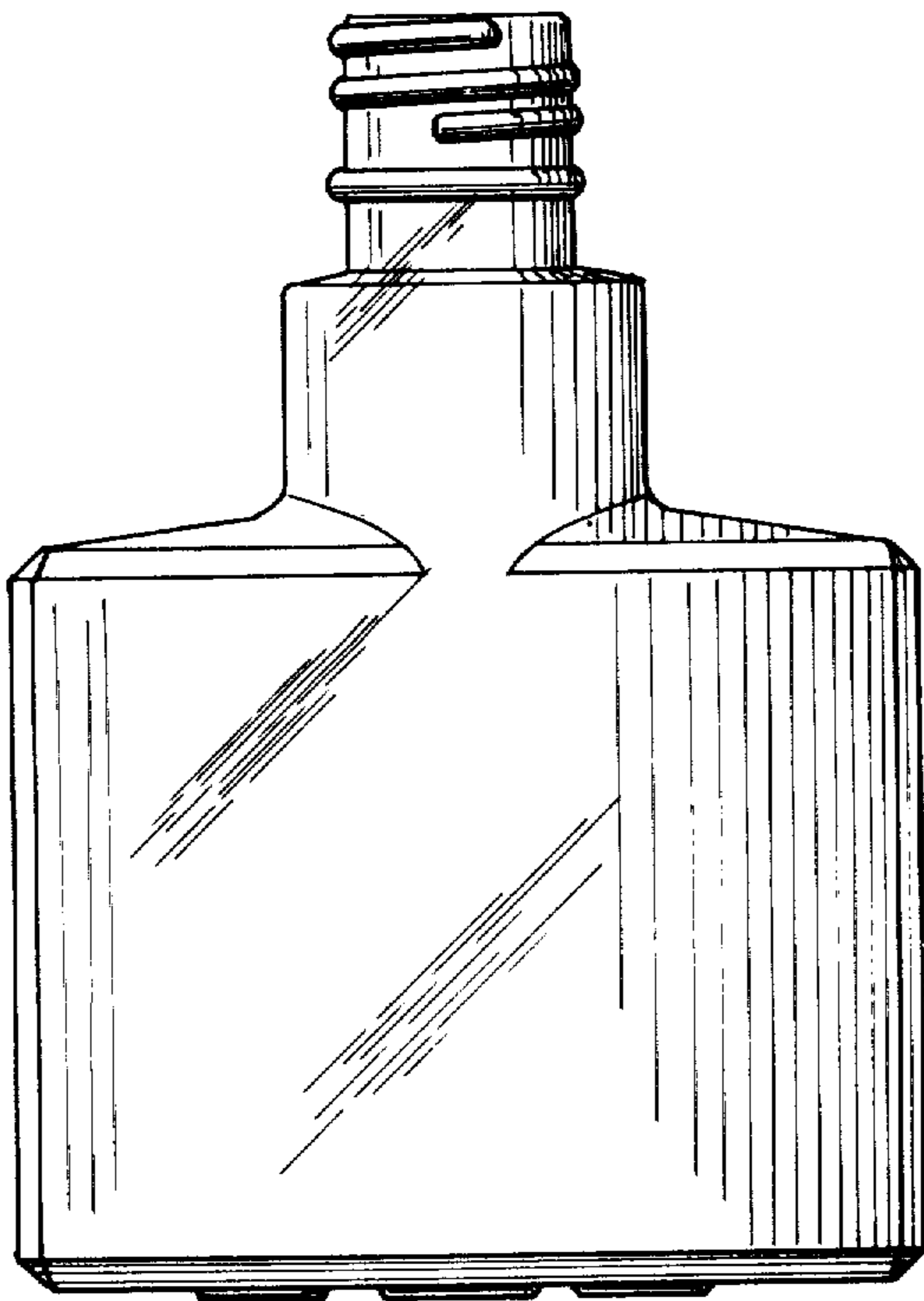

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bottle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the back being identical to the front;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being identical to the right side.
The beveled edges are plane surfaces.



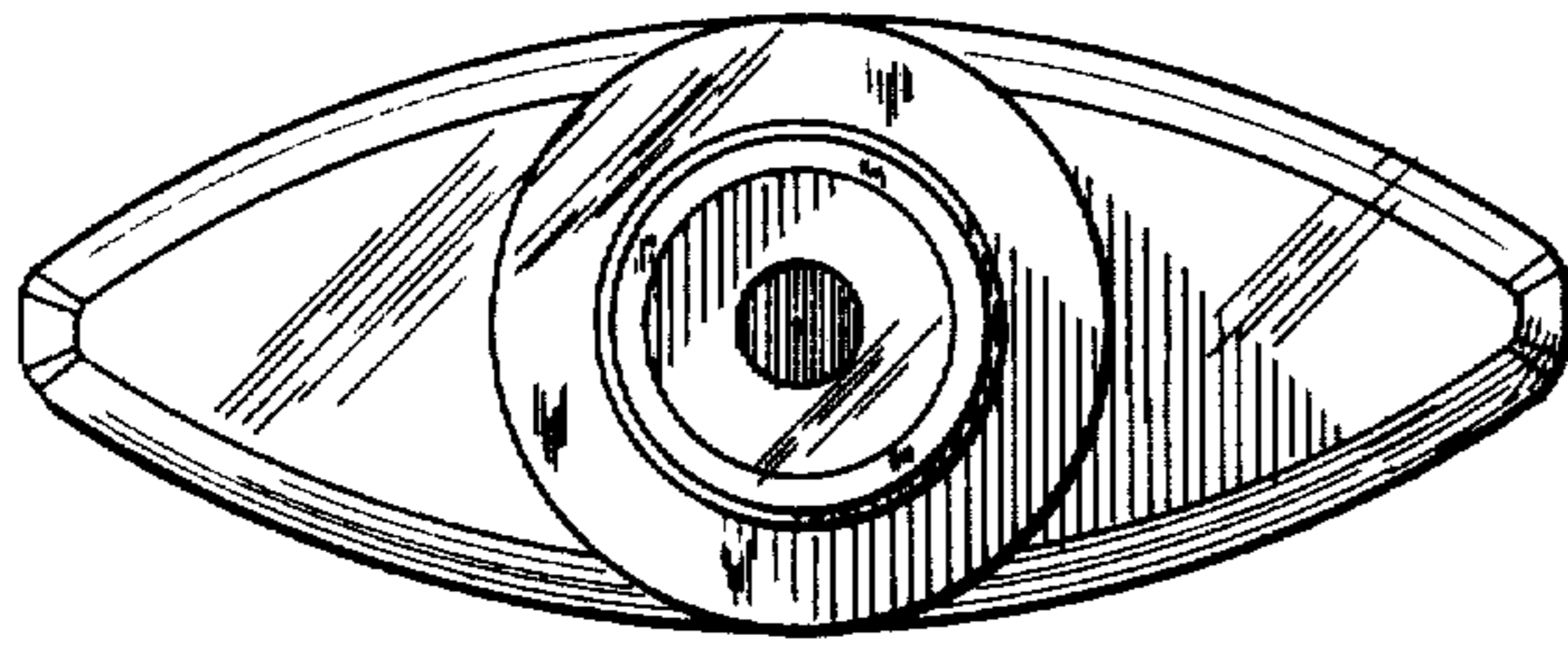

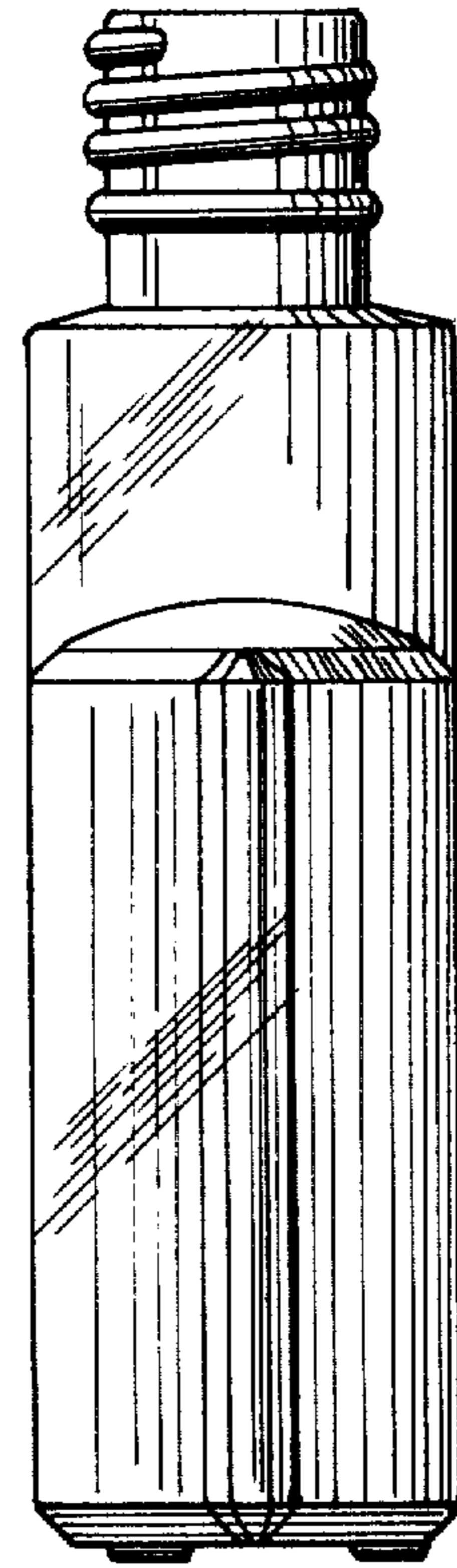

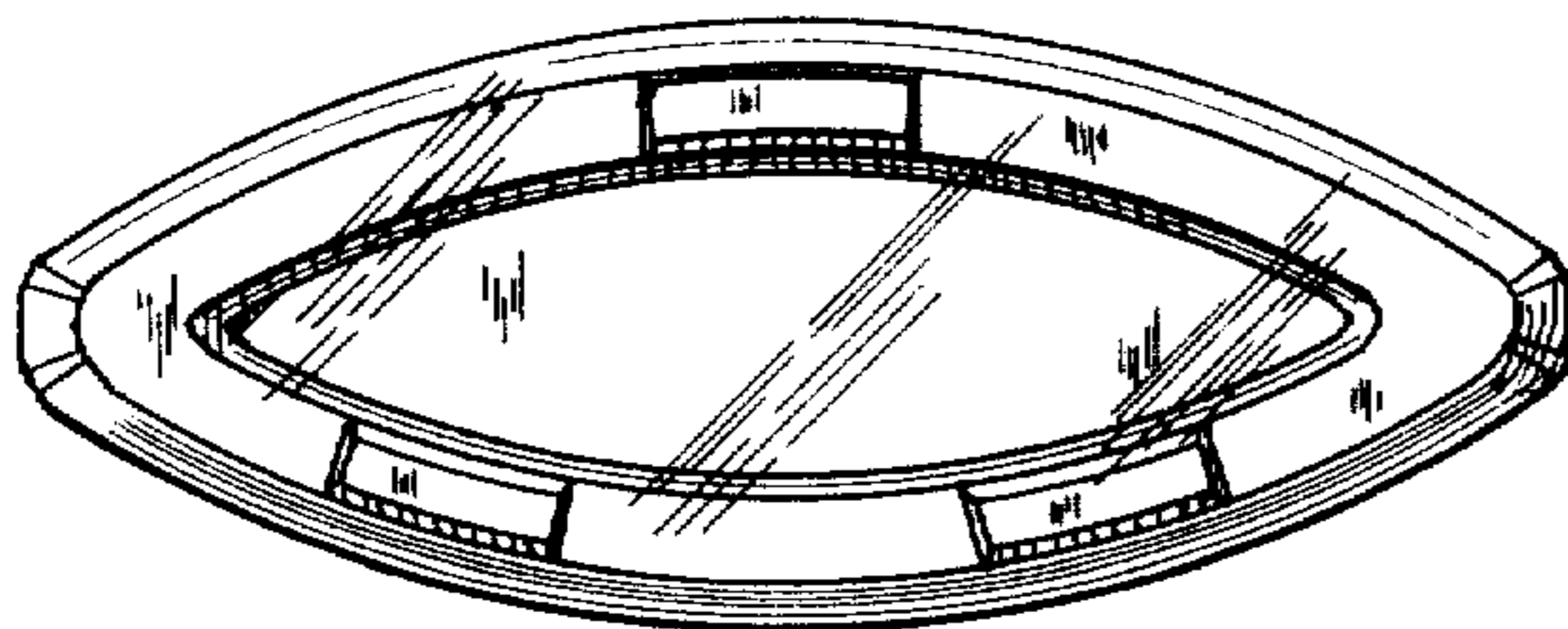
