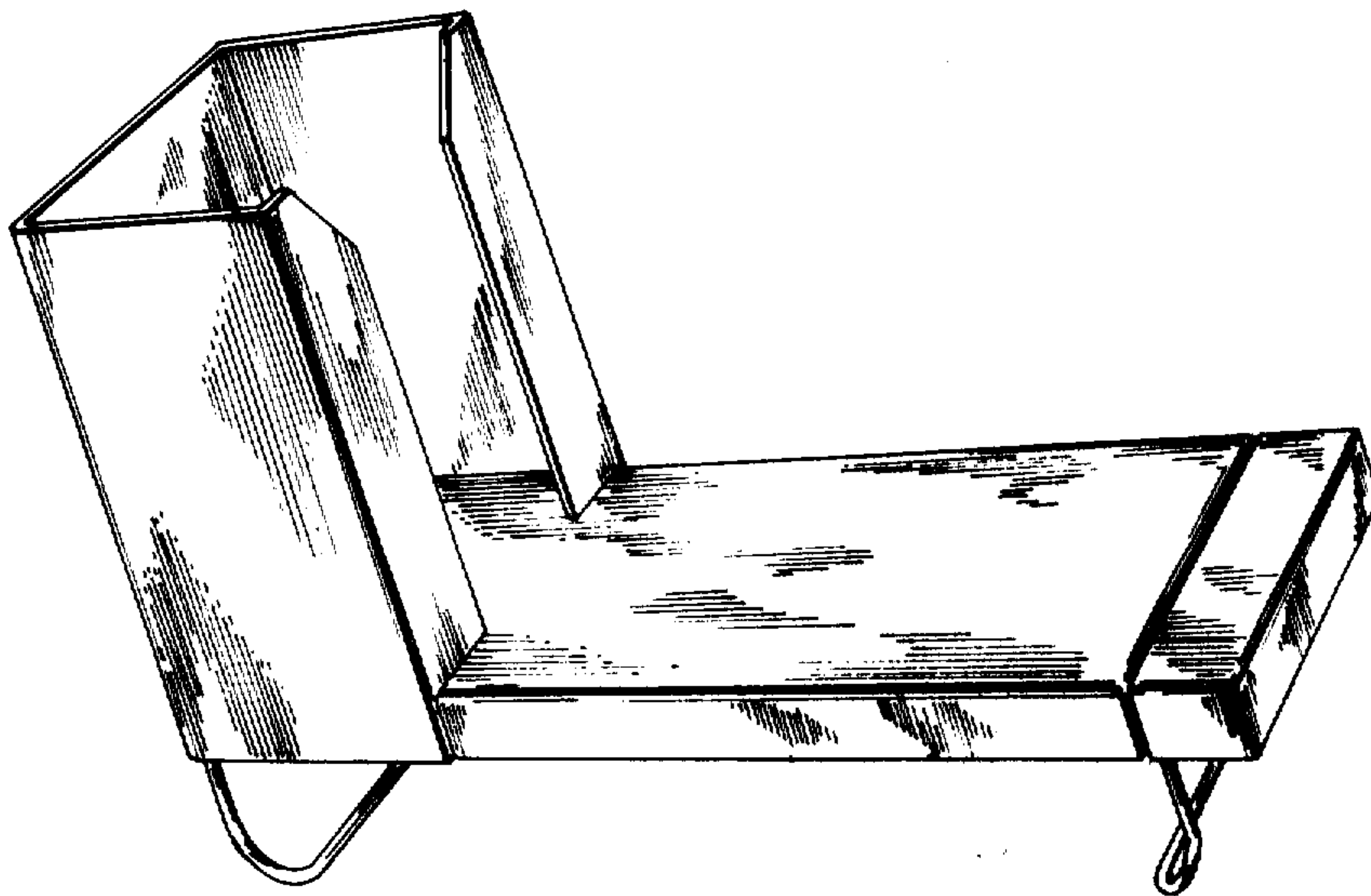

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an iron holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an iron holder, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view showing the front lip and clamp in extended position, preparatory for placement across the top surface of an ironing board;
FIG. 6 is a left end elevational view taken from the view shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a right end elevational view taken from the view shown in FIG. 1.



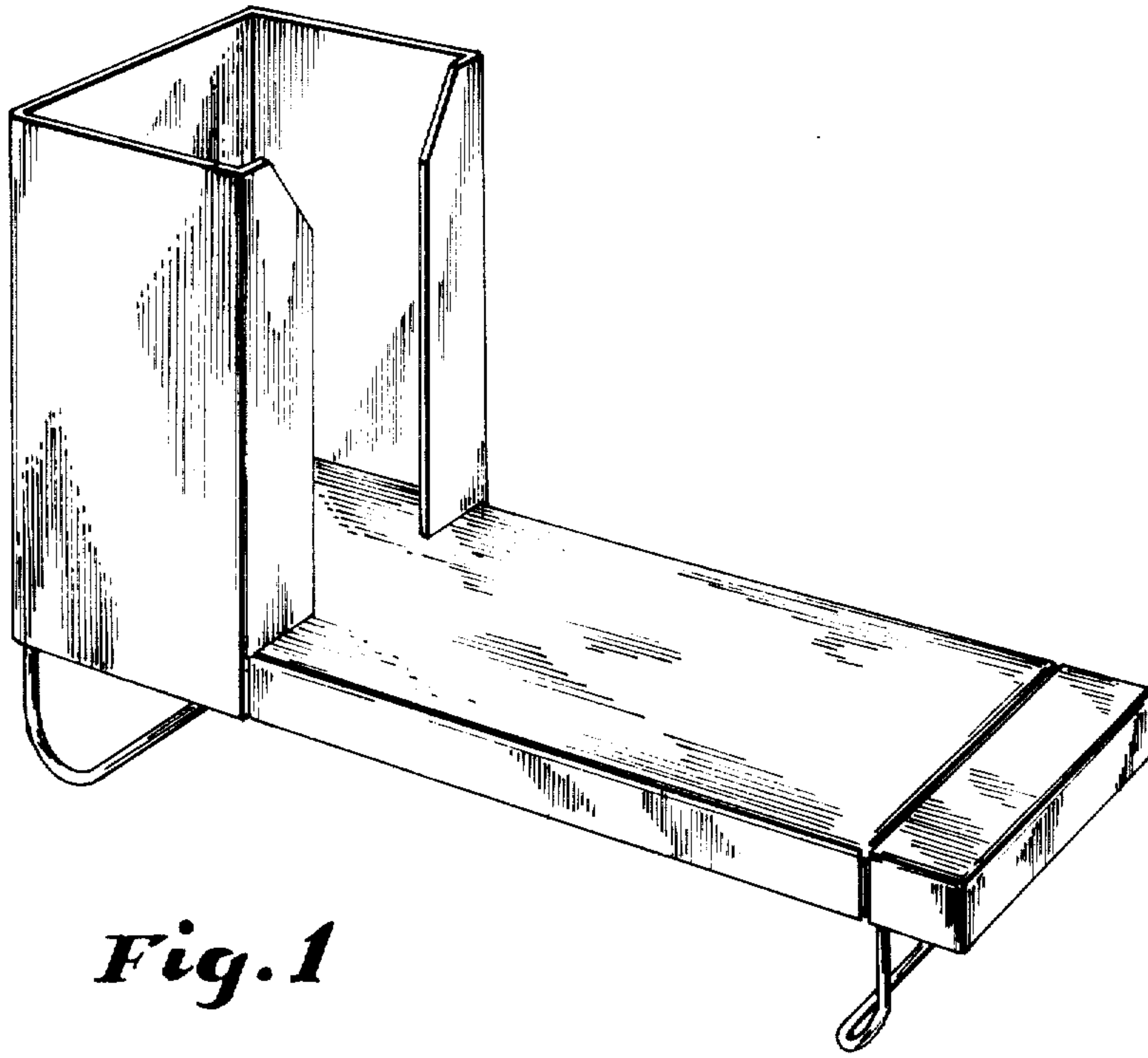

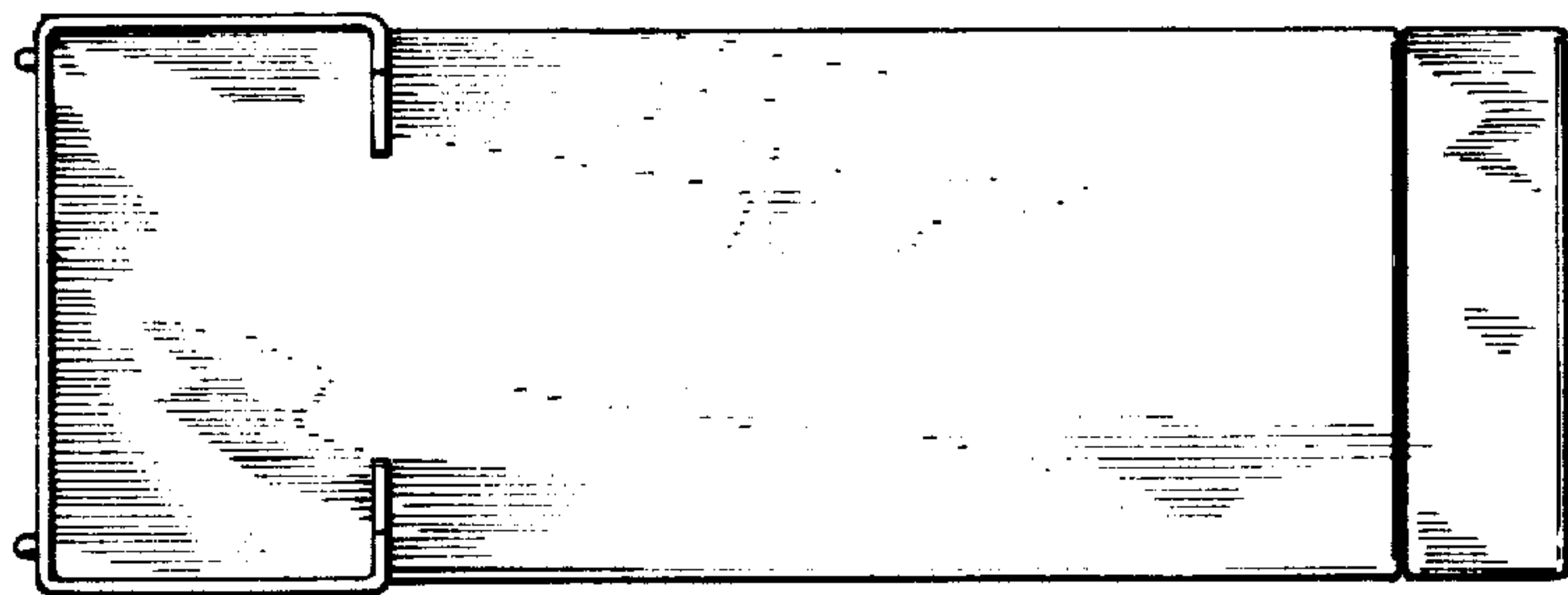

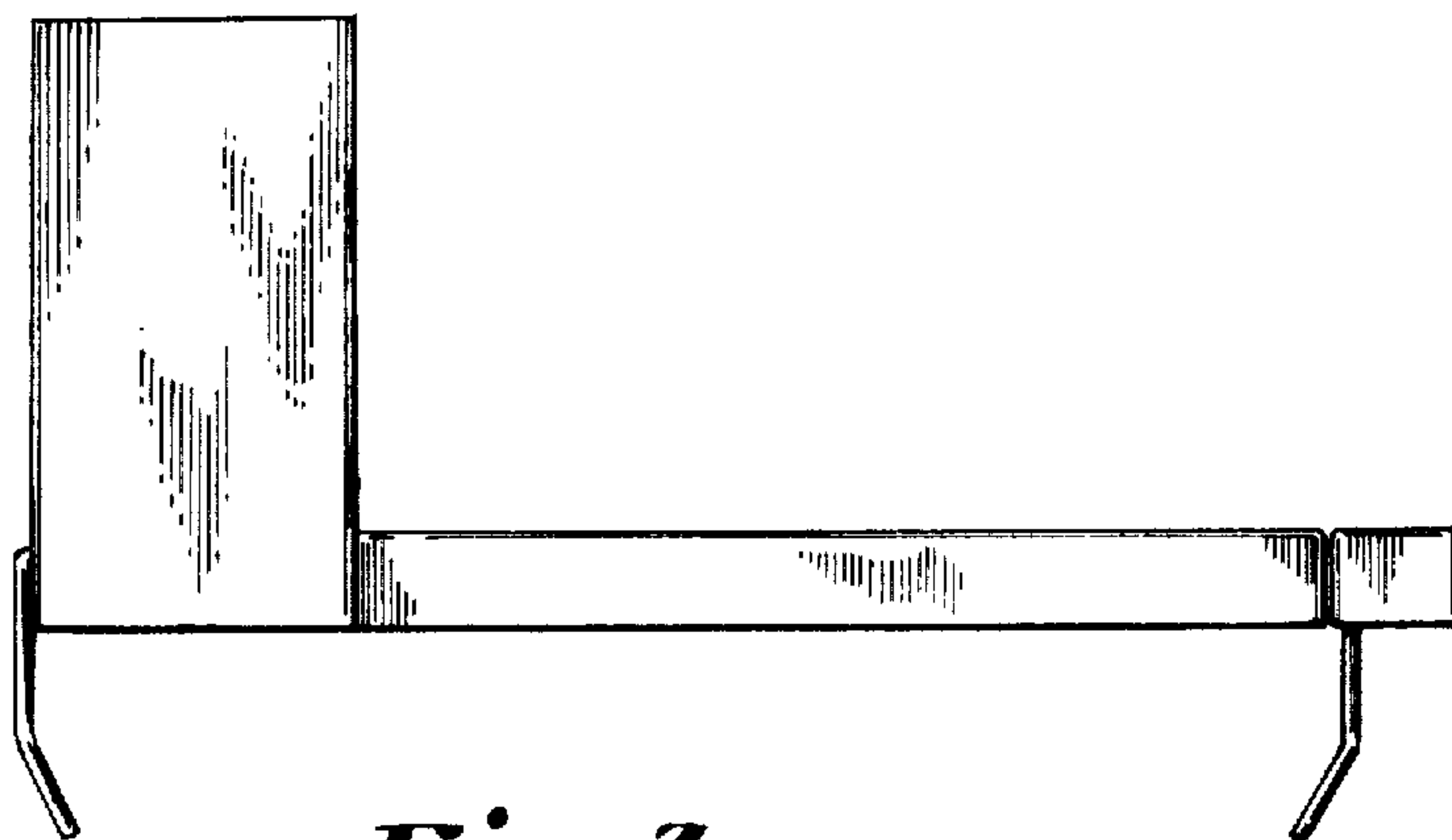

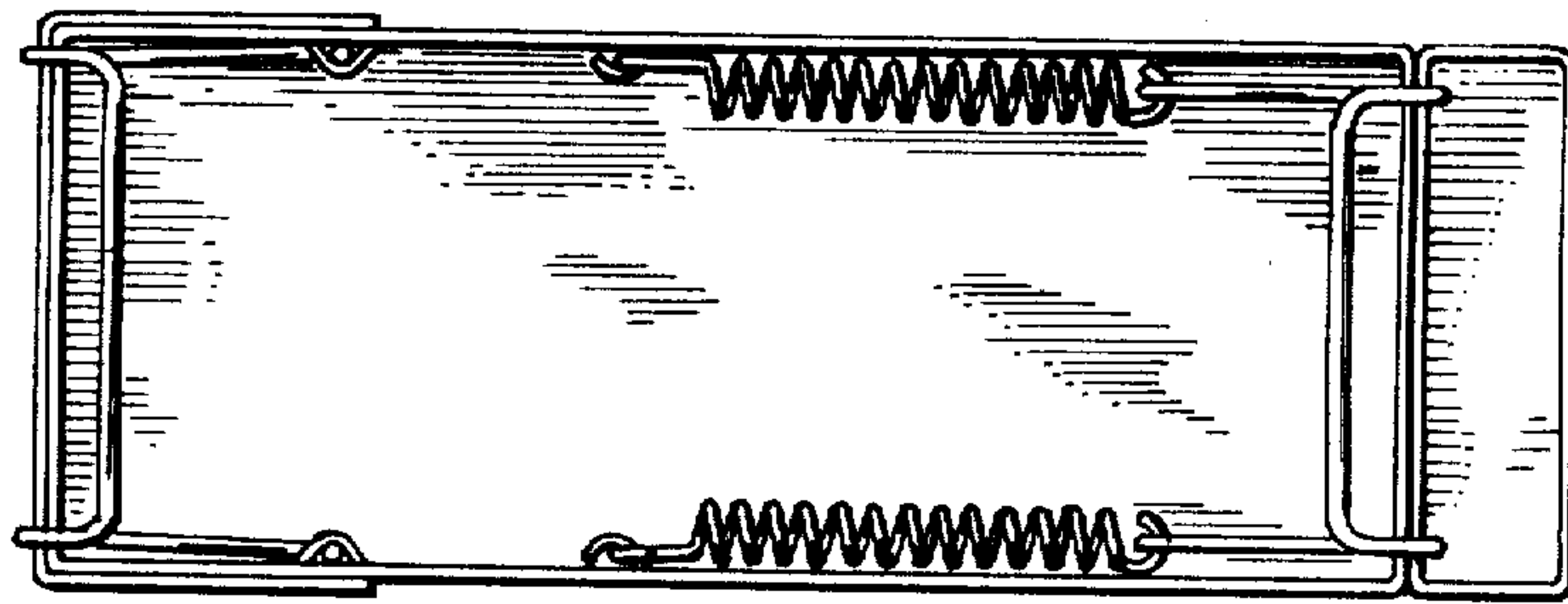

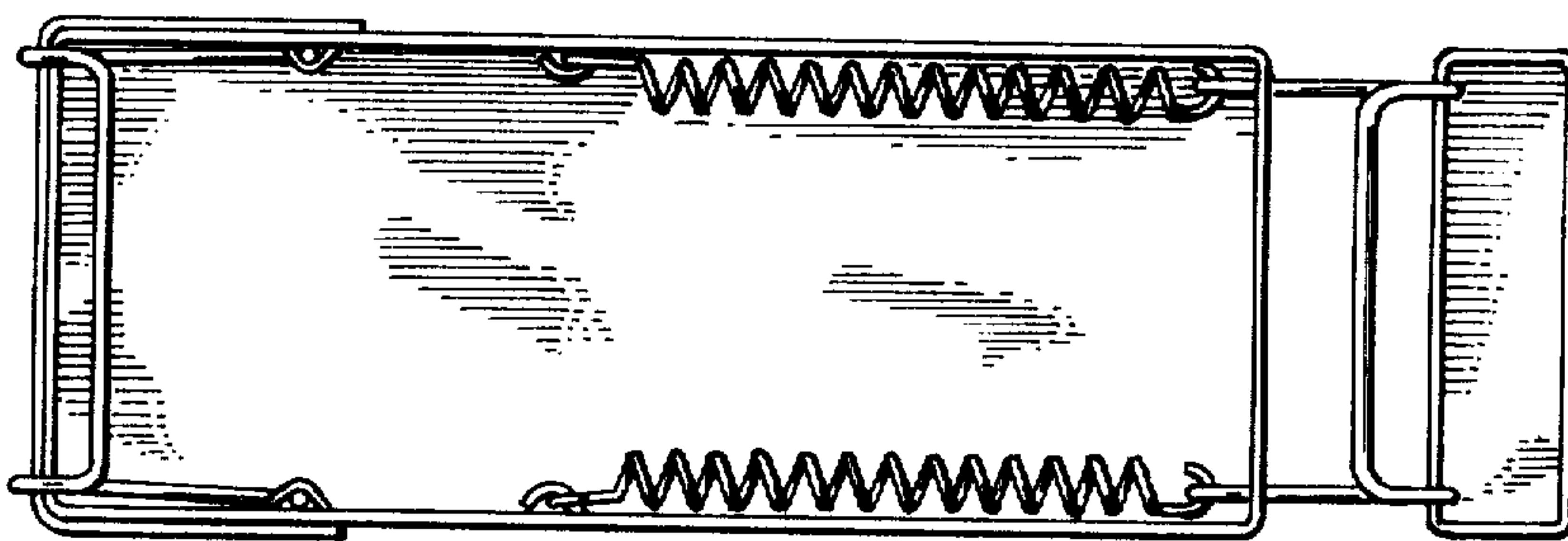

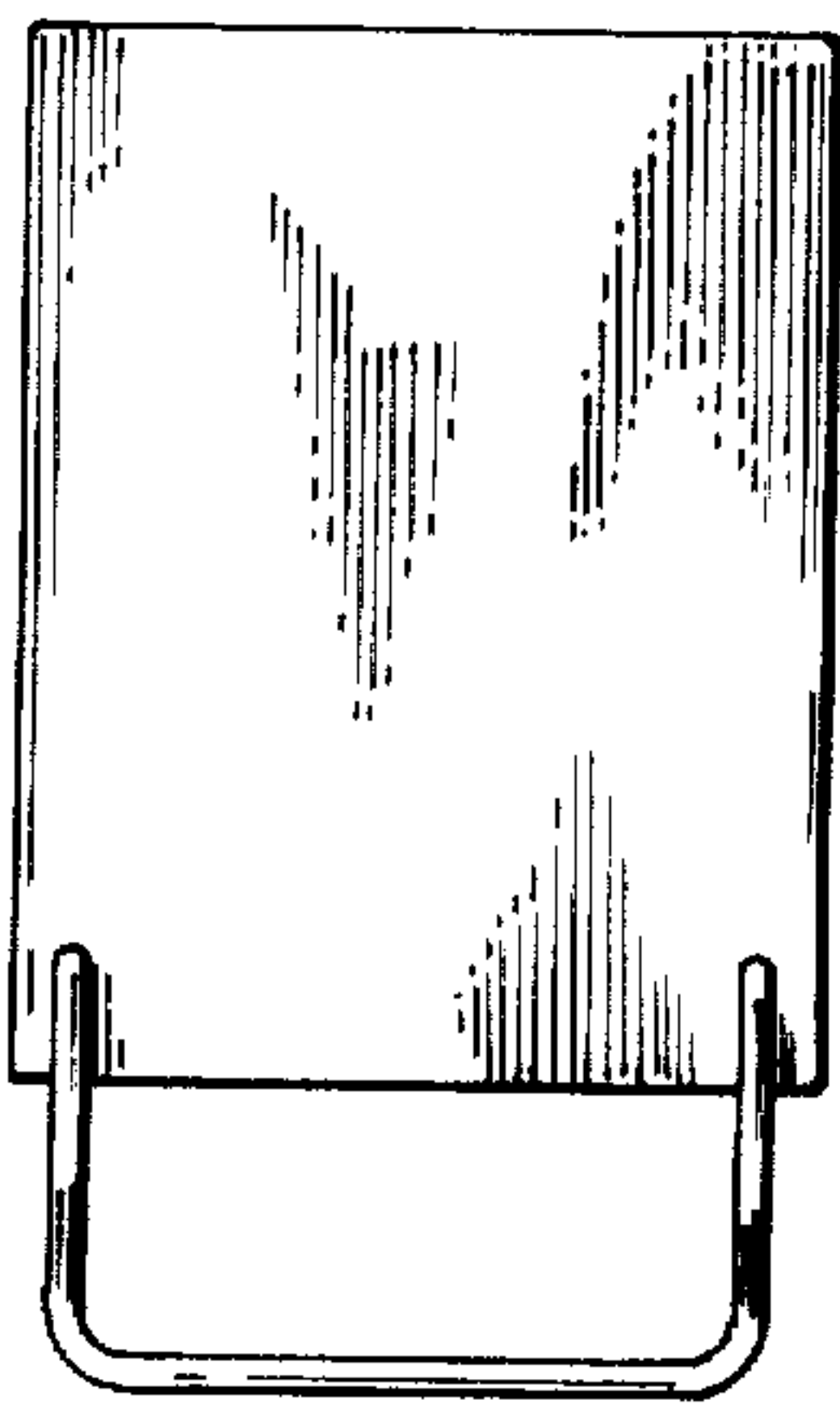

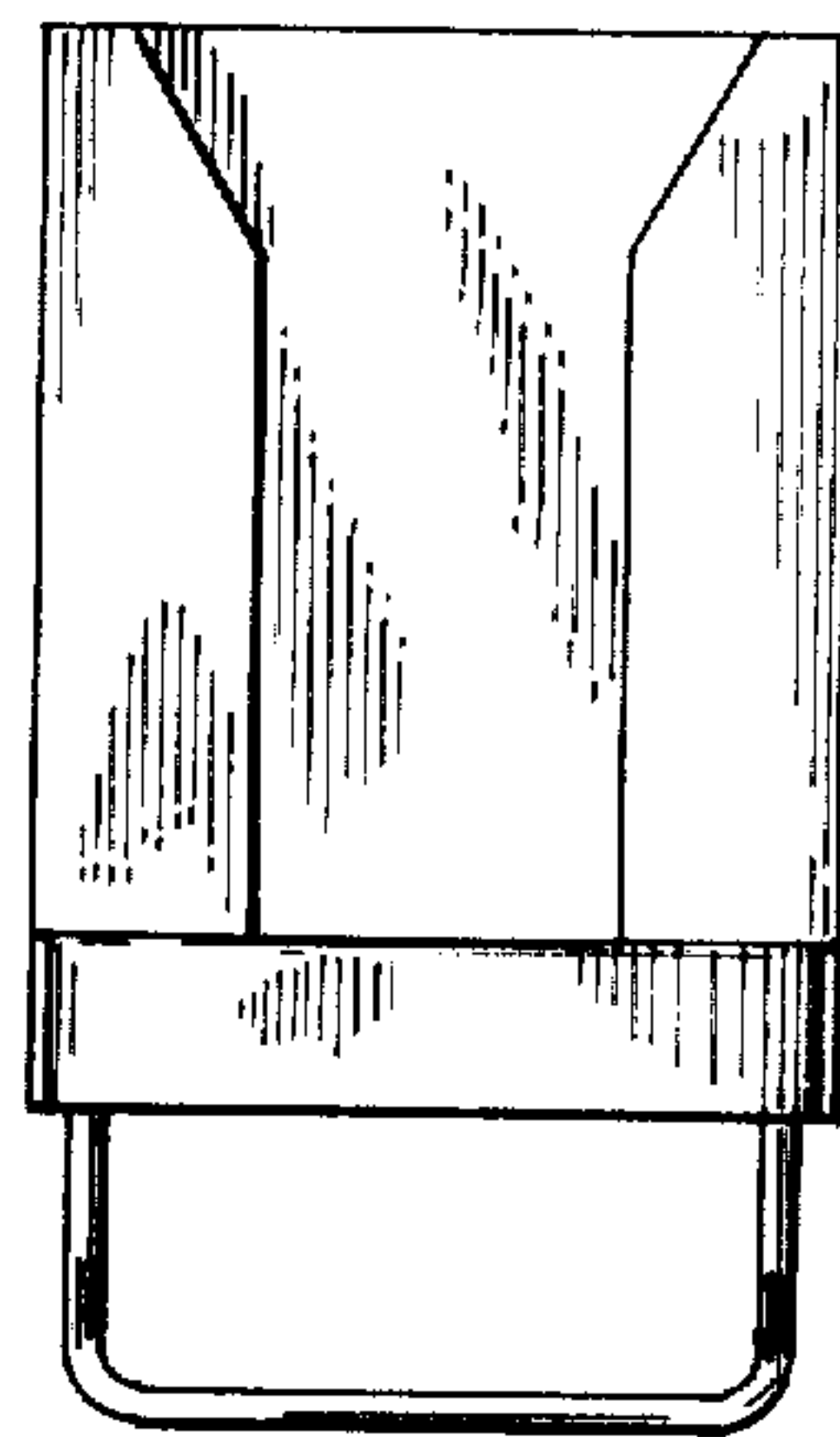
