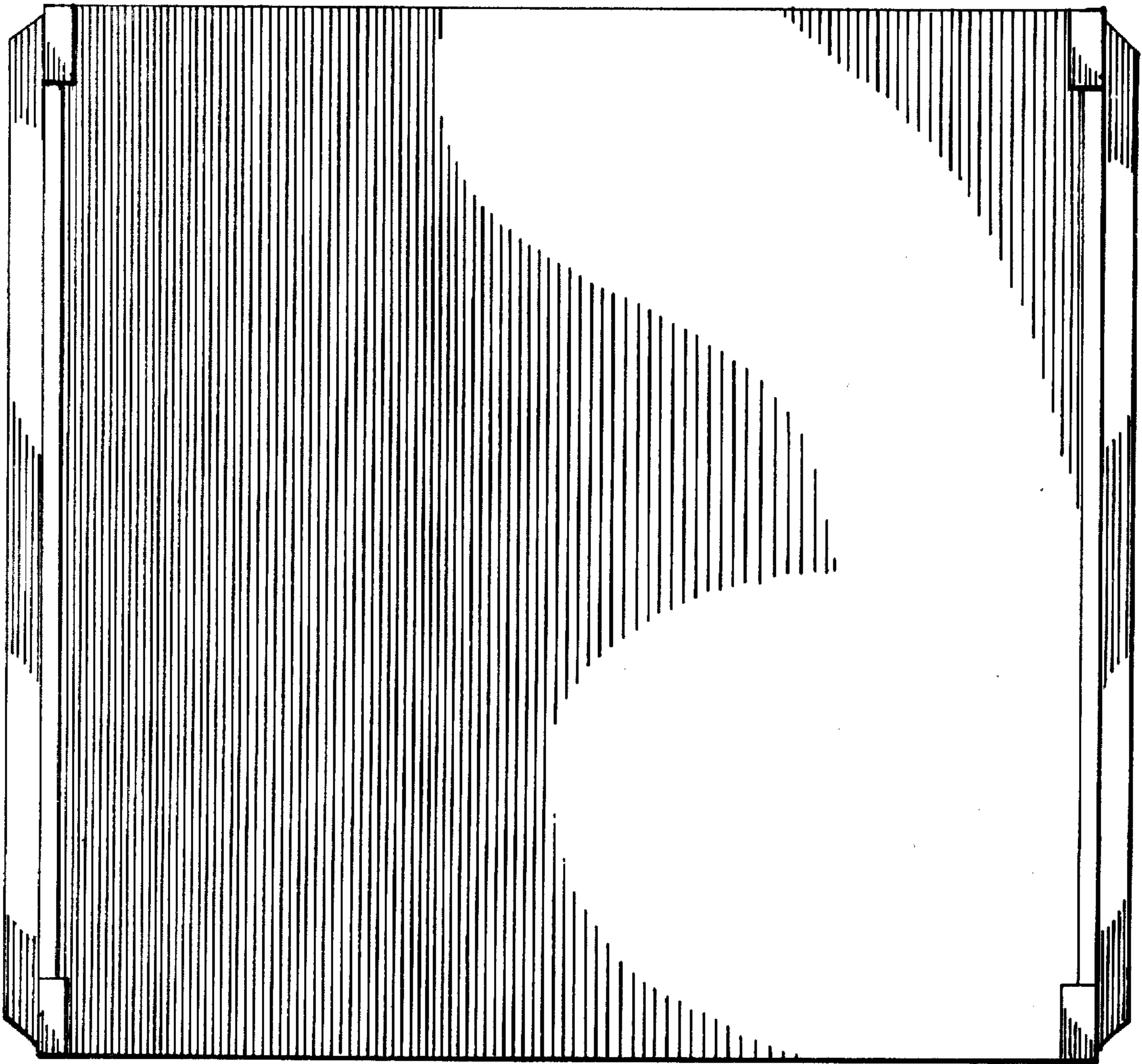

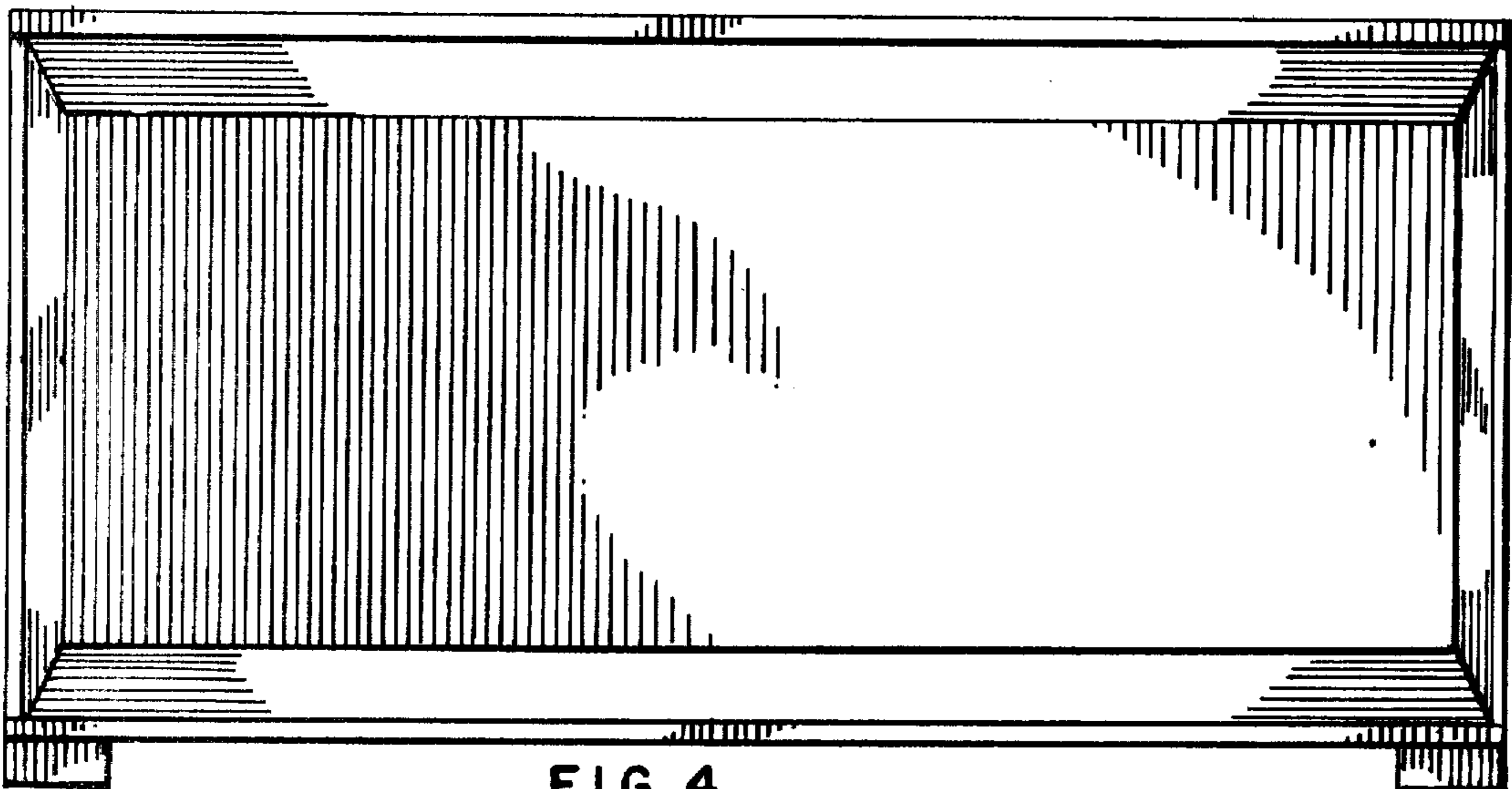

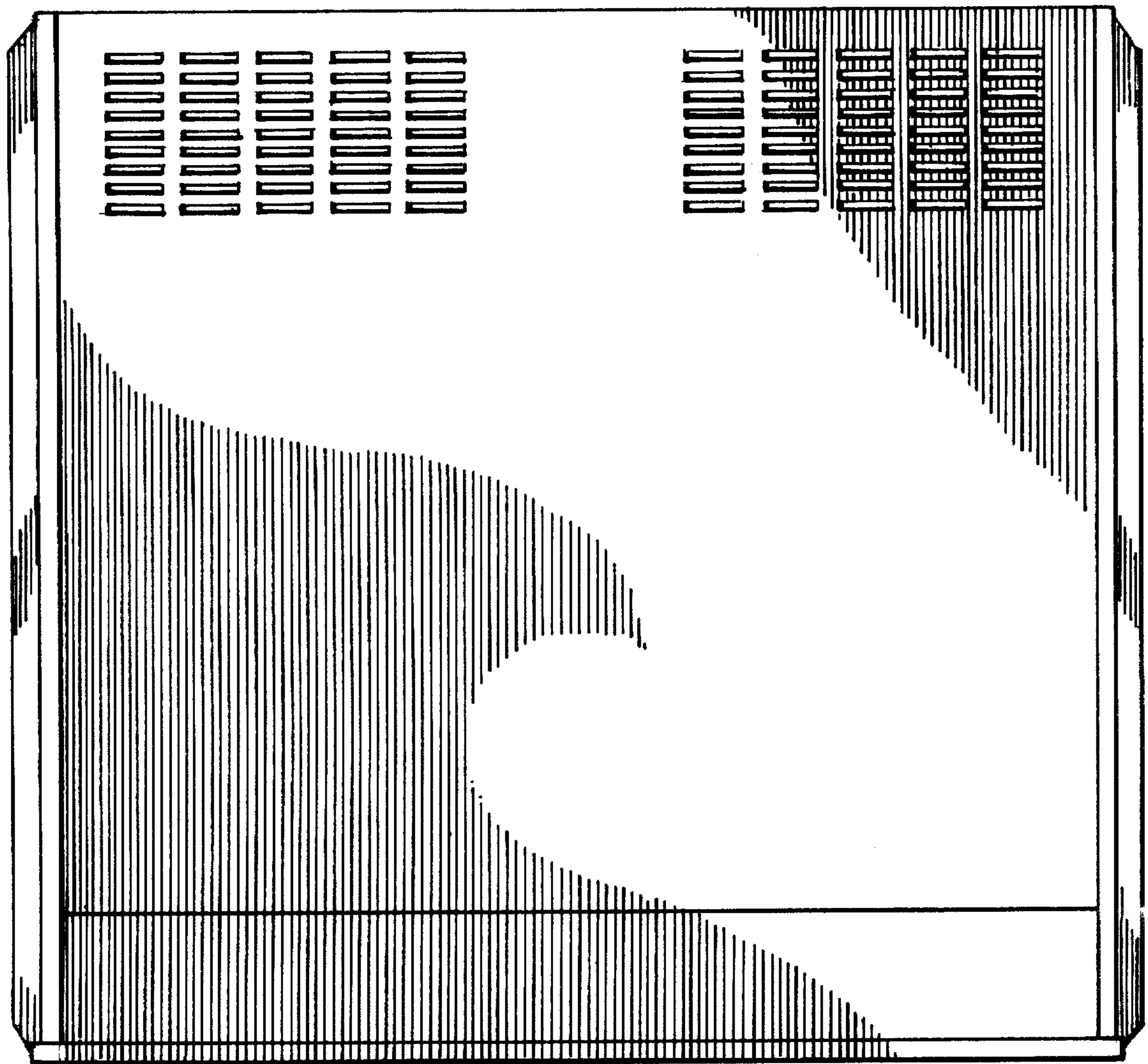

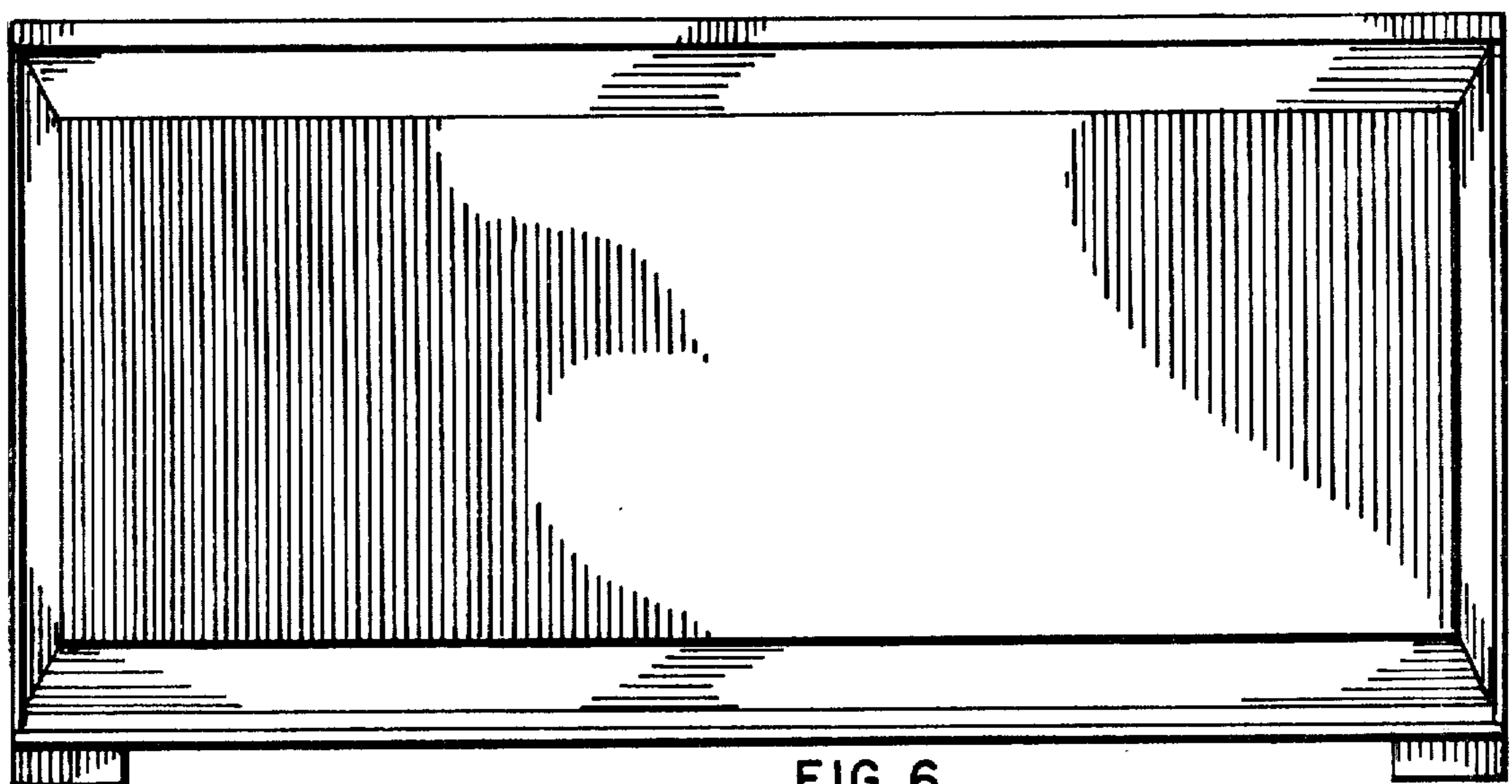
