CLAIM

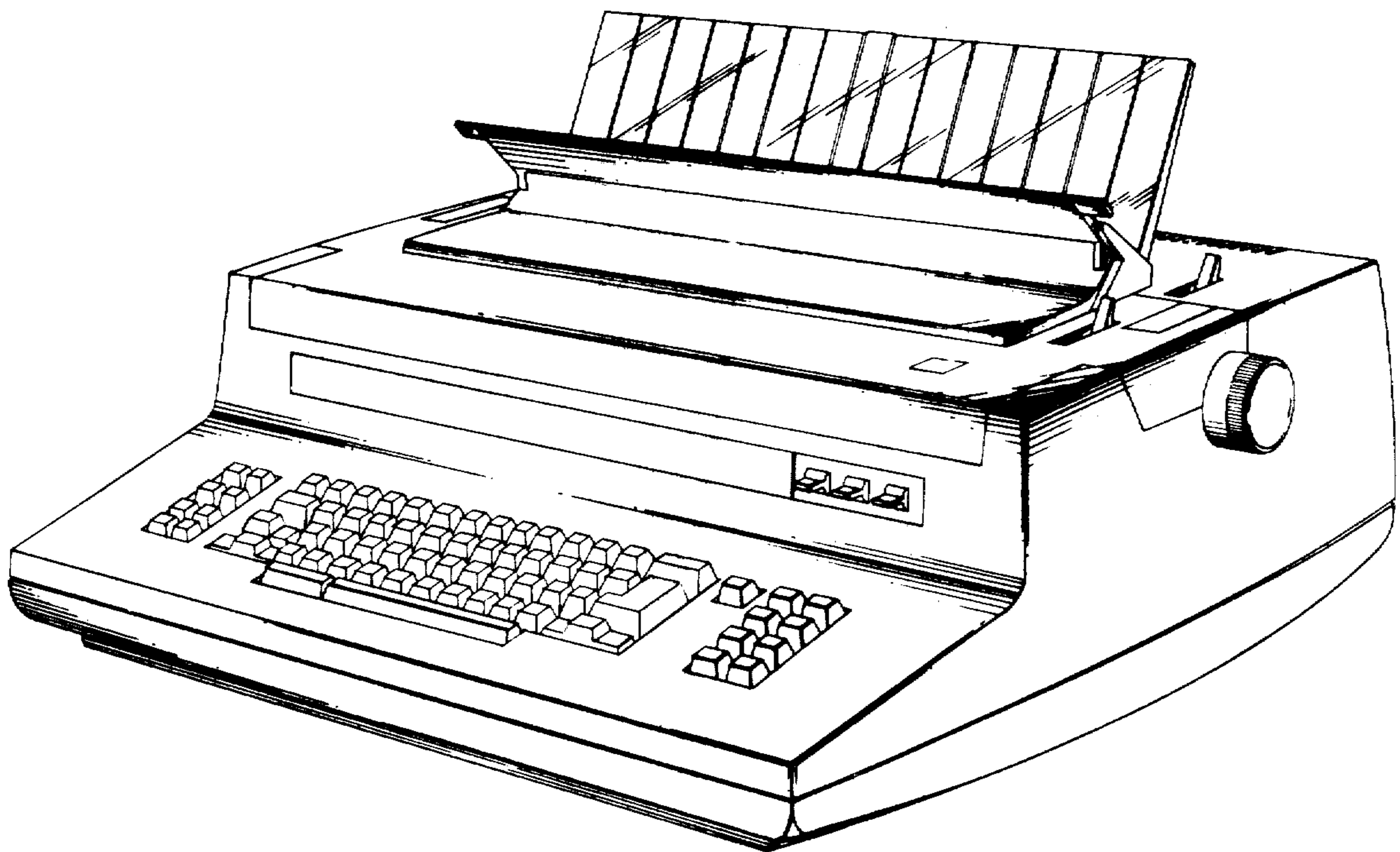
The ornamental design for a typewriter or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a typewriter or the like, showing our new design.

Shown in this view are the top, front, and right side of the typewriter or the like. The left side, not shown, is a mirror image of the right side.

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the typewriter or the like shown in FIG. 1.



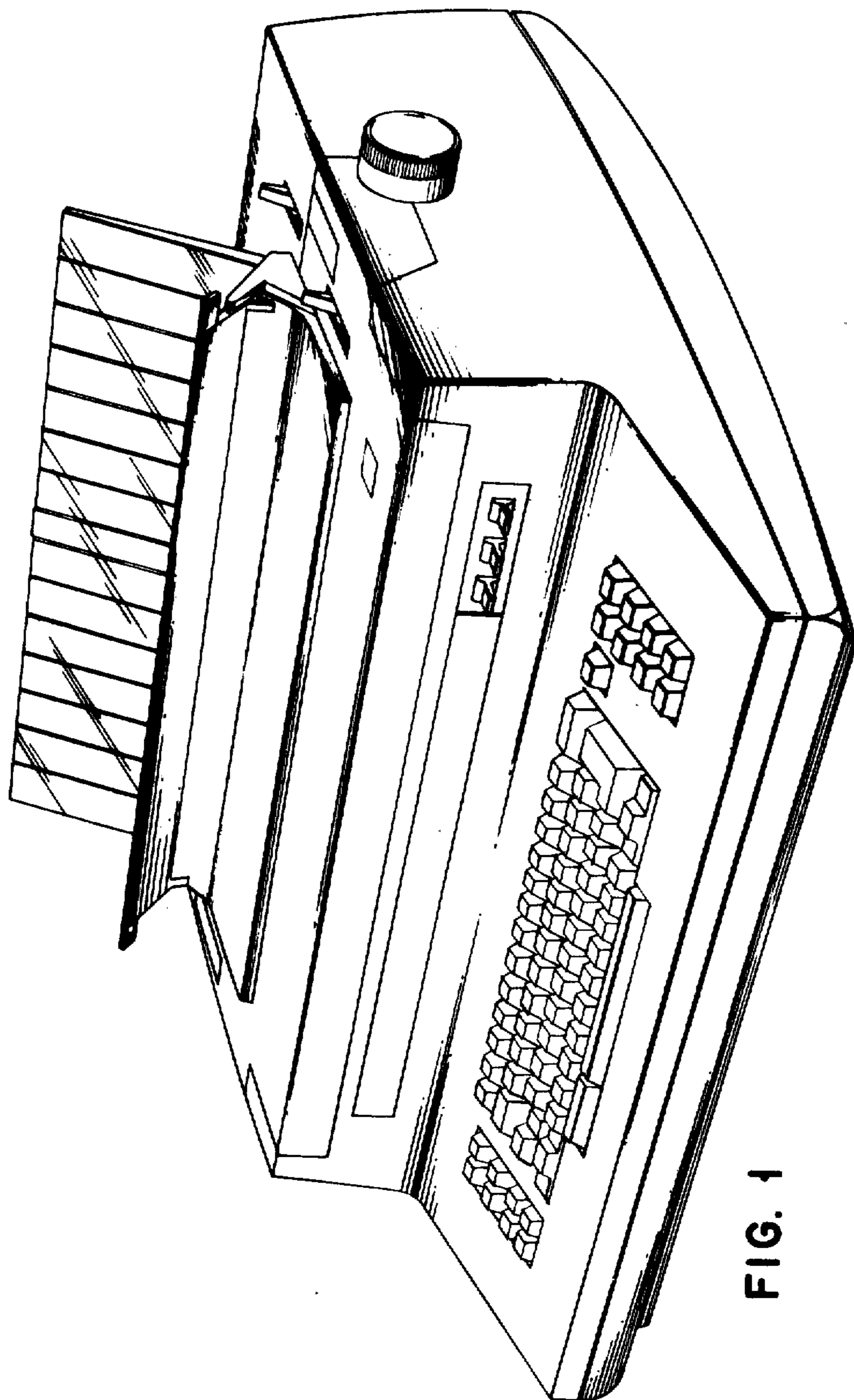

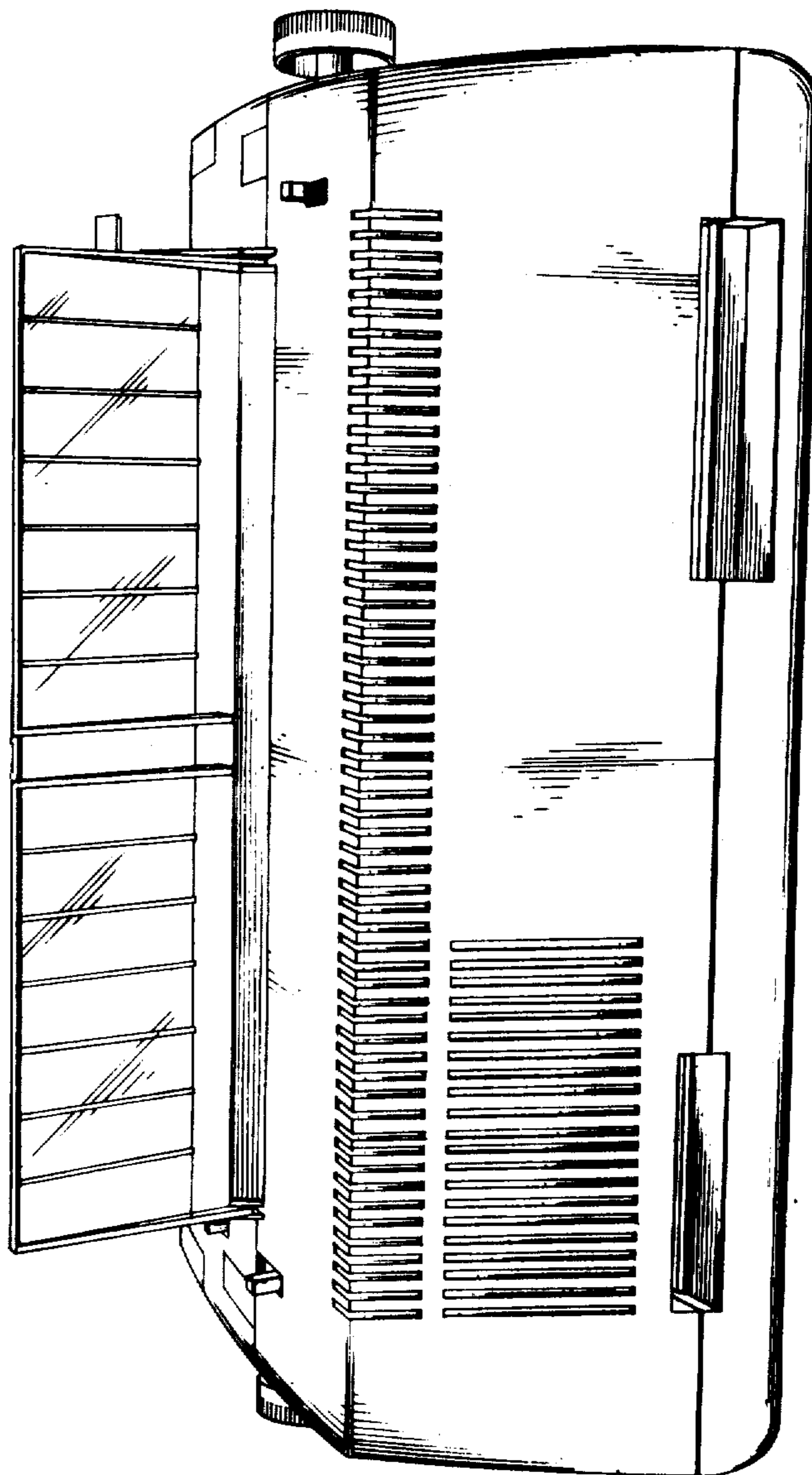
