The ornamental design for a floor lamp, substantially as shown and described.

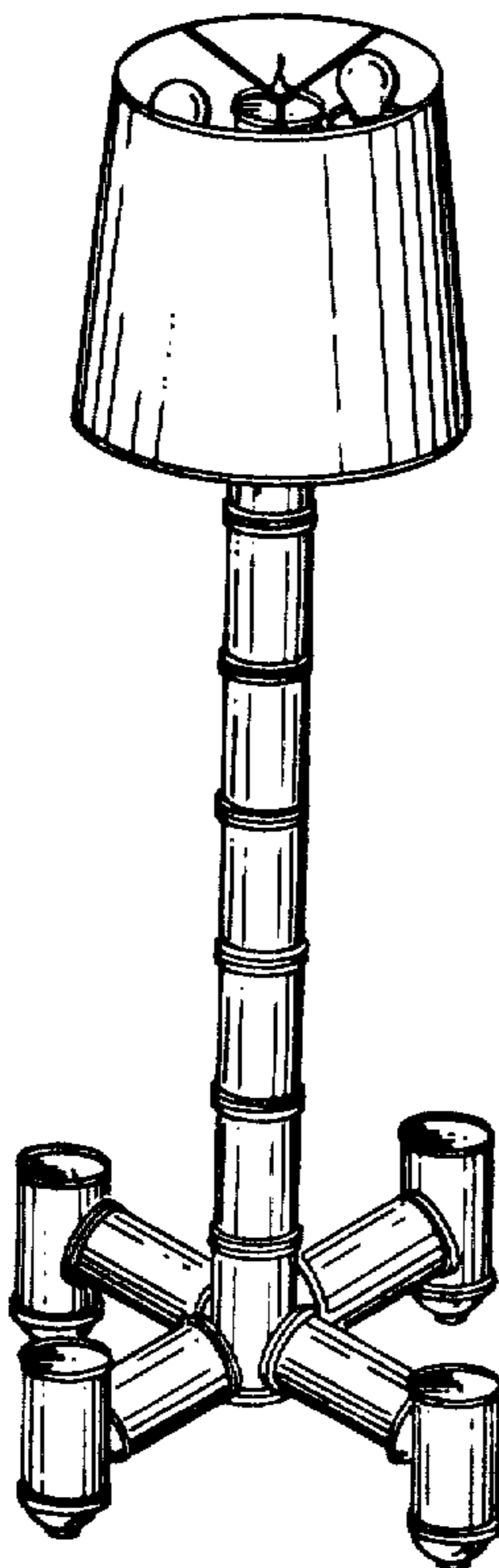
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof with the shade omitted for purposes of disclosure.



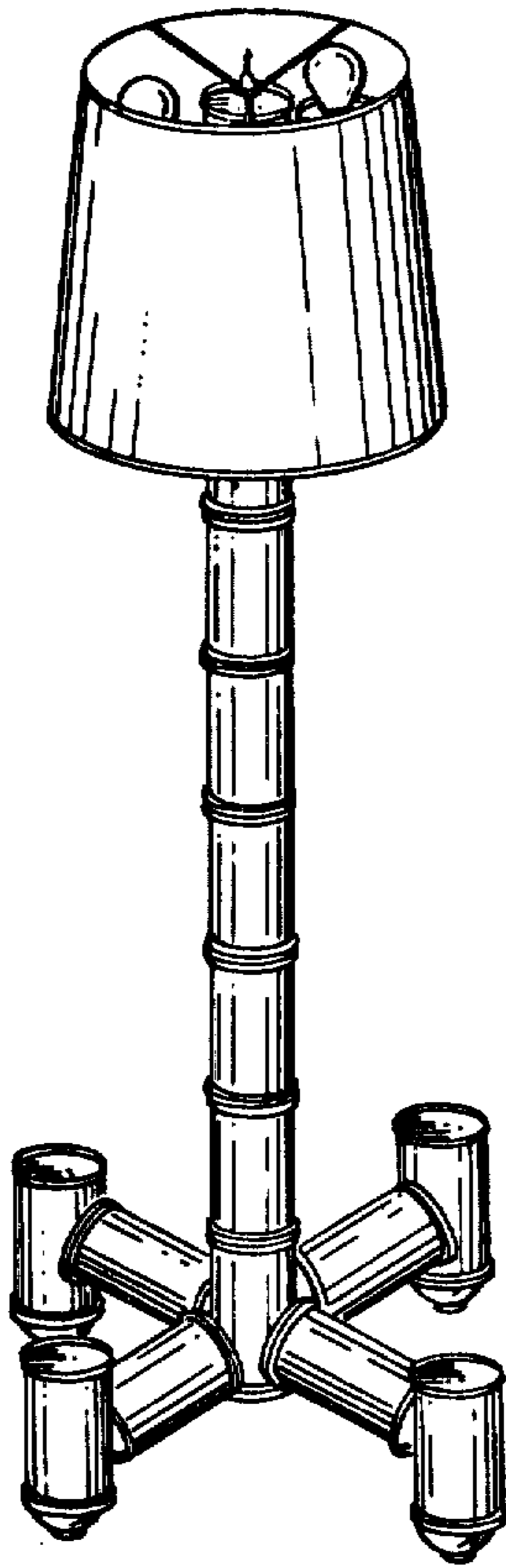

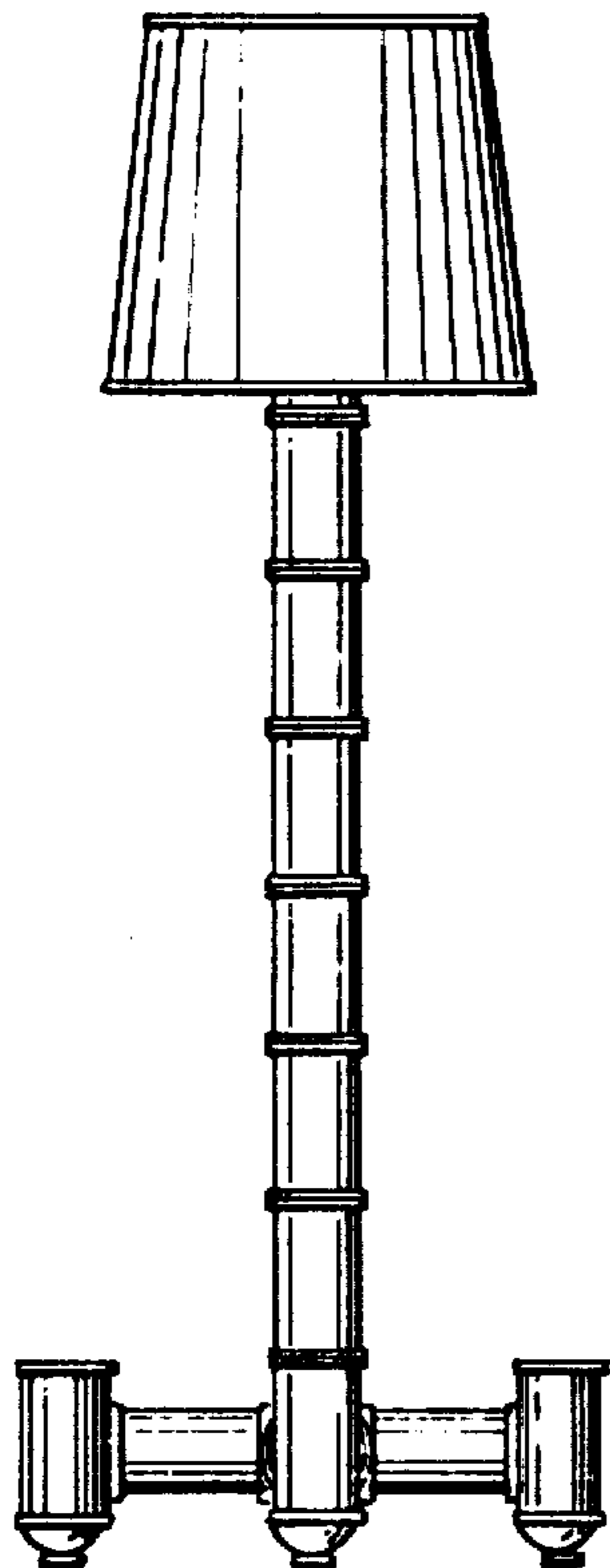

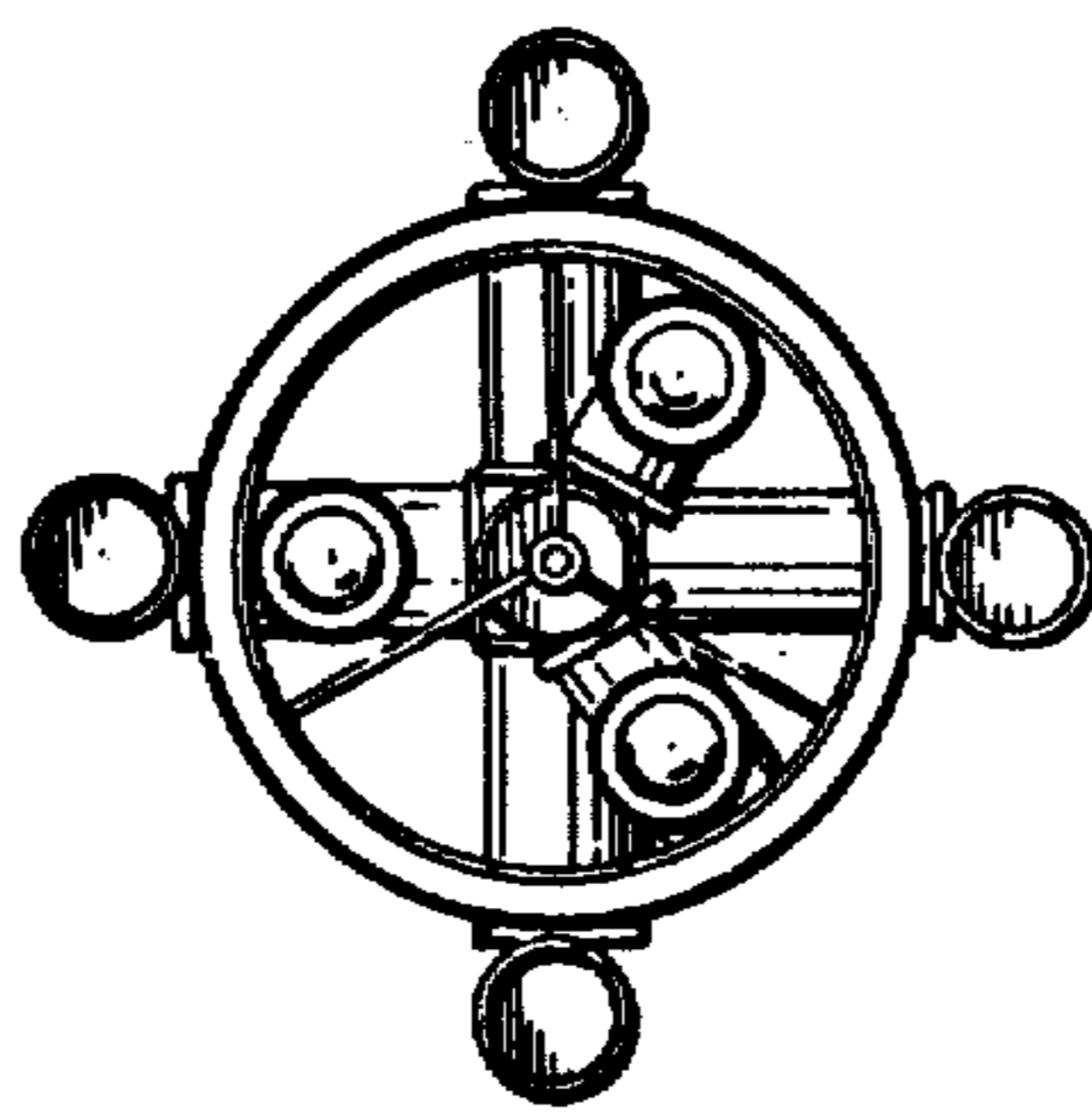

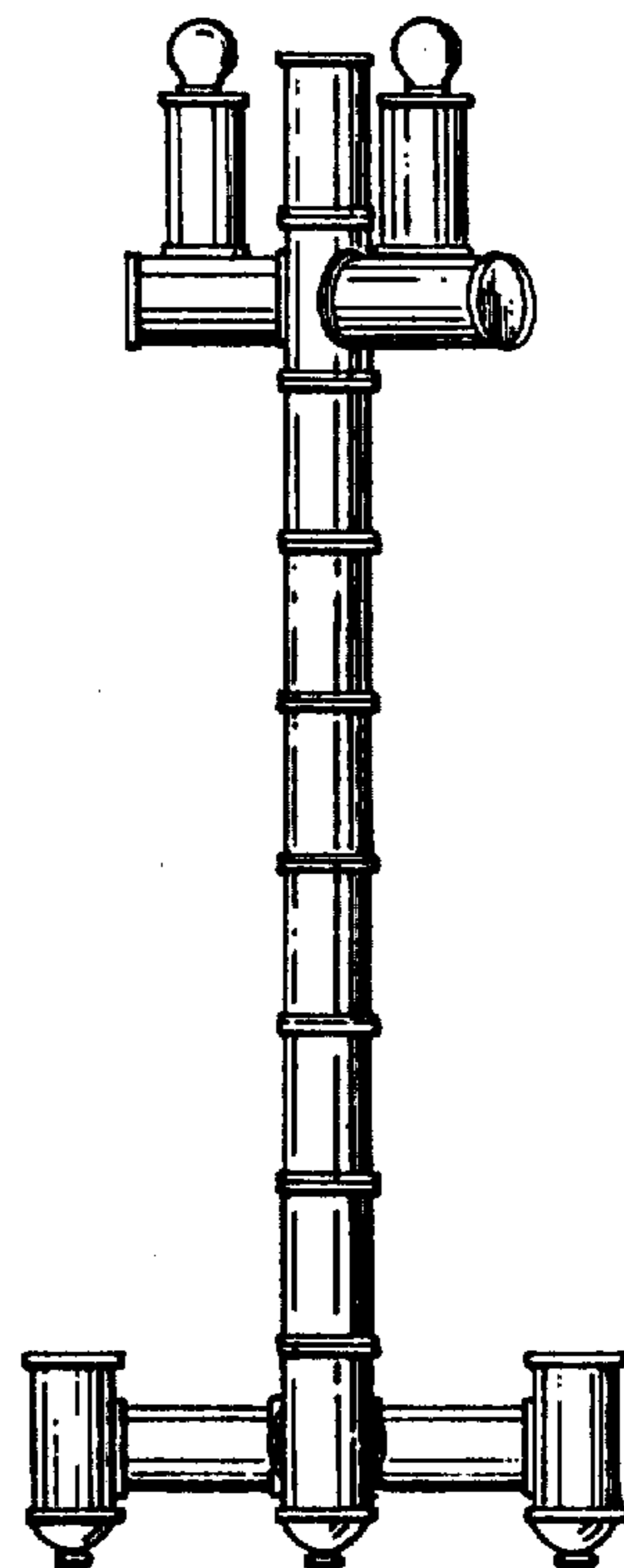
