[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a money pouch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a money pouch showing my new design in open condition, it being understood that the opposite side is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a left-end elevational view thereof, illustrating the slot for the insertion of coins;

FIG. 3 is a right-end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof with the draw-string tightened so as to be in closed condition.

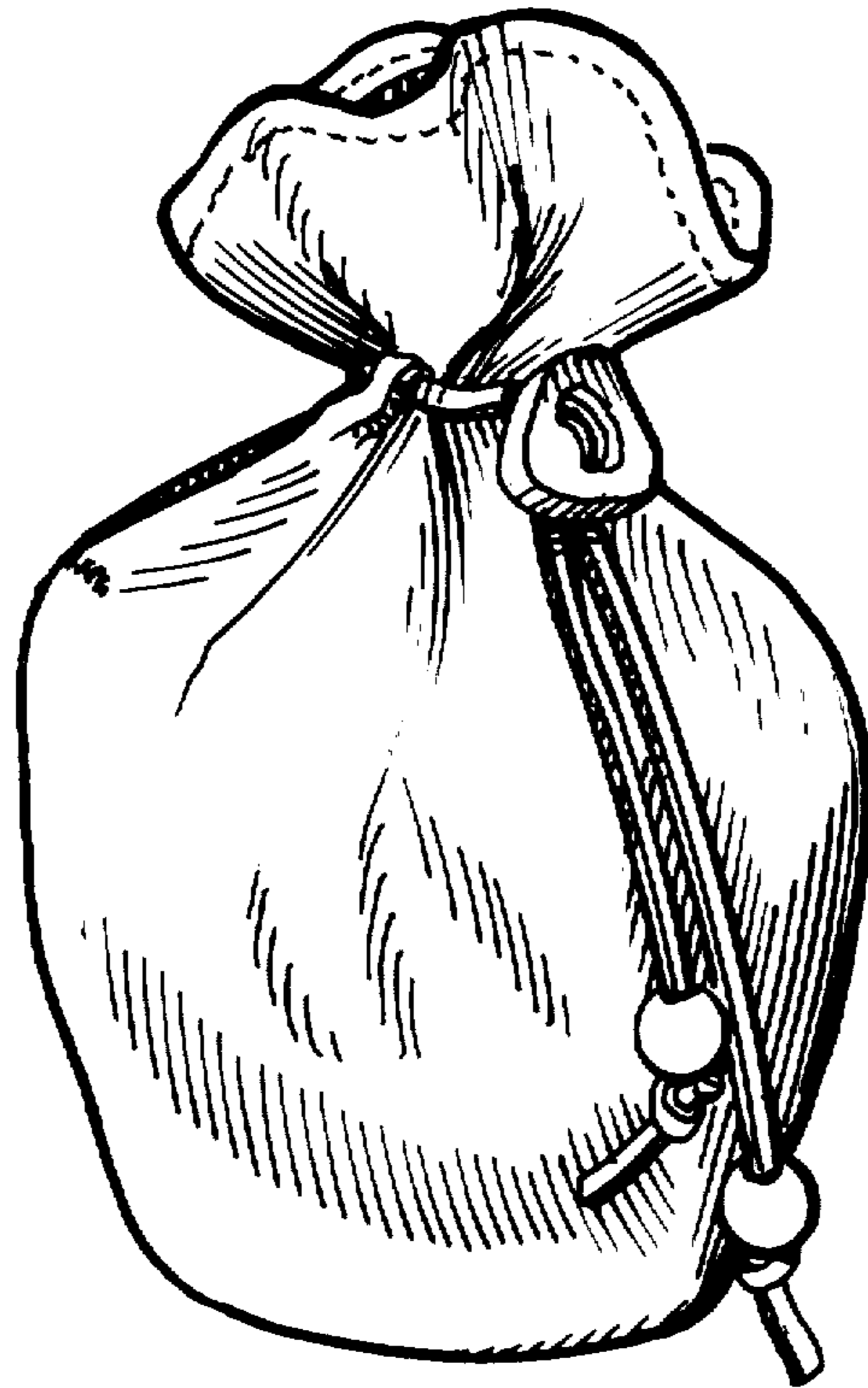

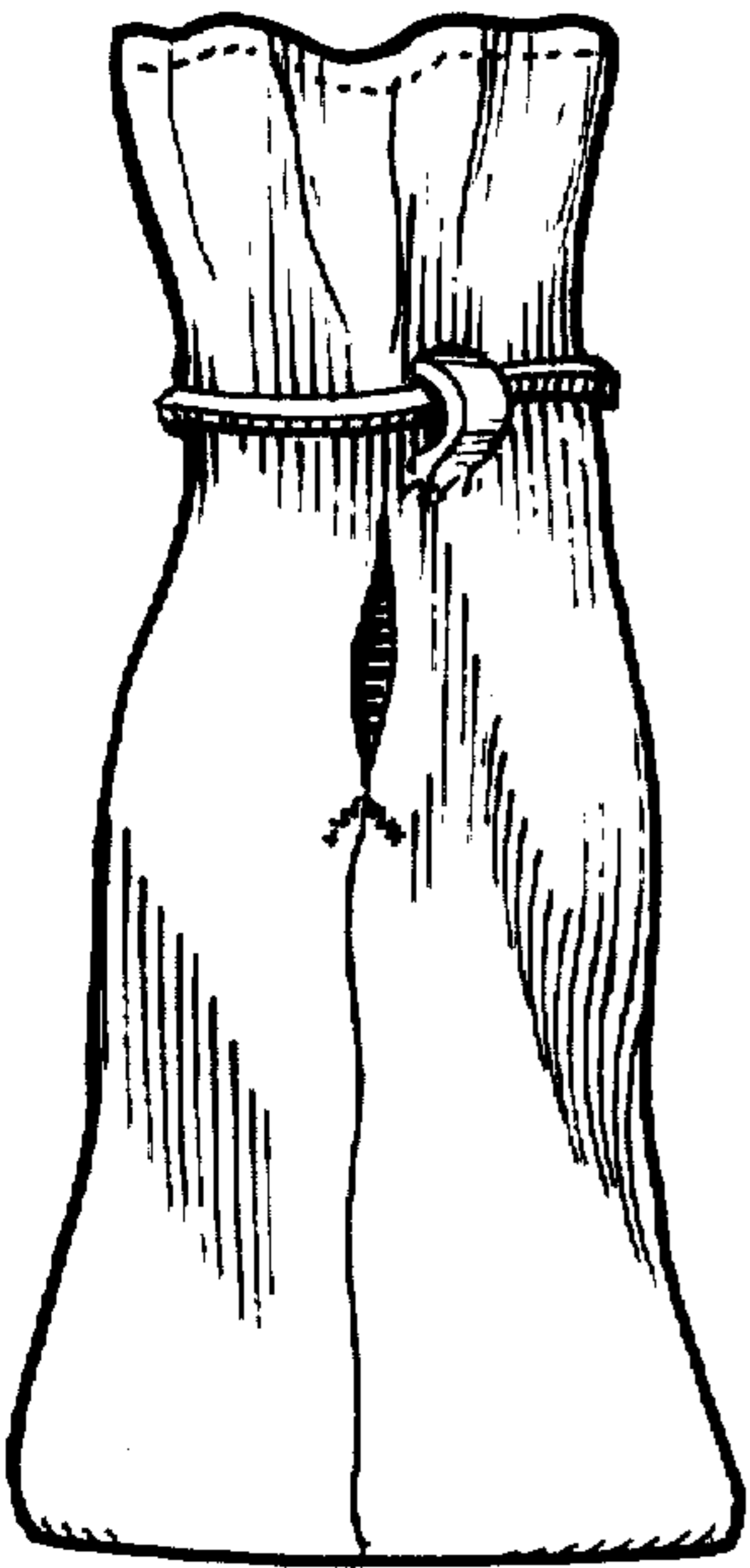
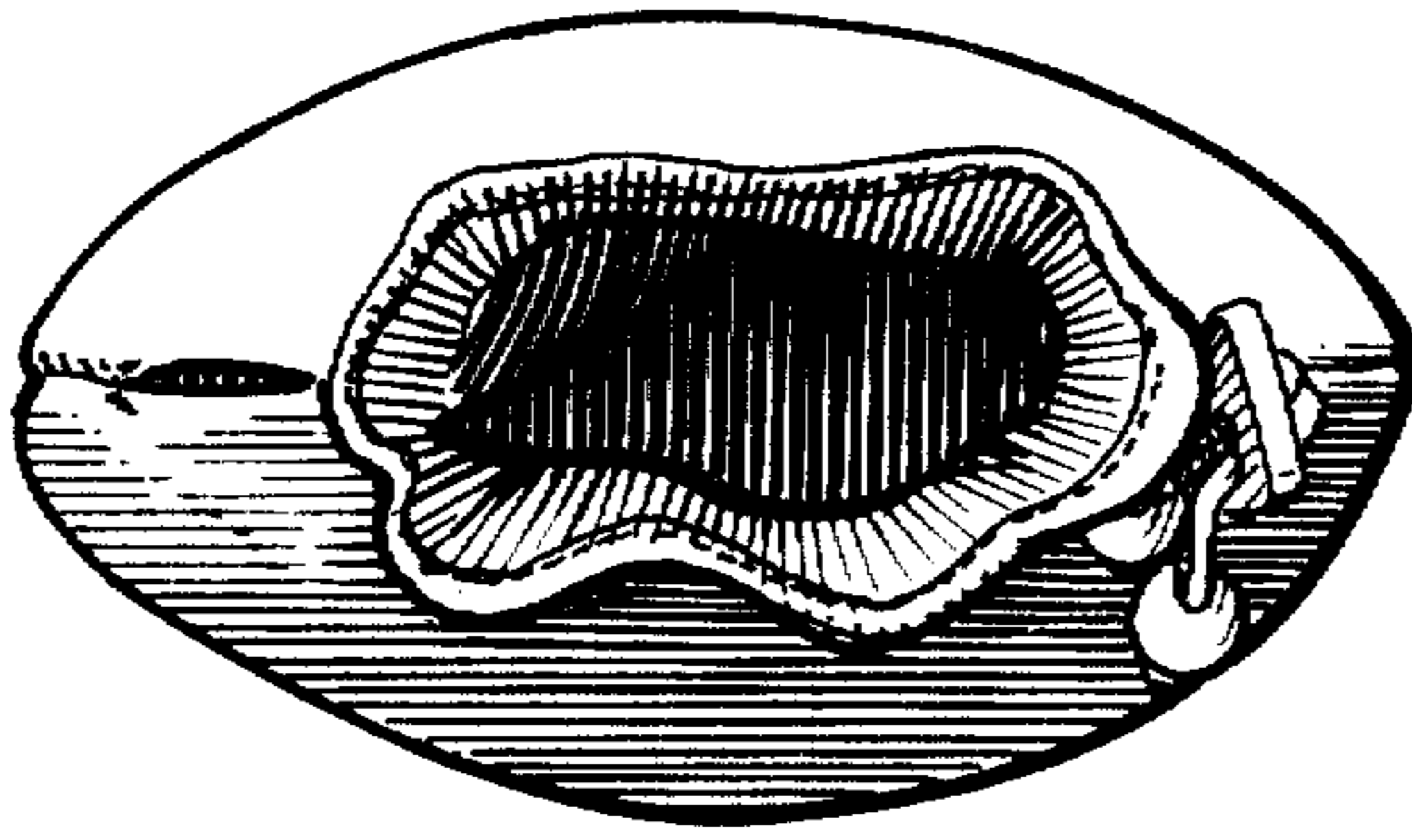

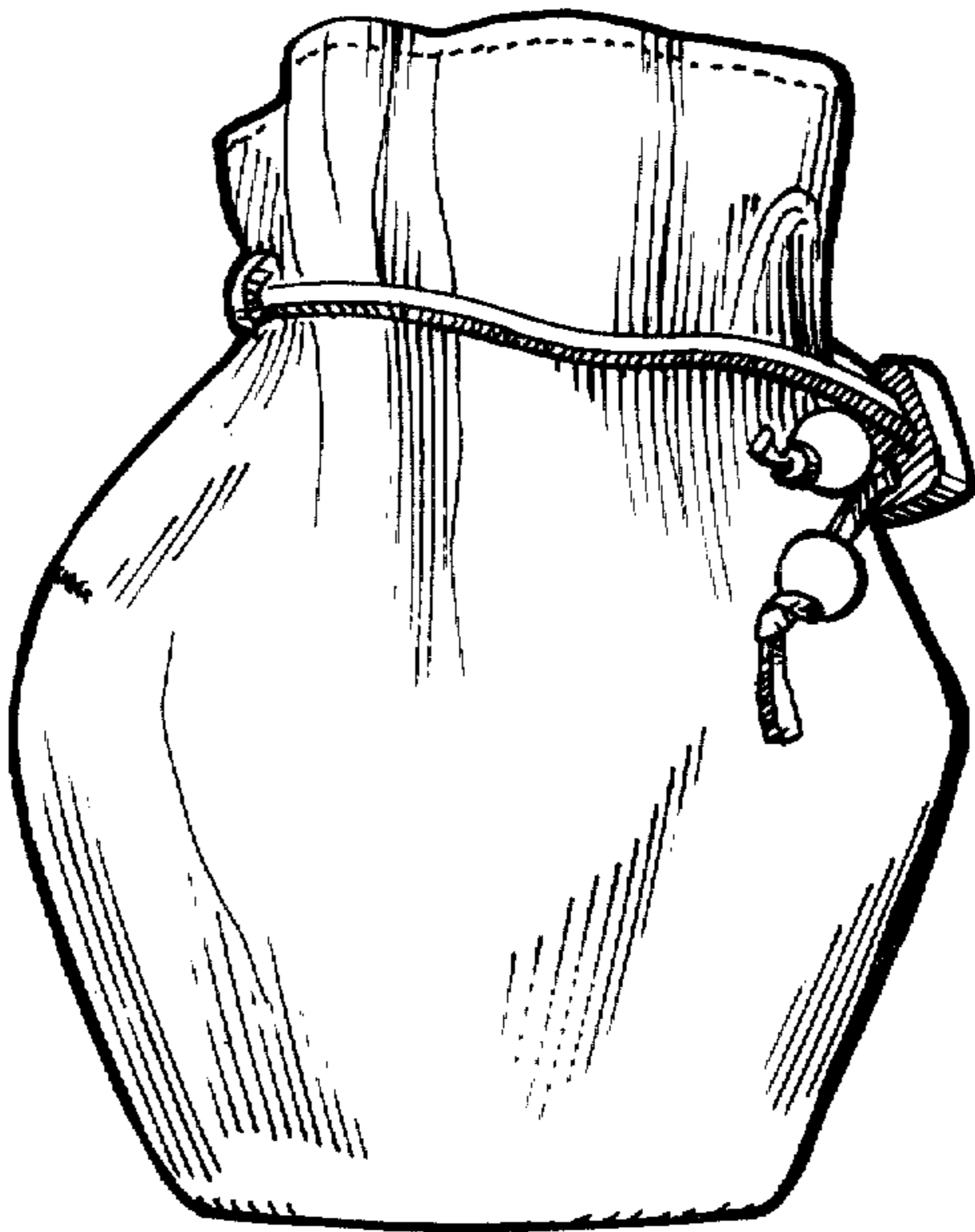

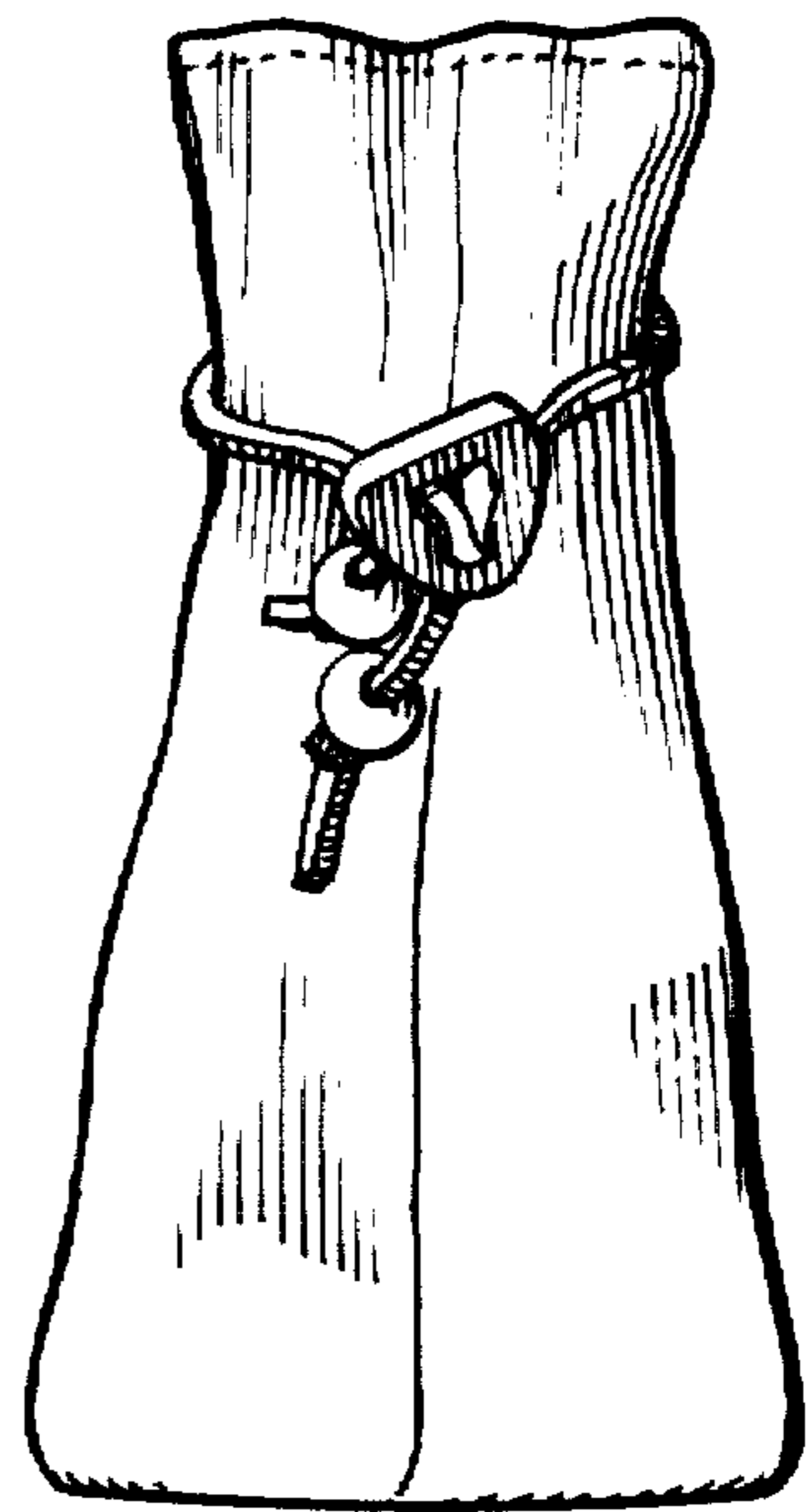

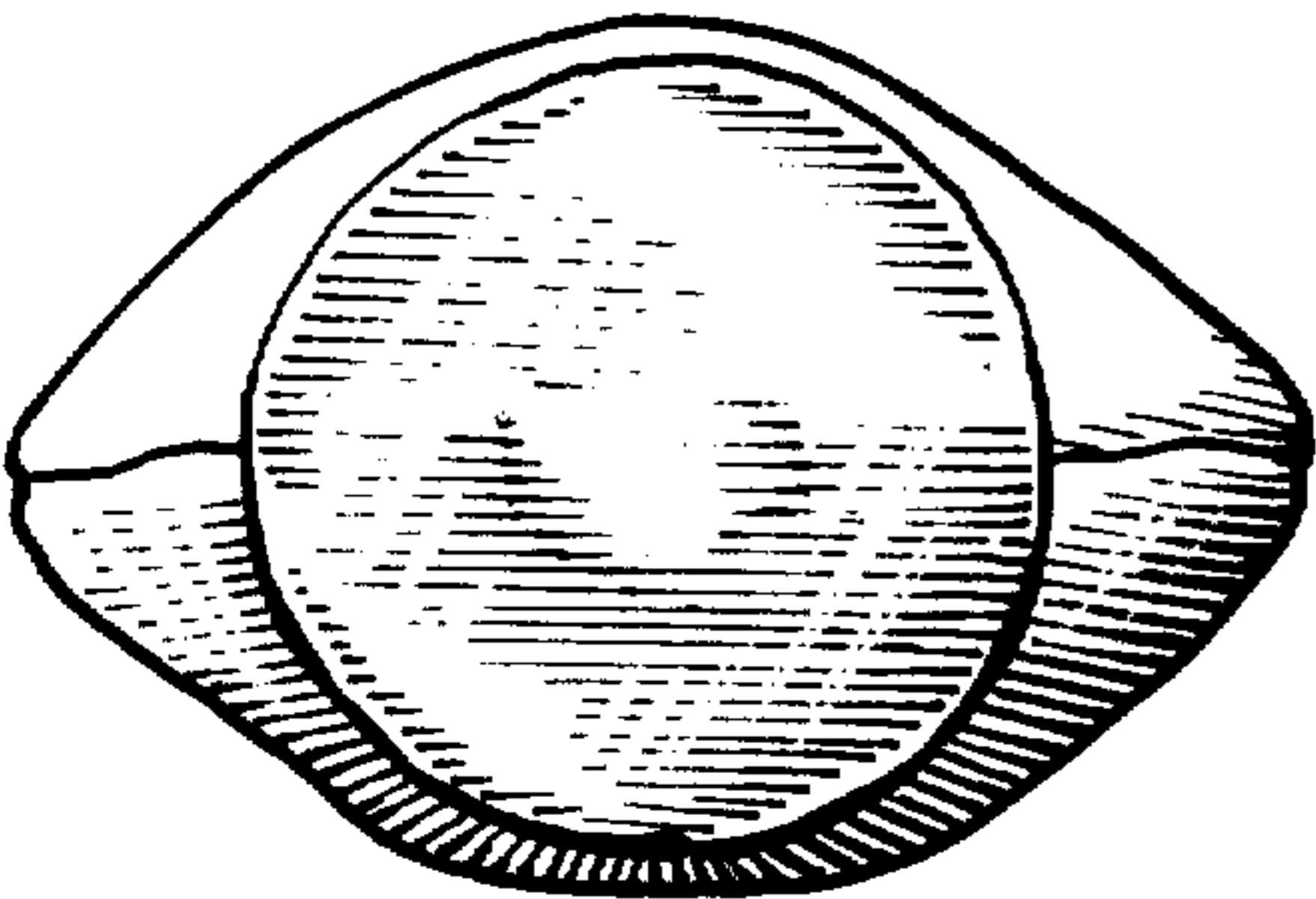

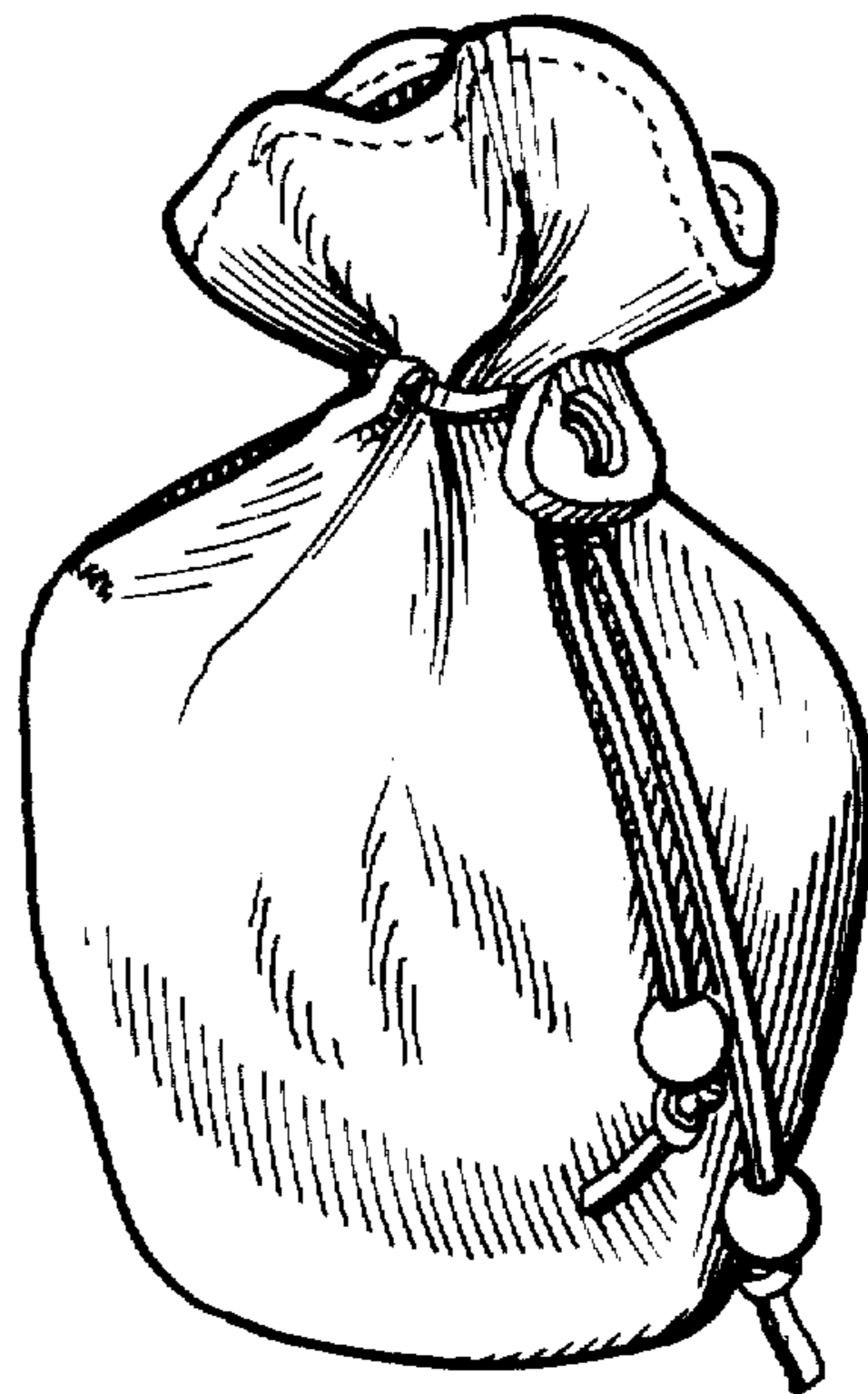
