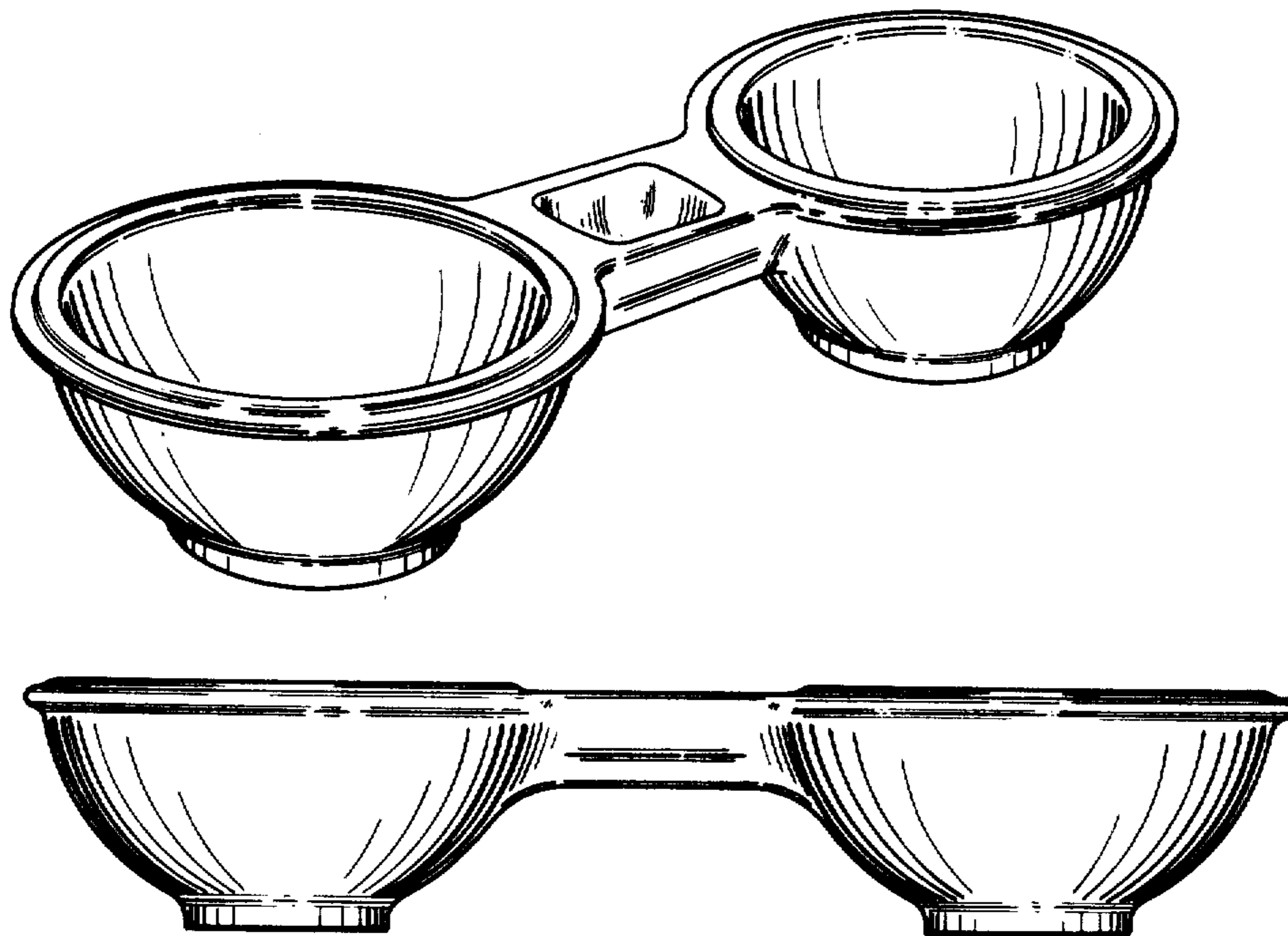

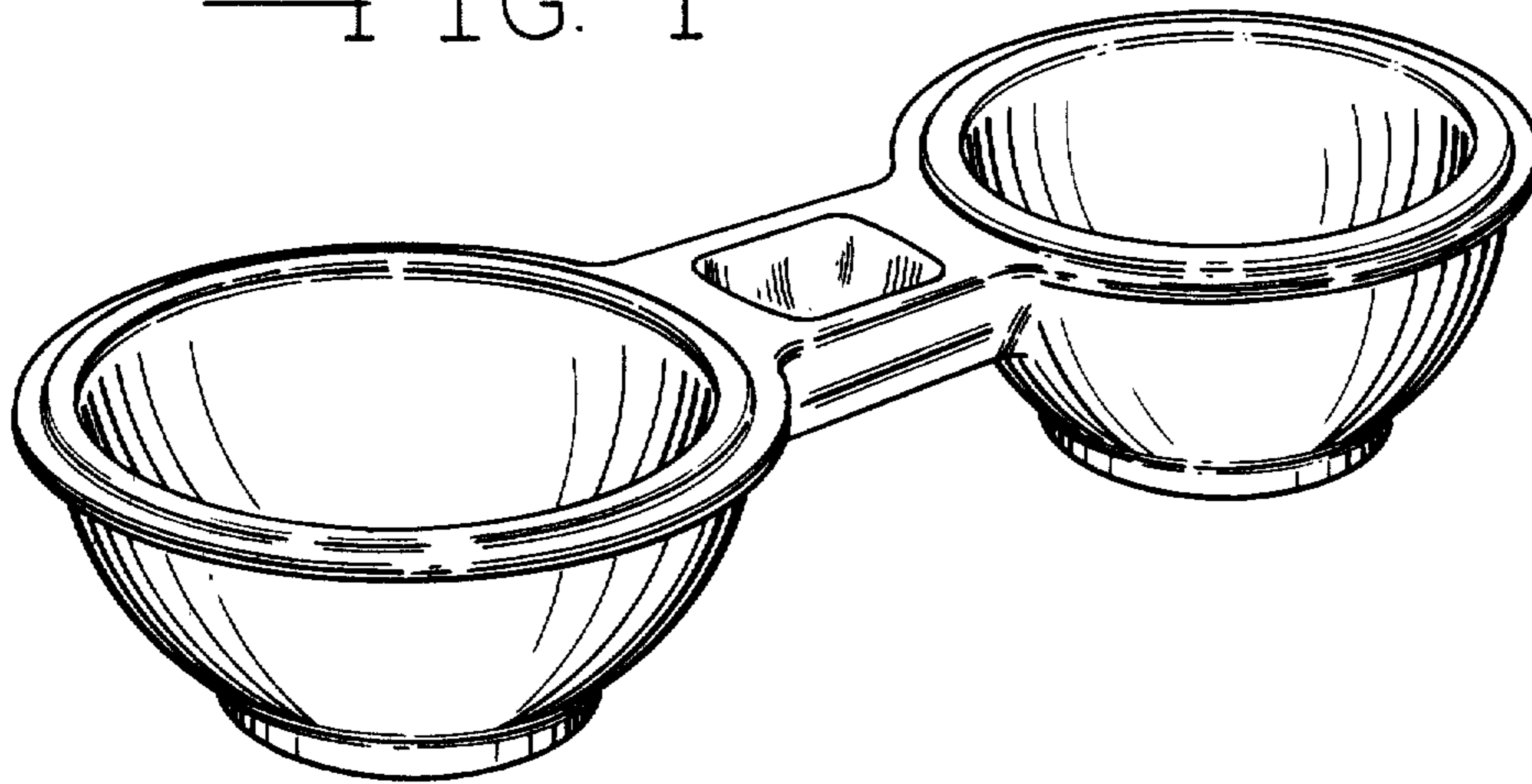
The ornamental design for a serving bowl, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

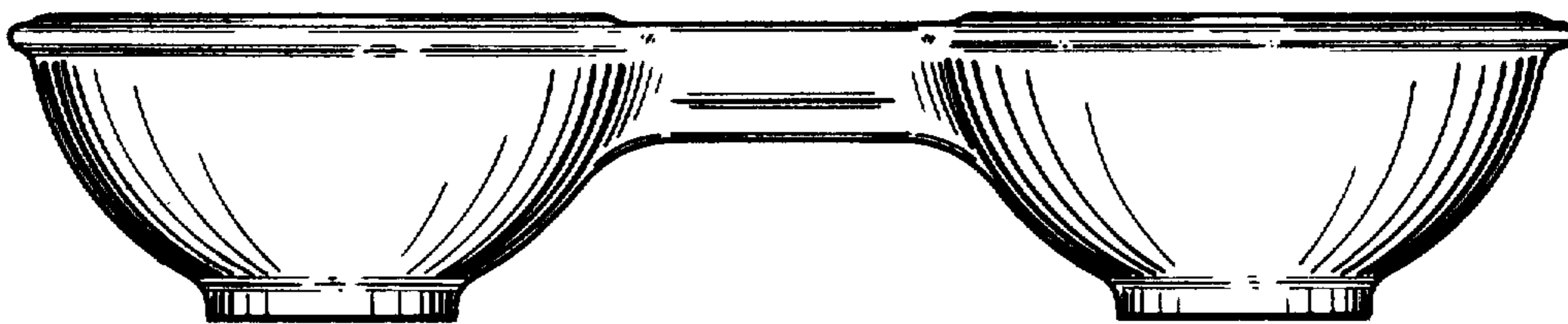
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a serving bowl showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof.



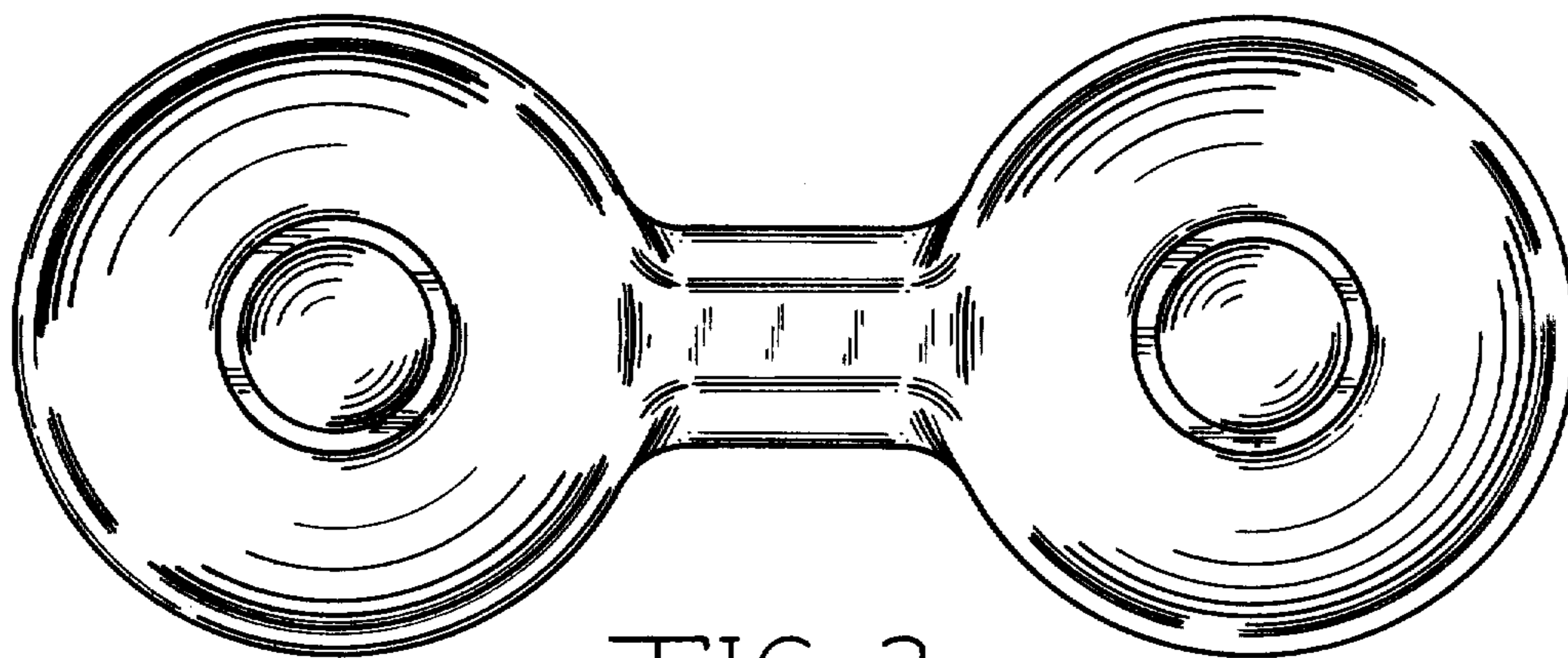
