DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a kettle showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view along 6-6 line in FIG. 4;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a lid thereof.

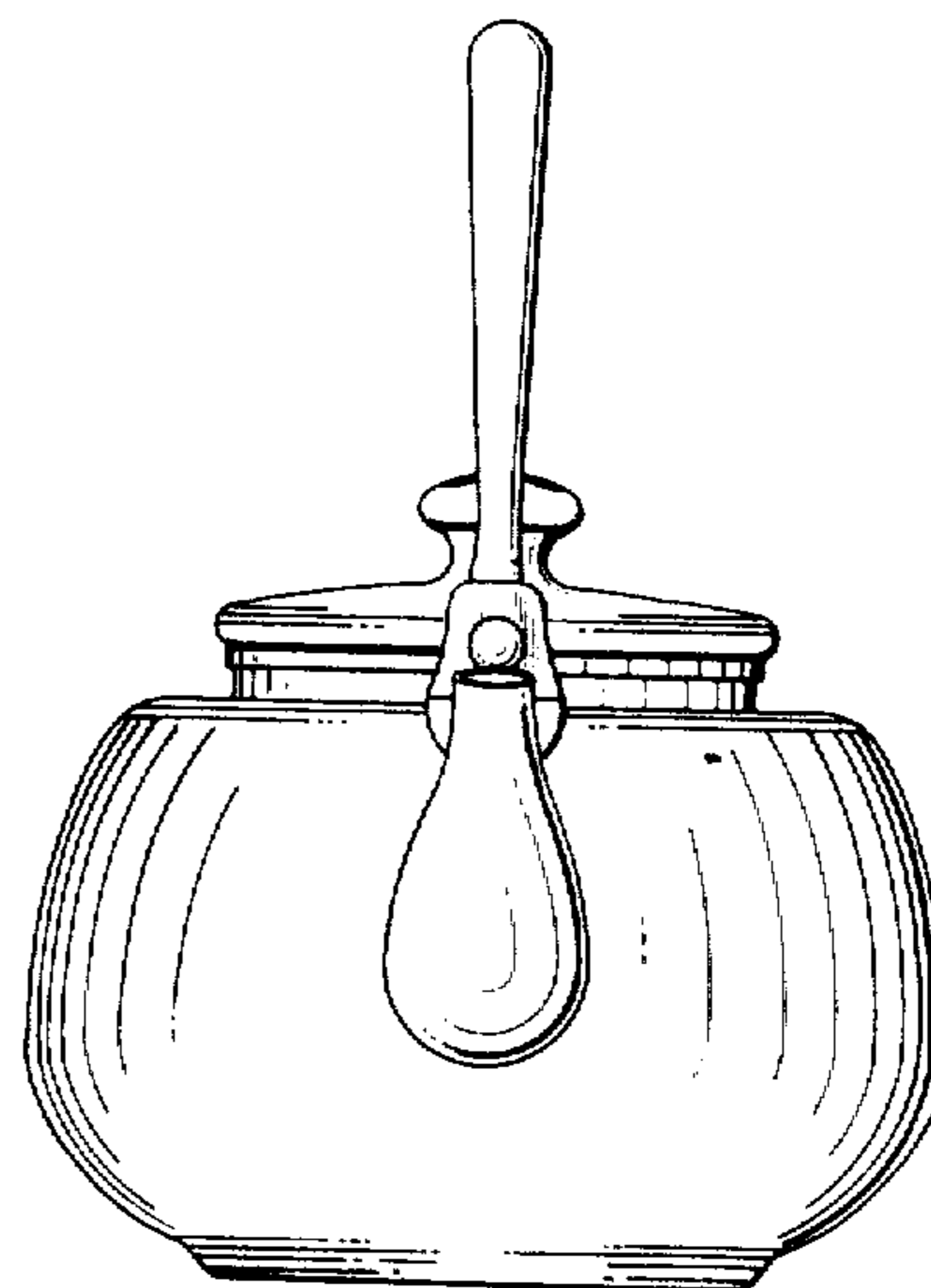

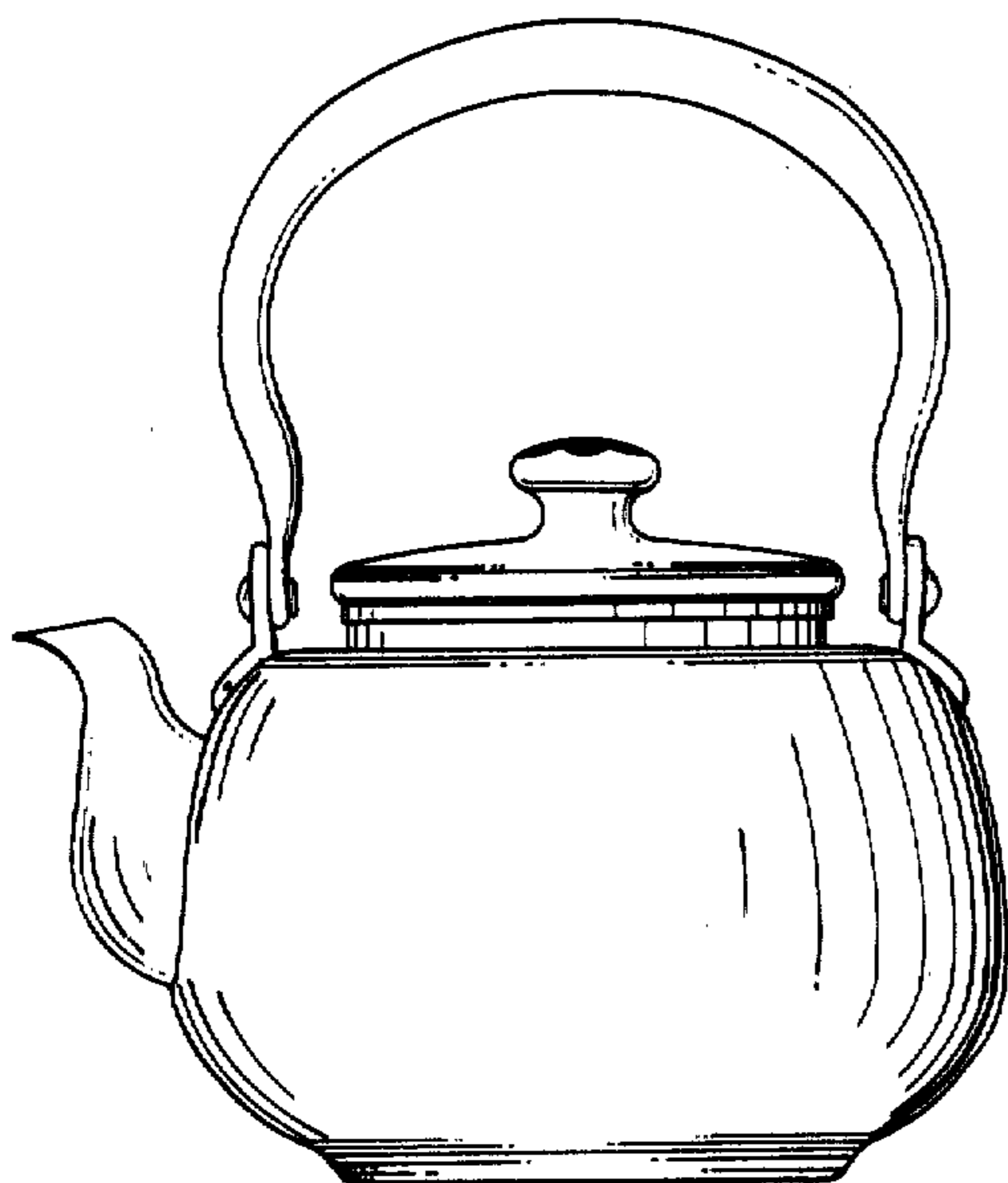

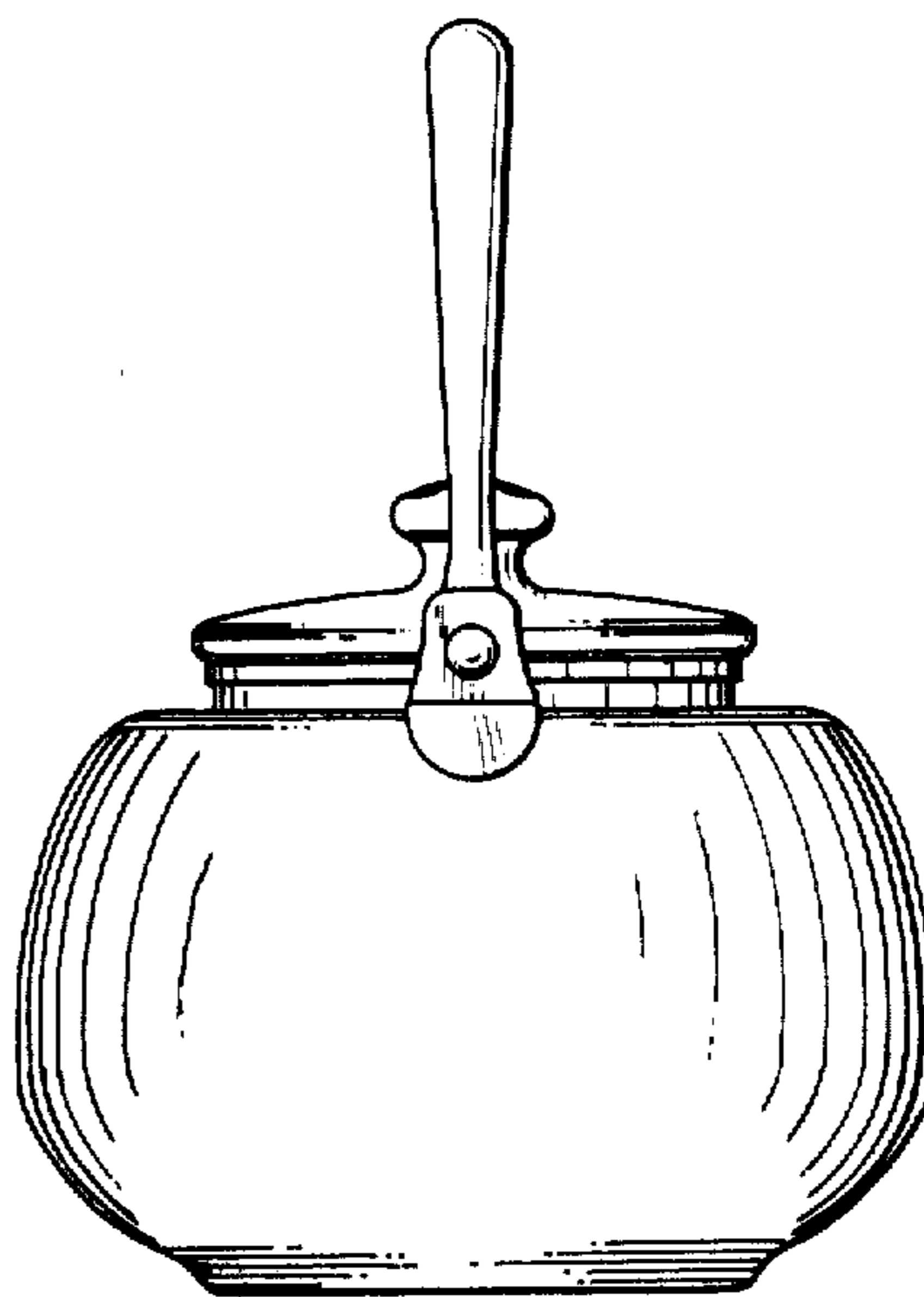

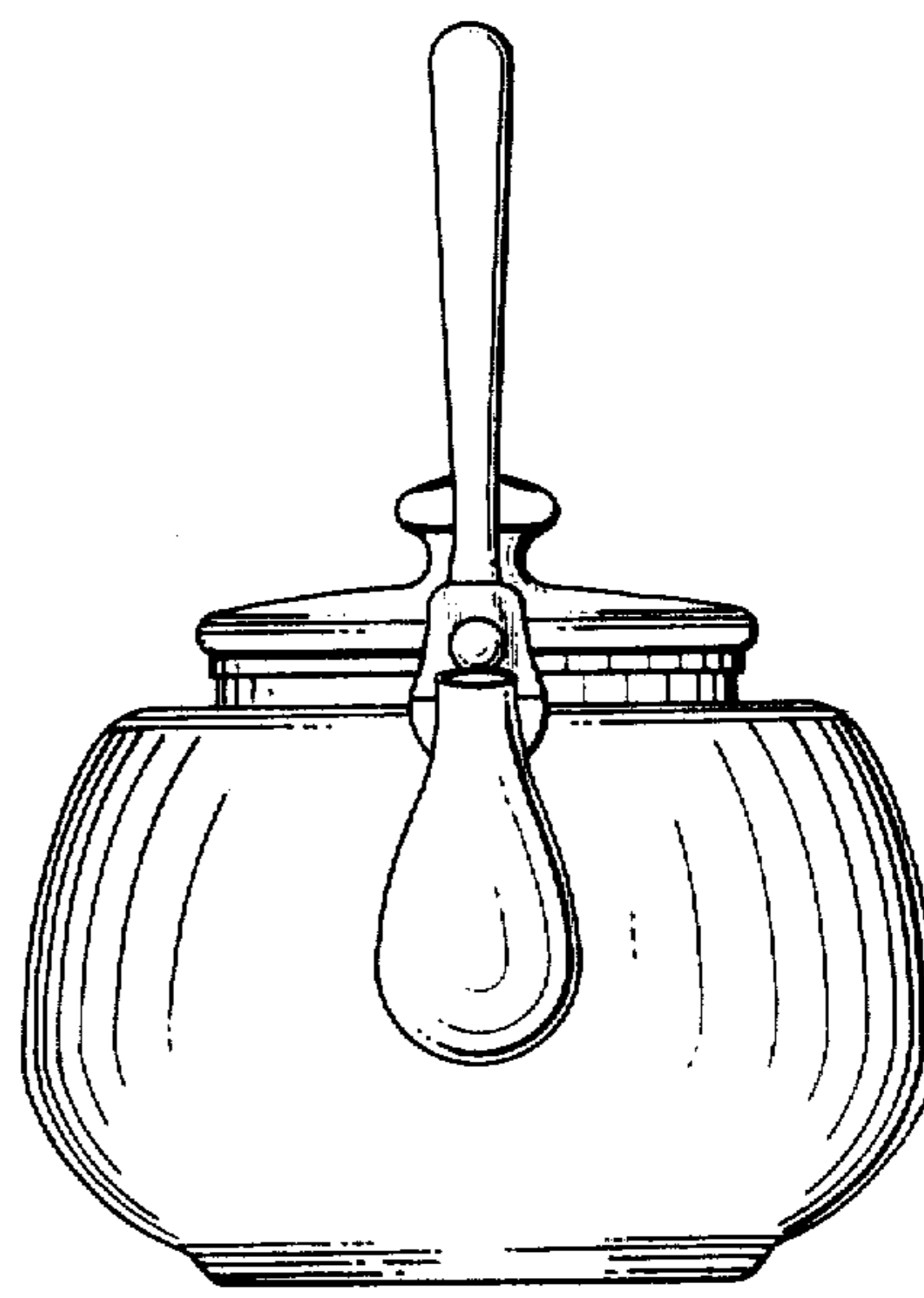

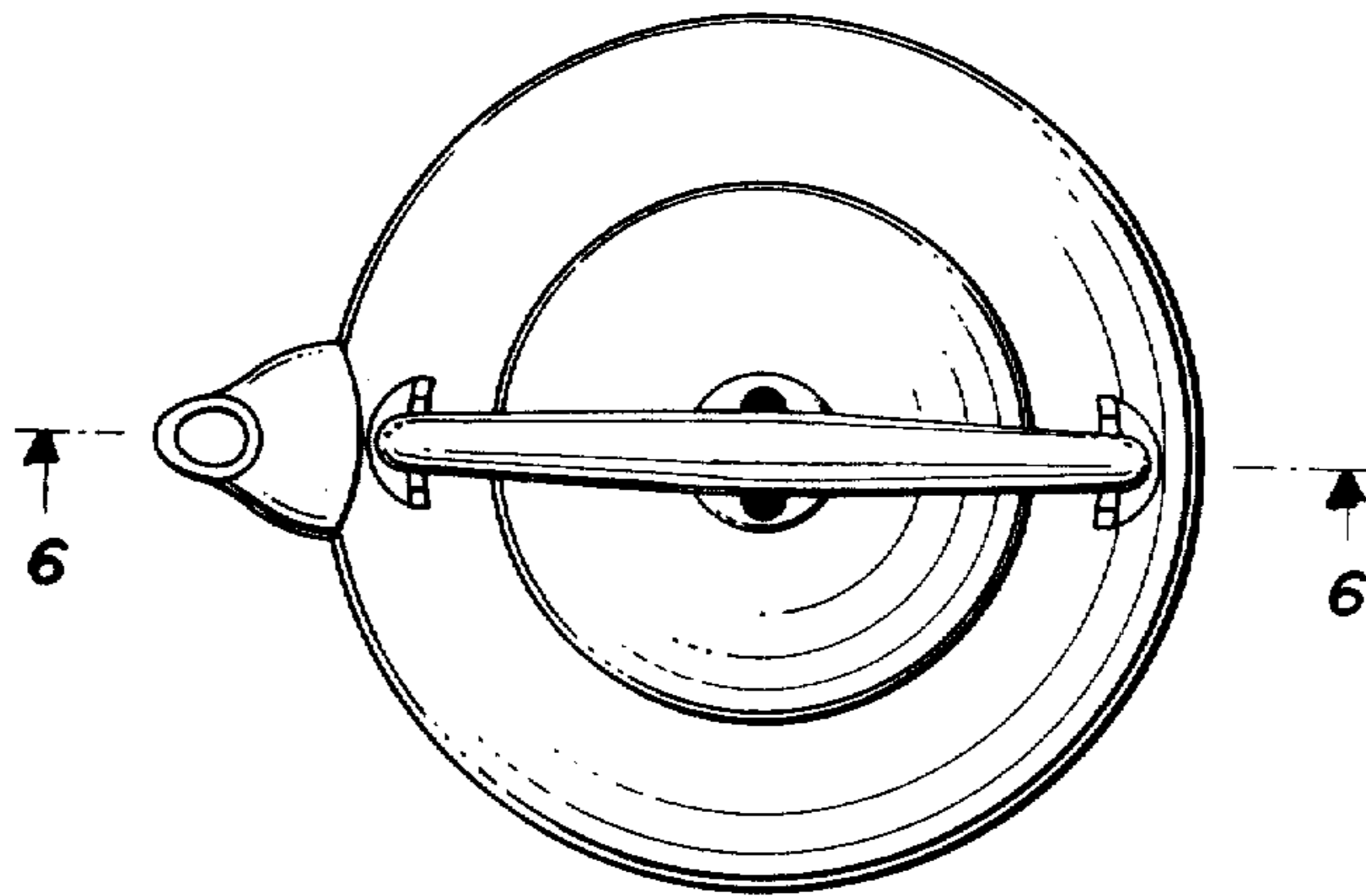

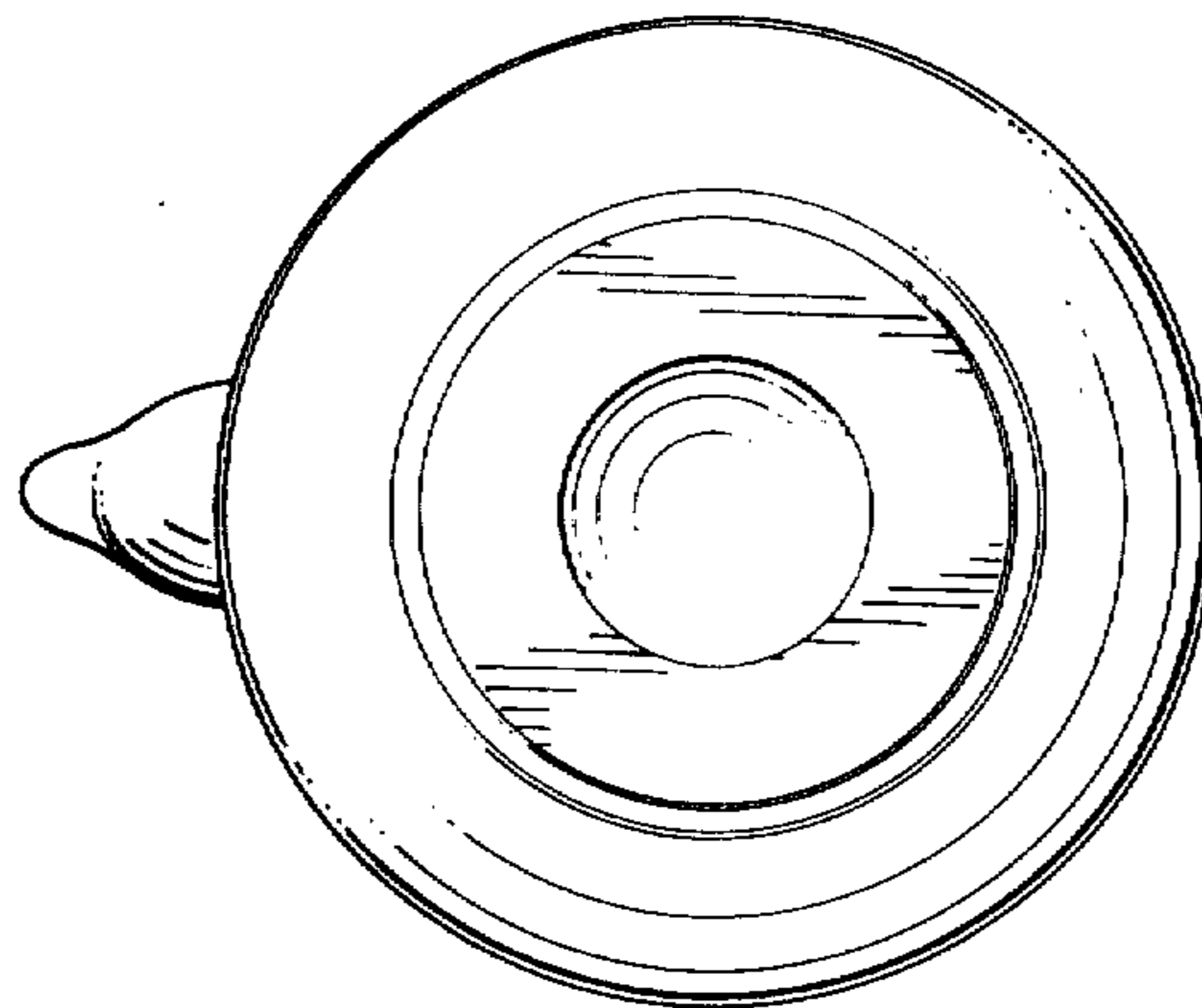
