The ornamental design for a table lamp, substantially as shown and described.

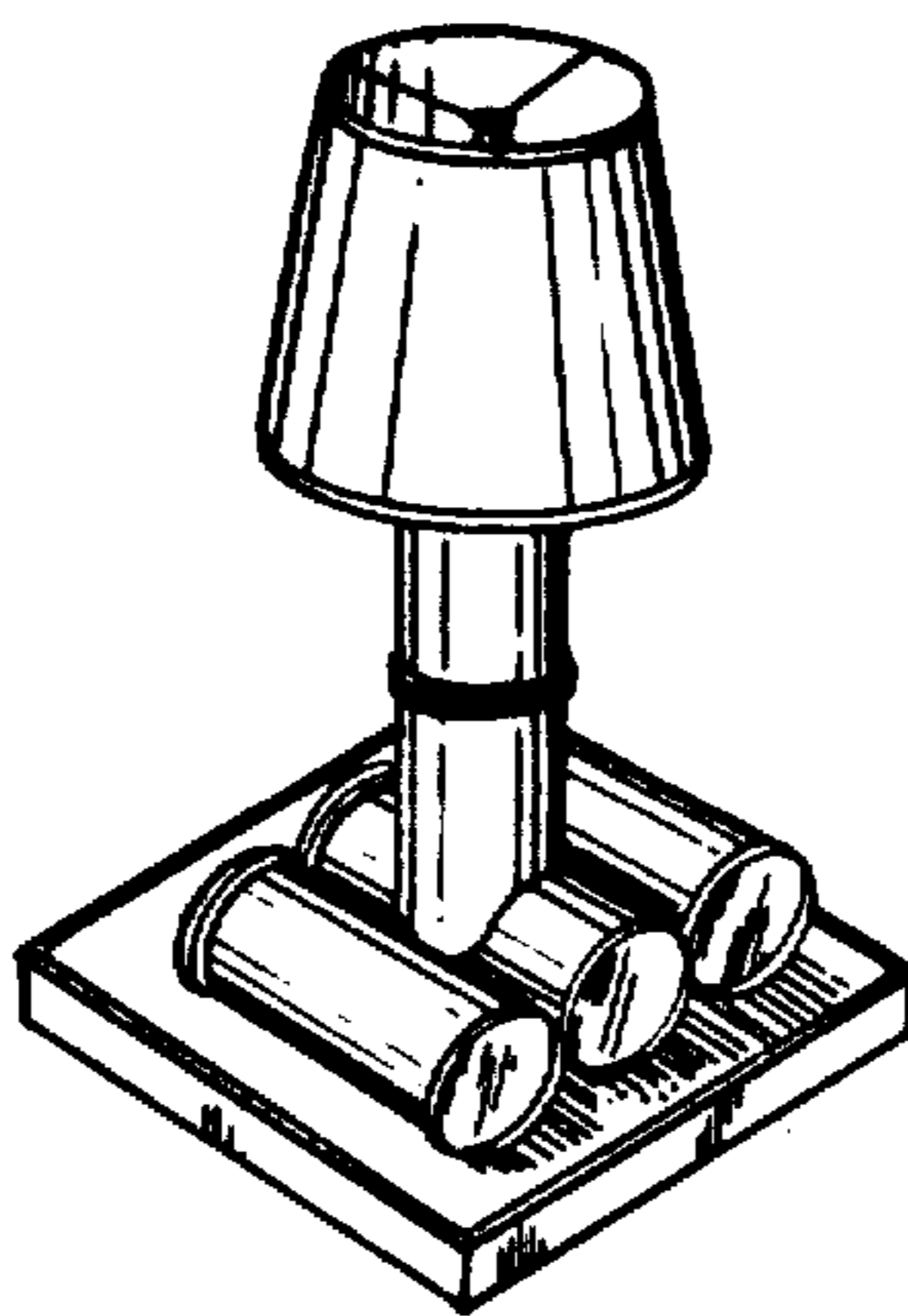
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.



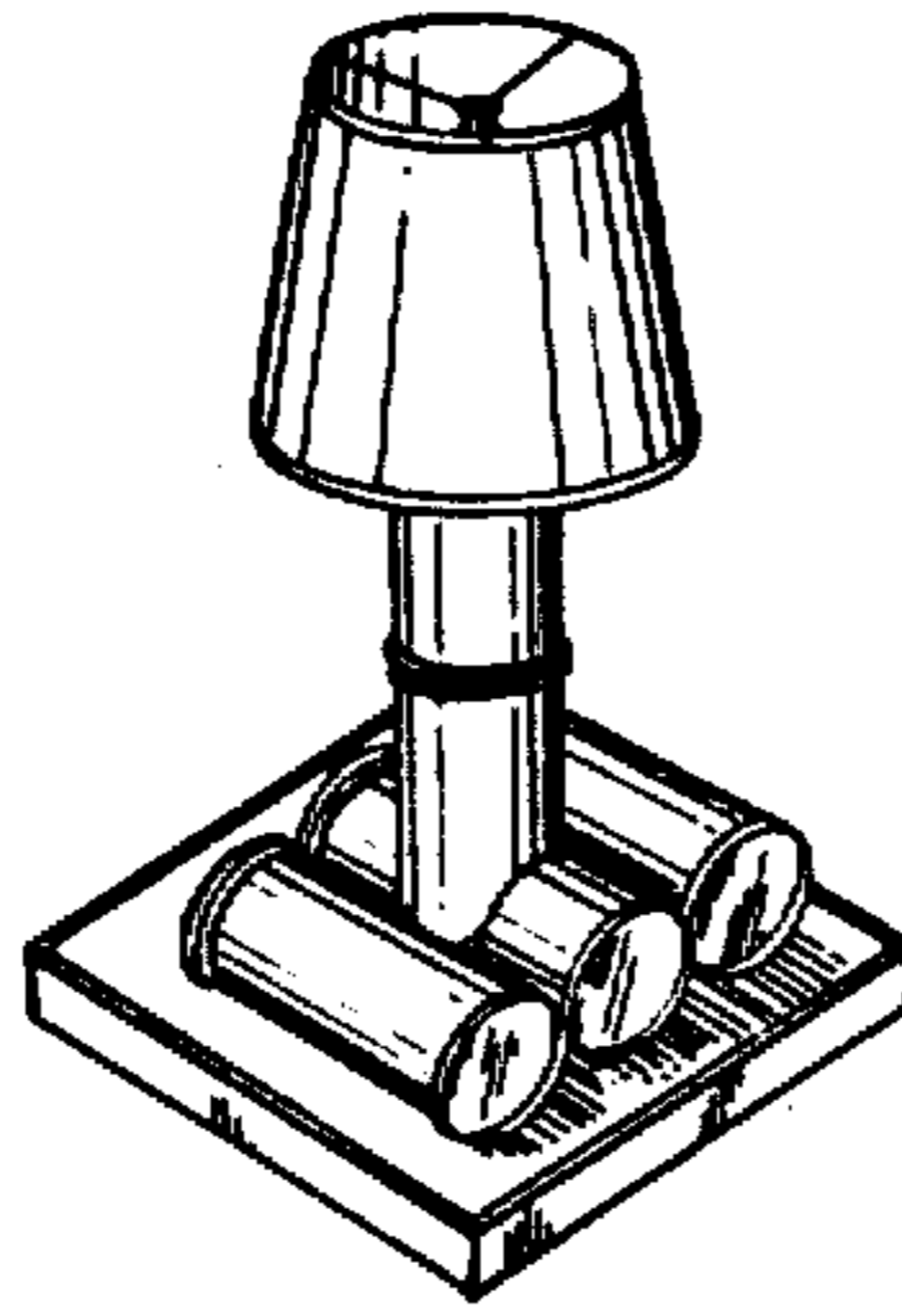

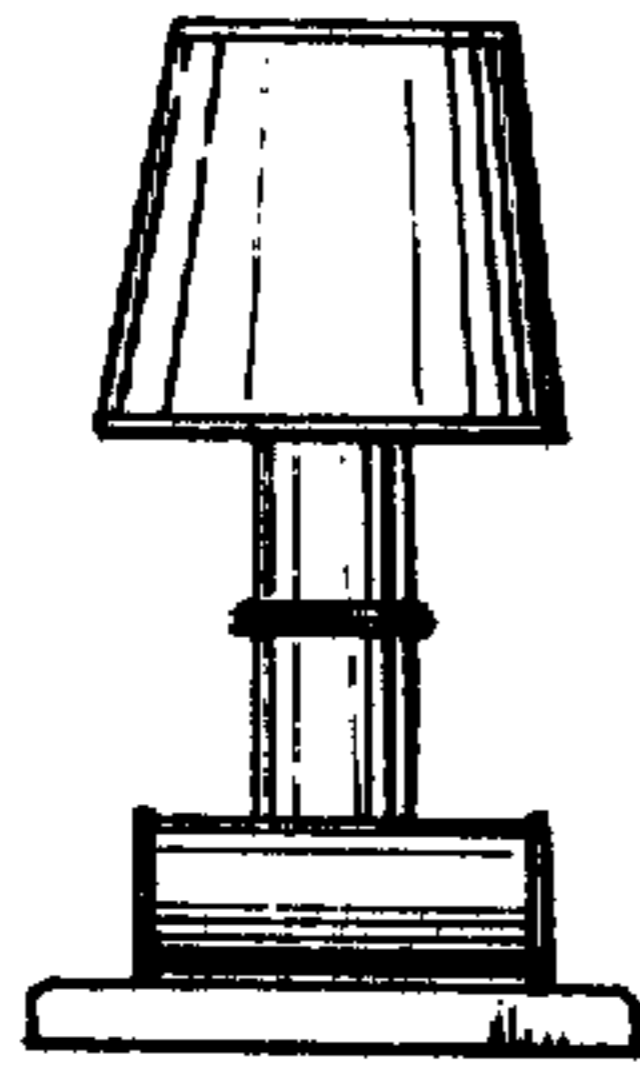

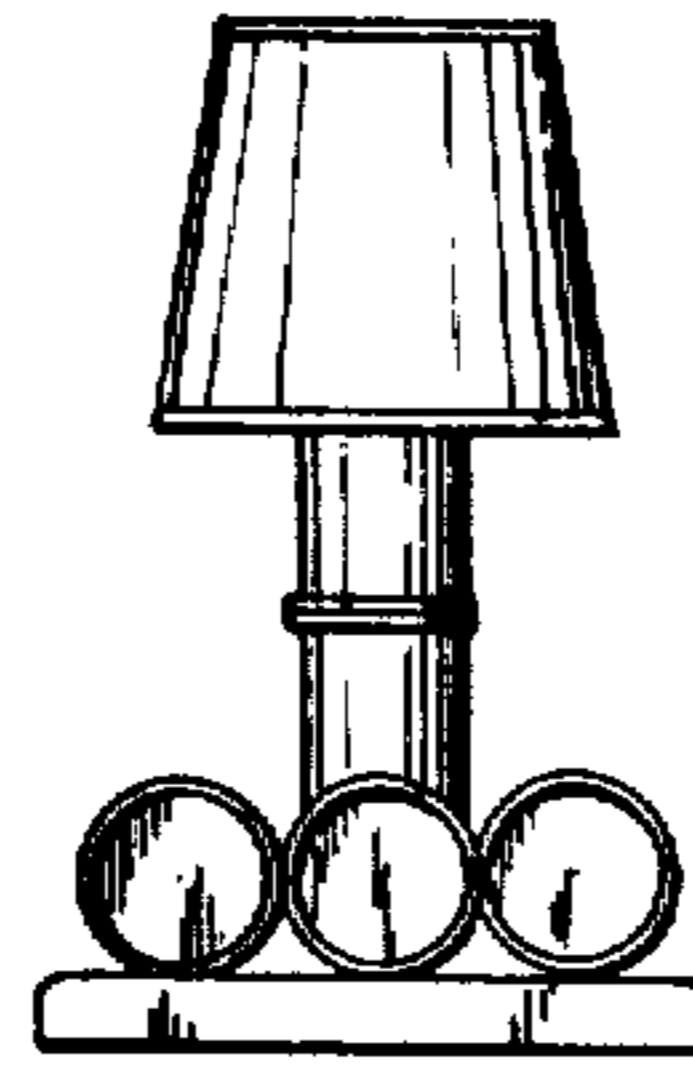

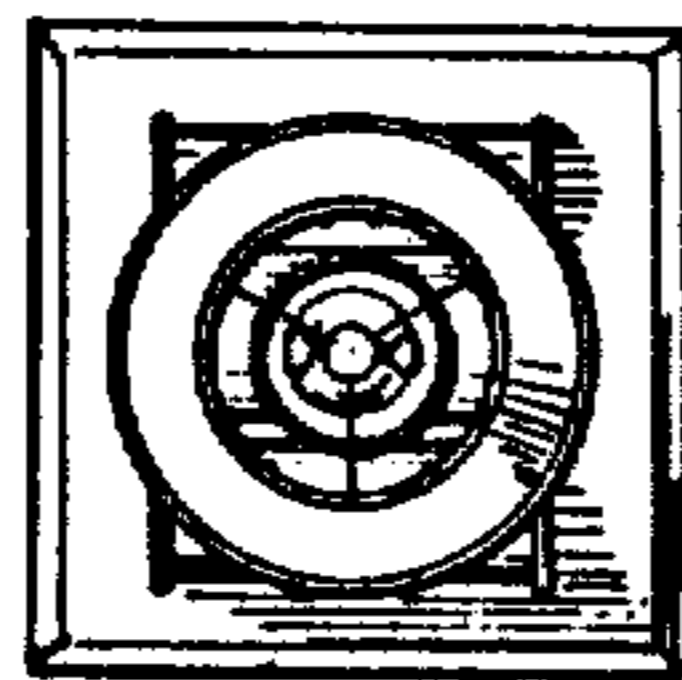
