The ornamental design for a food cutter, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a food cutter showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof. The bottom is plane and unornamented.

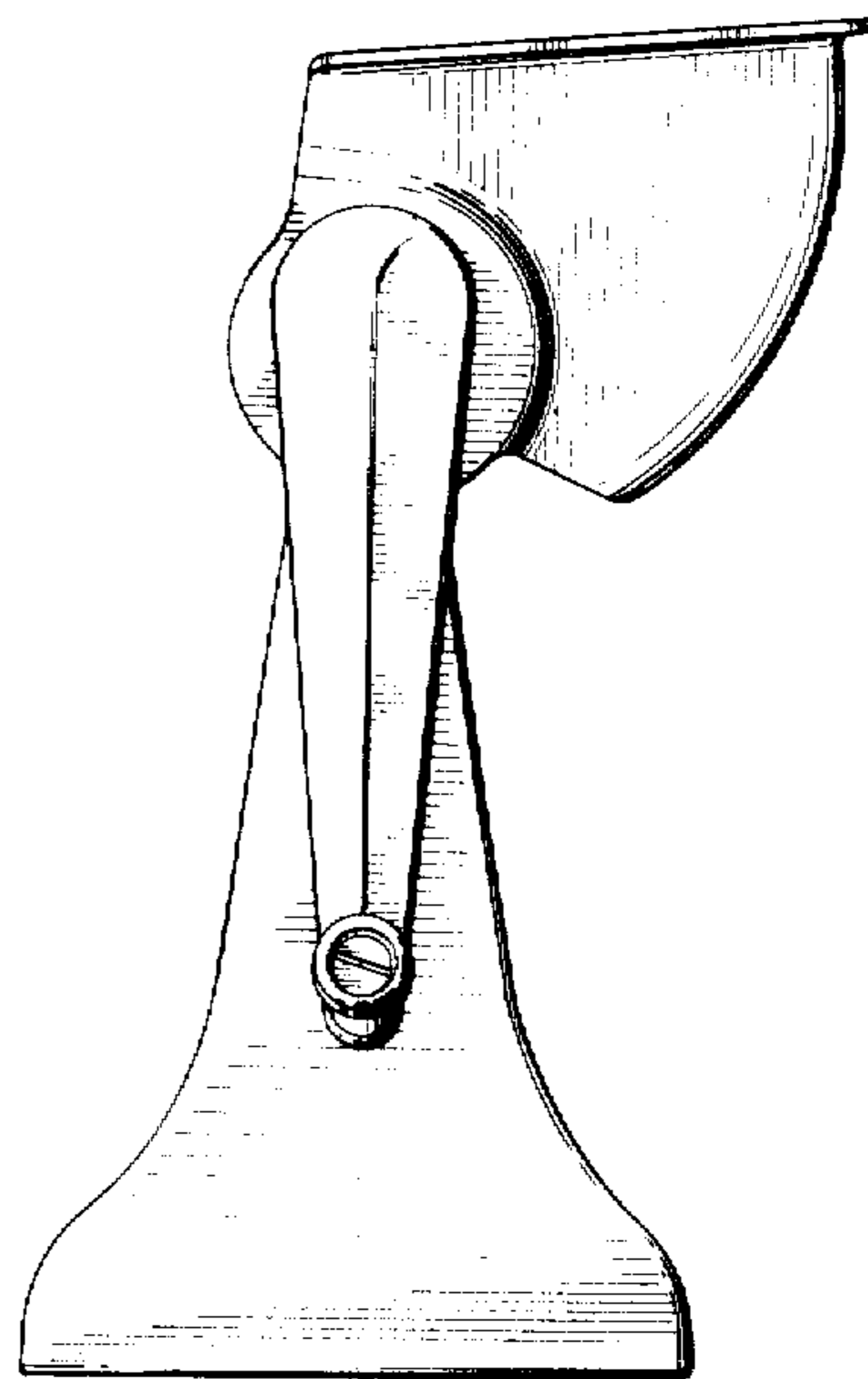
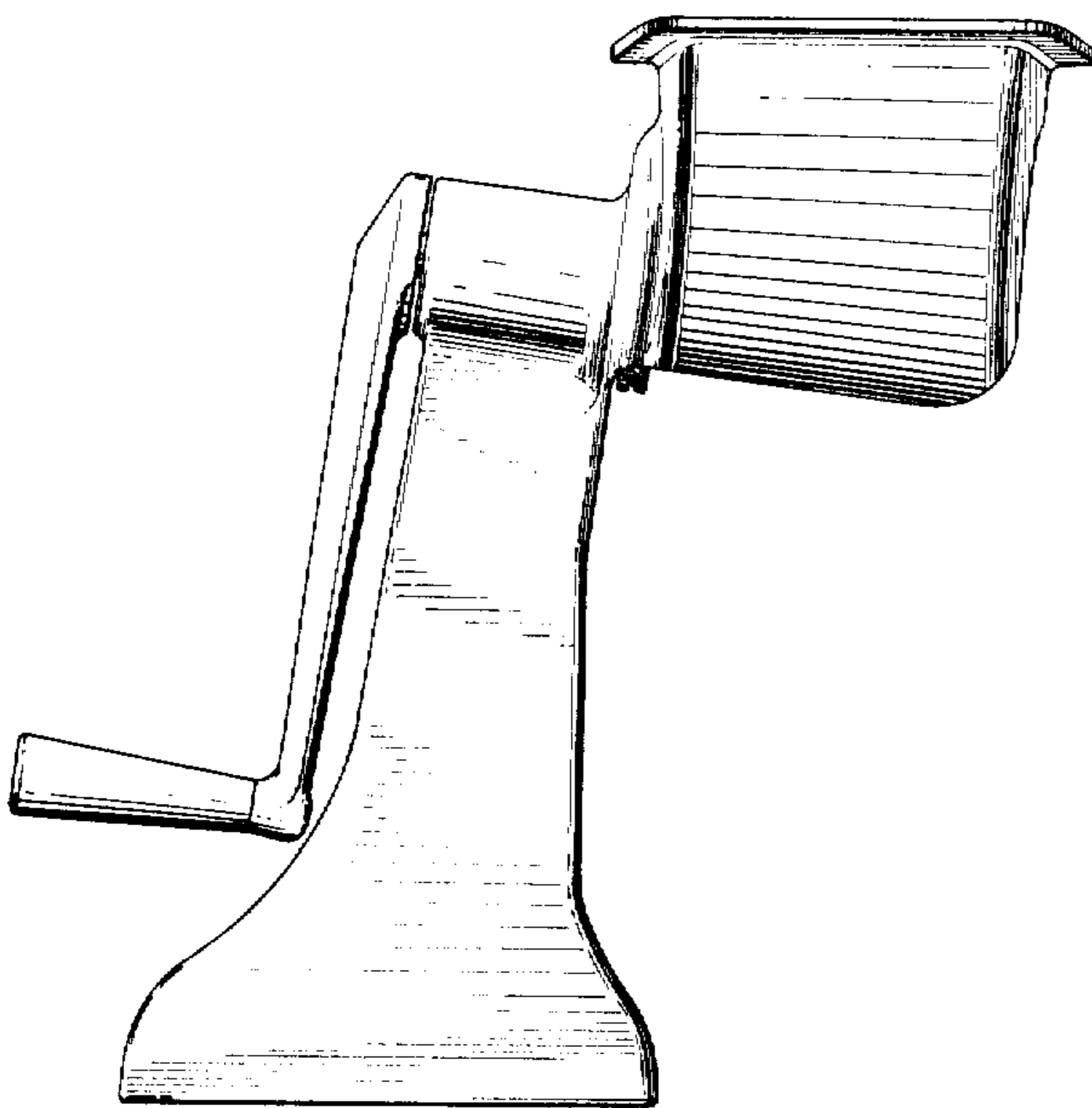

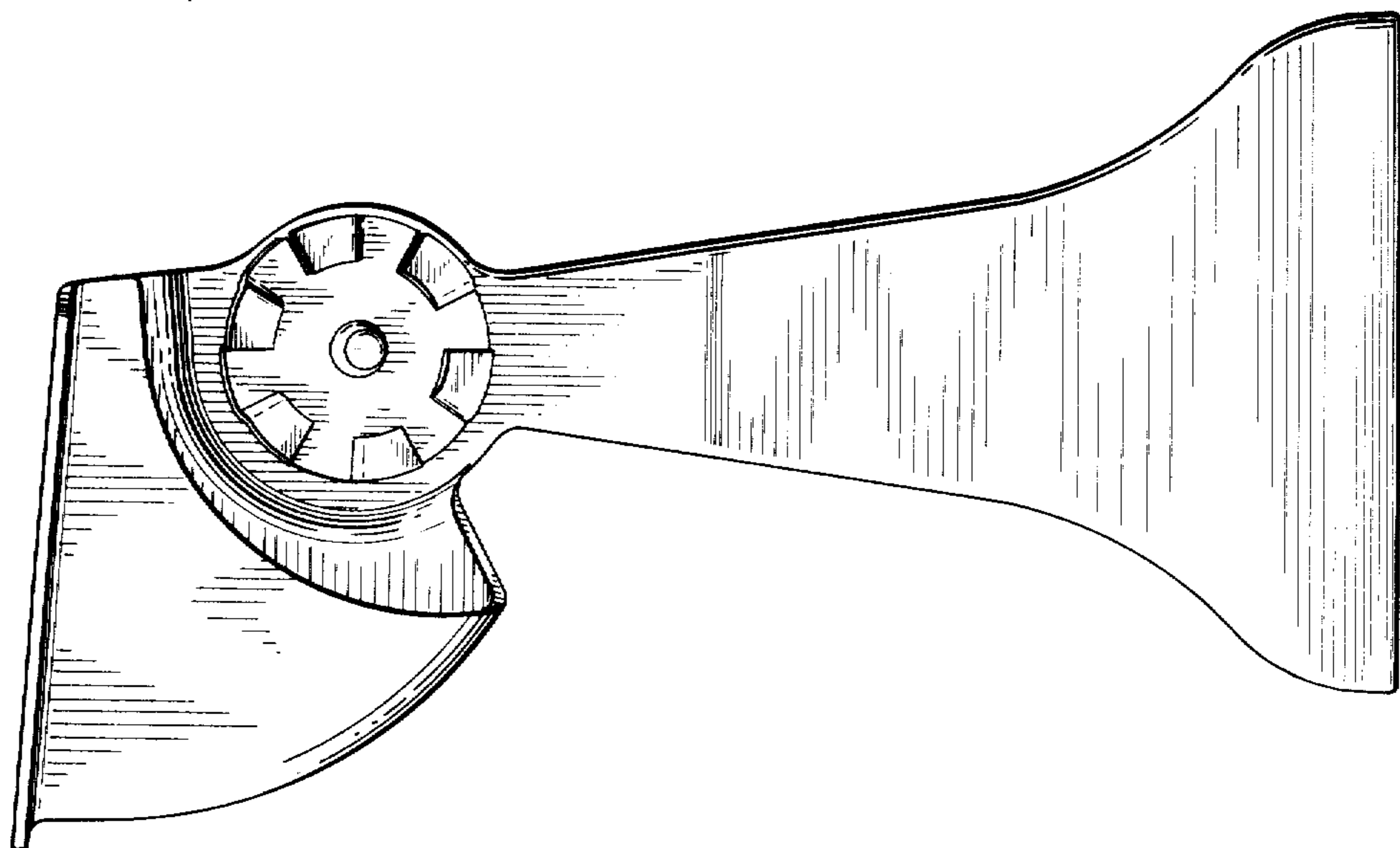

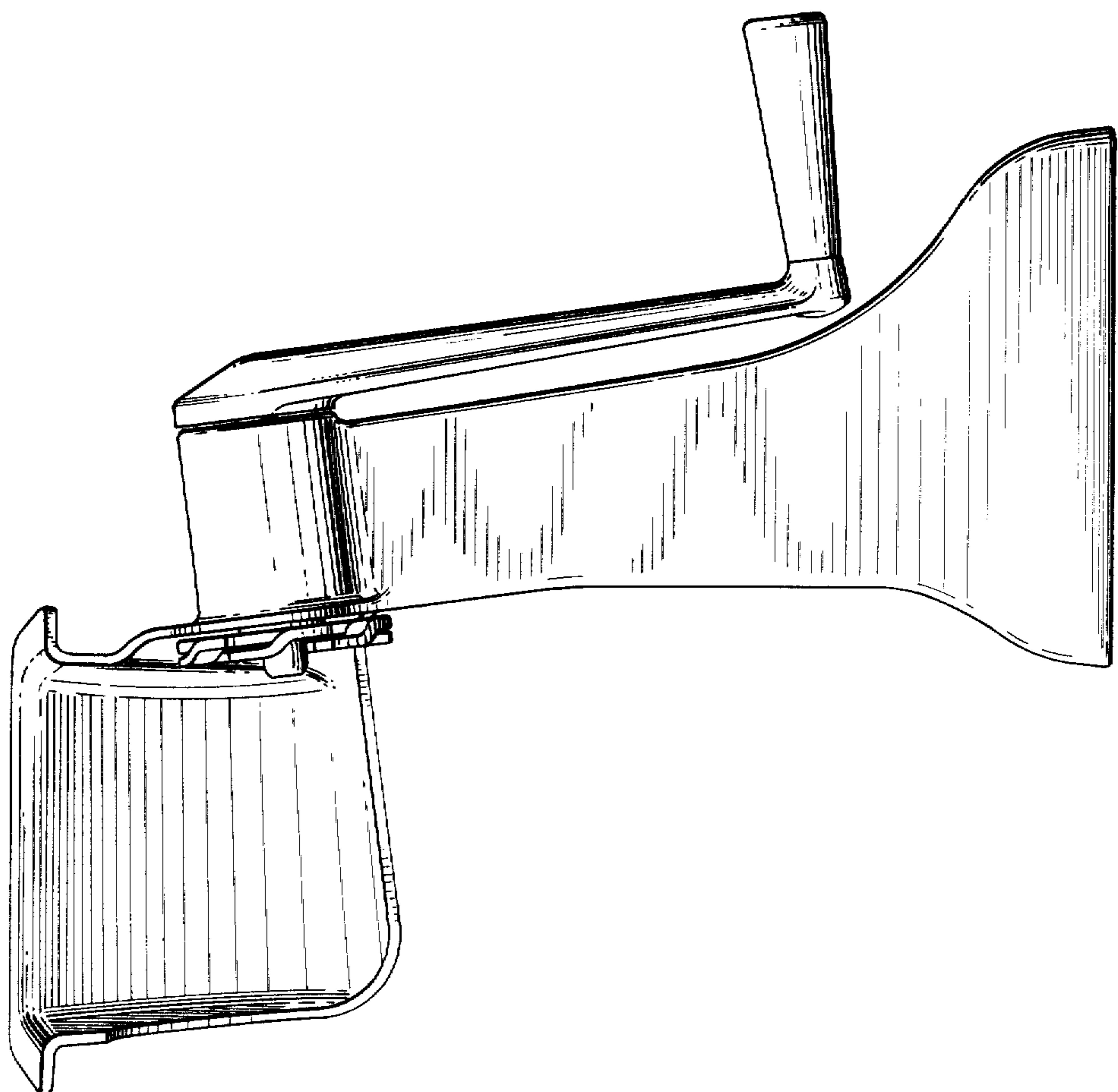

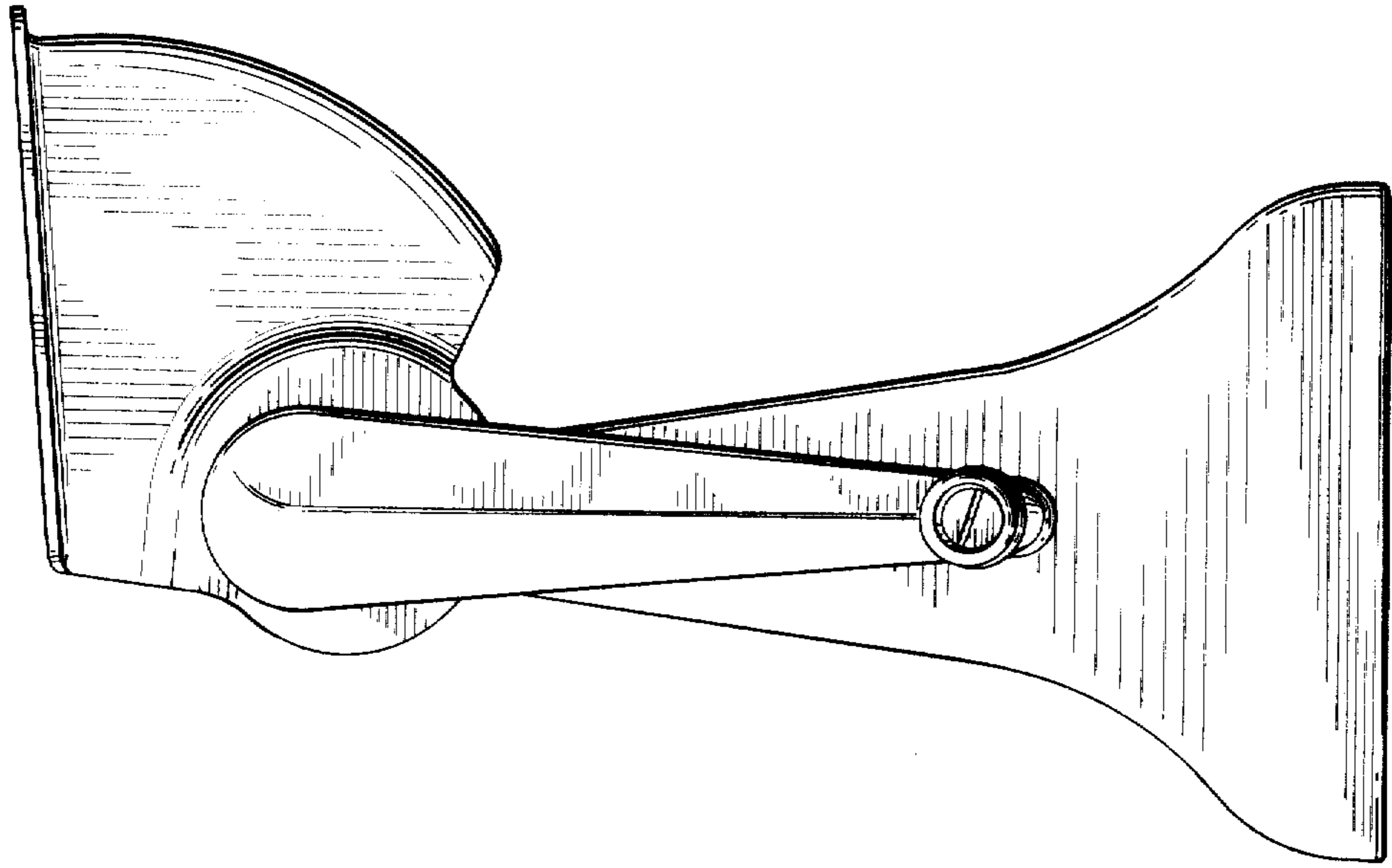

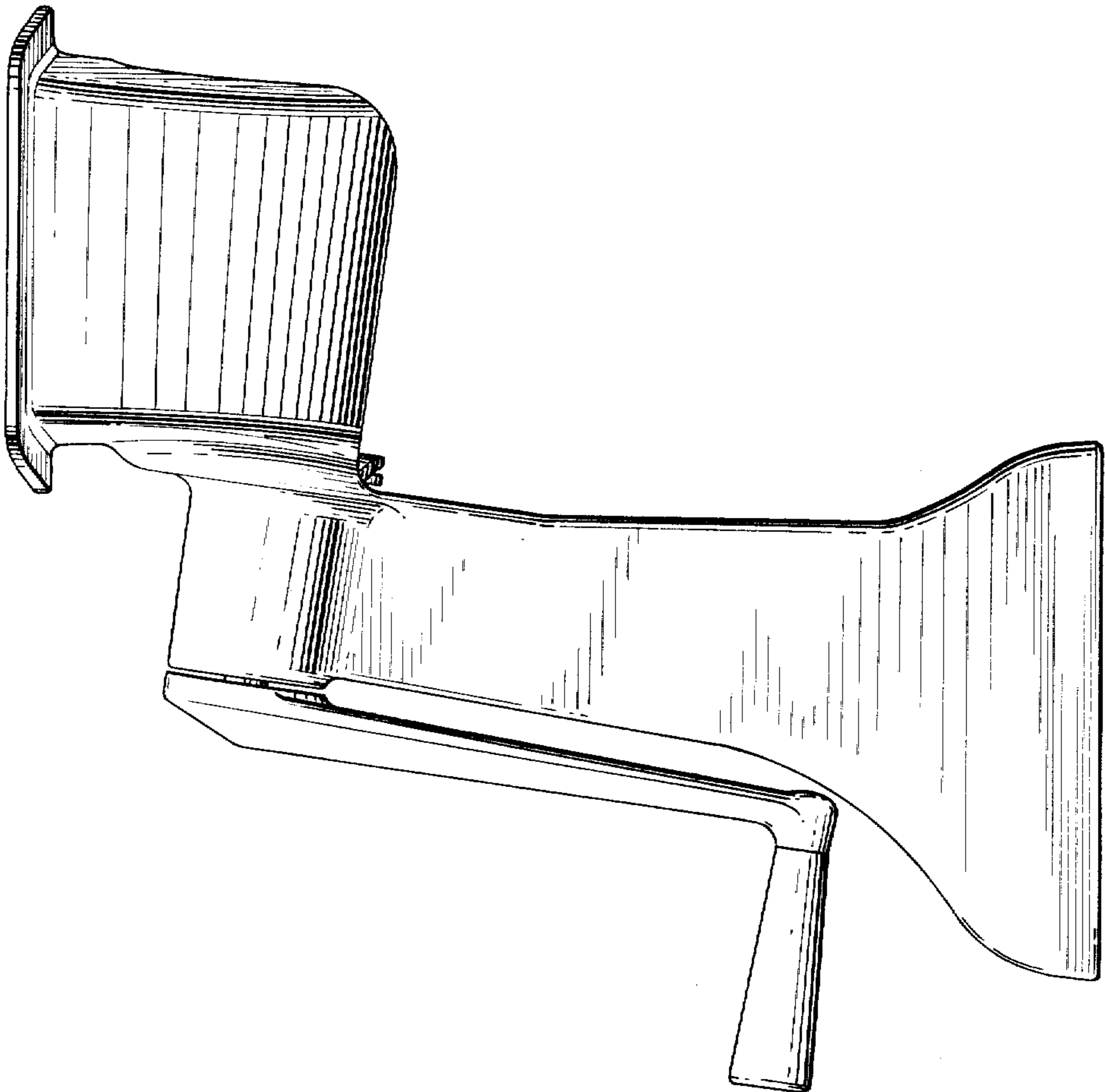
