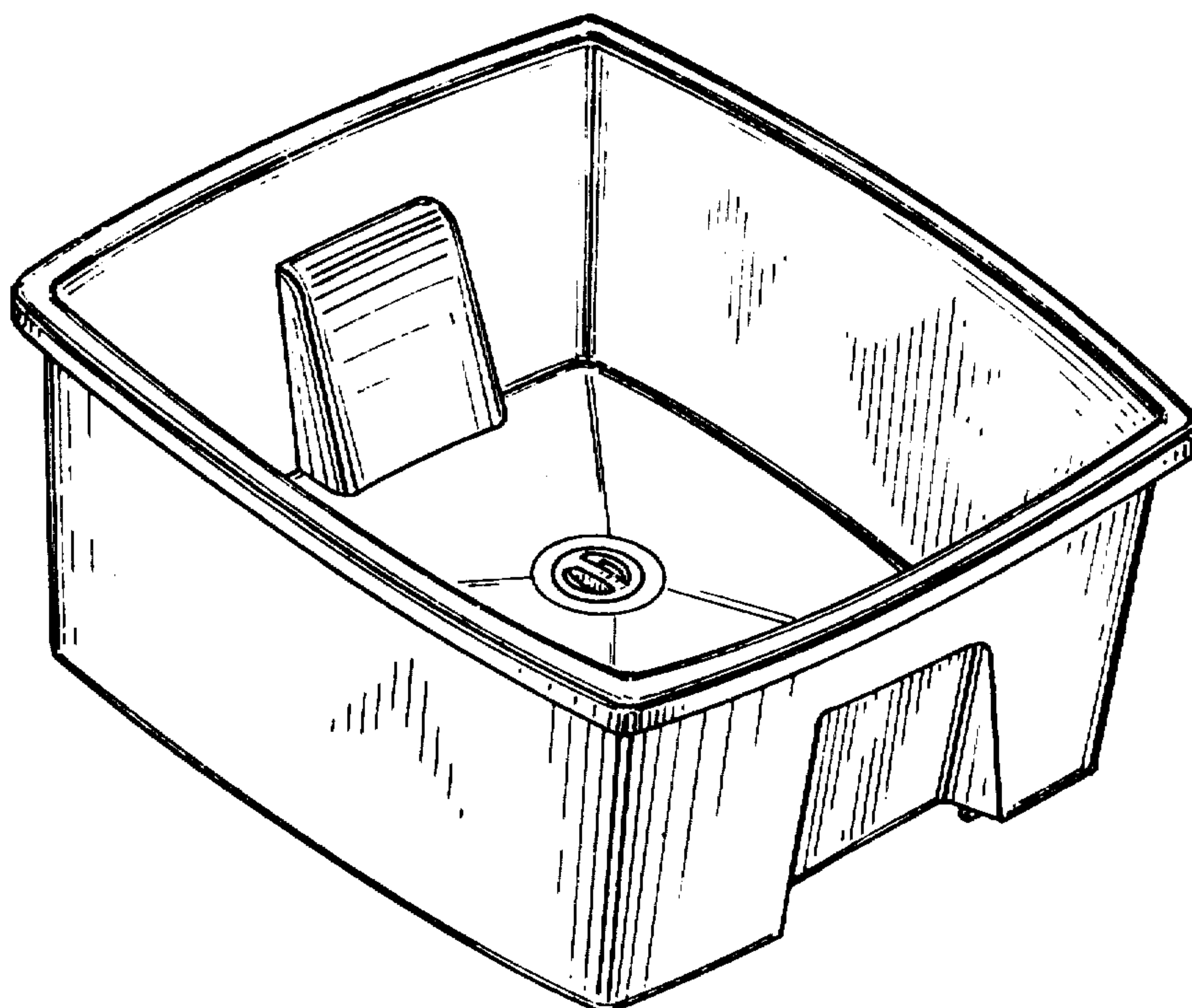

FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; revealing the drain.



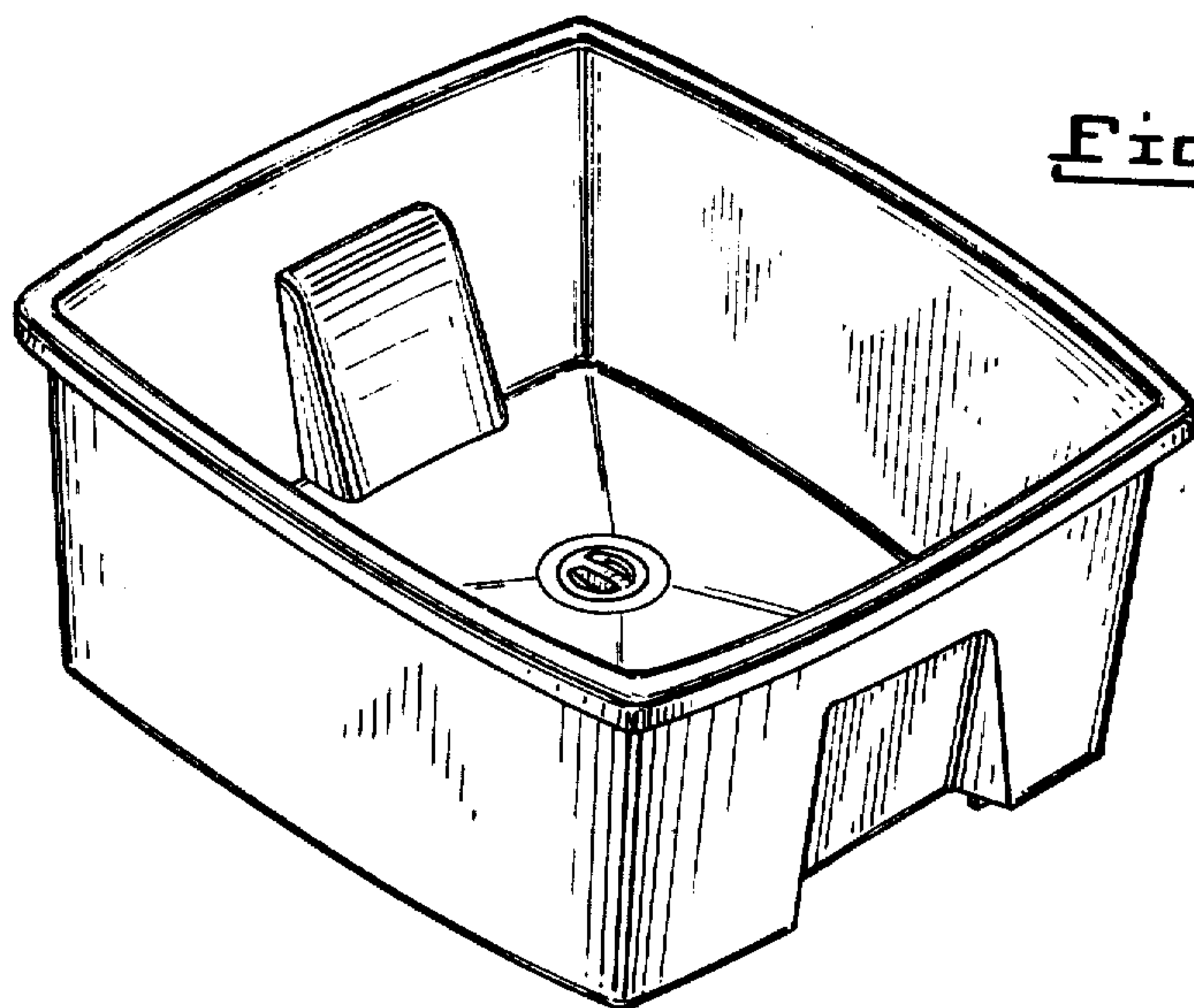

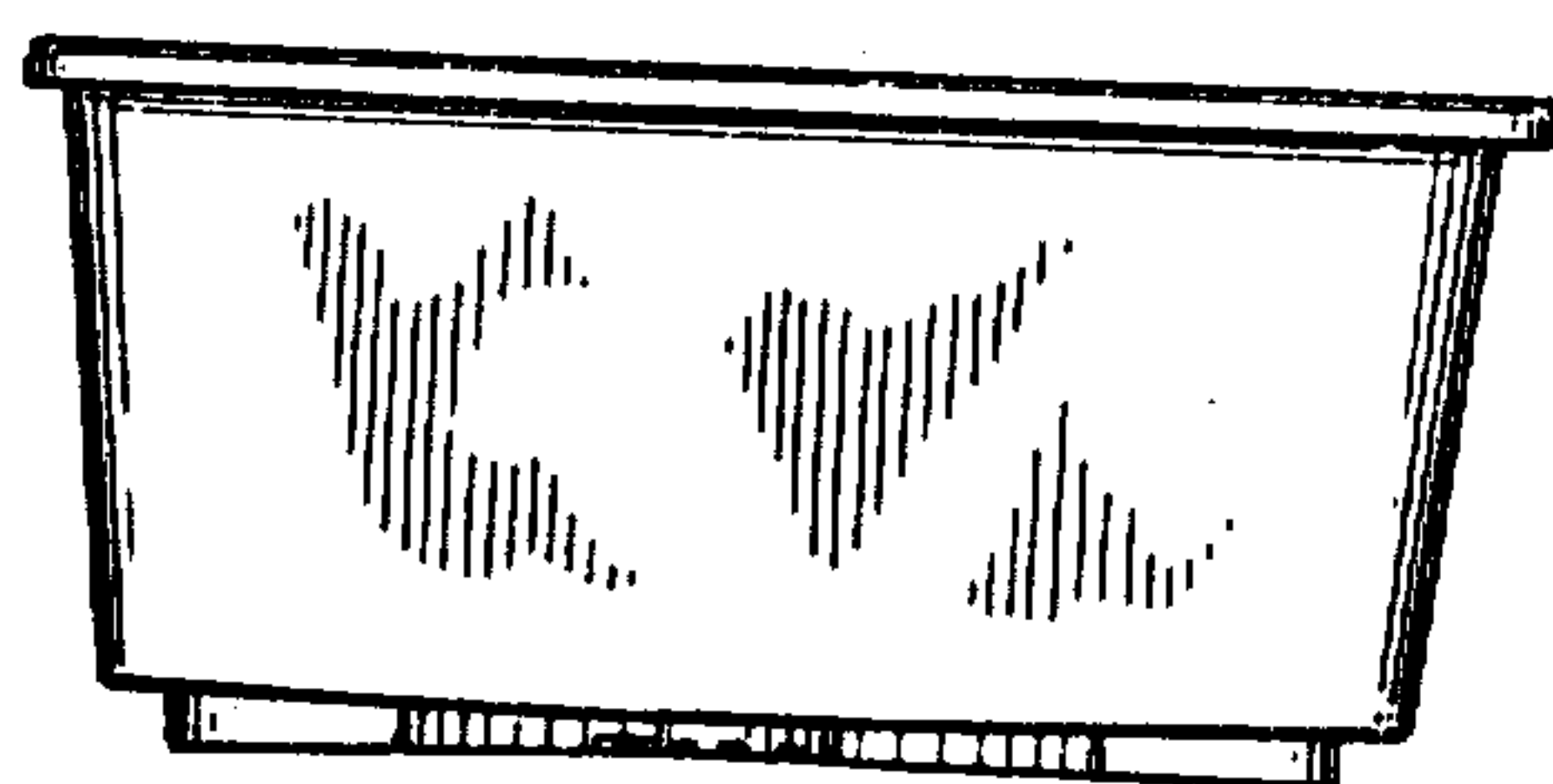

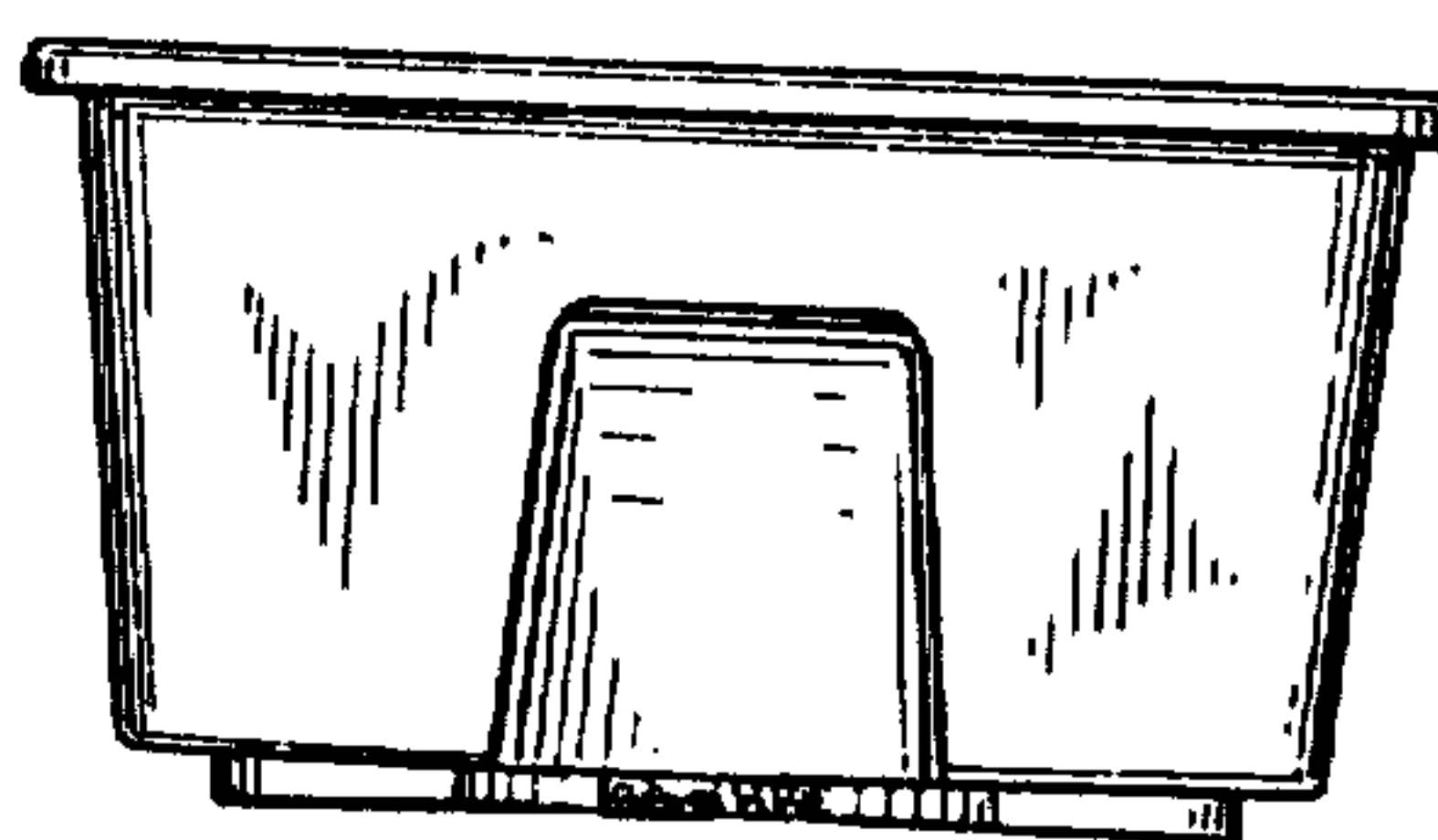

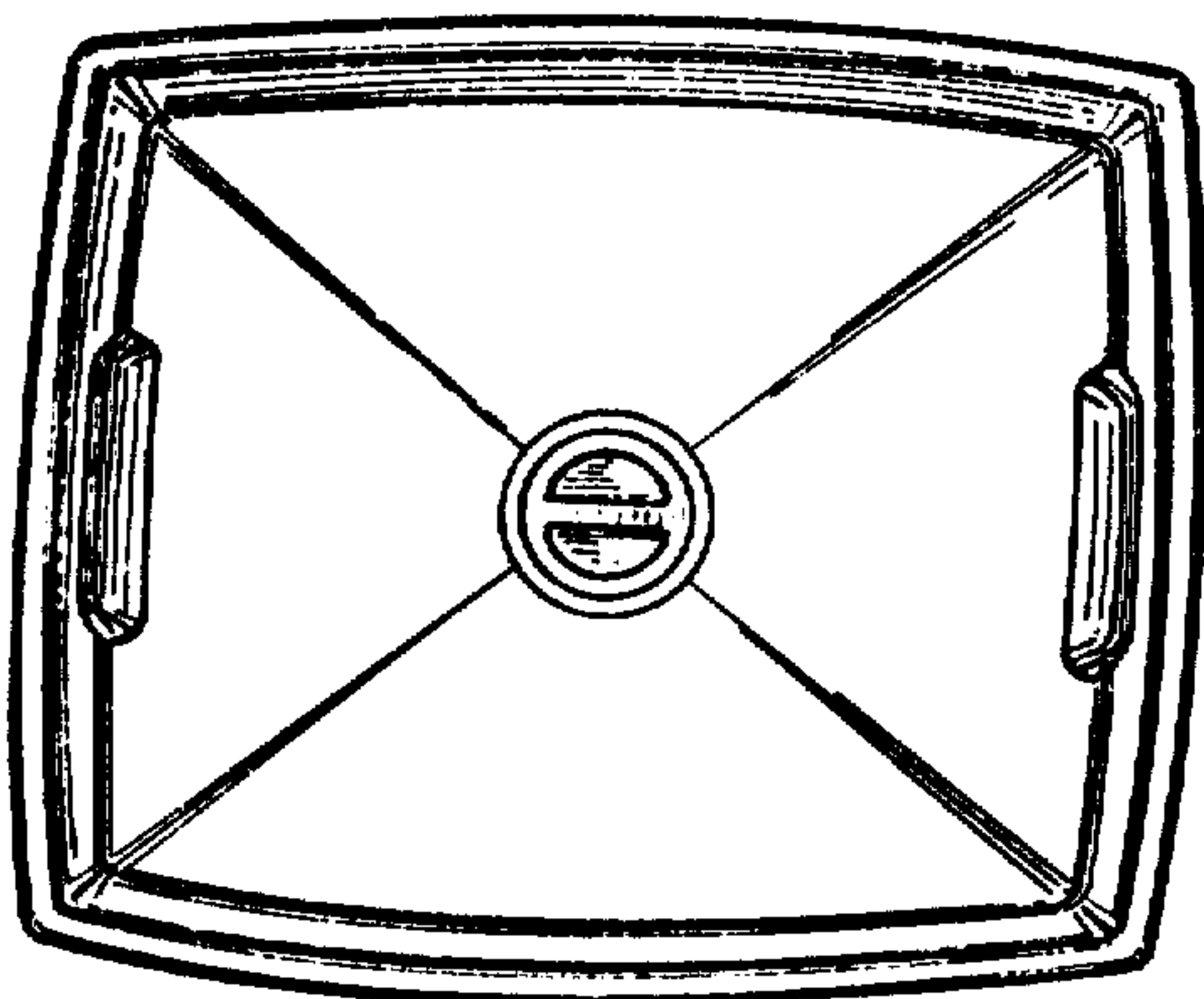

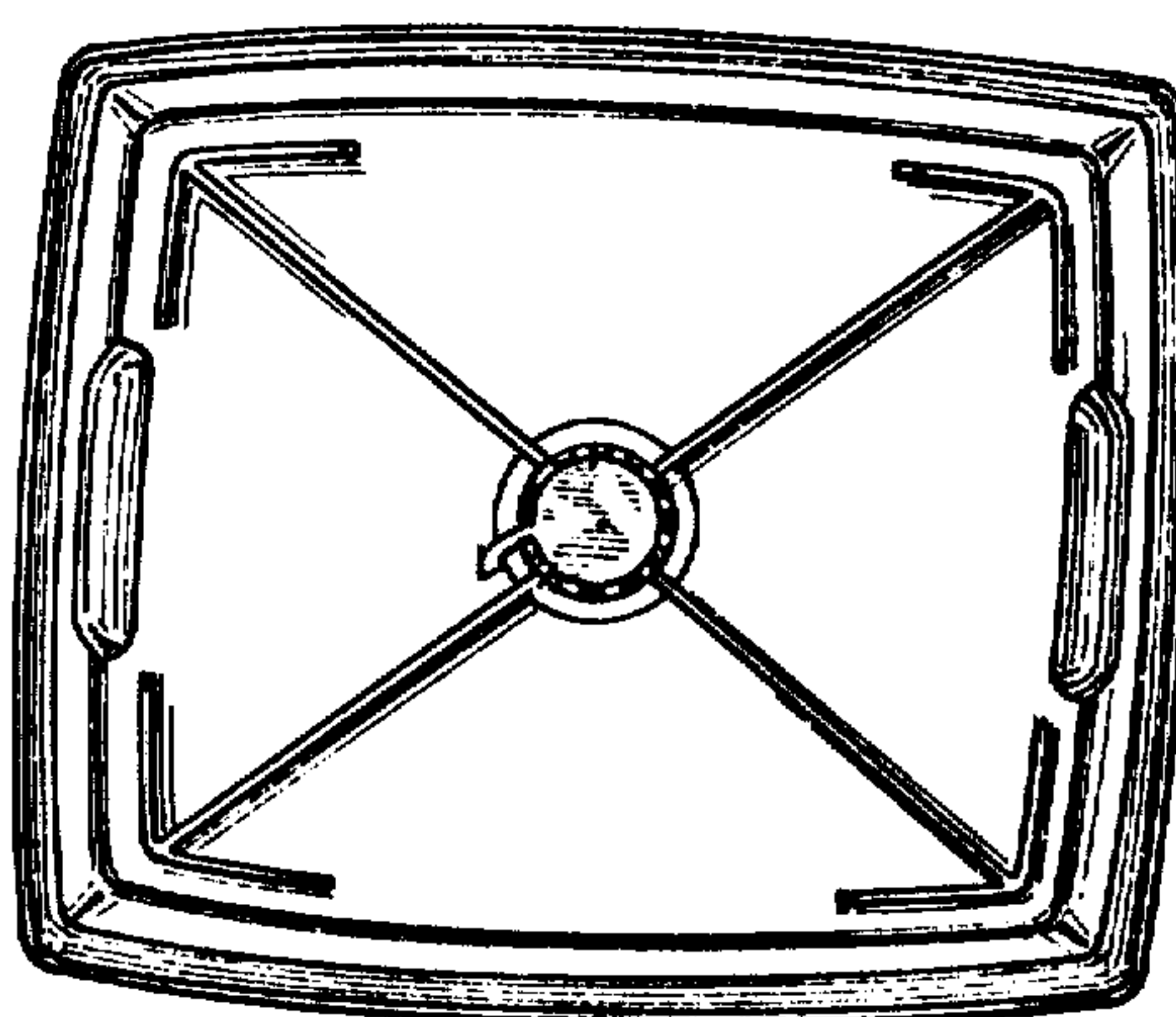
