The ornamental design for a tire, substantially as shown and described.

### **DESCRIPTION**

The FIGURE is a perspective view of a tire showing my new design, it being understood that the pattern is repeated throughout the circumference of the tire, as shown schematically by solid lines, the opposite side being substantially the same as that shown.
