DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair embodying the invention.
 FIG. 2 is a side view of the chair of FIG. 1.
 FIG. 3 is a rear view of the chair of FIG. 1.
 FIG. 4 is a top view of the chair of FIG. 1.
 FIG. 5 is a sectional view, to an enlarged scale, taken along the section 5—5 in FIG. 3.

 FIG. 9 is a top view of the chair of FIG. 6.

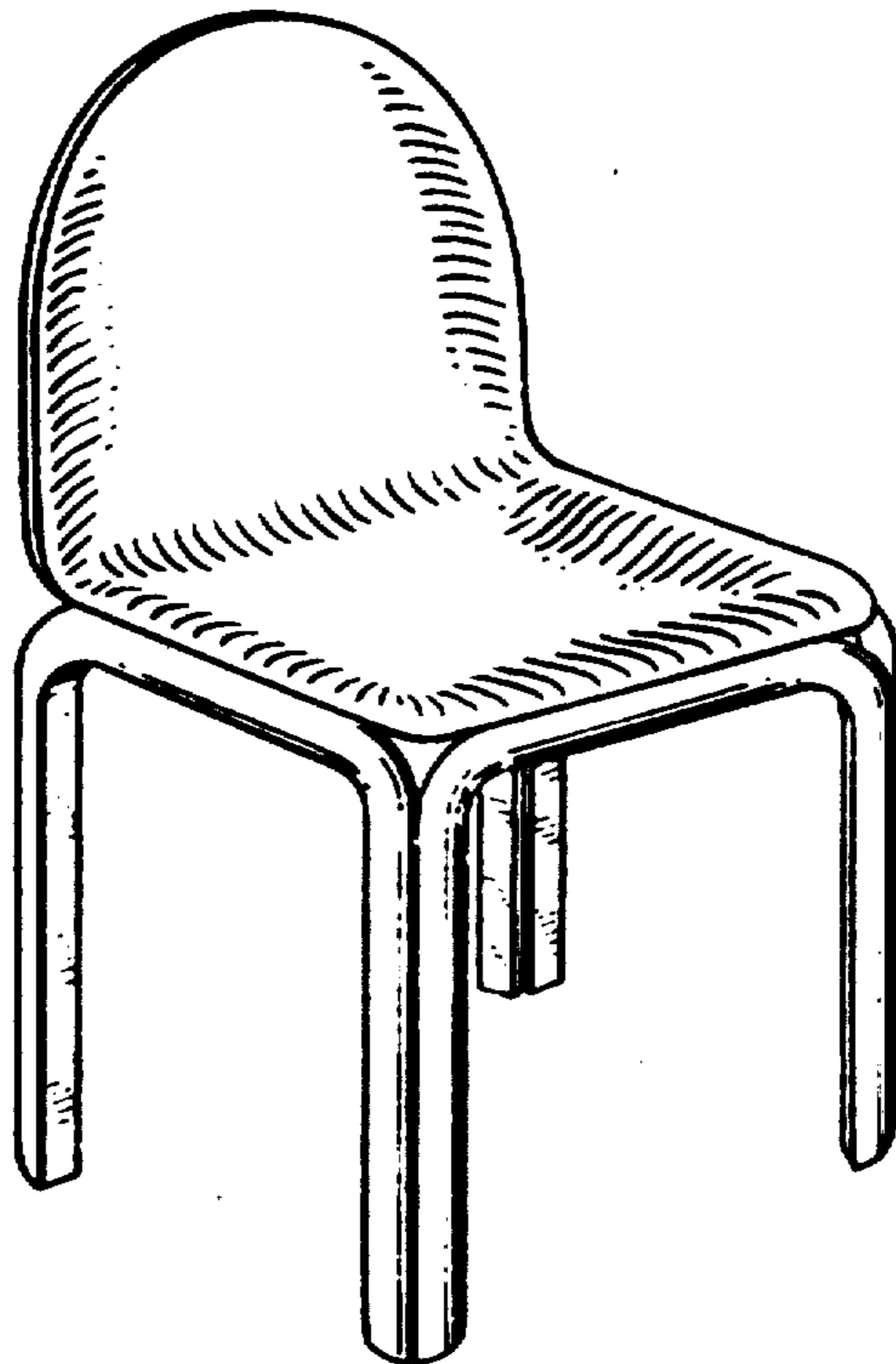

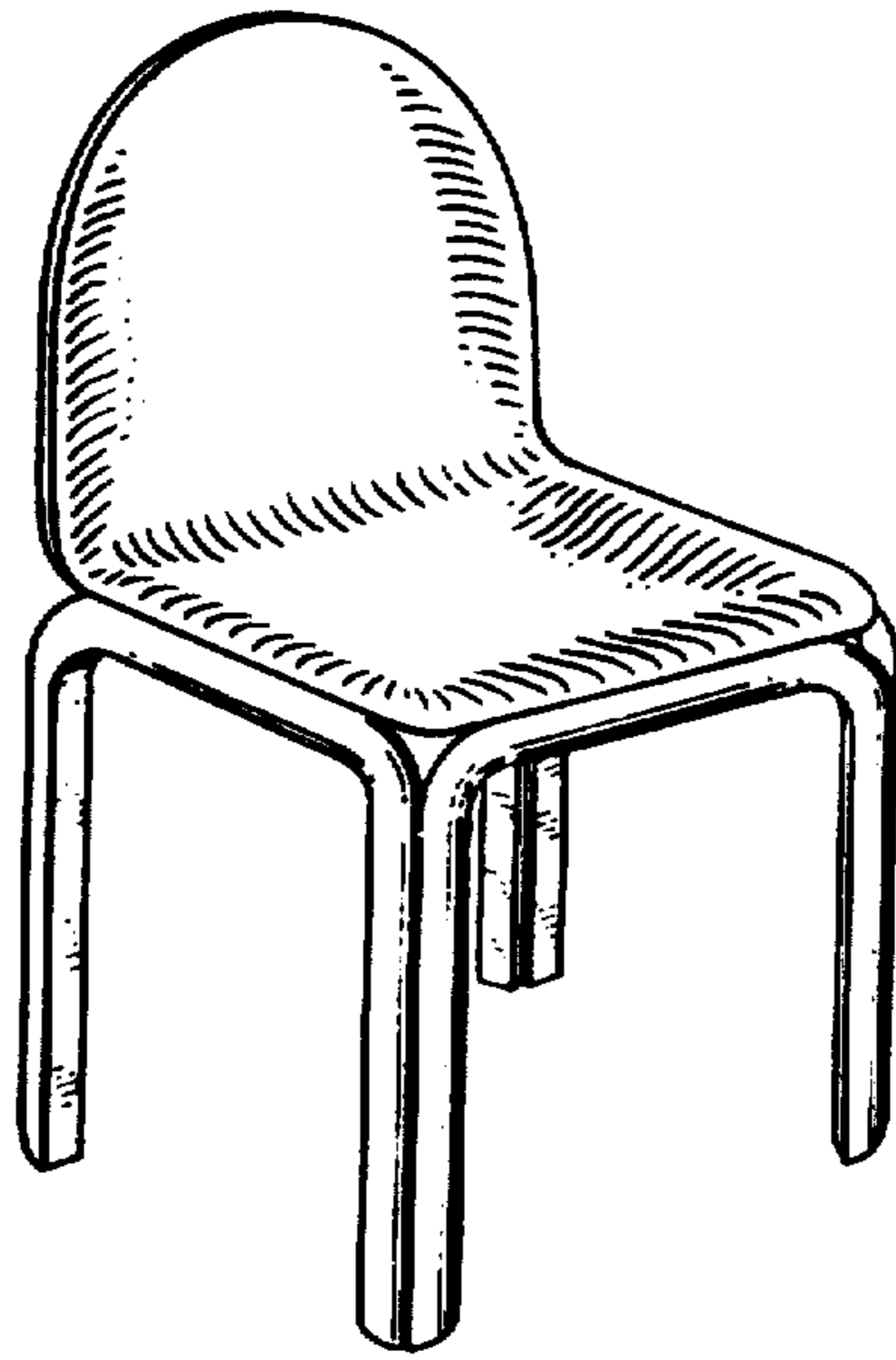

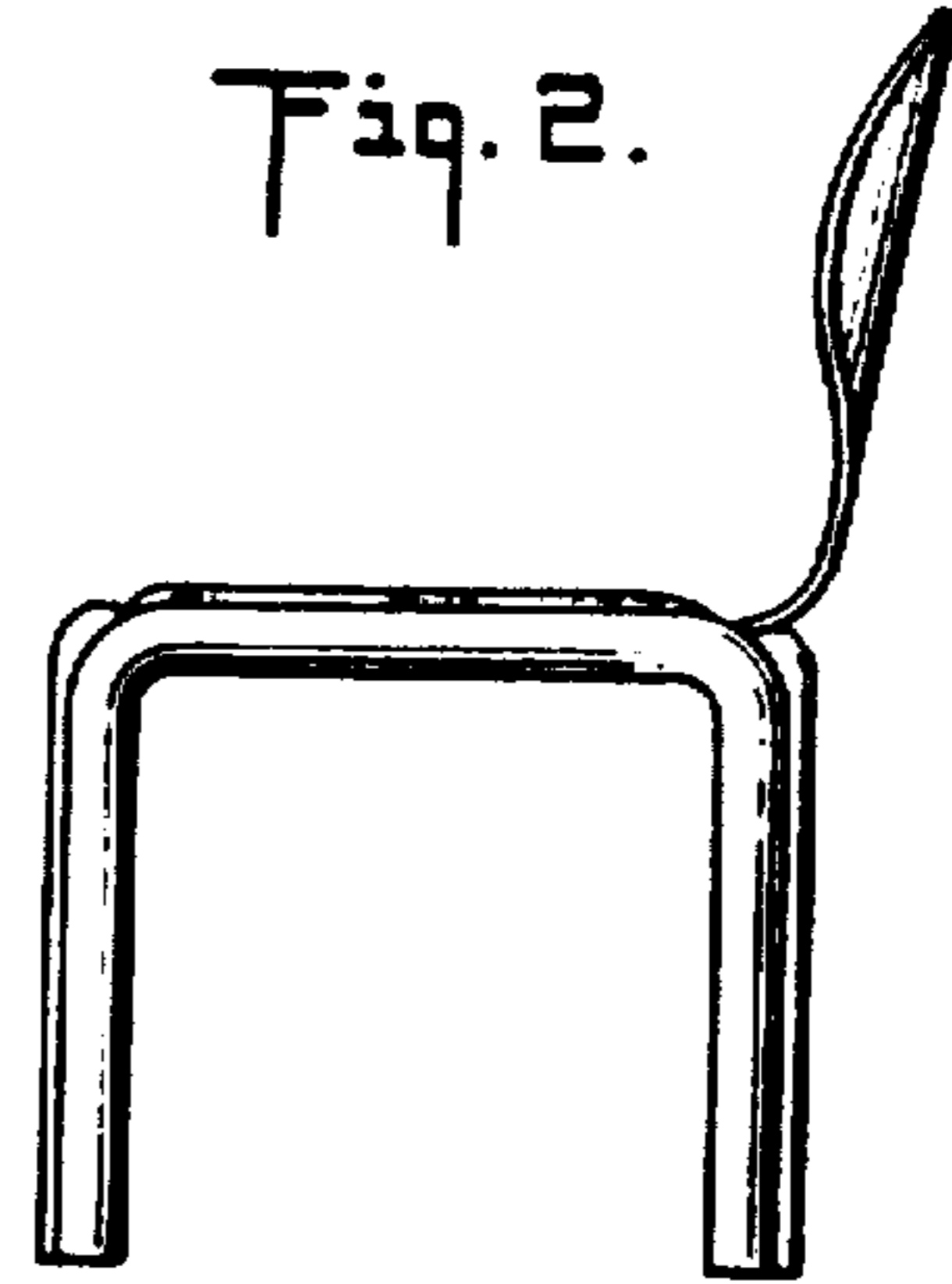

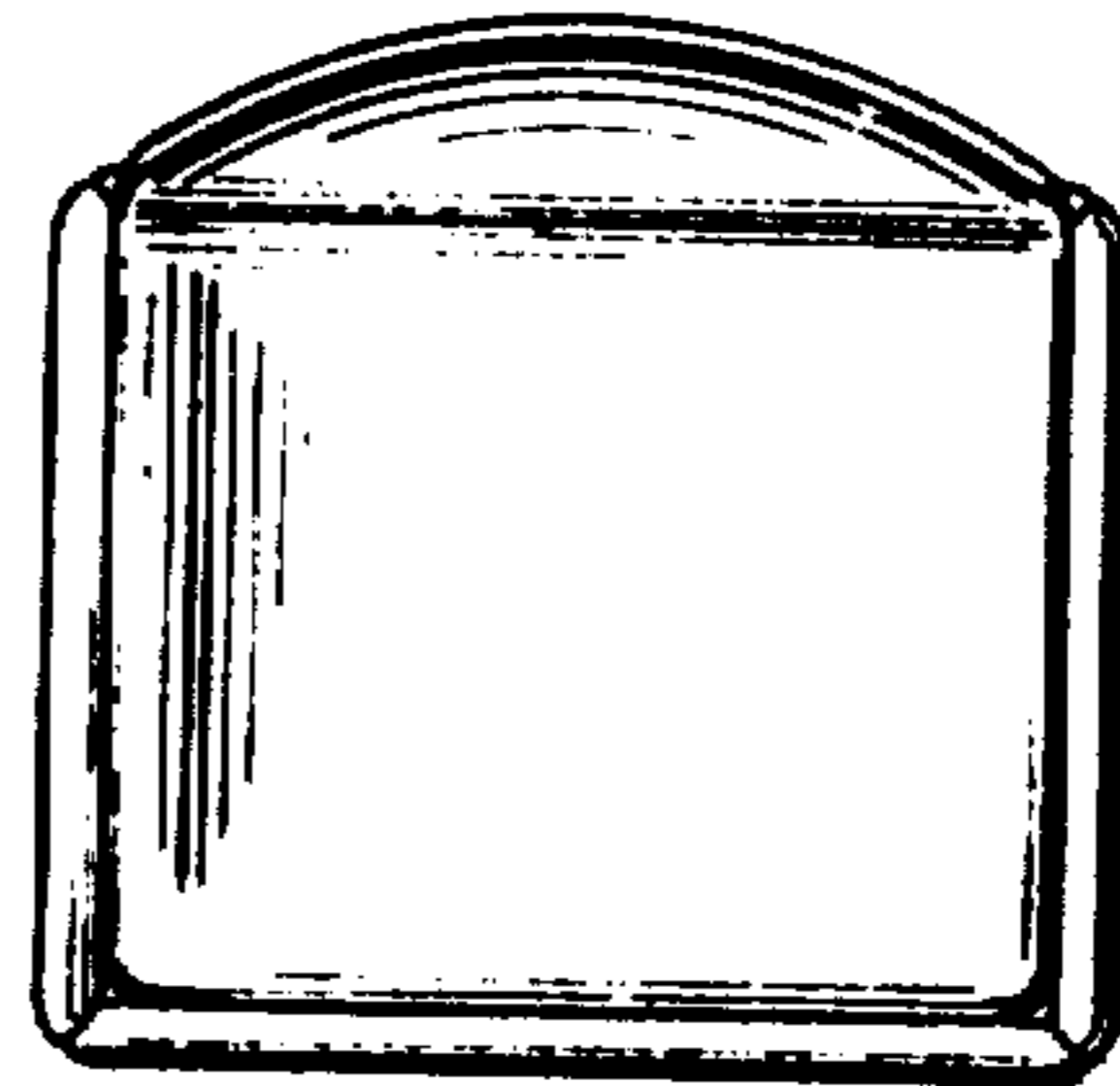

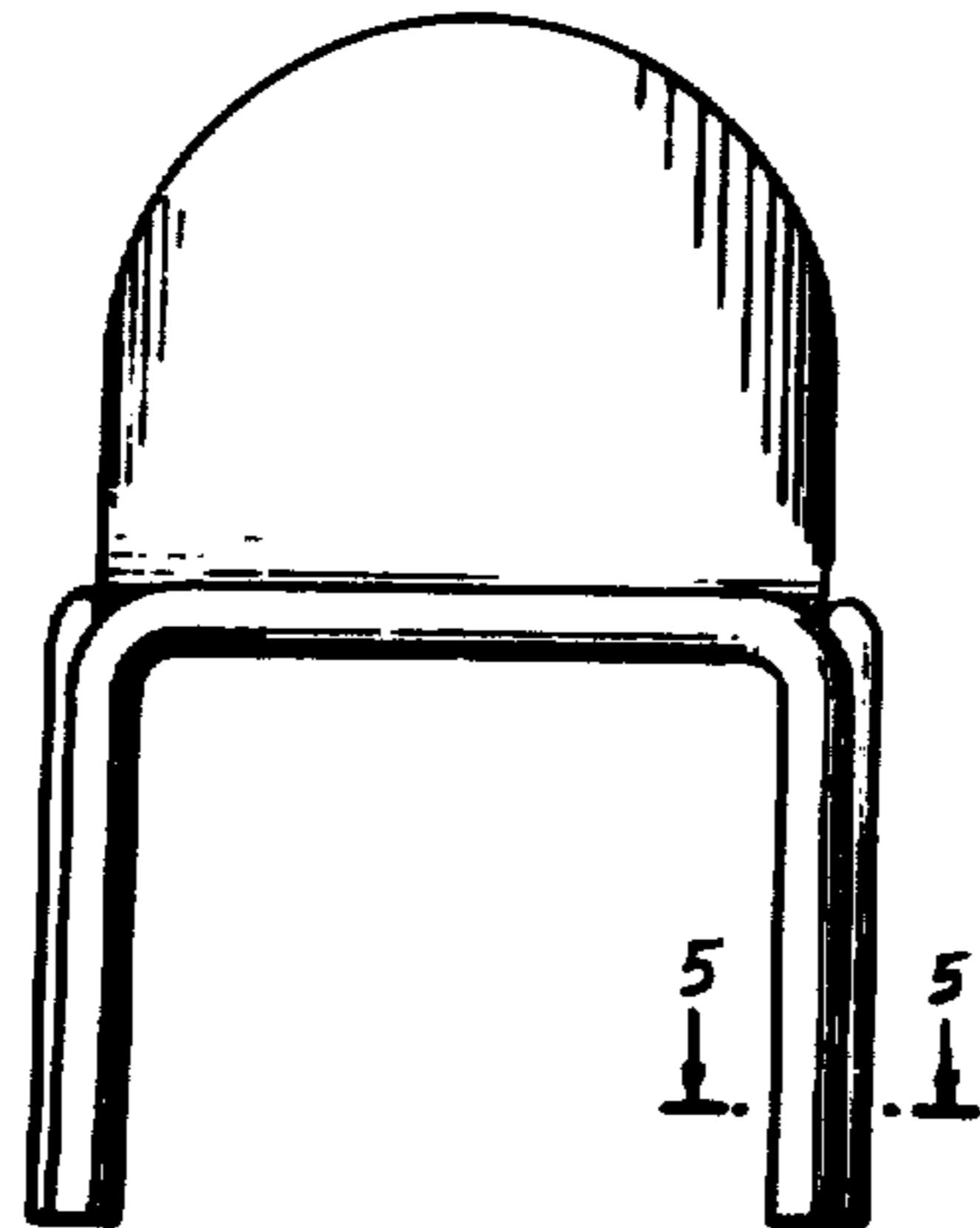

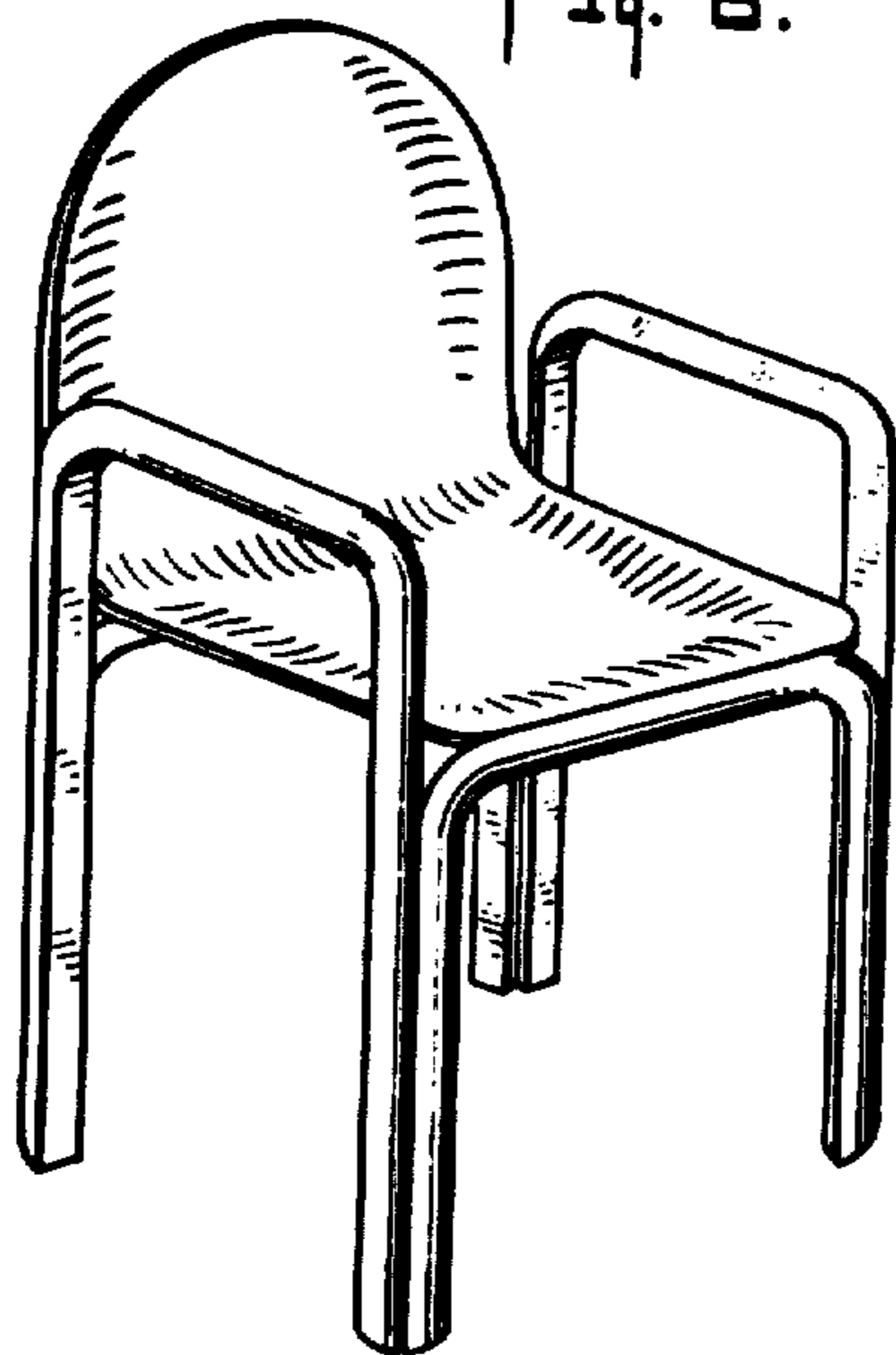

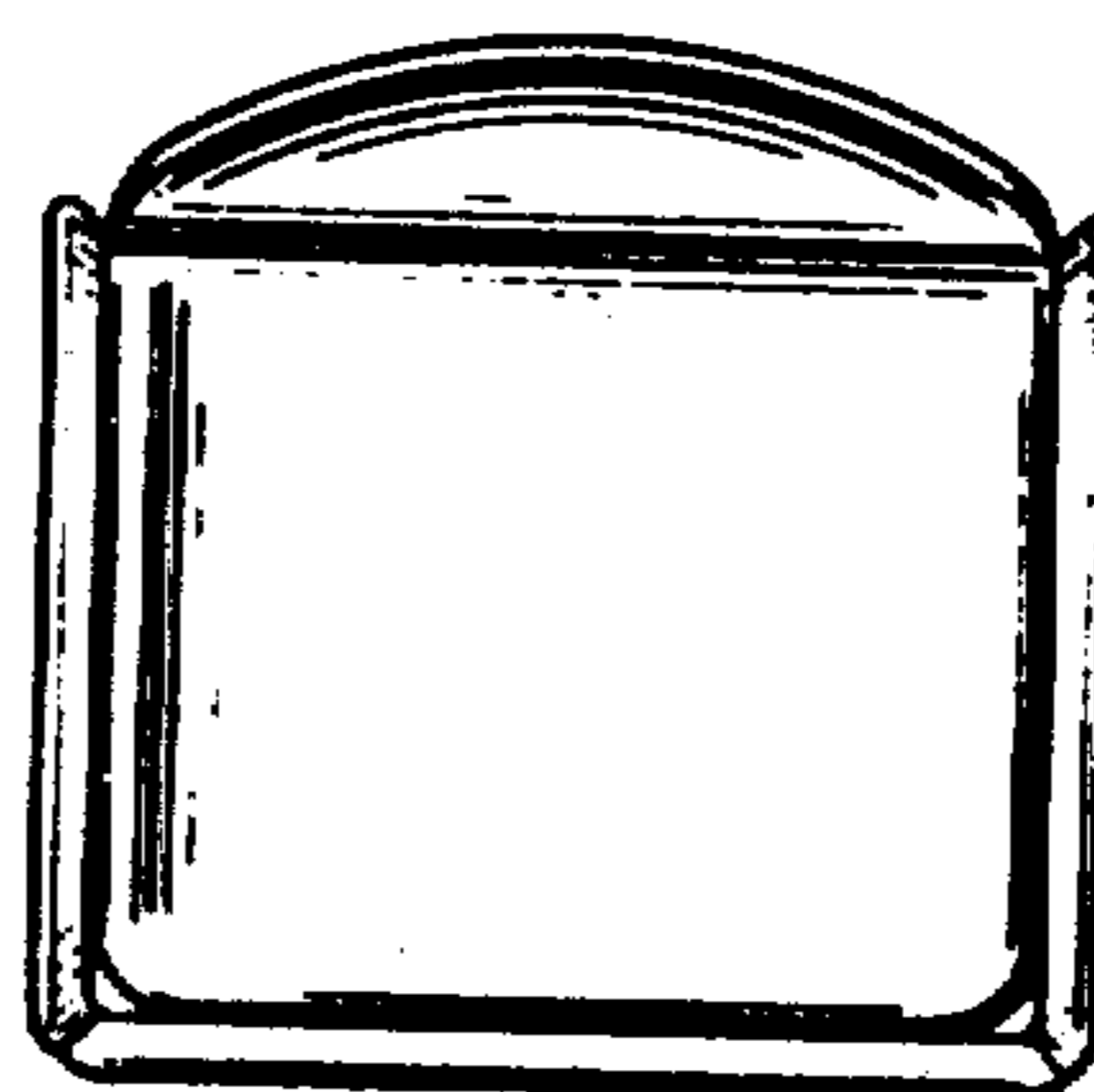
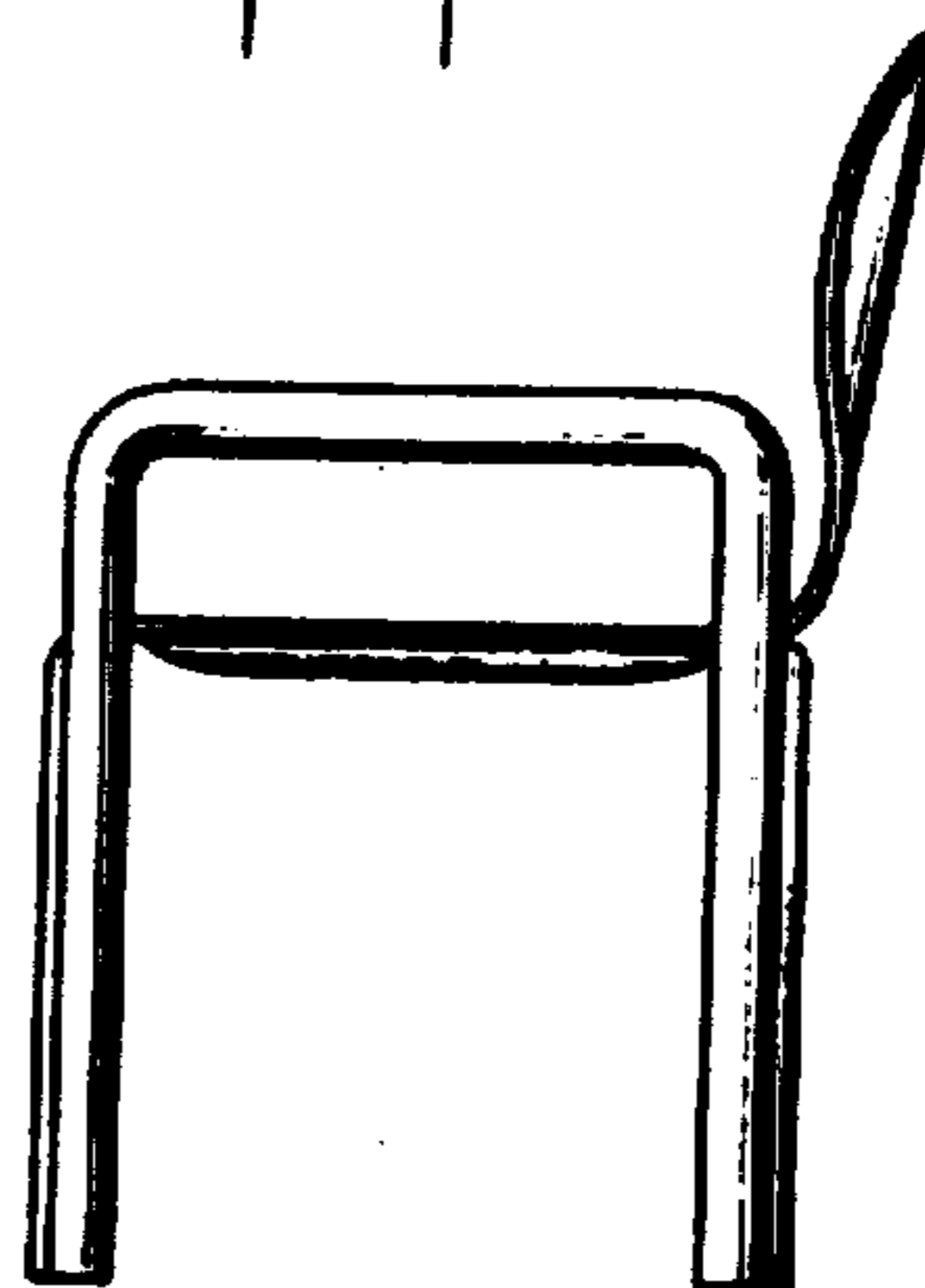

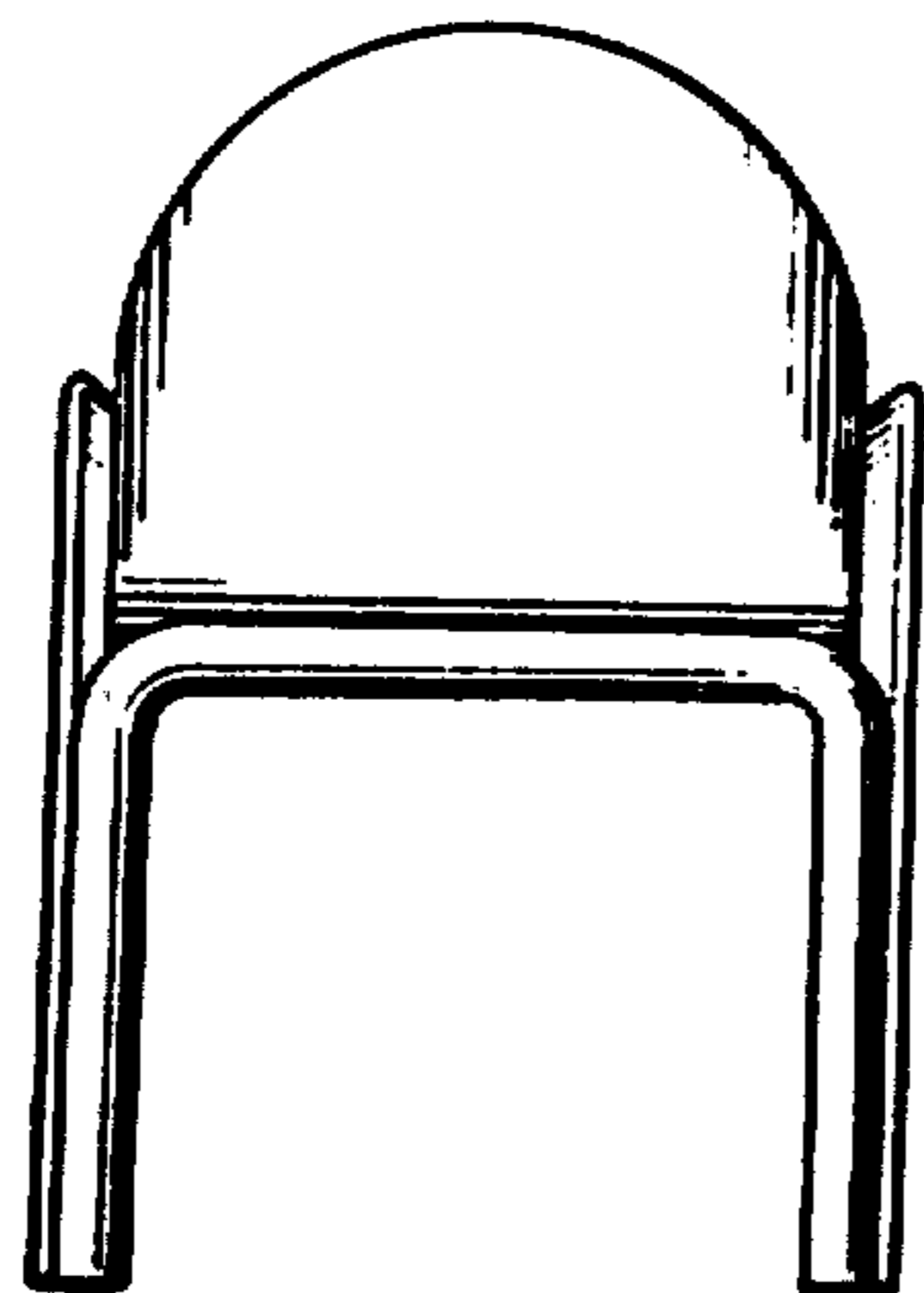
