


CLAIM The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view in perspective showing one embodiment of my design incorporated in a settee; FIG. 2 is a side view of the settee of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a back view of the settee of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a front view of the settee of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a view in perspective showing another embodiment of my design incorporated in a chair; FIG. 6 is a front view of the chair of FIG. 5; and FIG. 7 is a side view of the chair of FIG. 5.




