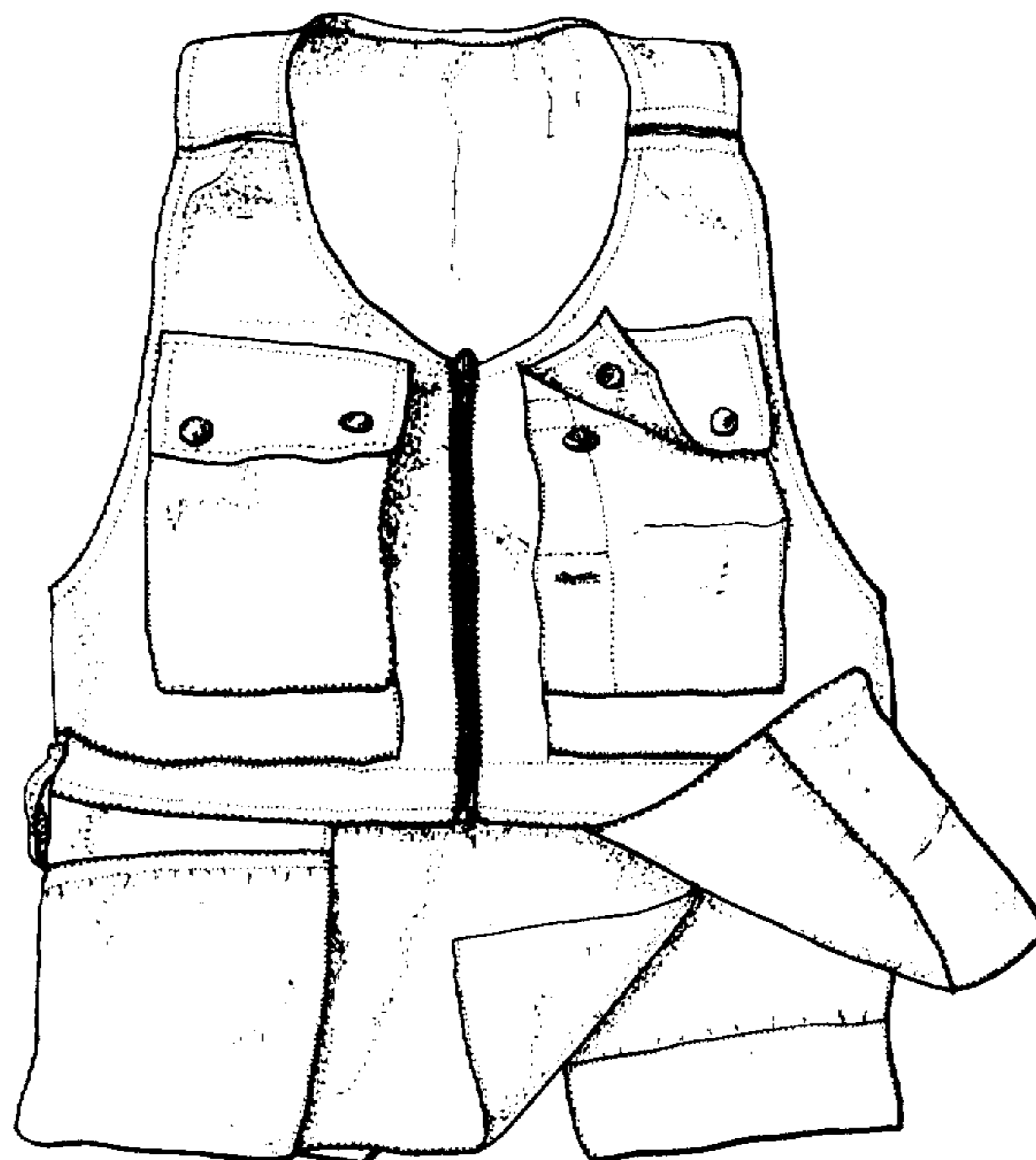

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a workman's vest showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view. The bottom structure, below the top-stitched band, is symmetrical.



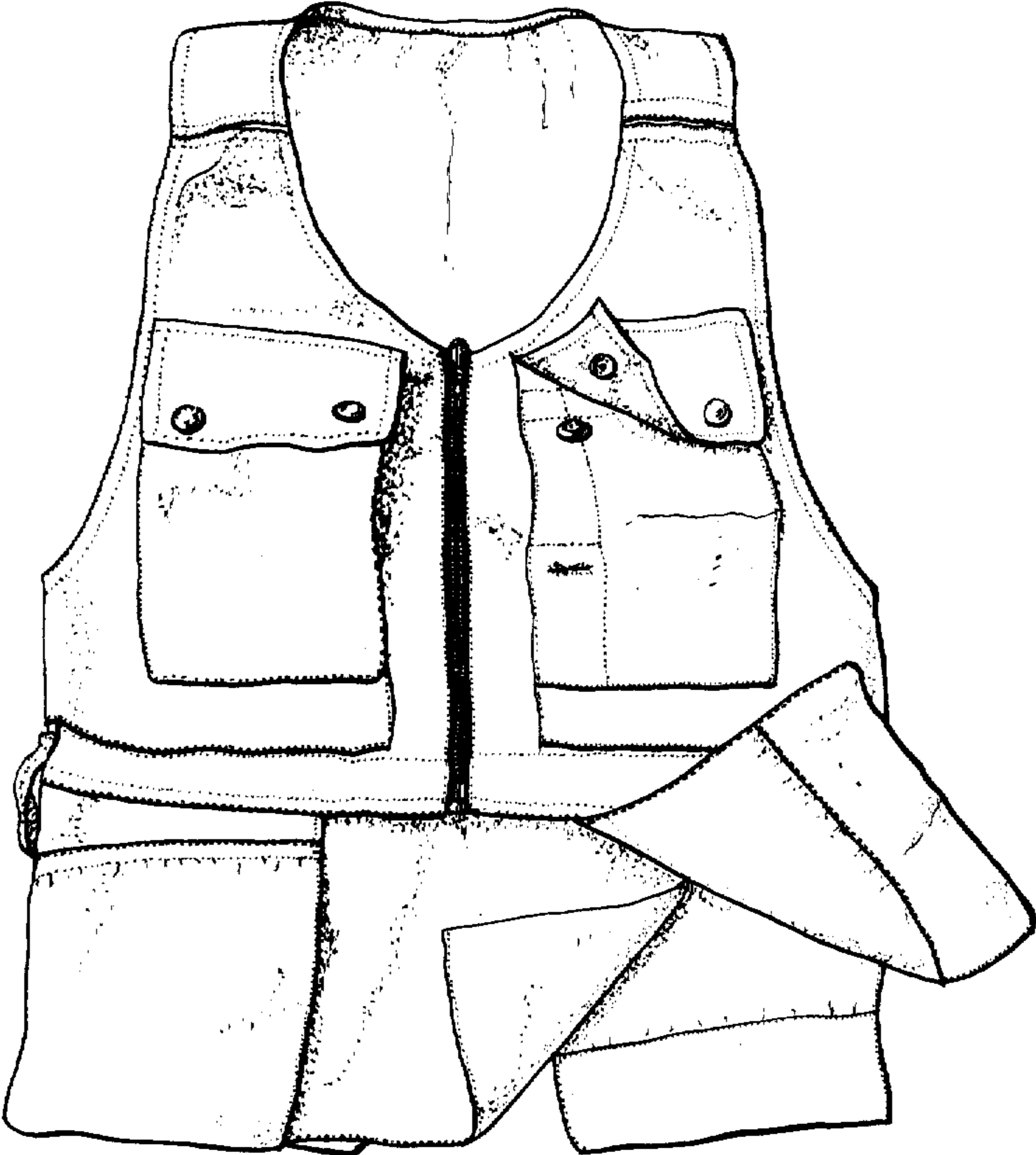
