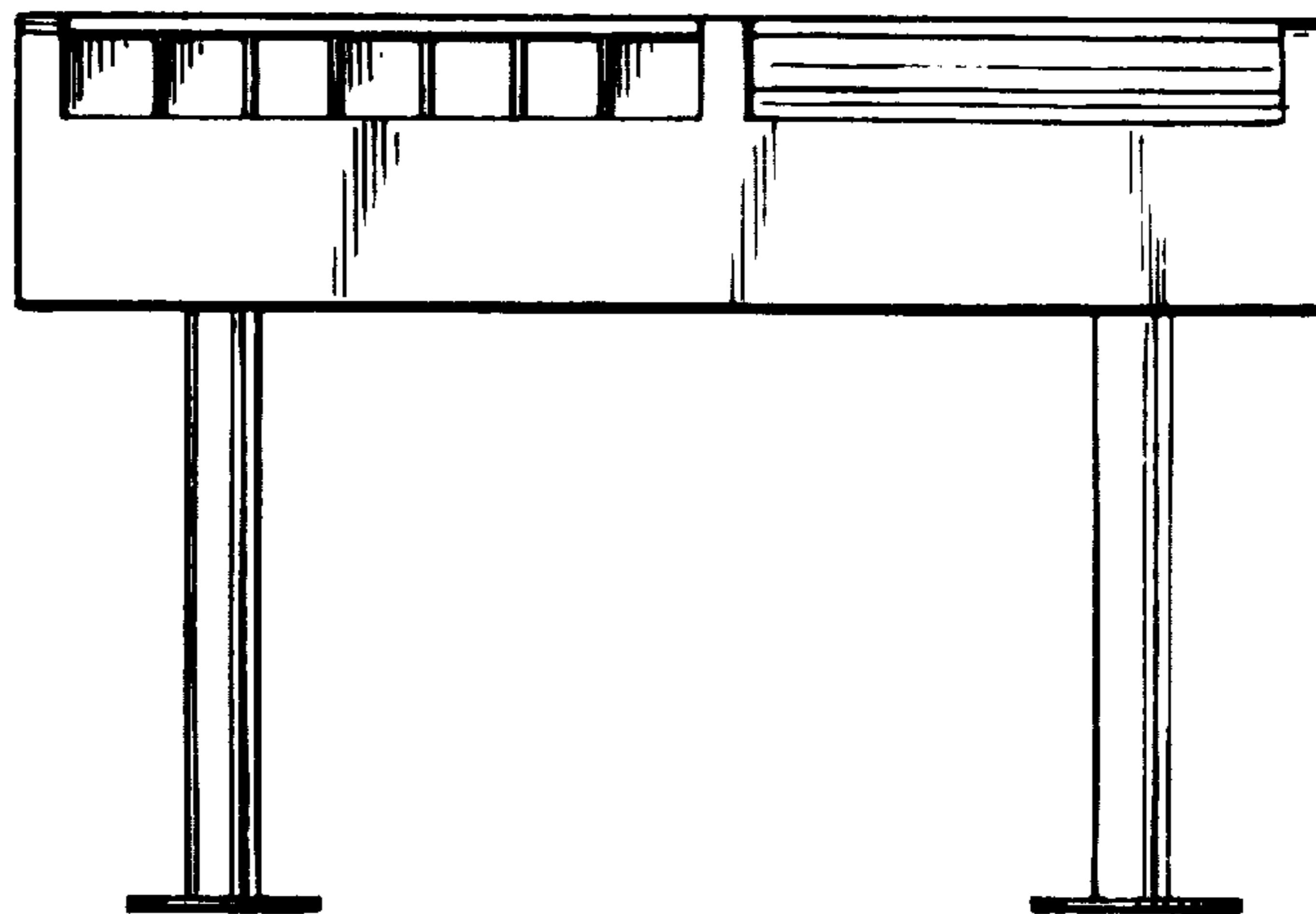

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a desk, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a leg-supported desk with a back-to-back arrangement of two modules; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the desk of FIG. 1 wherein the desk is supported on tubular legs; and FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of a back-to-back, tubular leg supported desk. The side of the desk not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3.



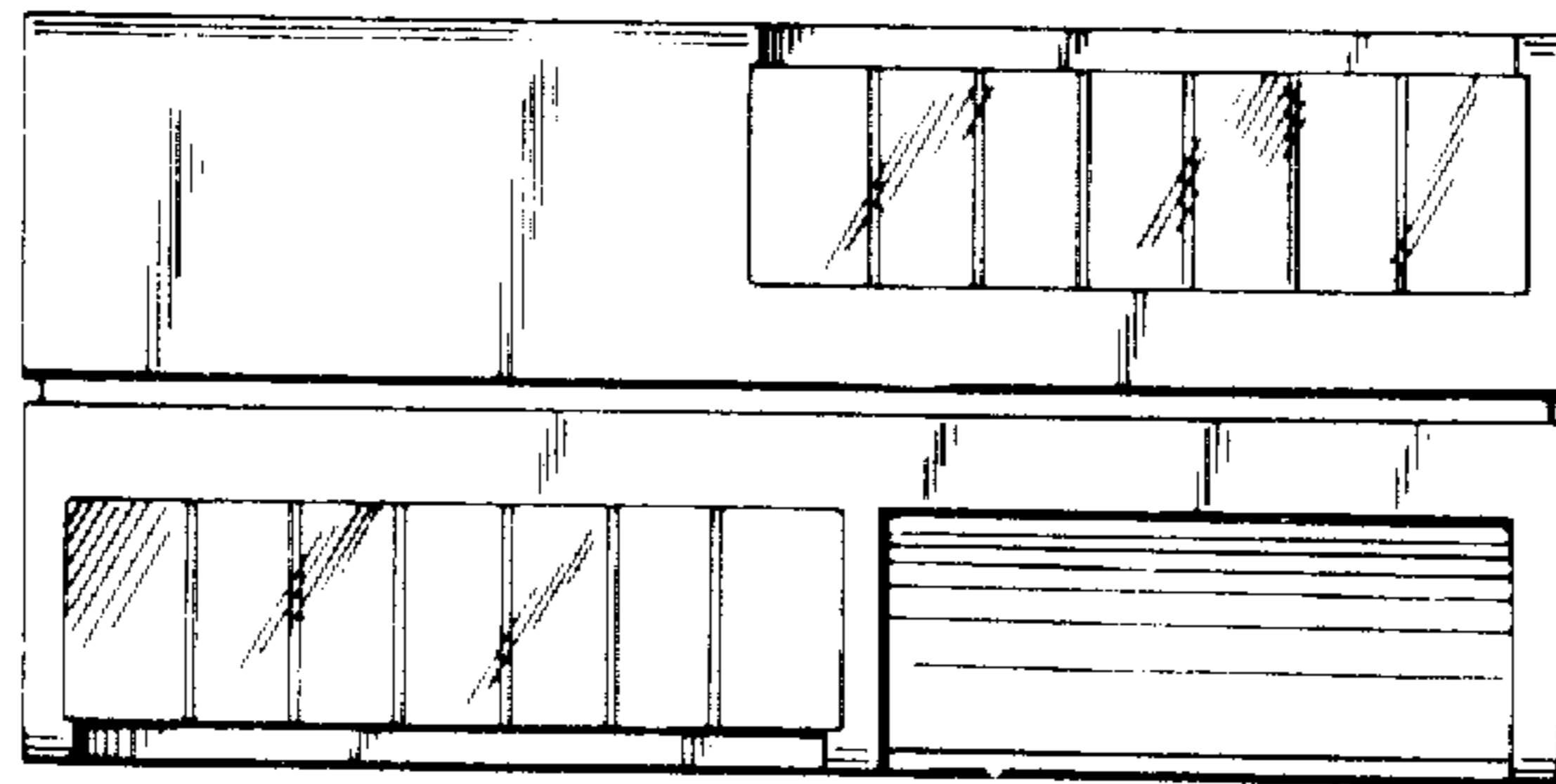

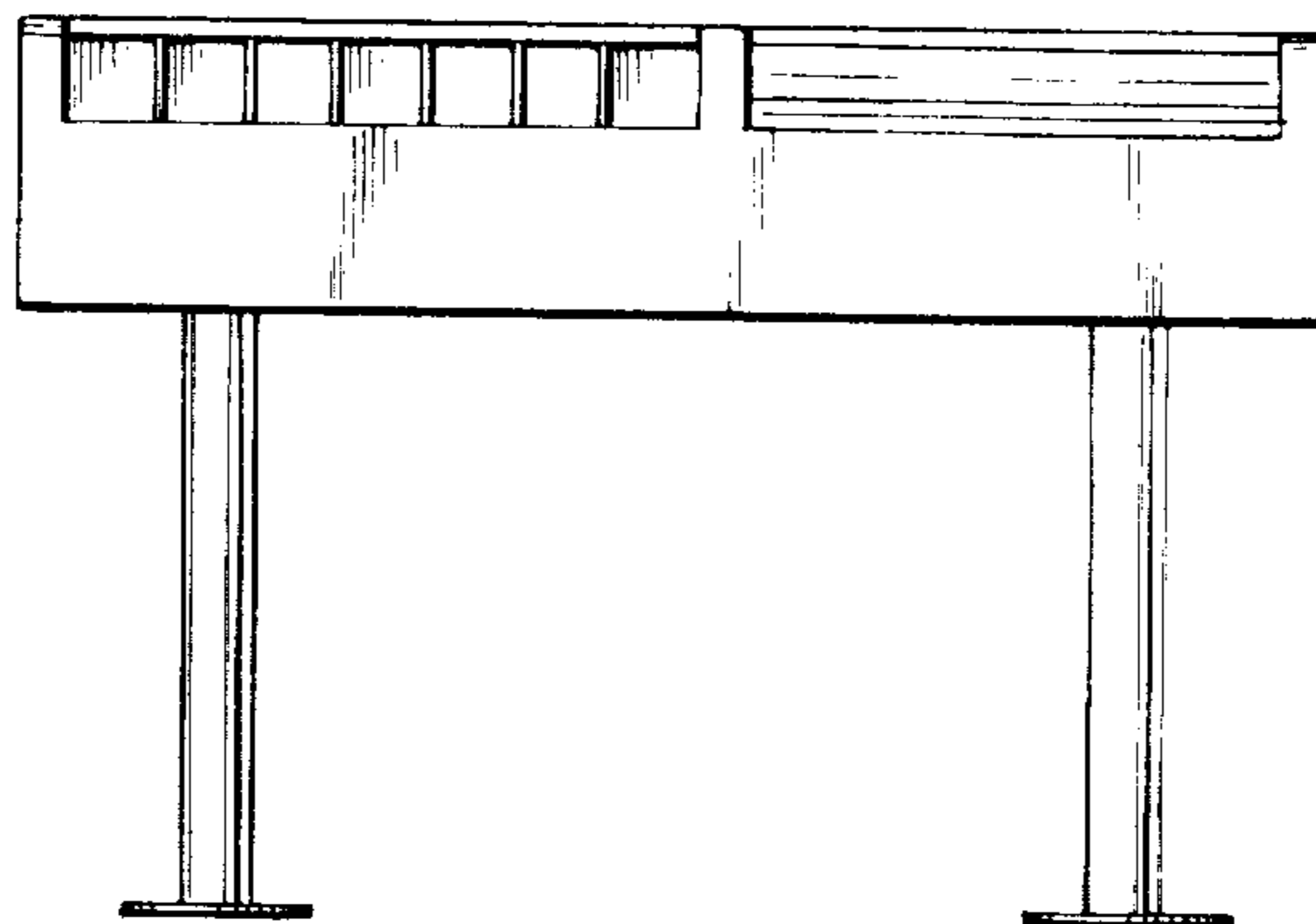

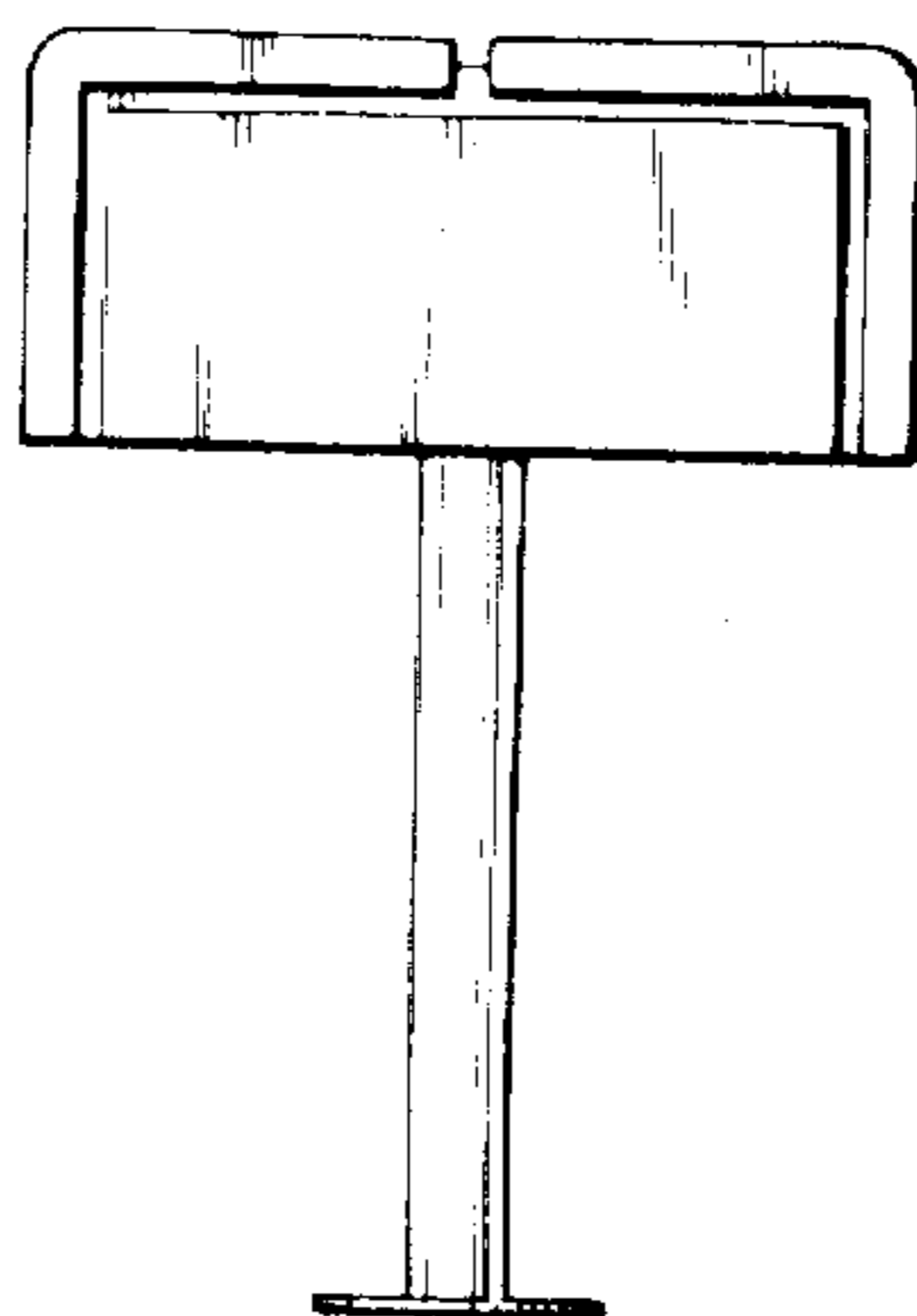
