[57] **CLAIM**  
The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**  
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spoon showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and  
FIGS. 4, 5 and 6 are enlarged sectional views taken along lines 4-4, 5-5, and 6-6, respectively, of FIG. 1.  
The essential features of my design reside in the handle portion as shown in the accompanying drawings.

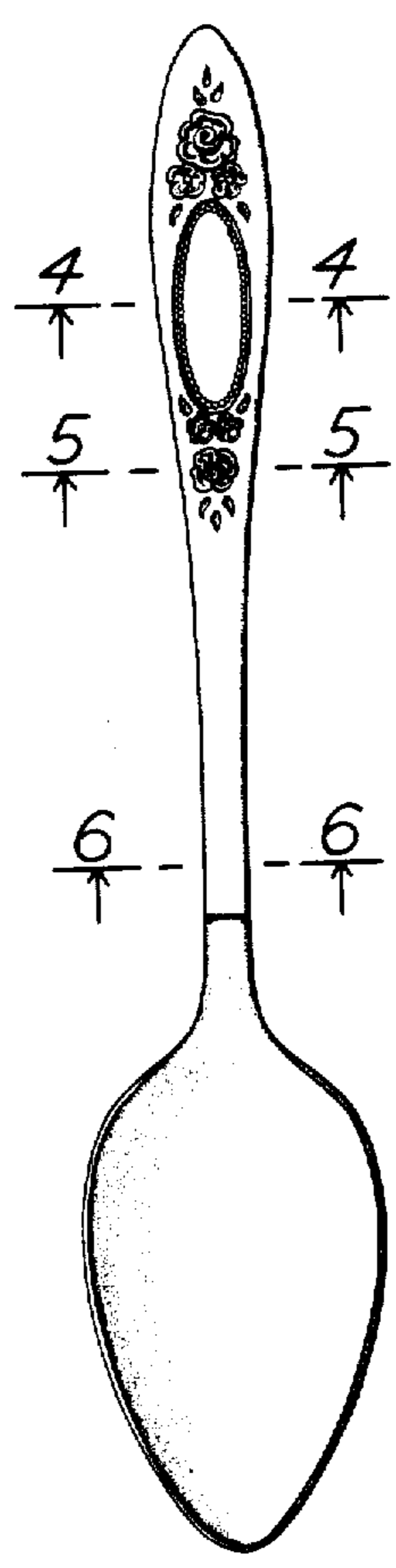

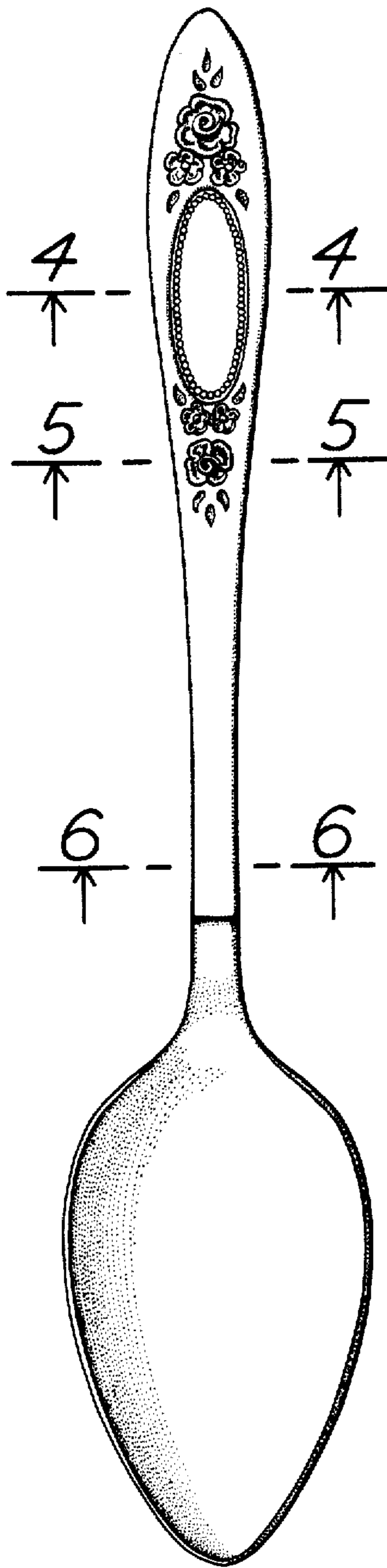

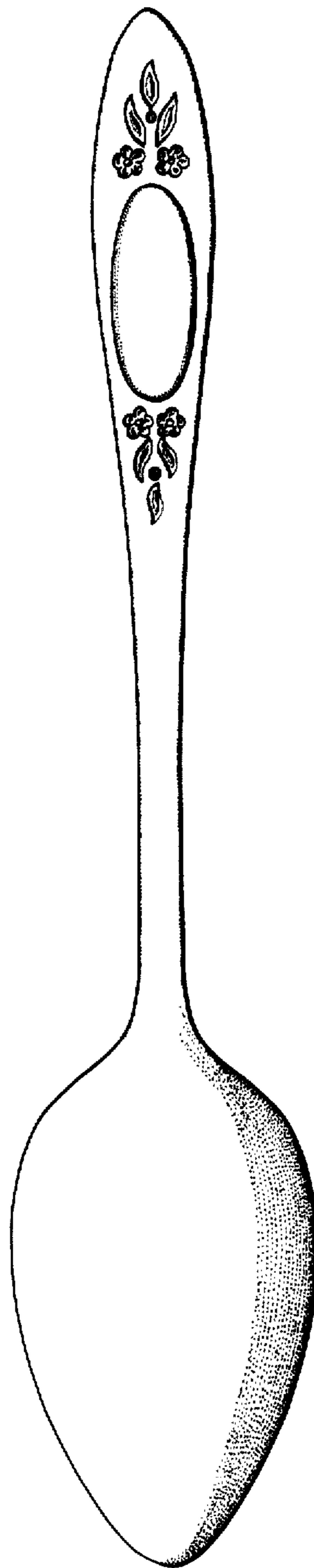

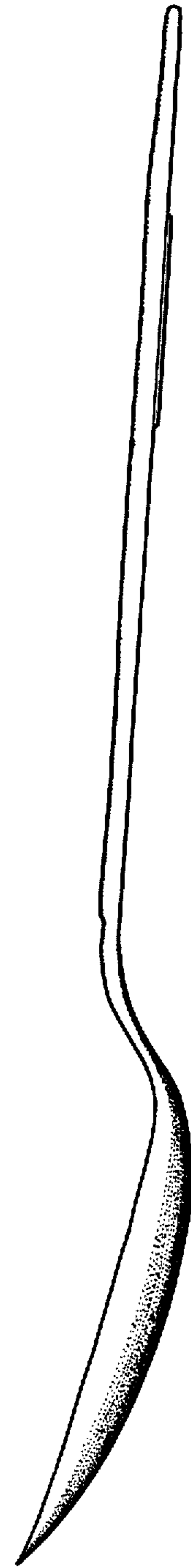
