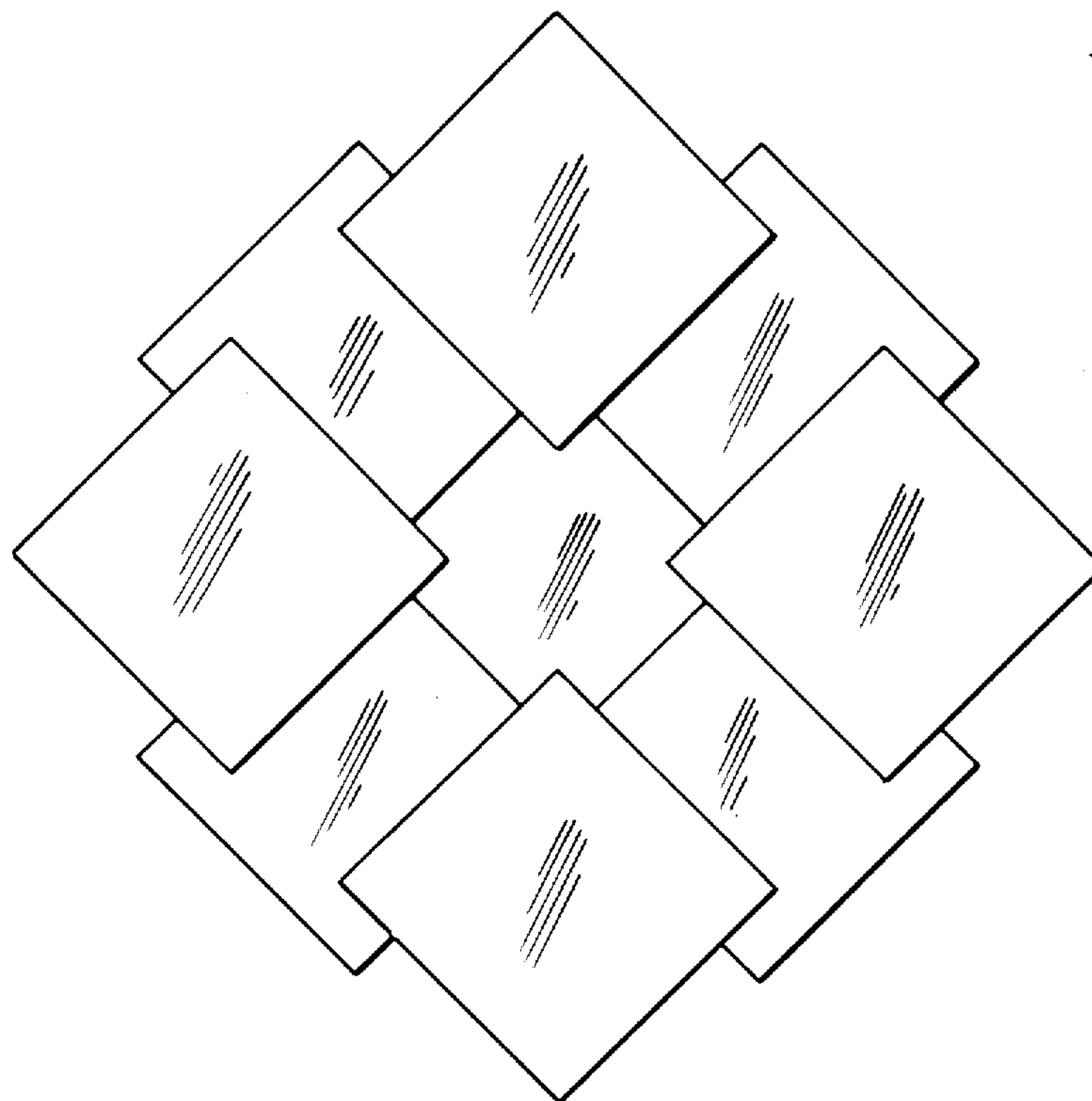

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mirror showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 3 is an elevational view thereof taken along line 3—3 in FIG. 1, the end opposite being a mirror image.



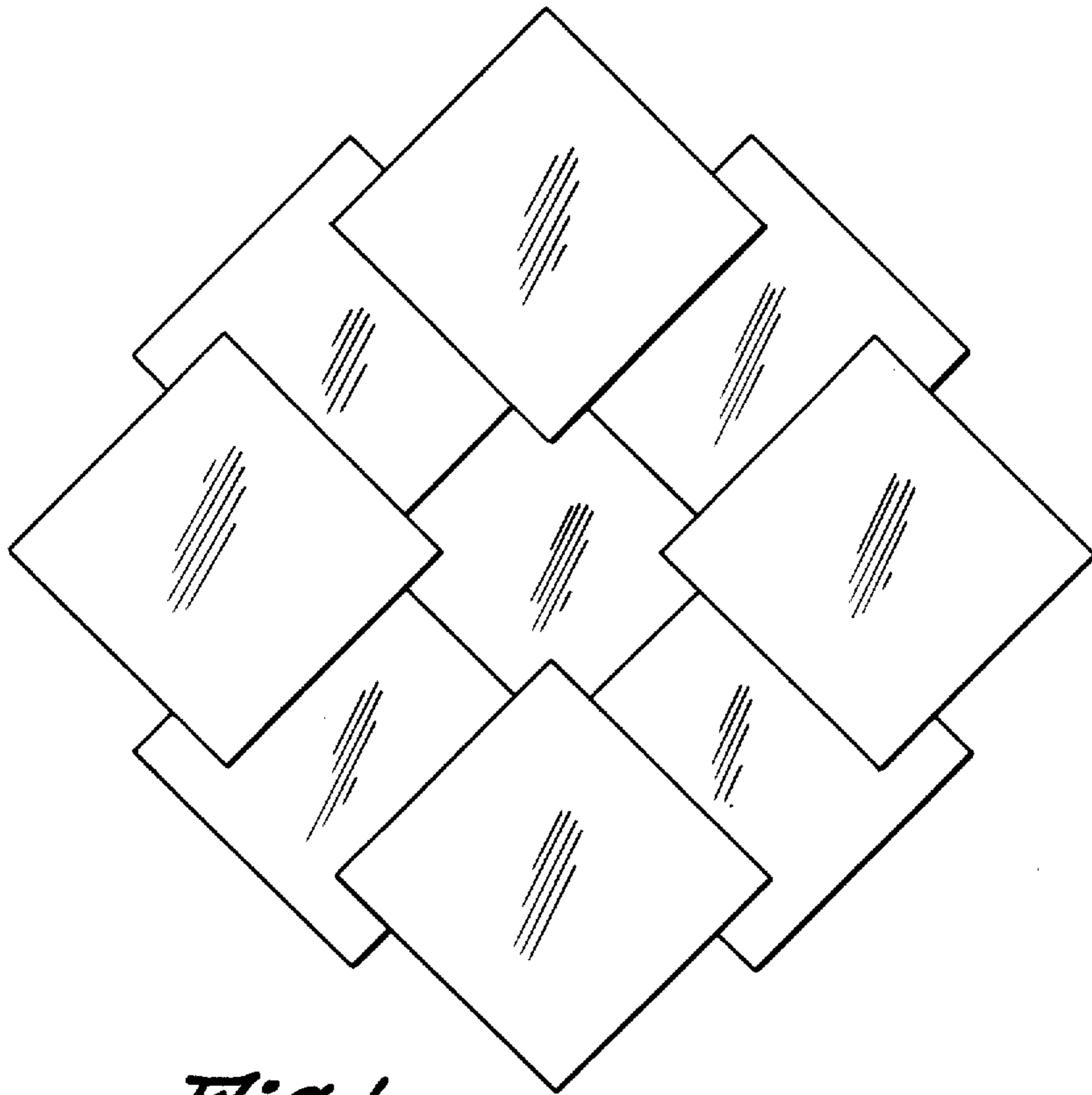

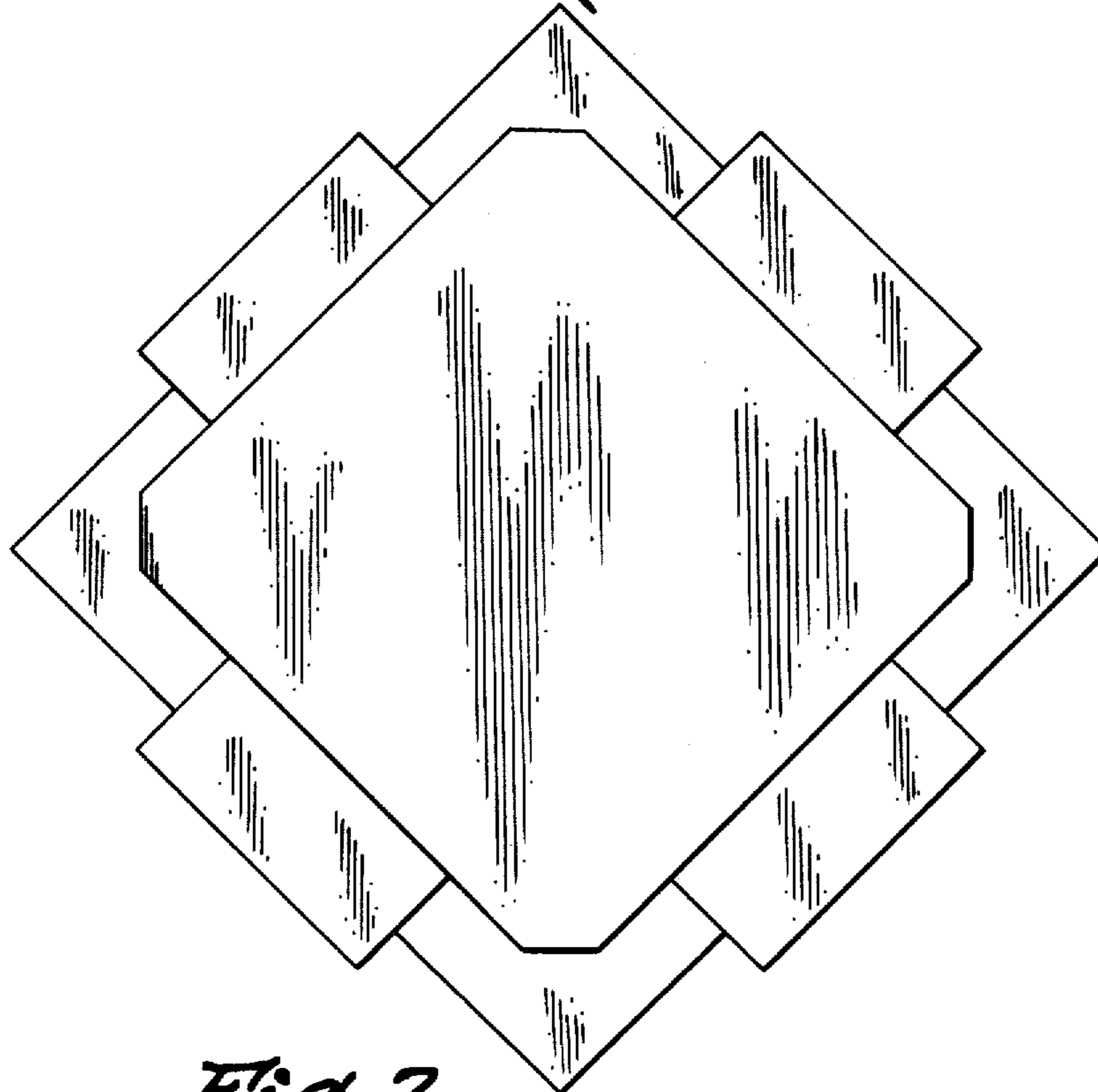
