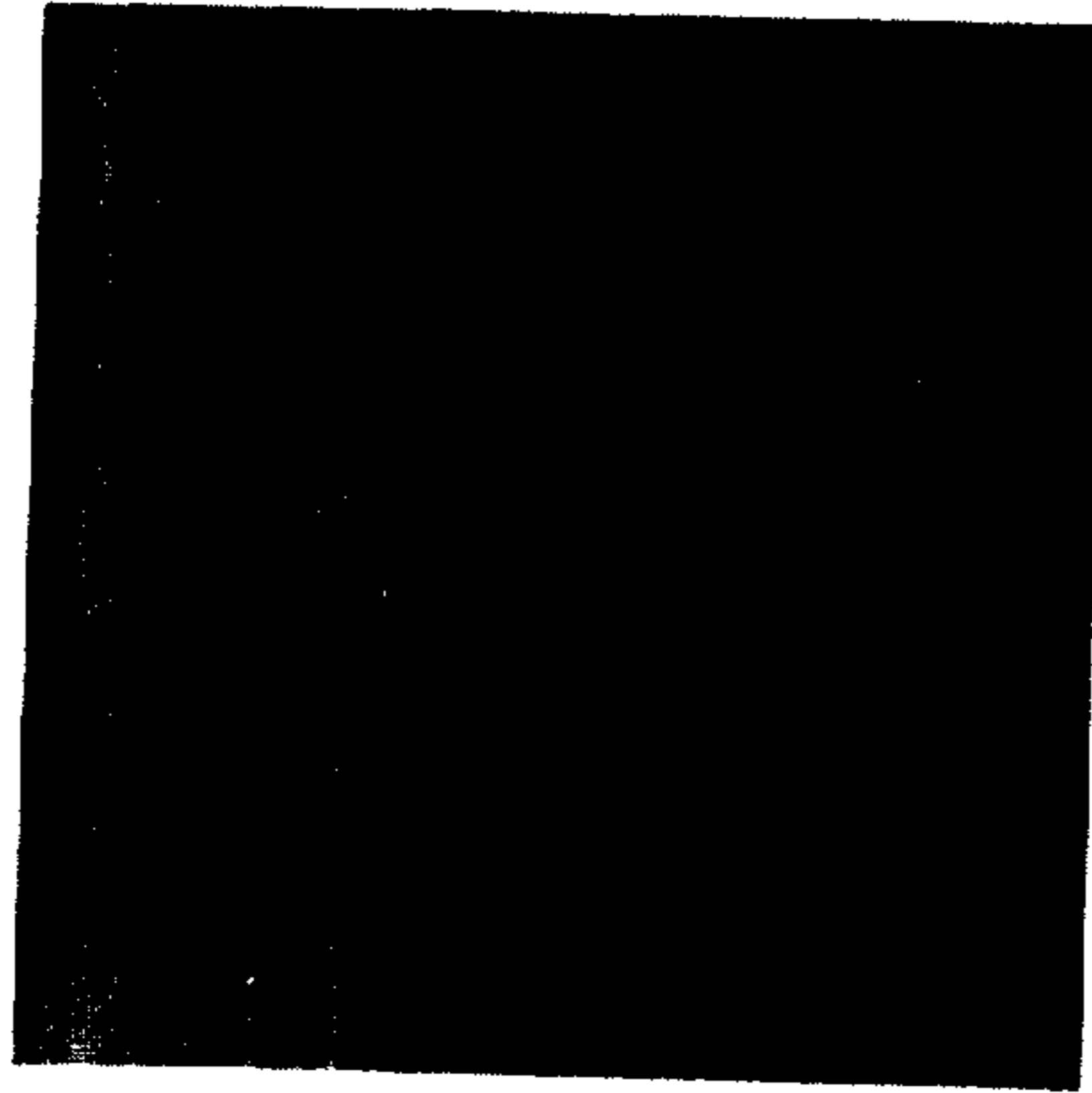
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a laminate sheet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a plan view of a laminate sheet showing our new design, the sheet being of conventional thickness.

The lateral edges of the FIGURE constitute the width-wise boundaries of the laminate sheet and the unit and manner of repeat being shown.
