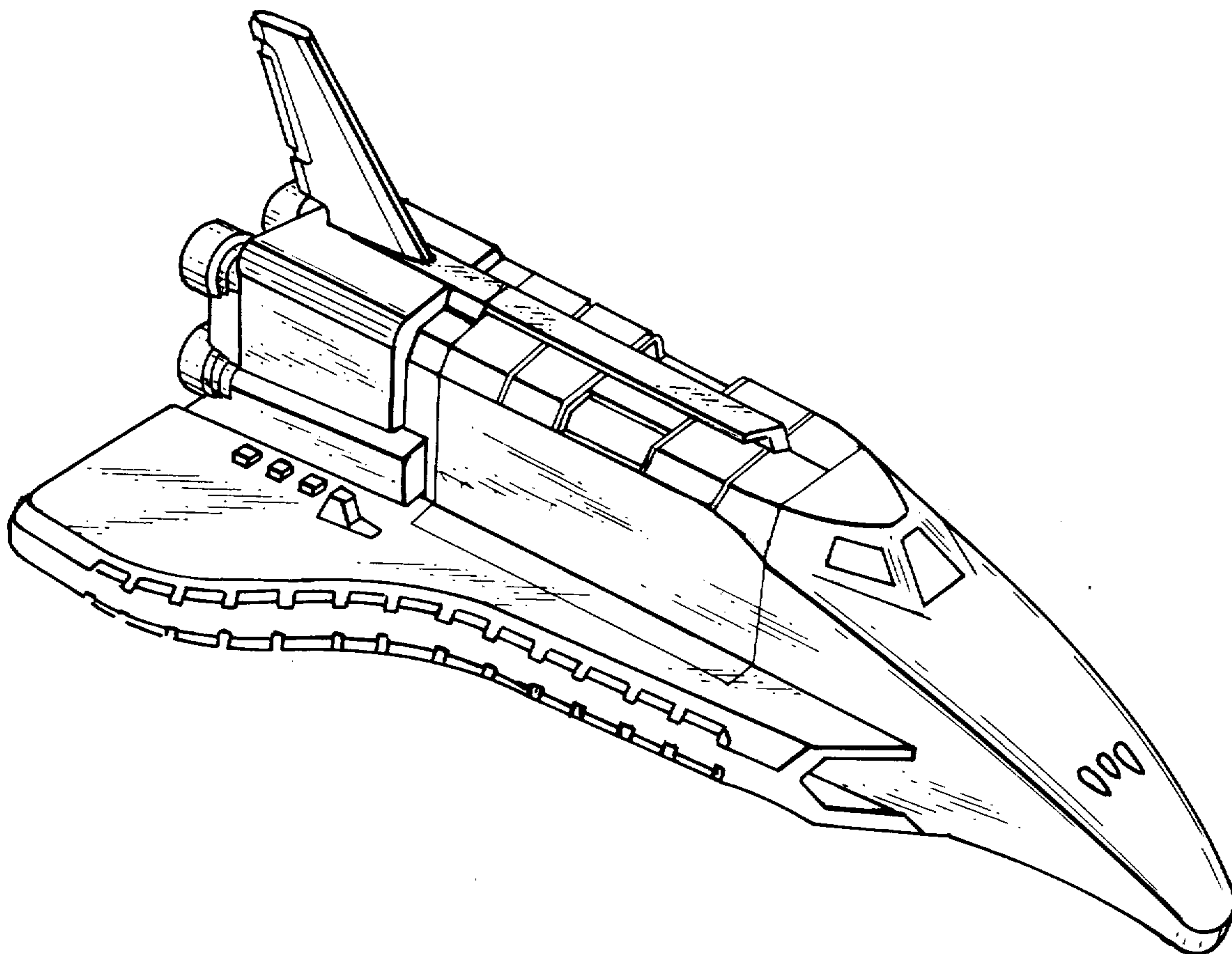

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy space shuttle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy space shuttle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



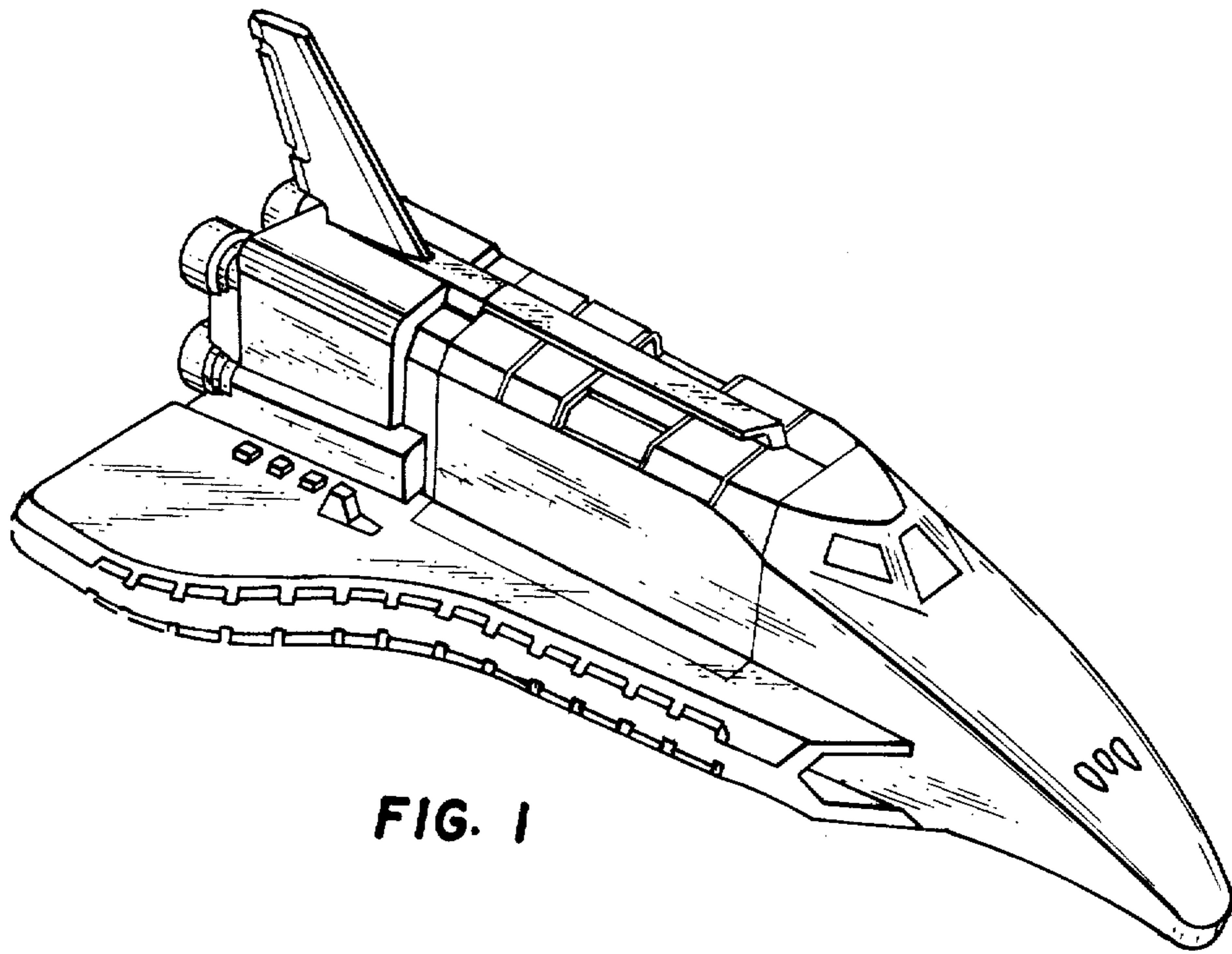

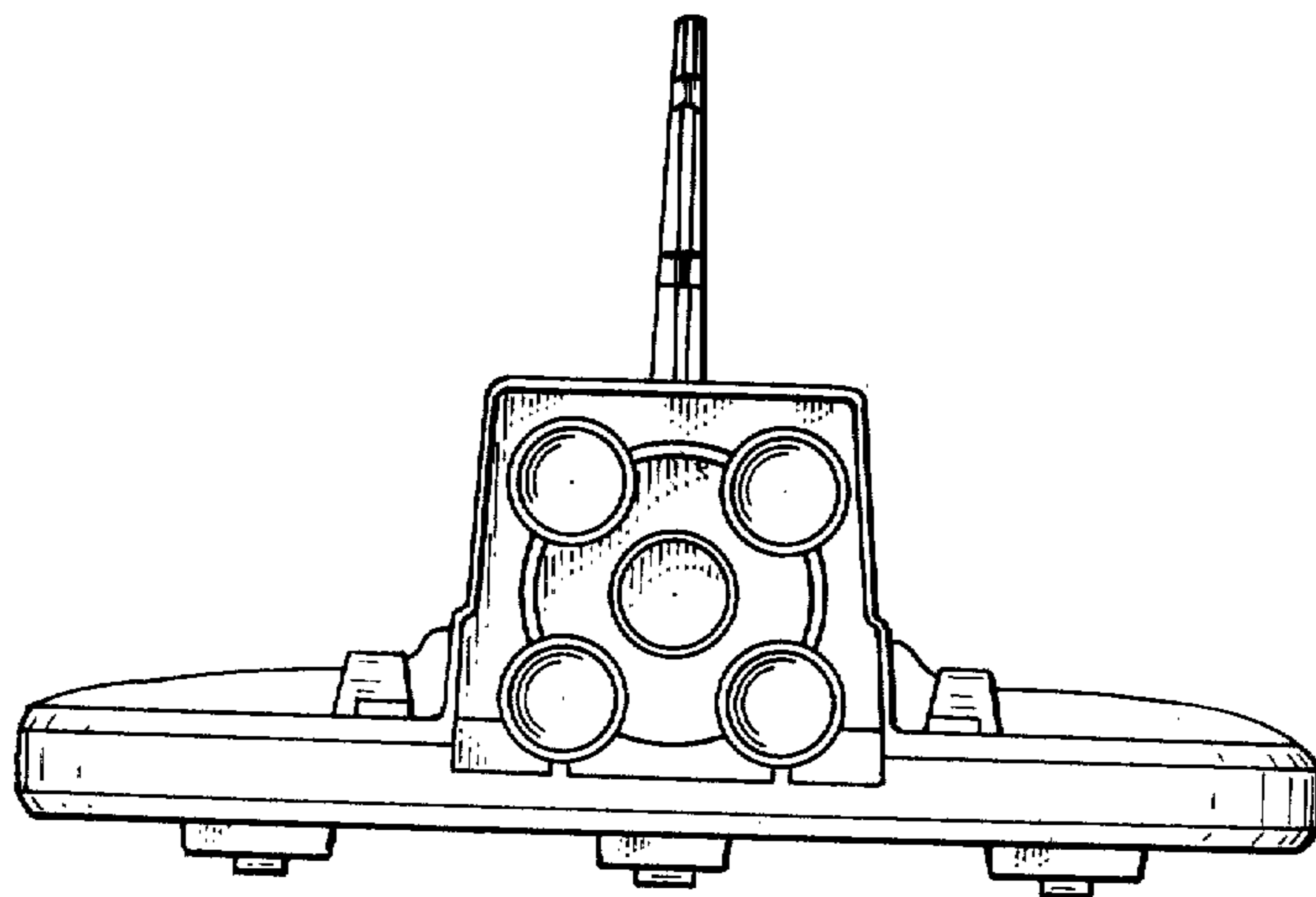

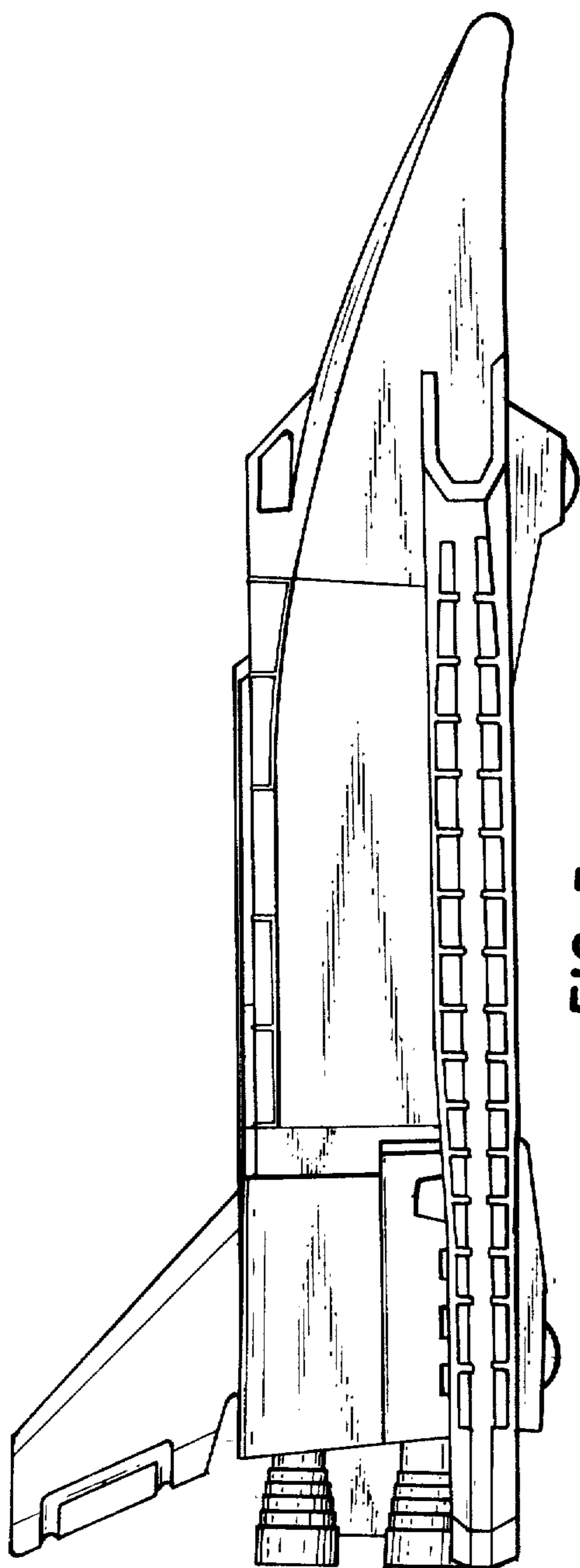

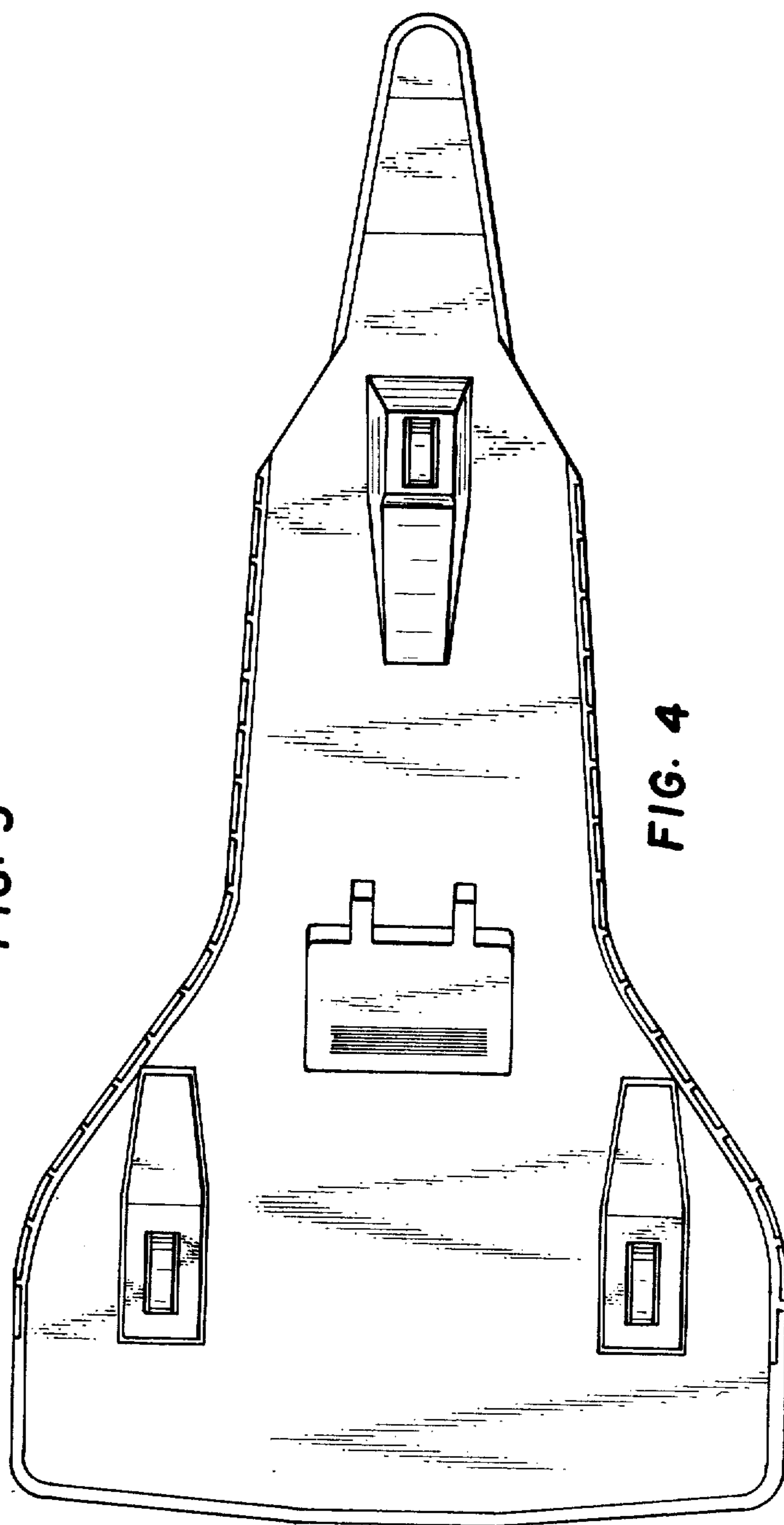
