The ornamental design for a simulative photo frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a simulative photo frame, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image; and FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view thereof taken along line 6-6 of FIG. 2.

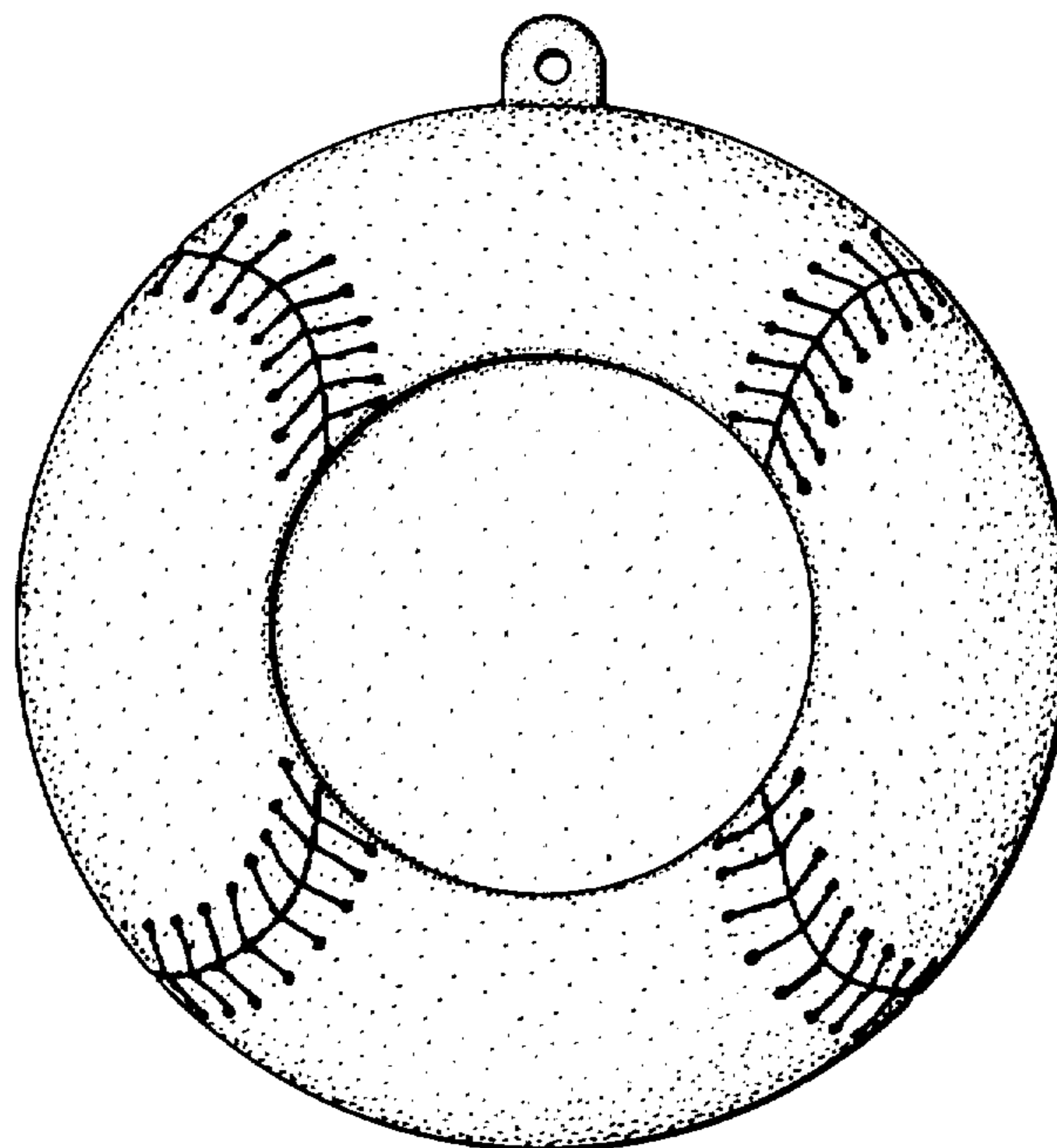

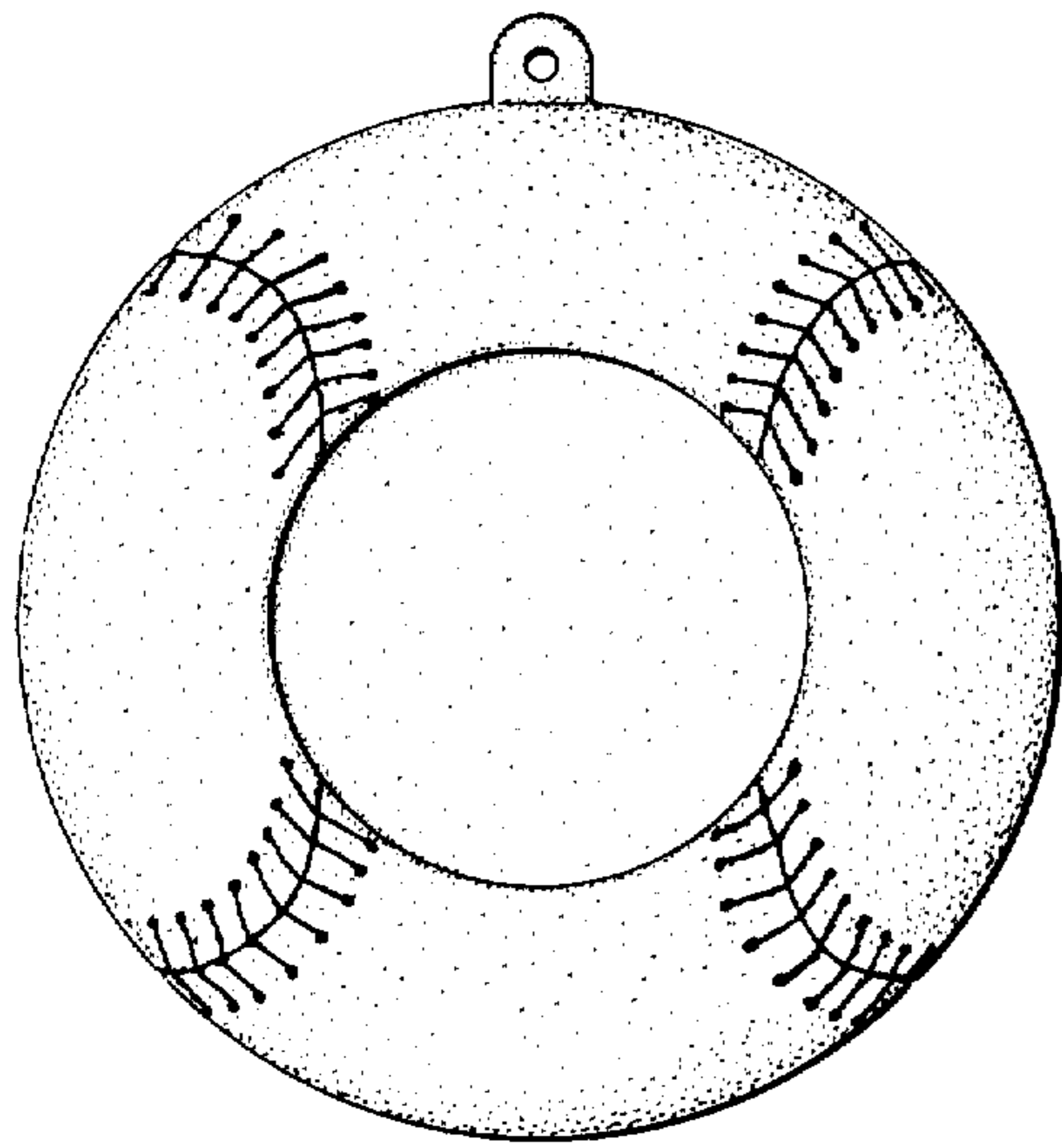
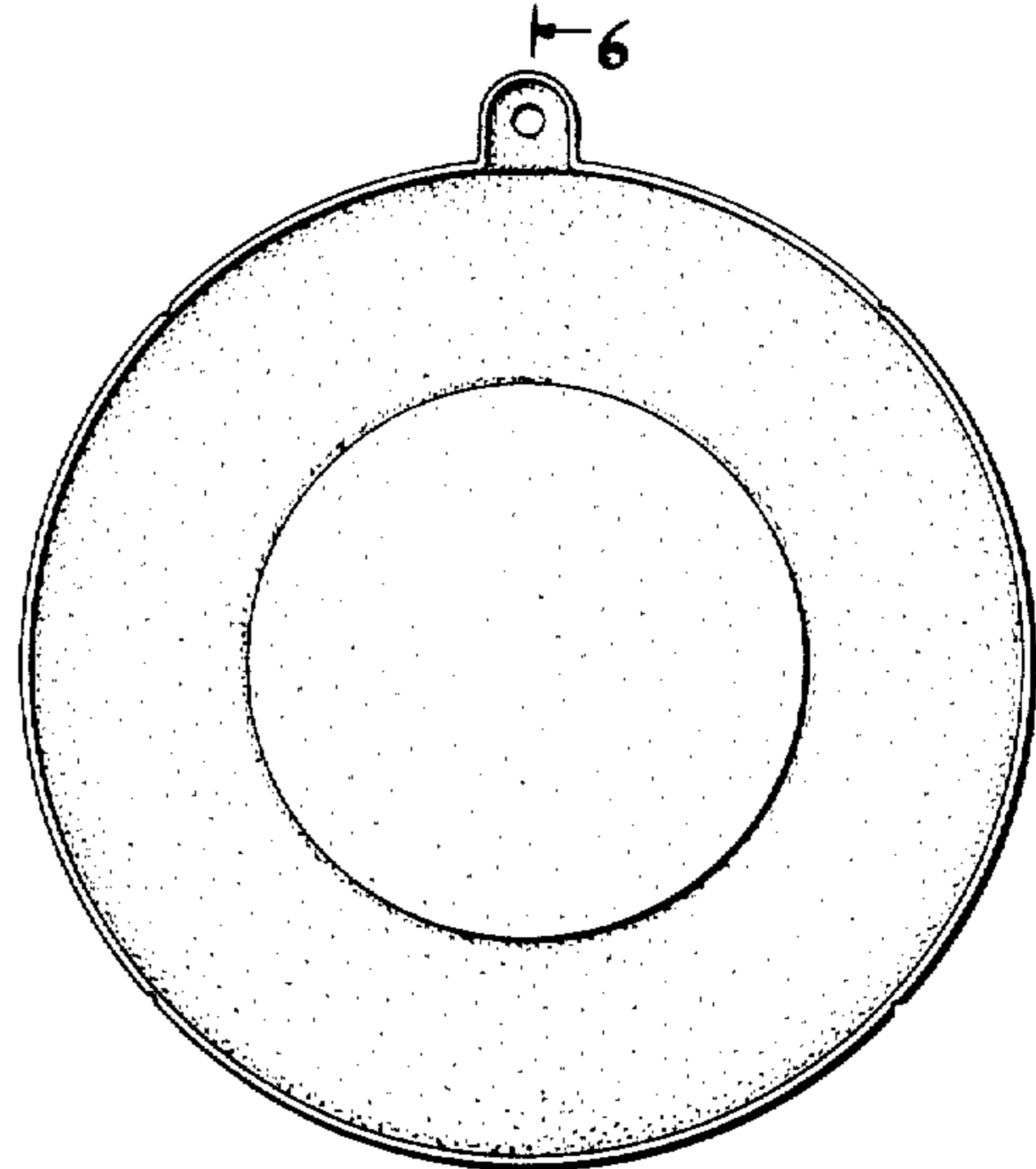

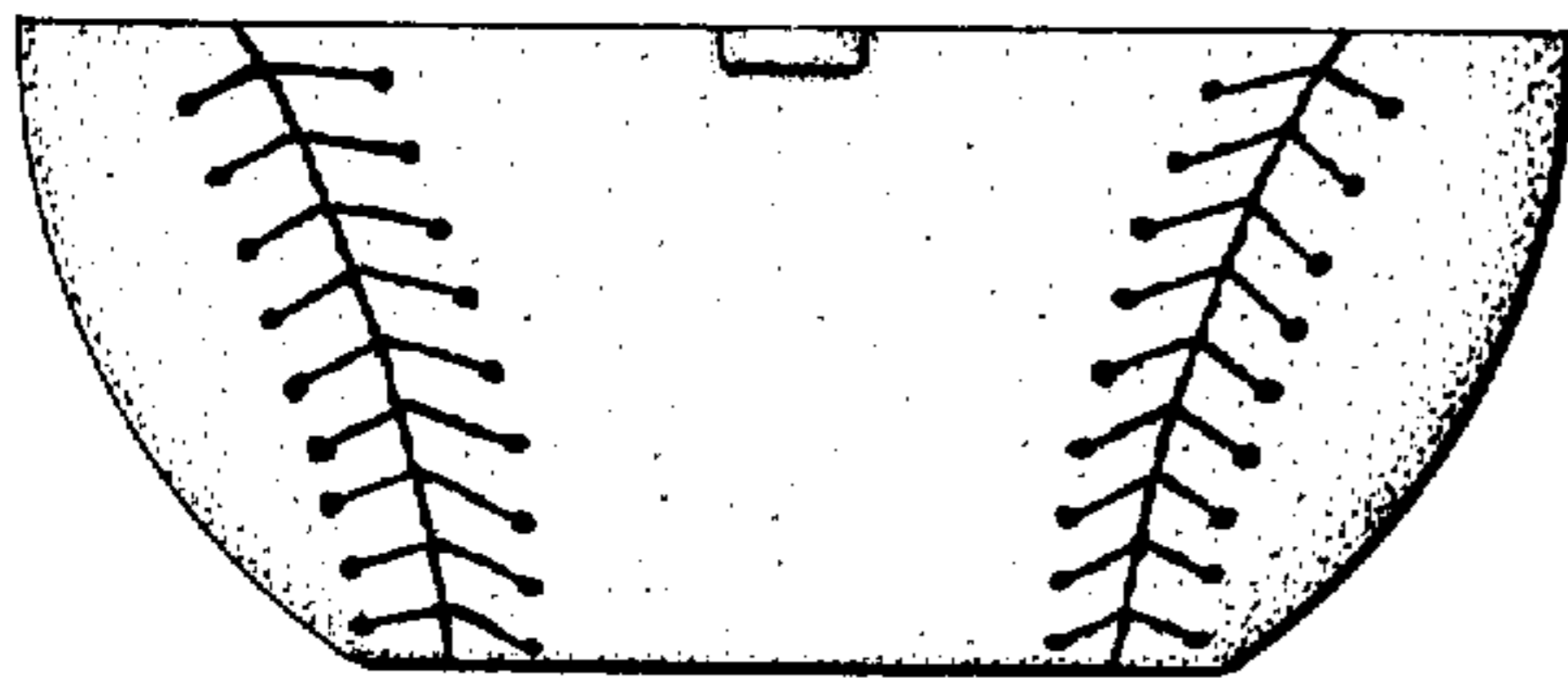

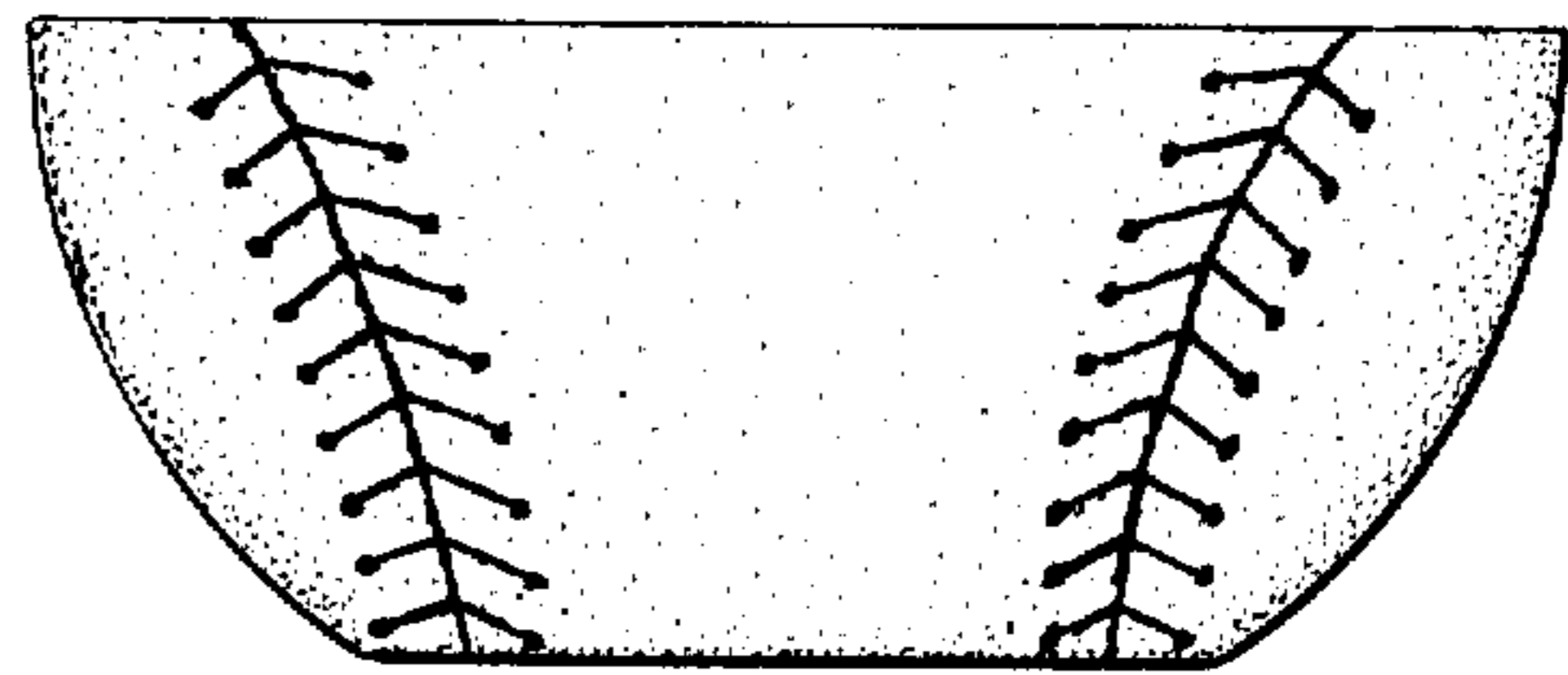

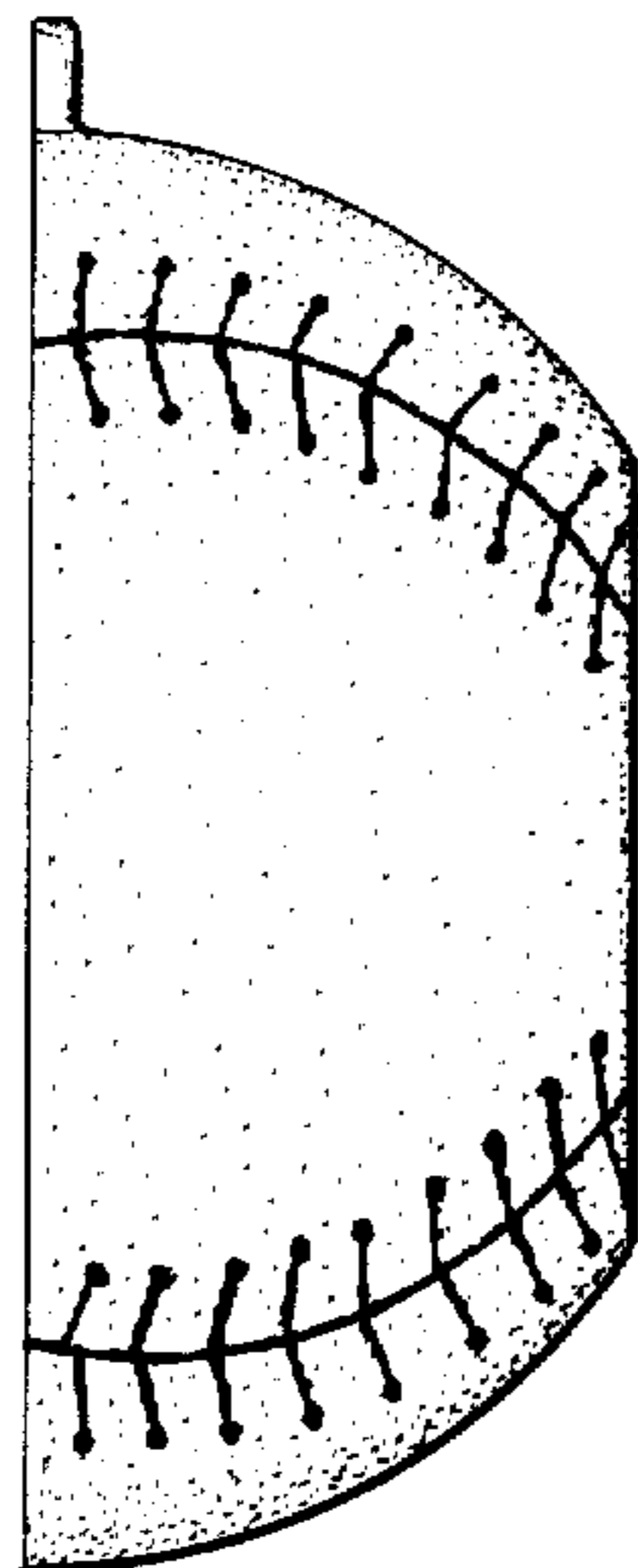
