[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined chair, tablet arm, ashtray and magazine rack, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left perspective view of a combined chair, tablet arm, ashtray and magazine rack showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side of which corresponds;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 1 but showing the chair with the seat in a tipped-up condition.

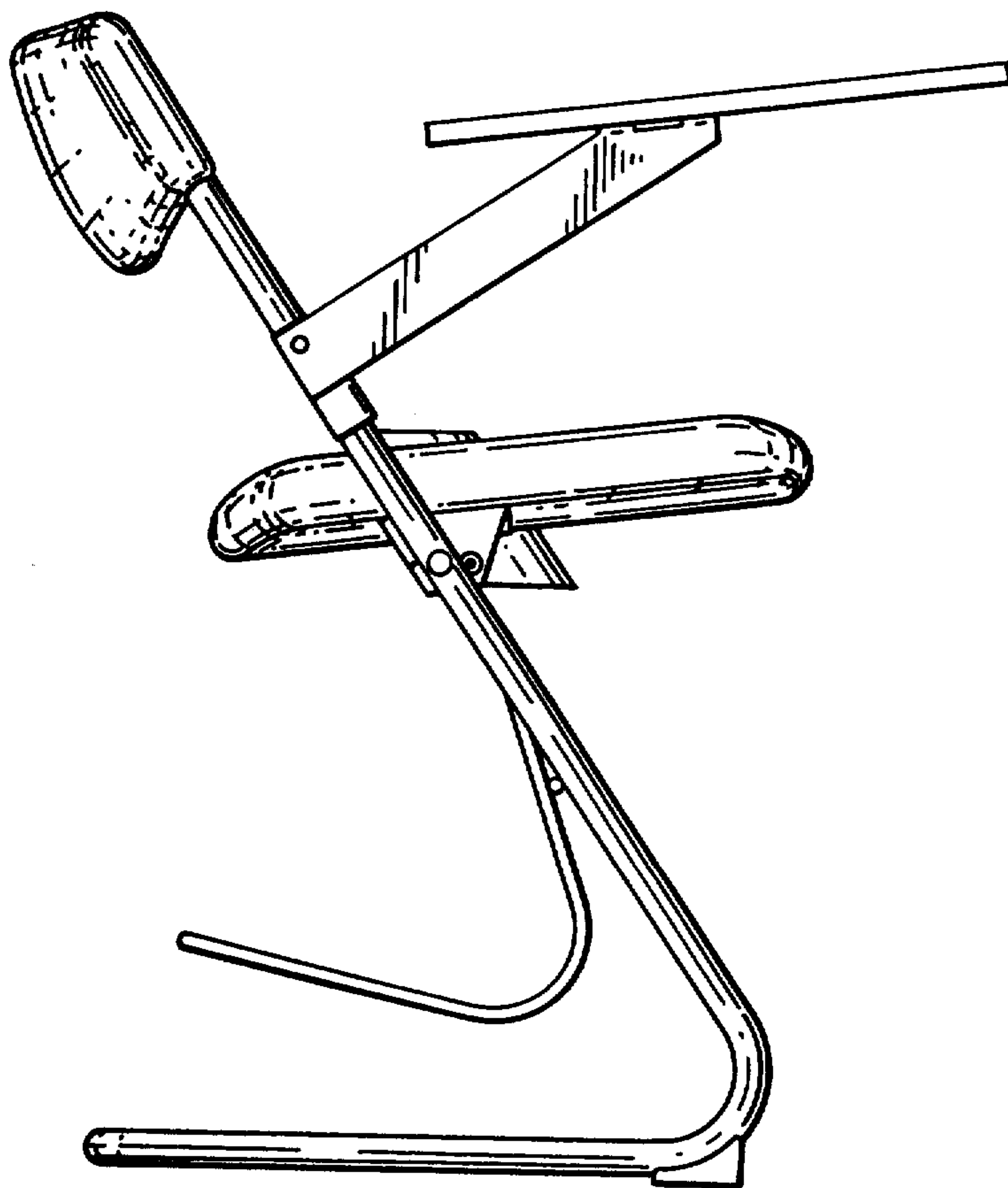

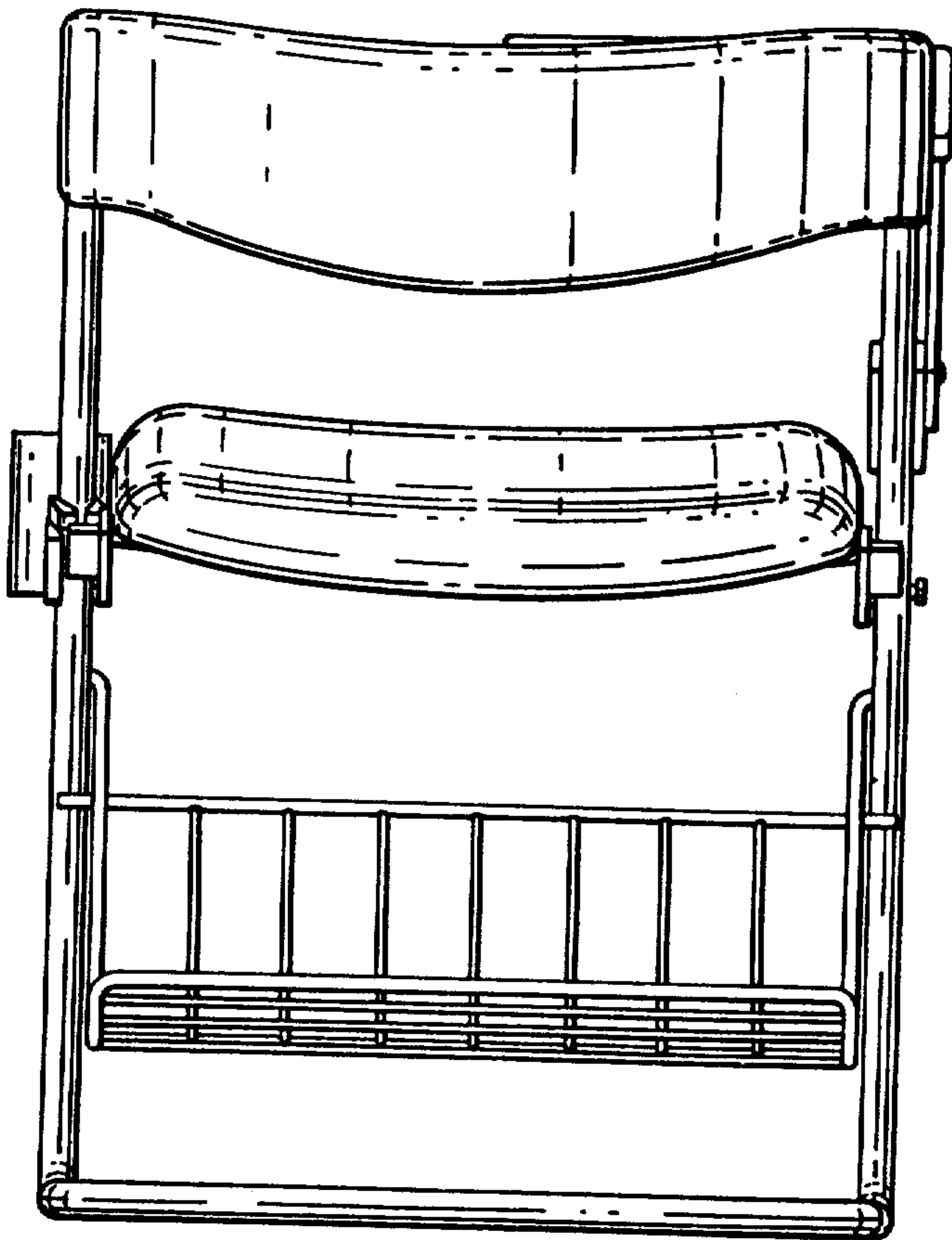
