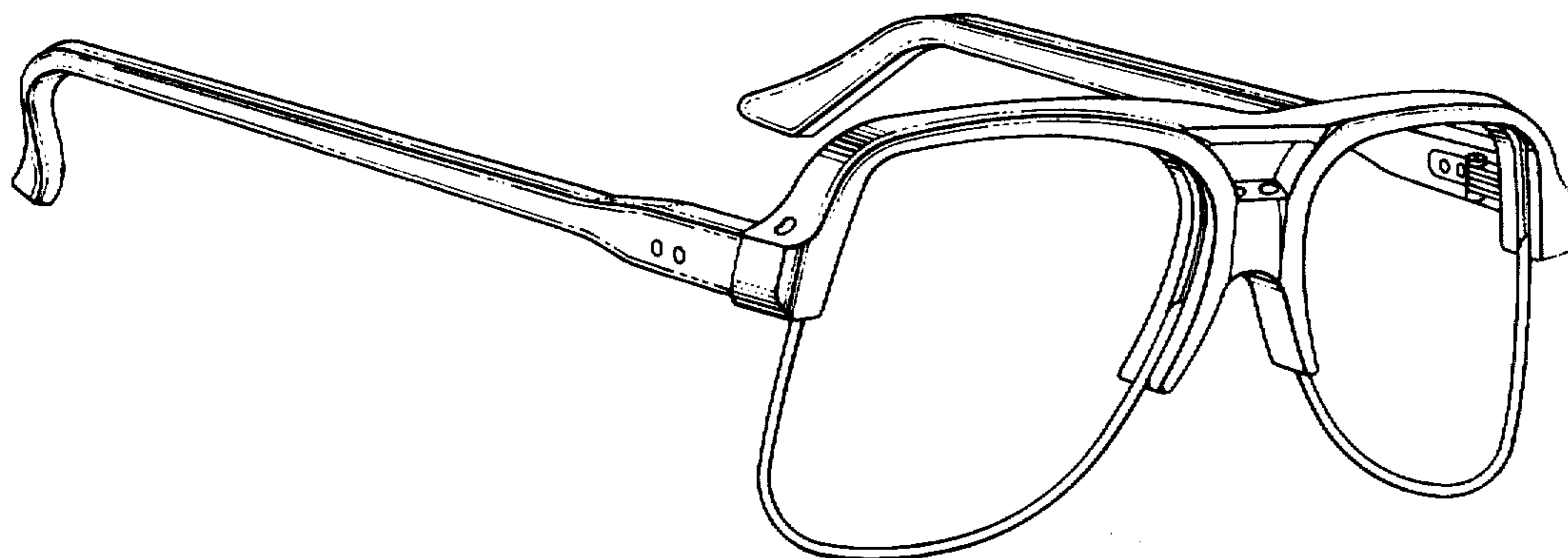

FIG. 3 is a fragmentary front view thereof, portions of the frame being broken away for purposes of disclosure.



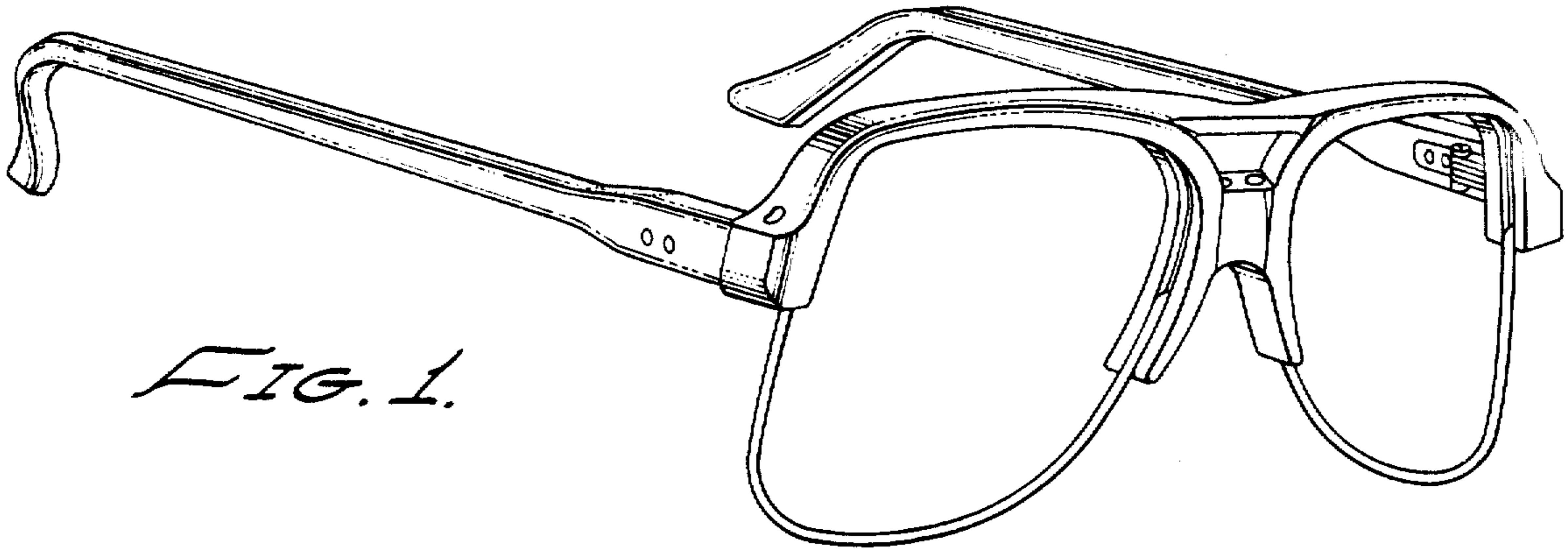

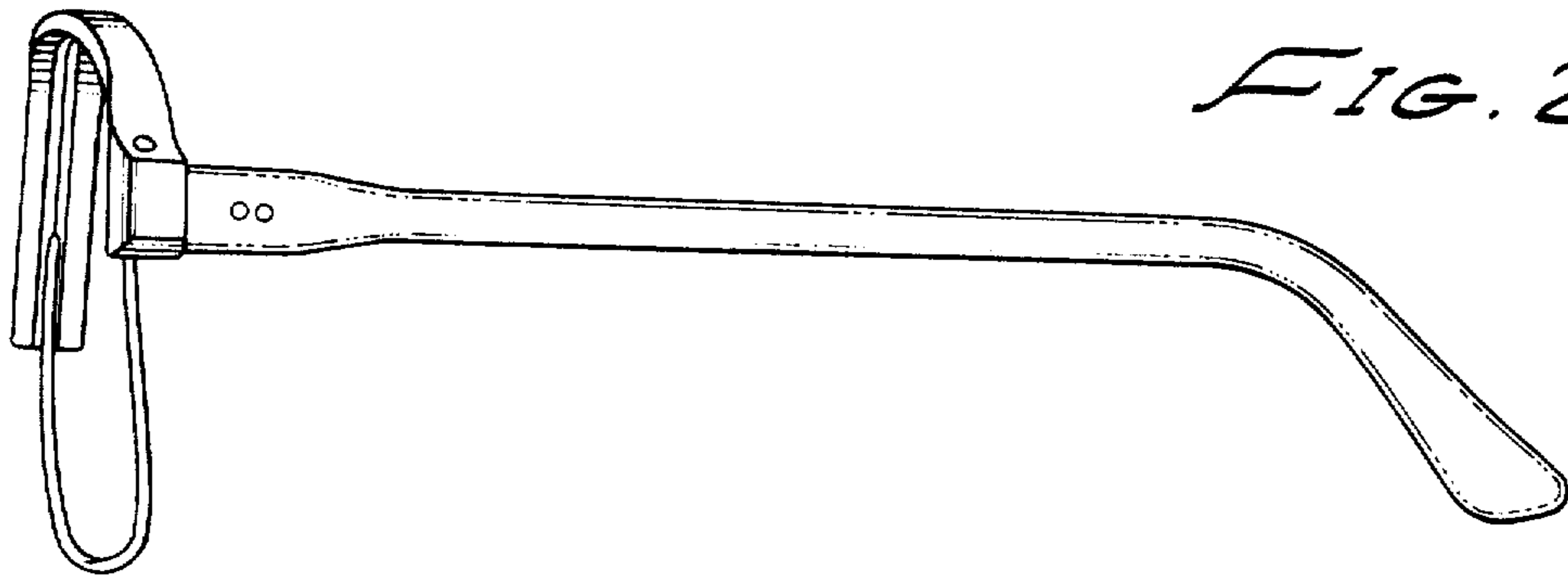
