DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a cane showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of a modified form of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 4.

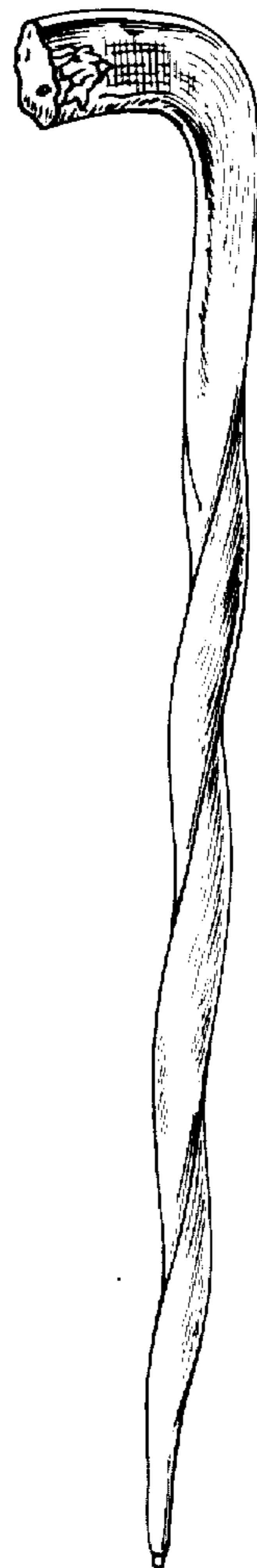

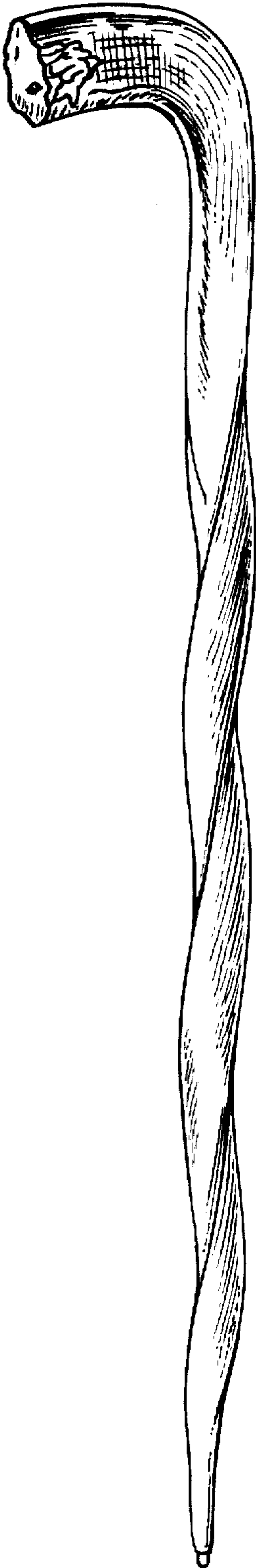

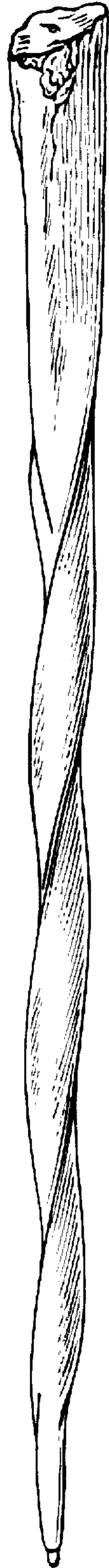
