[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tub mounted bath lift, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tub mounted bath lift showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view thereof of the side opposite to that shown in FIG. 2; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

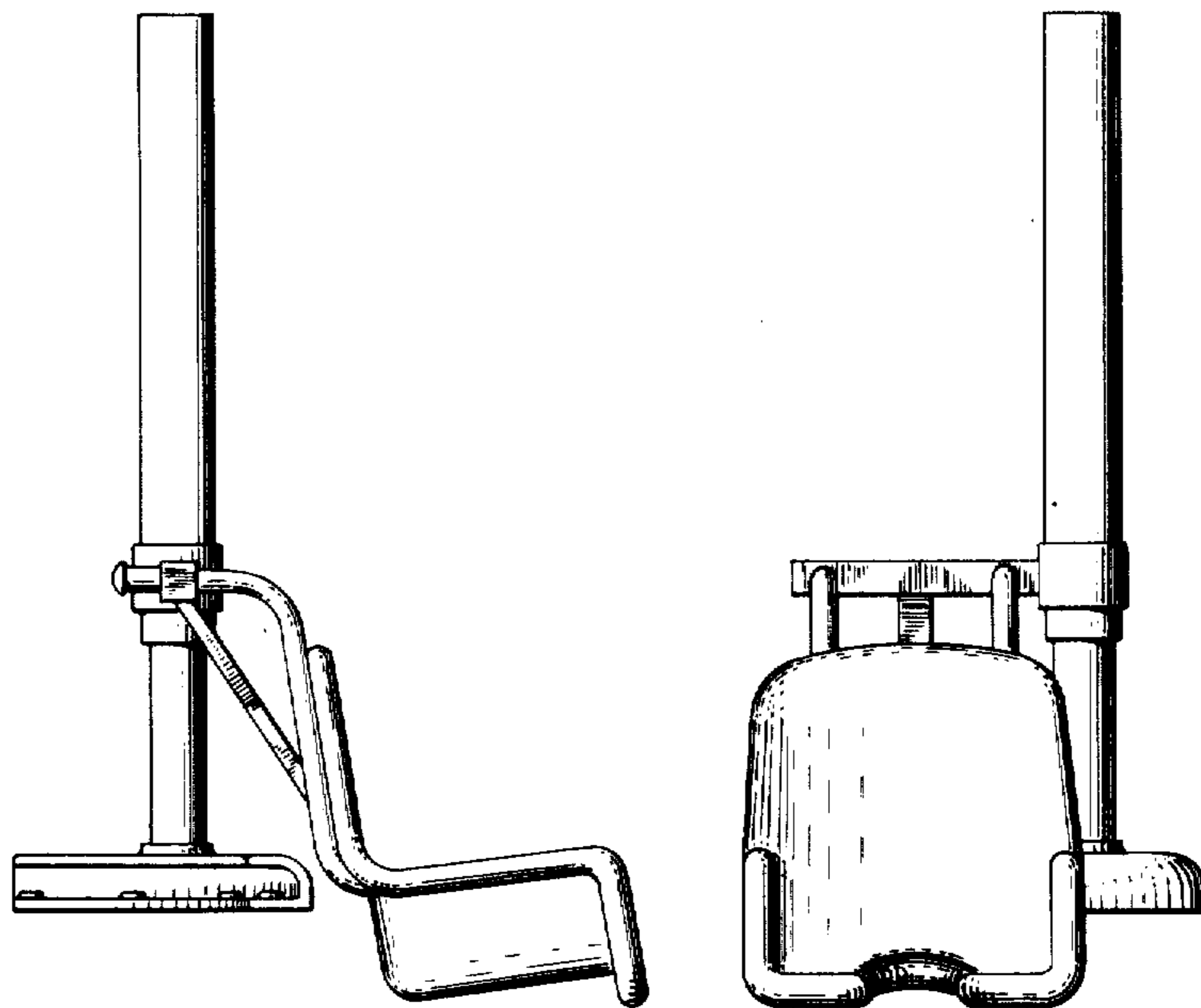

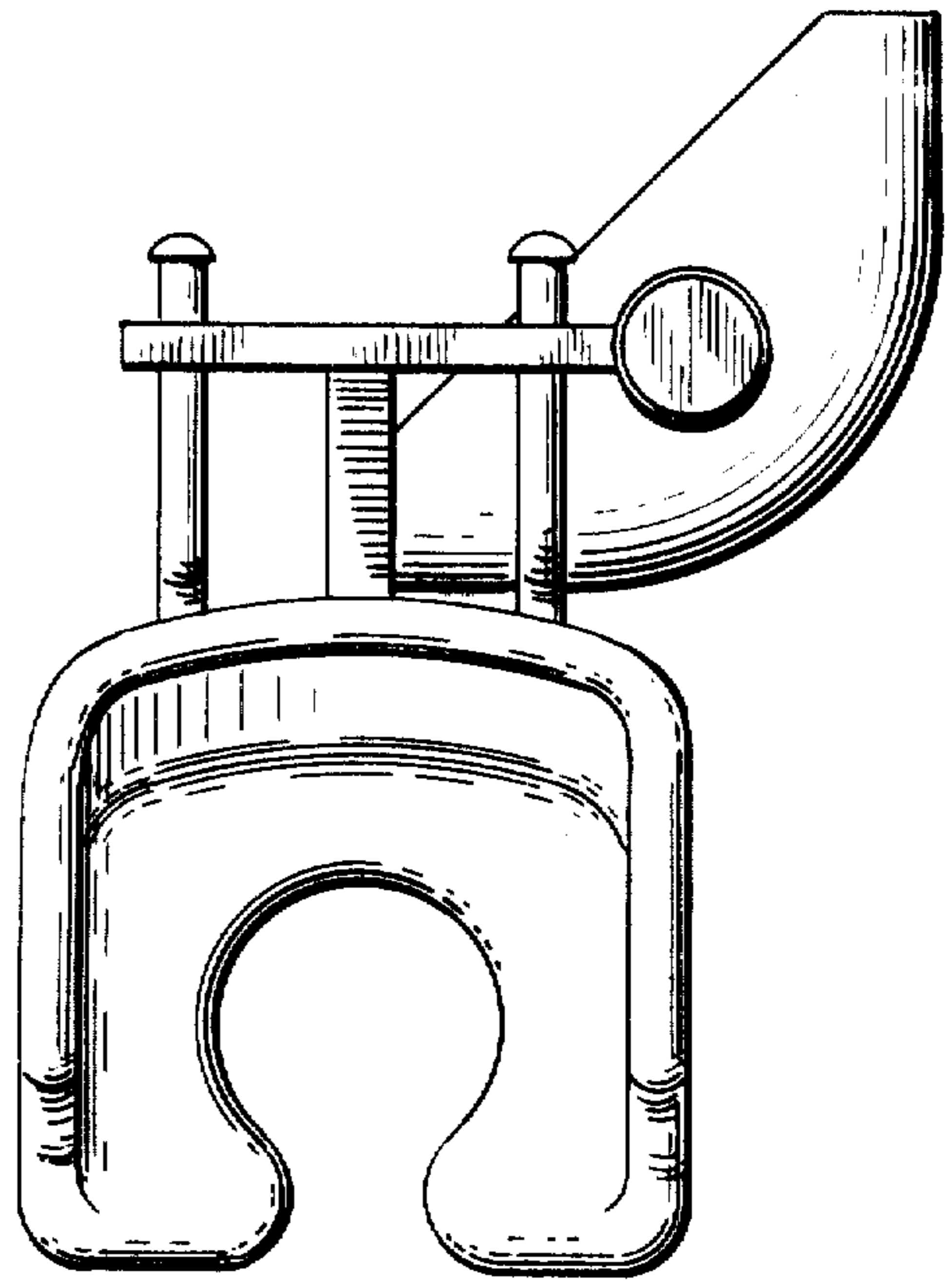

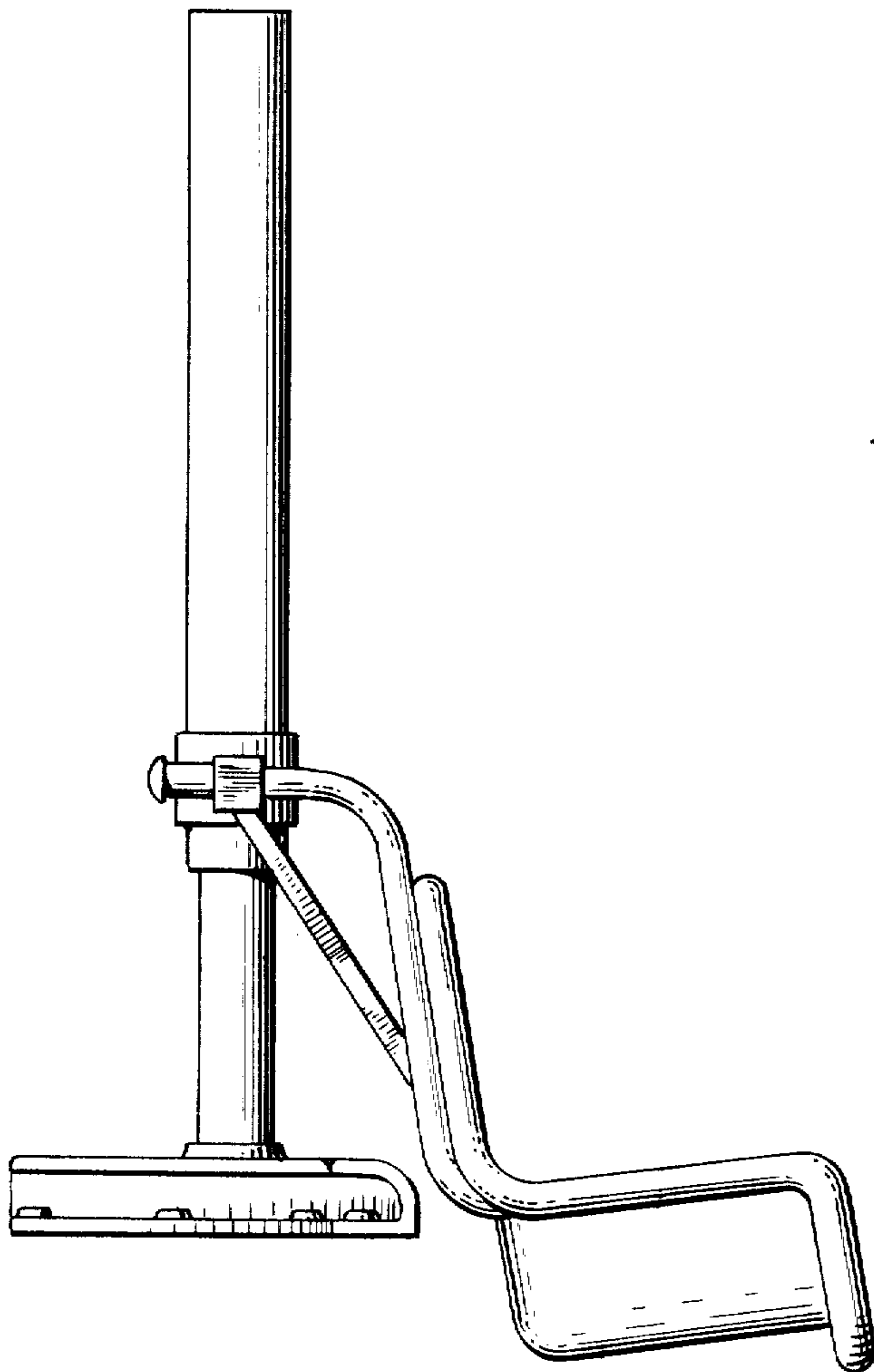

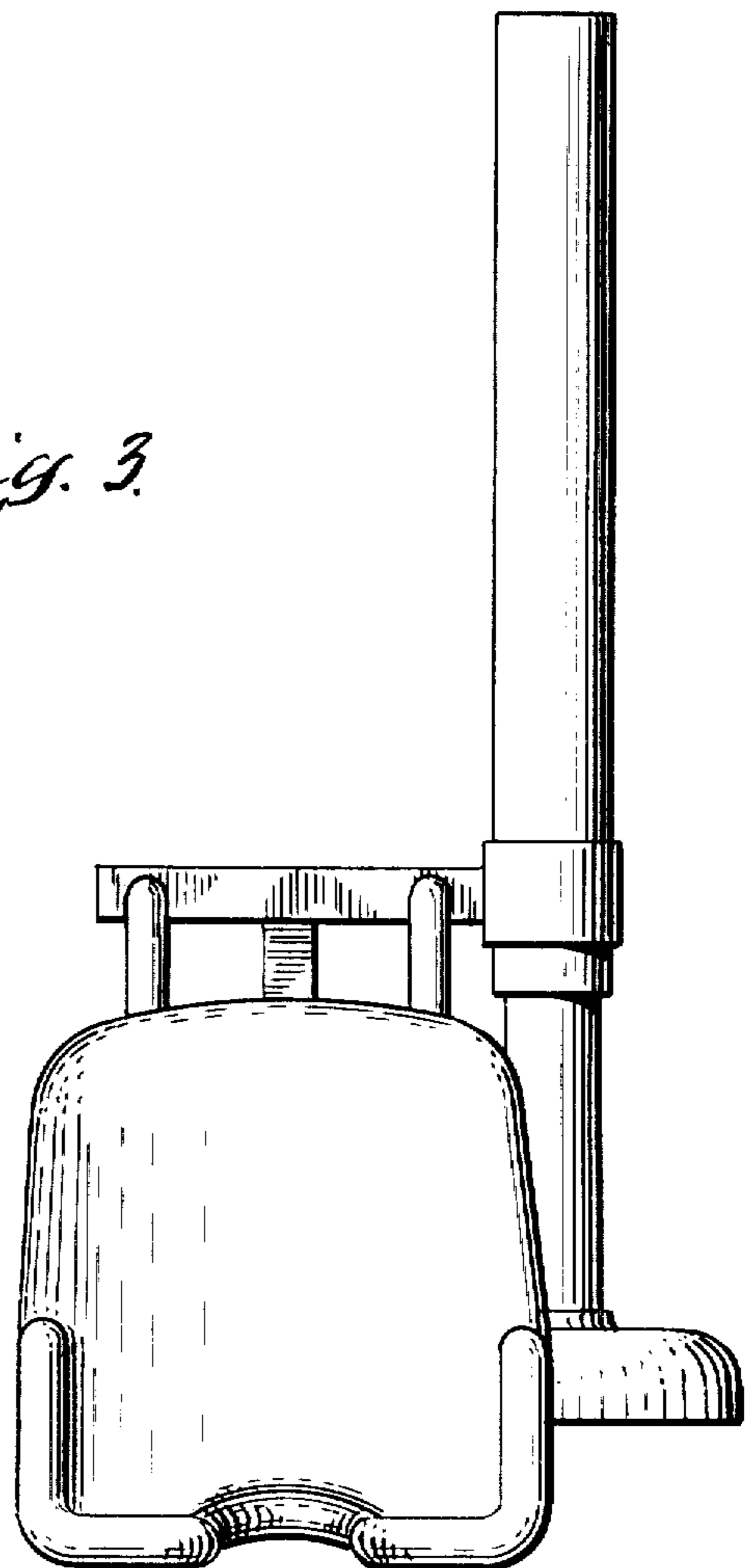

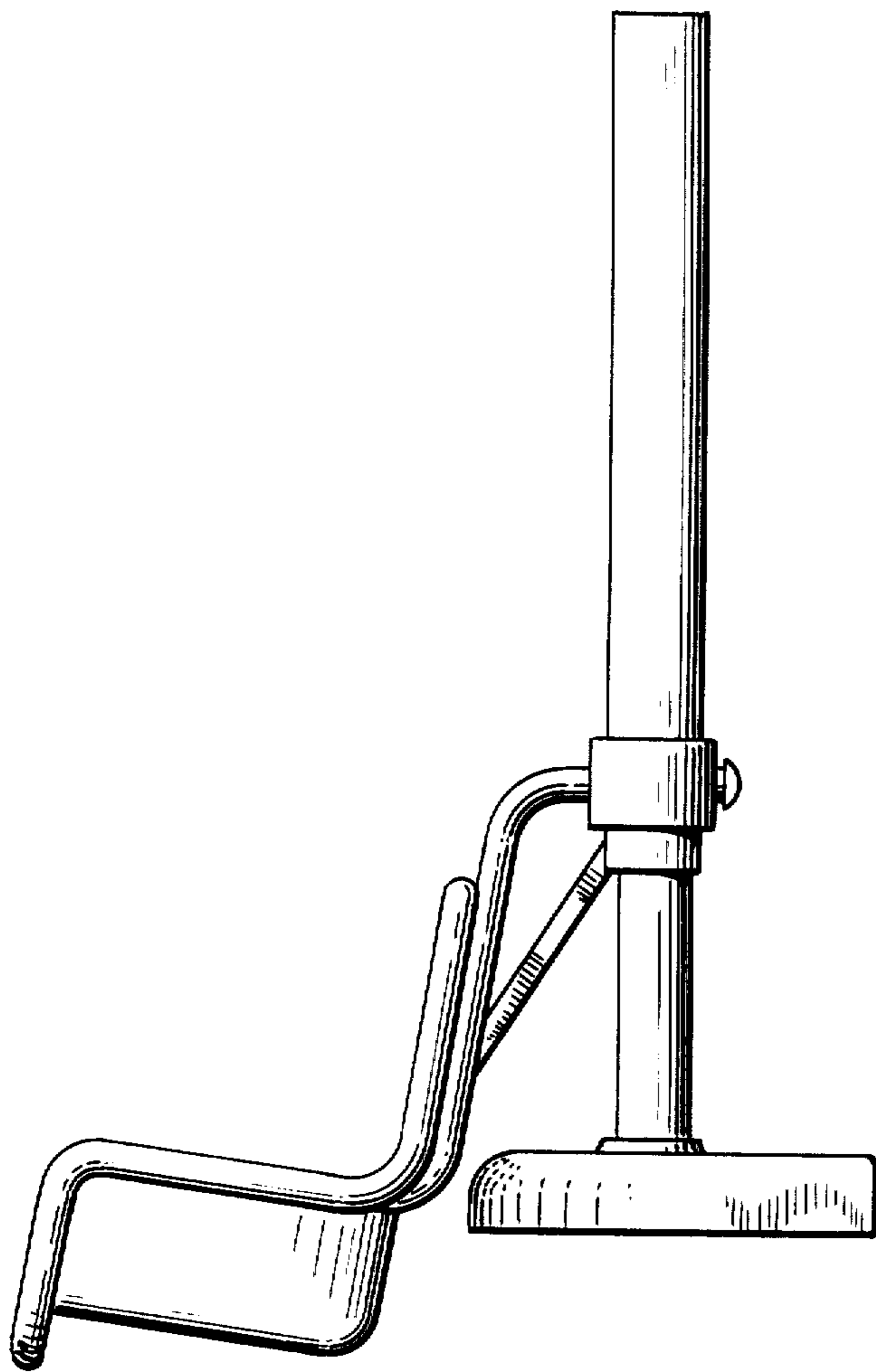
