[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy play case or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy play case or similar article, showing my new design in an open position; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof in an inverted position; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view as viewed from the right end of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is an end elevational view as viewed from the left end of FIG. 1.

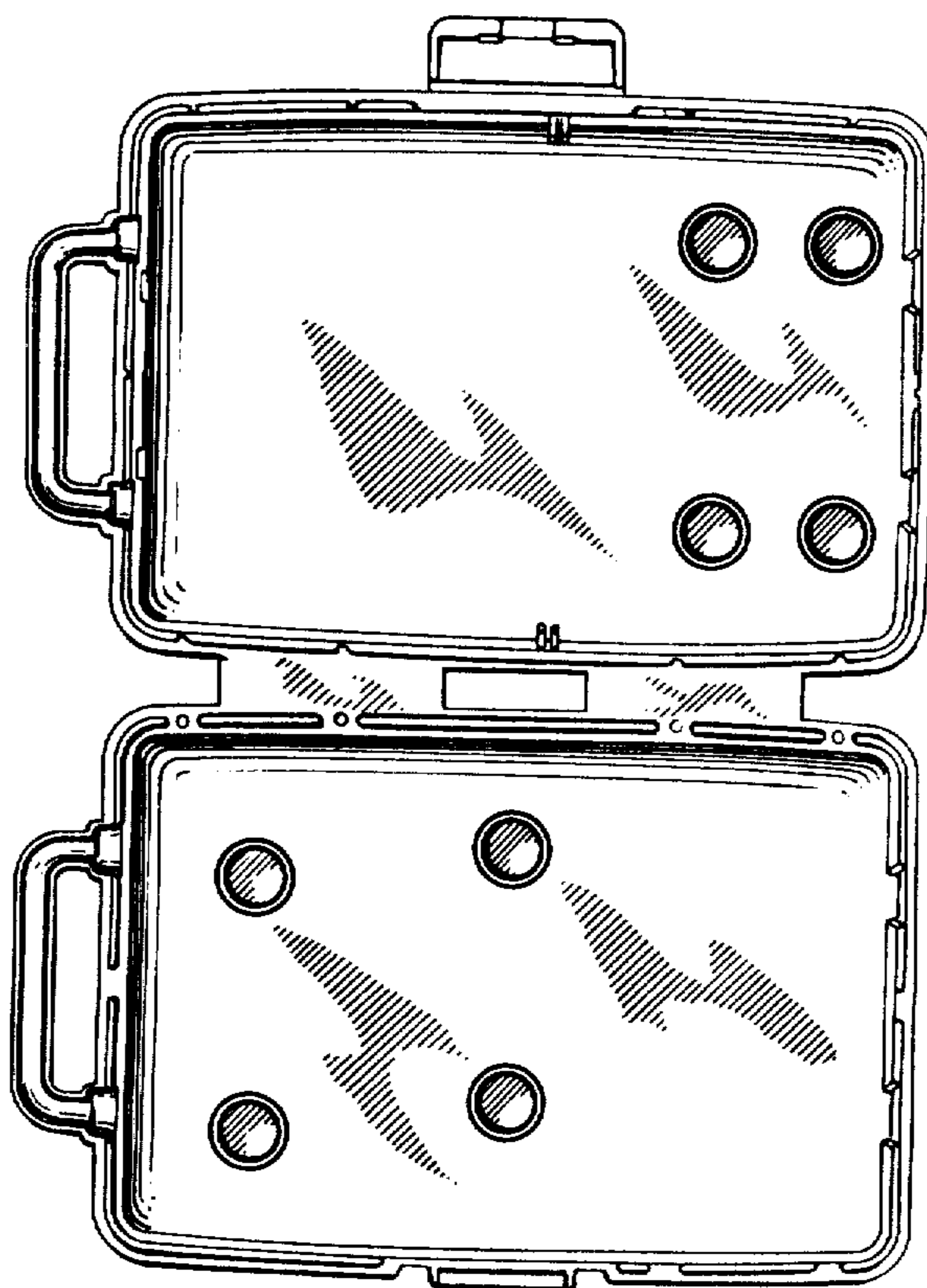

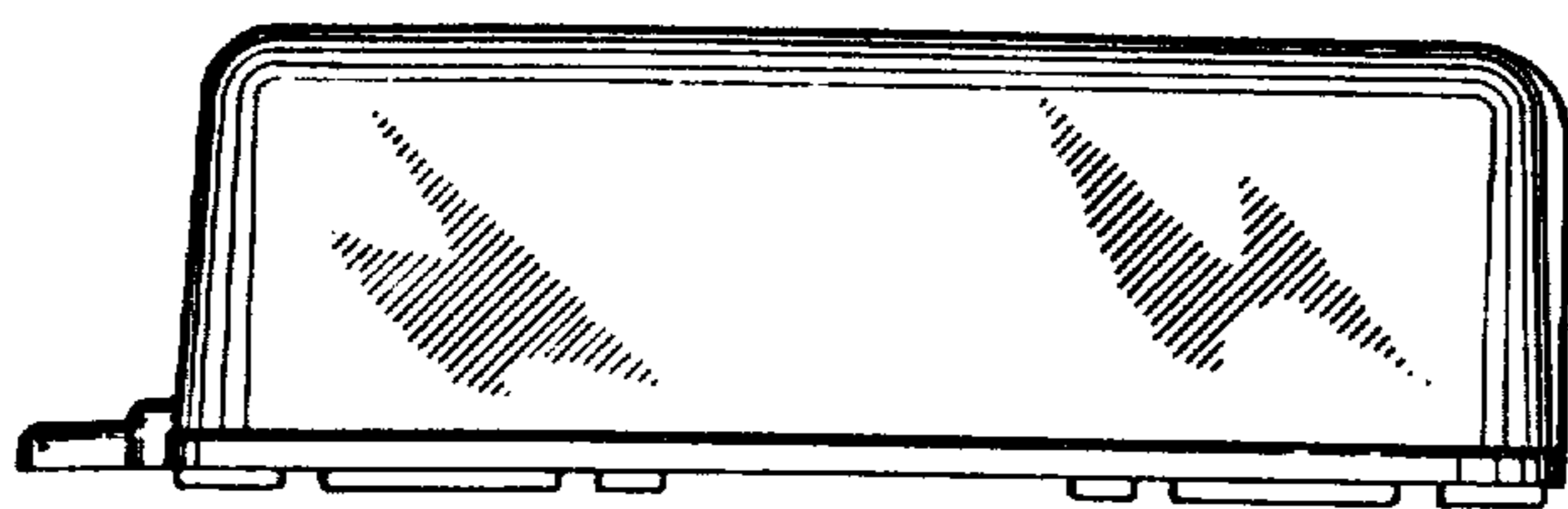

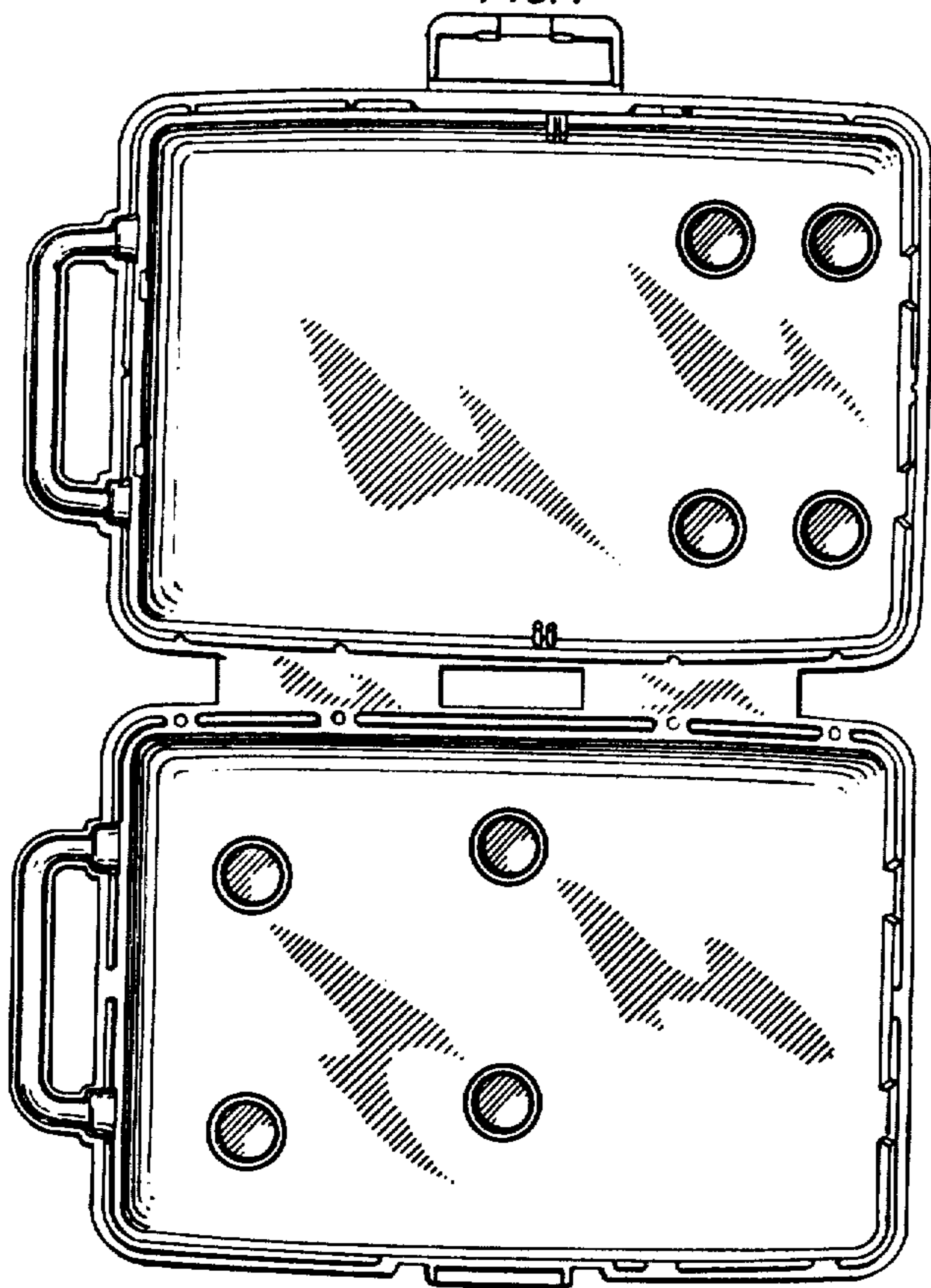

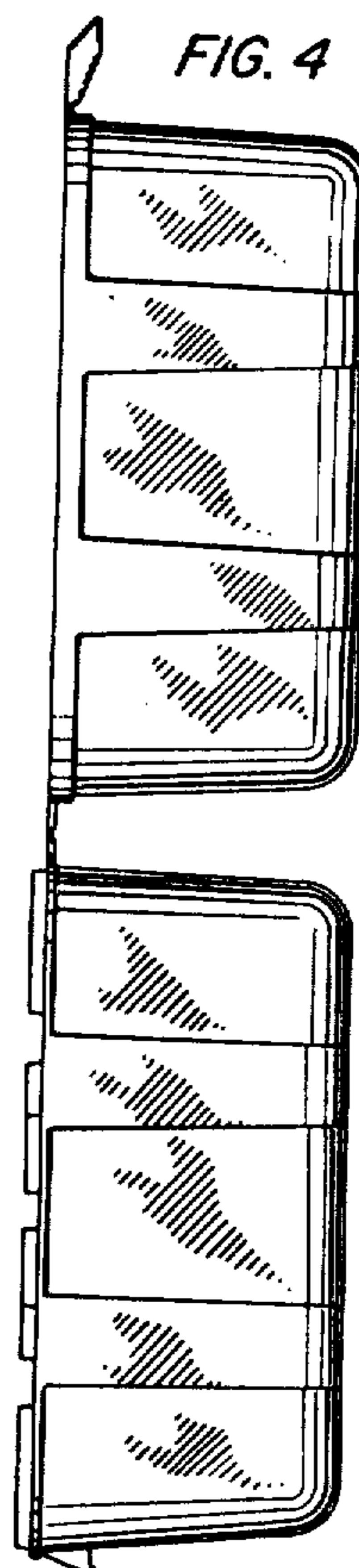

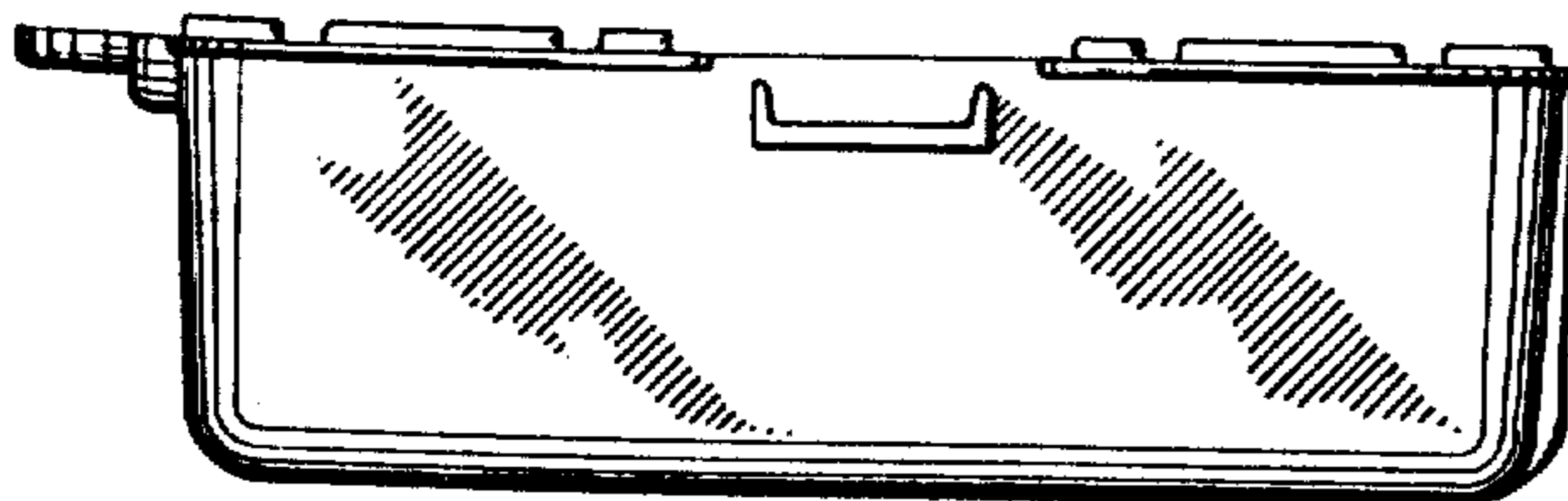

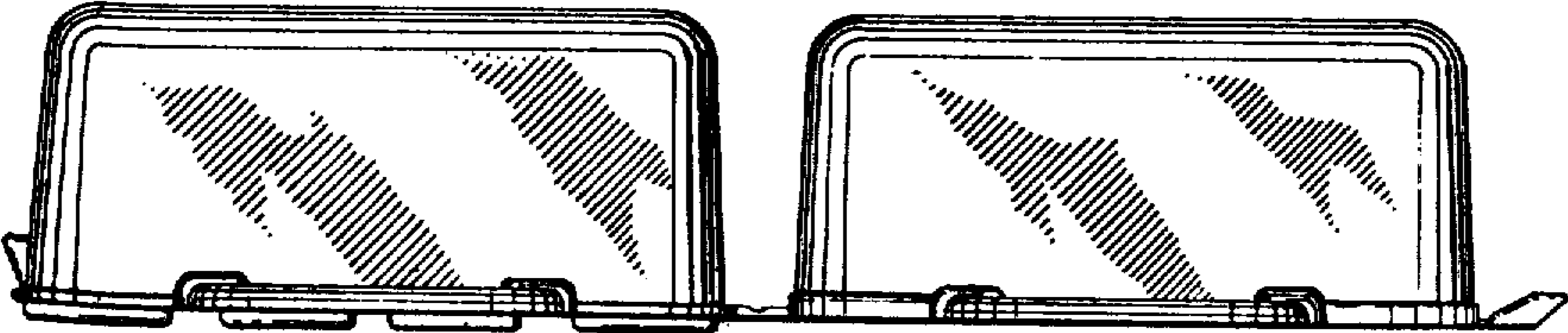
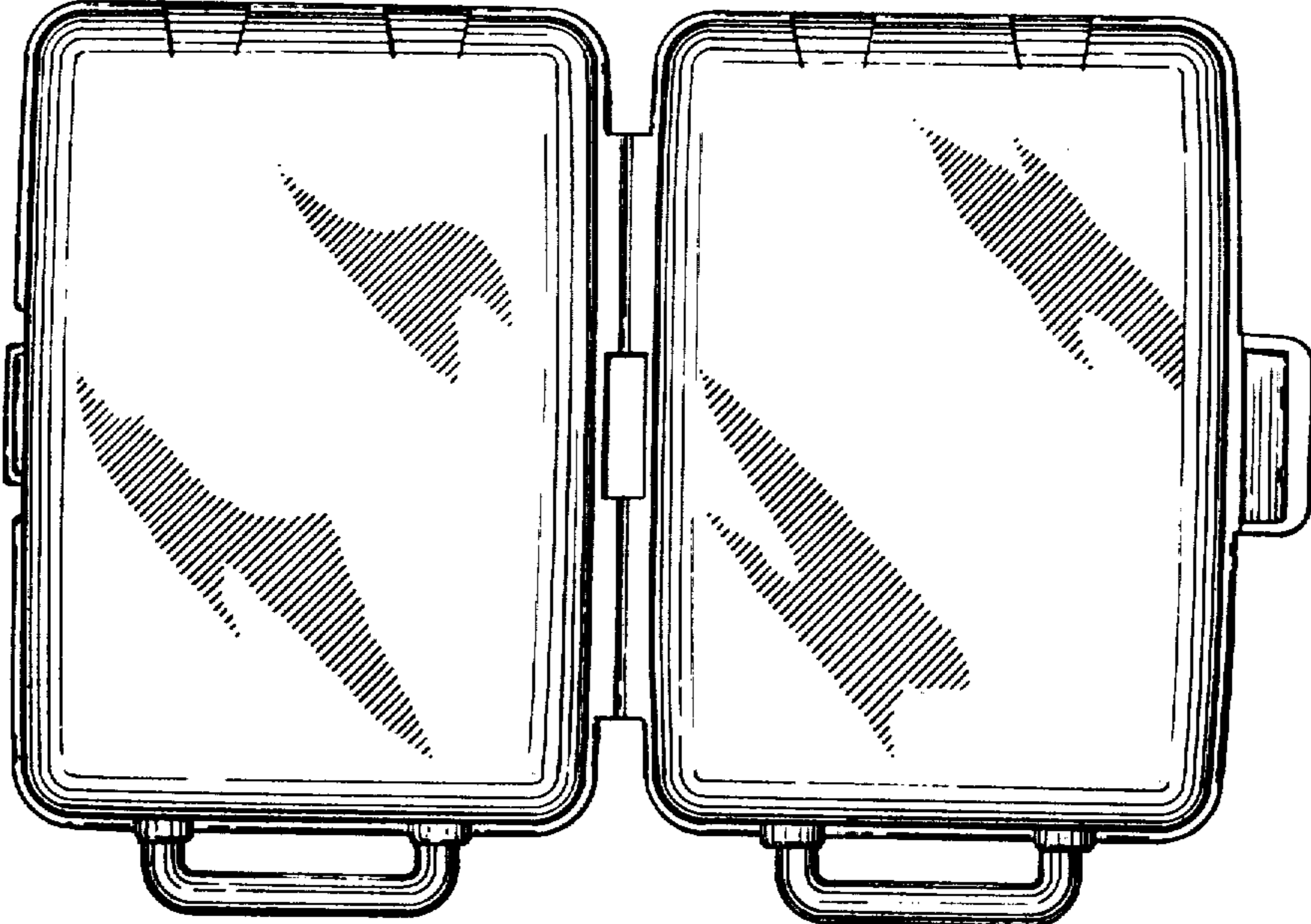
