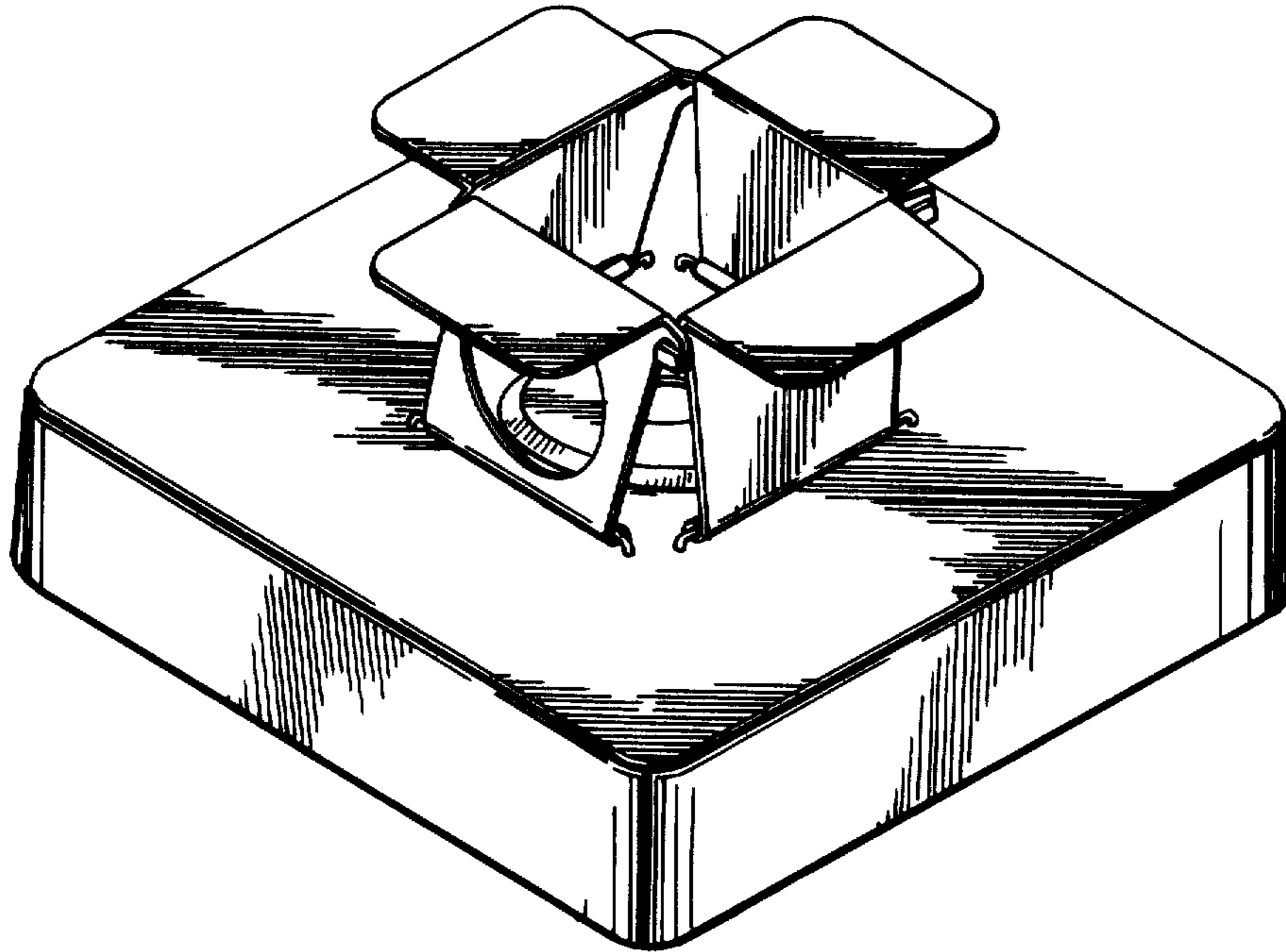

CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pot stand assembly for a portable camp stove, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pot stand assembly for a portable camp stove, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side view thereof, to which the rear view and opposite side view are substantially identical; FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



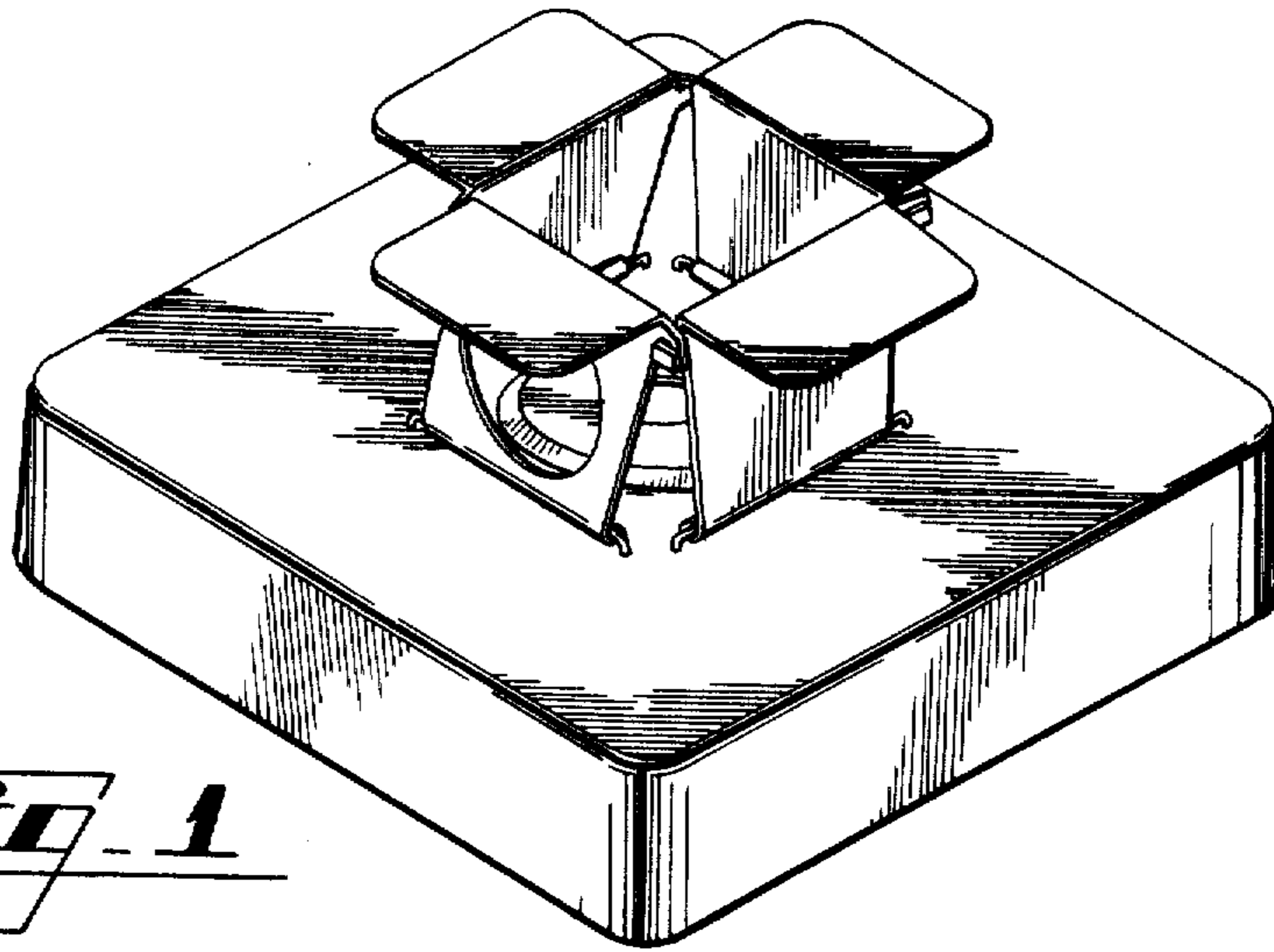

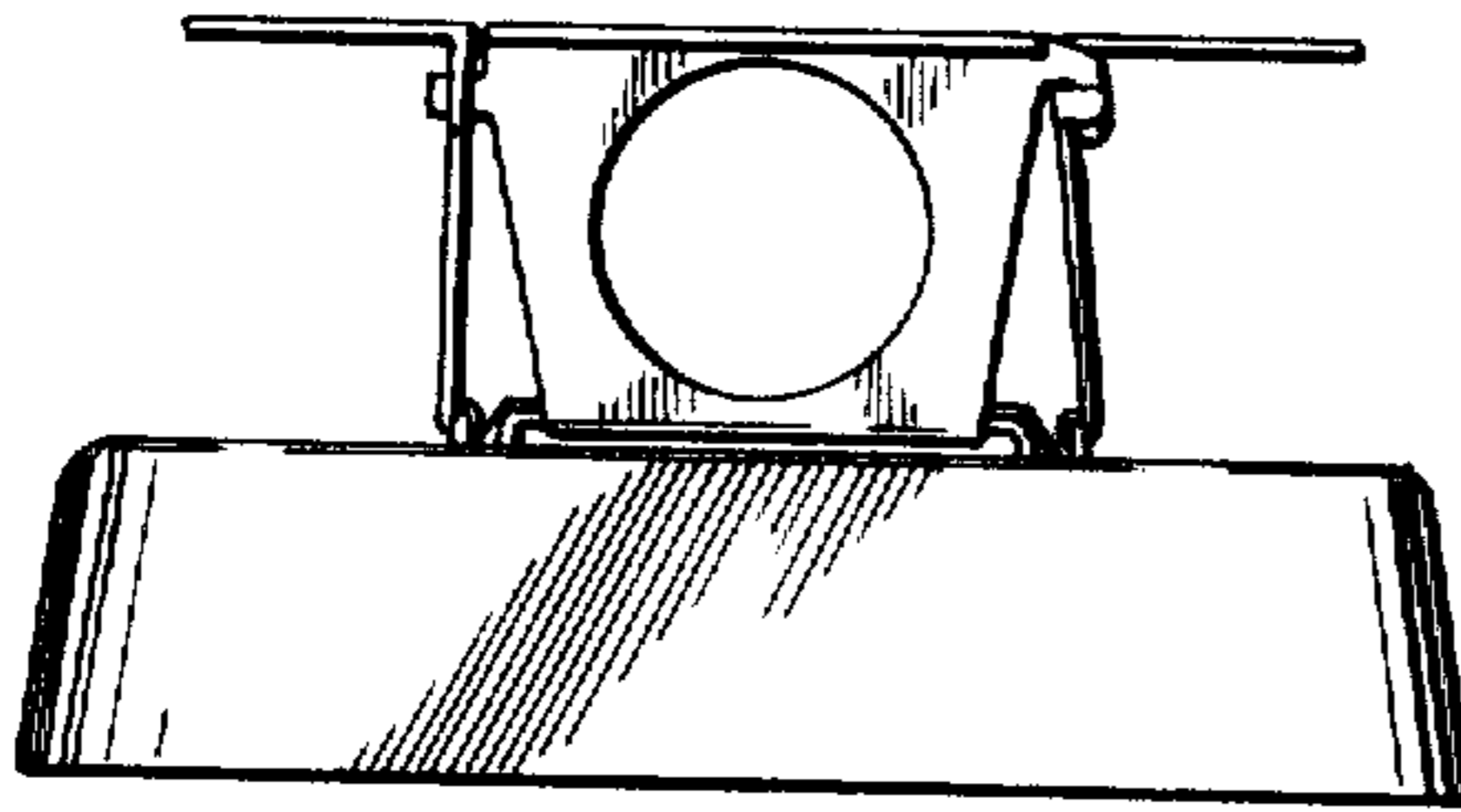

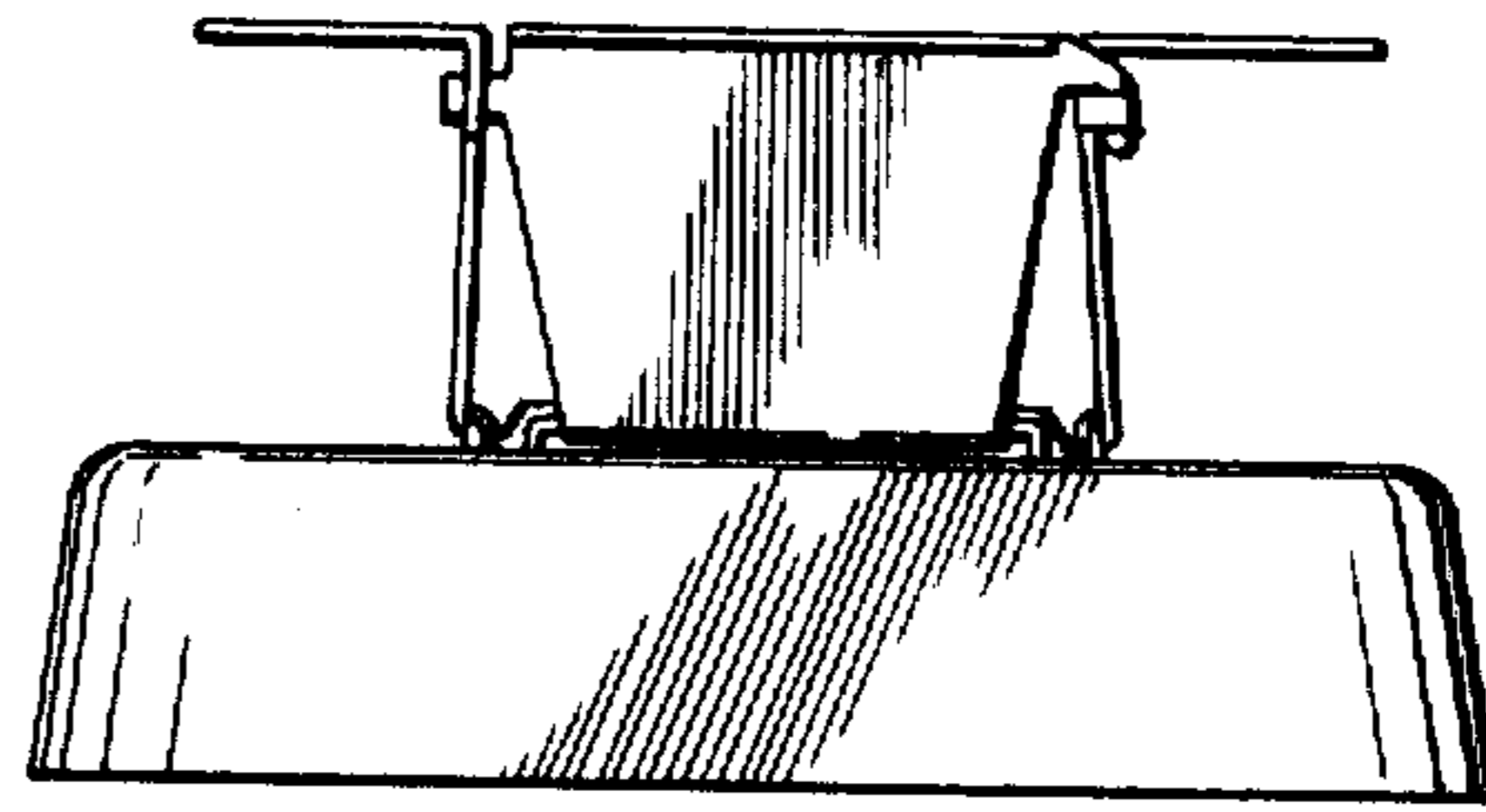

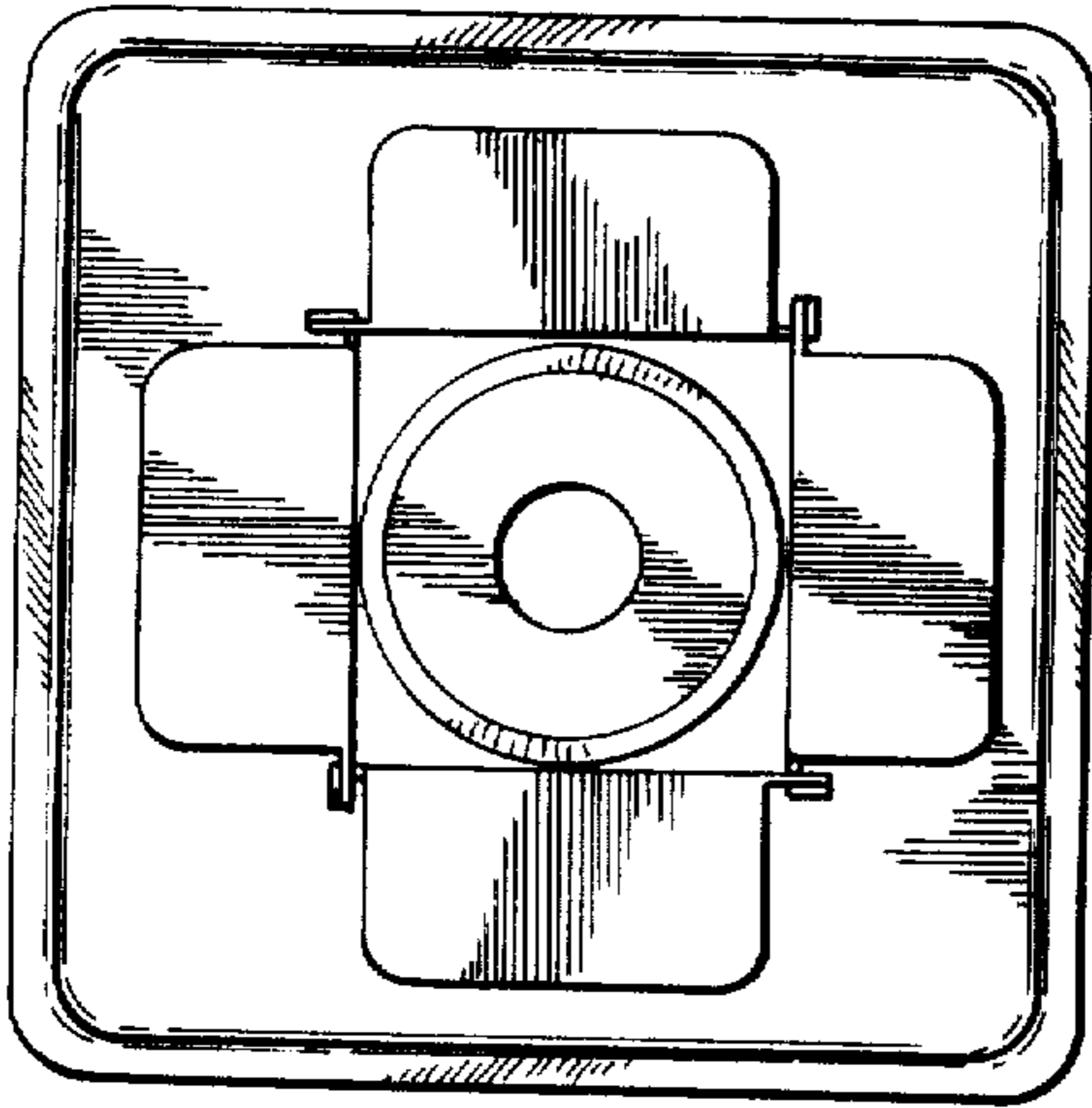

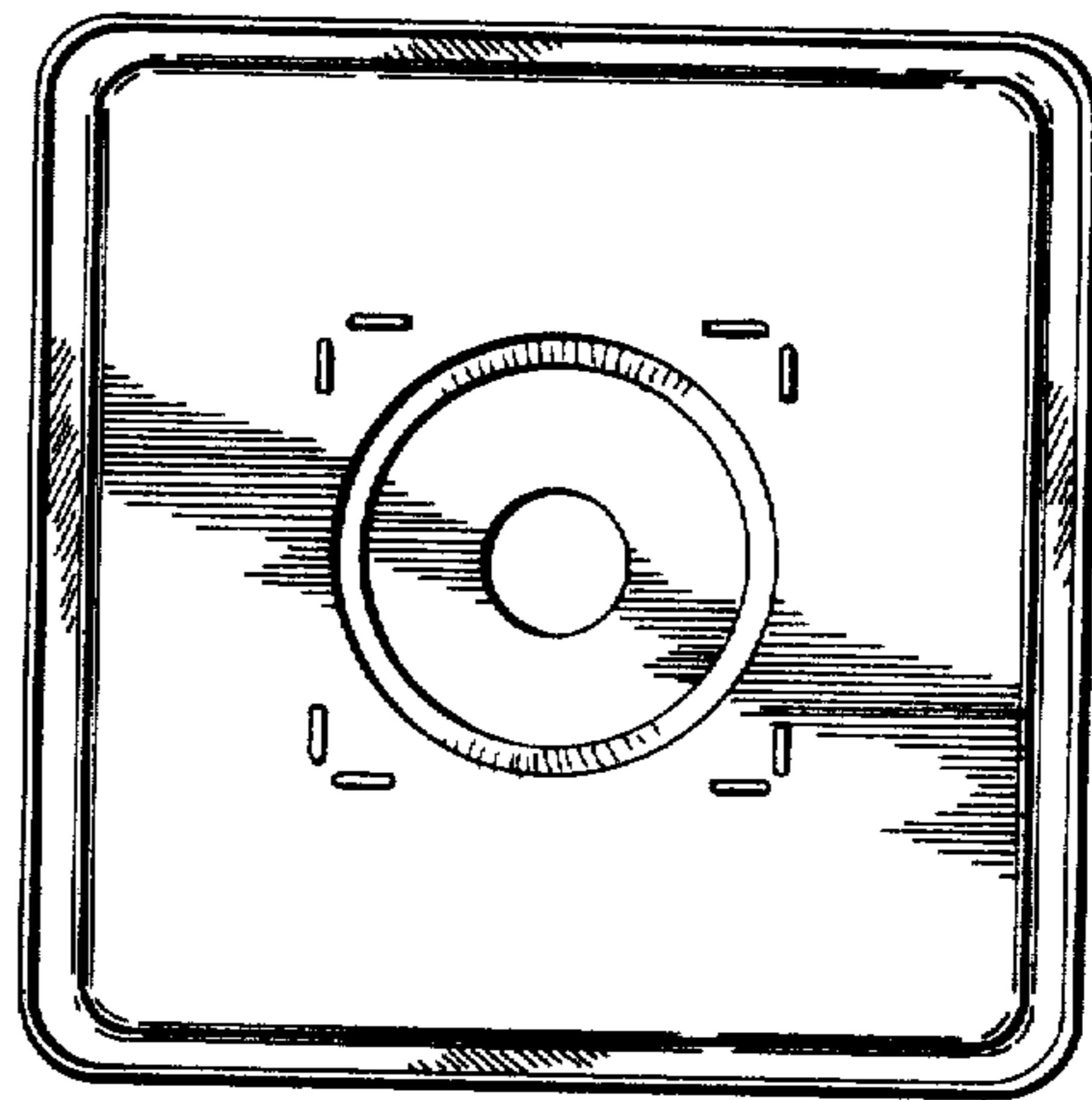
