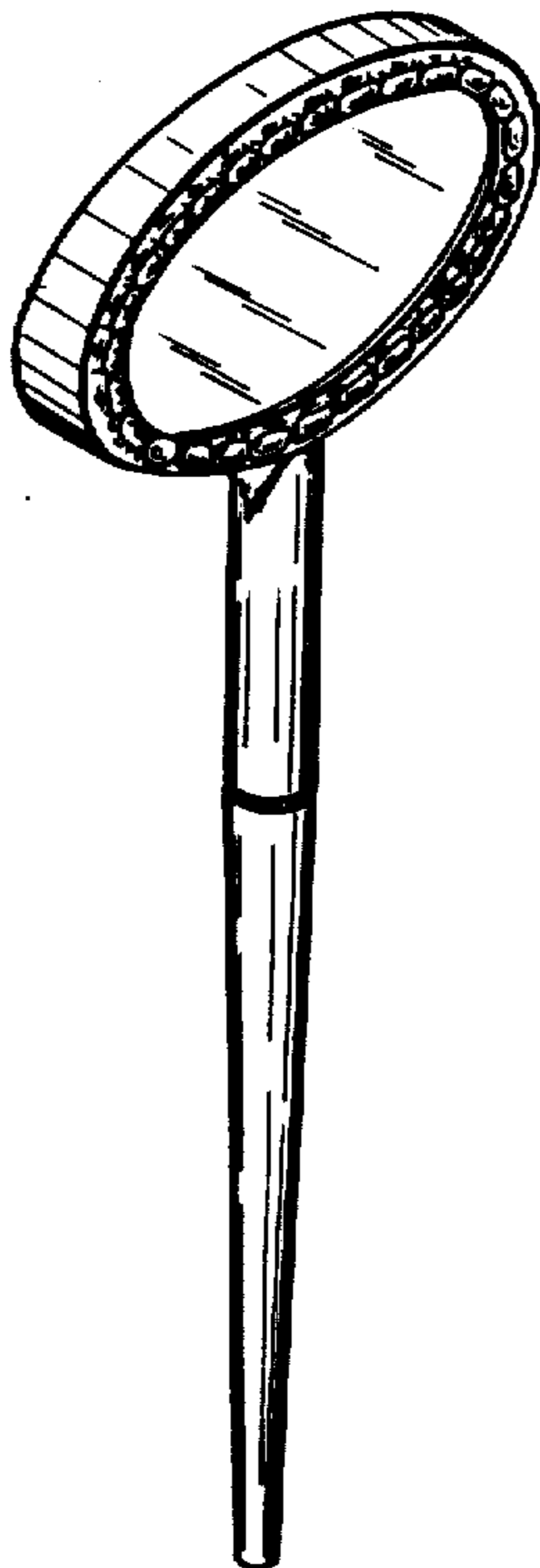

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined brush and mirror, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined brush and mirror showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof showing the brush portion separated from the mirror portion.



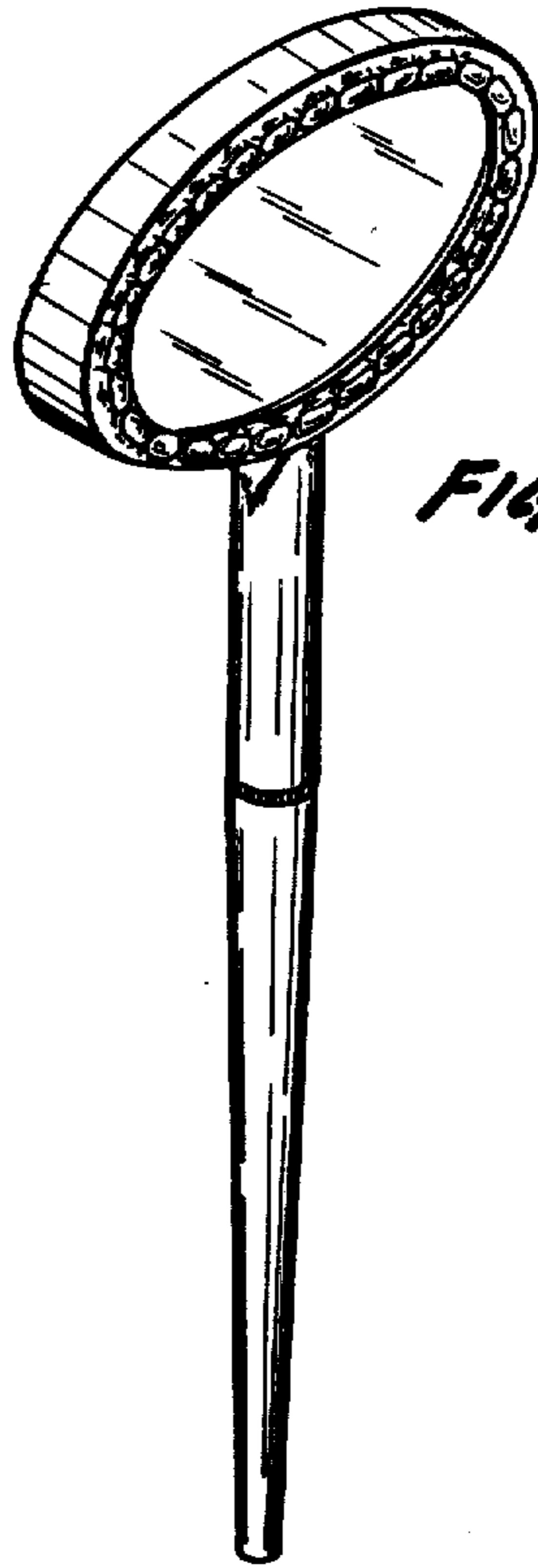

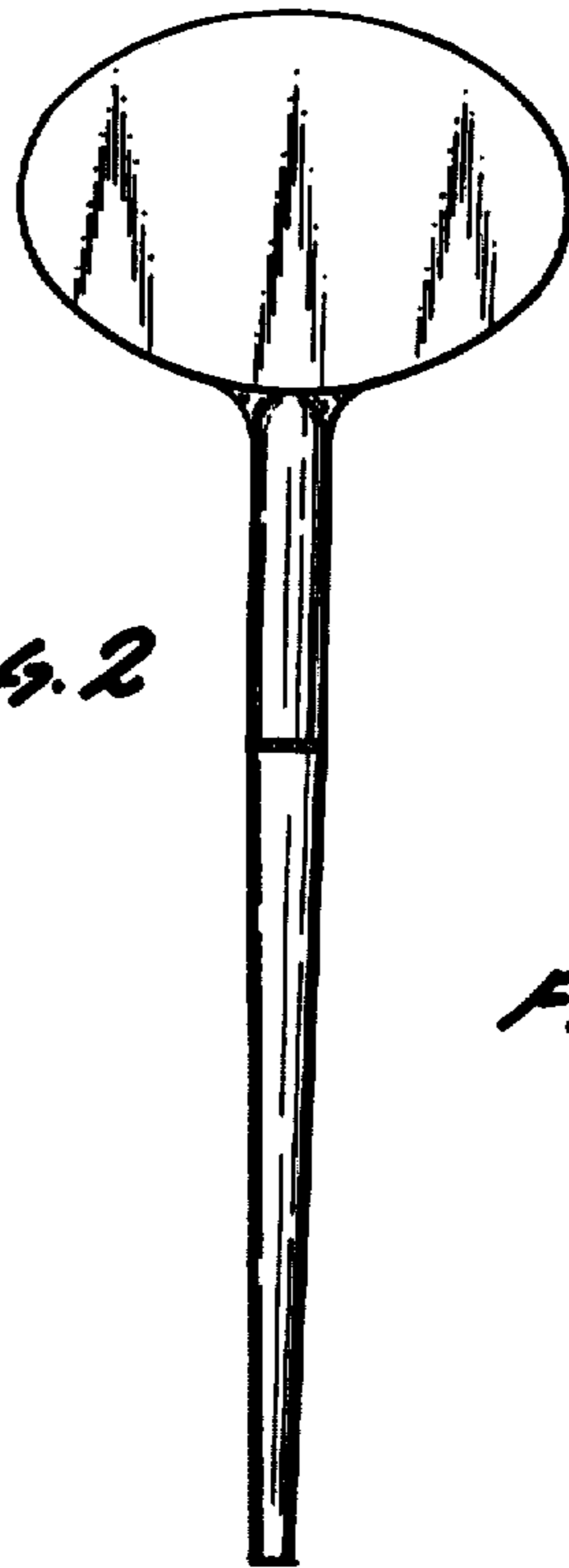

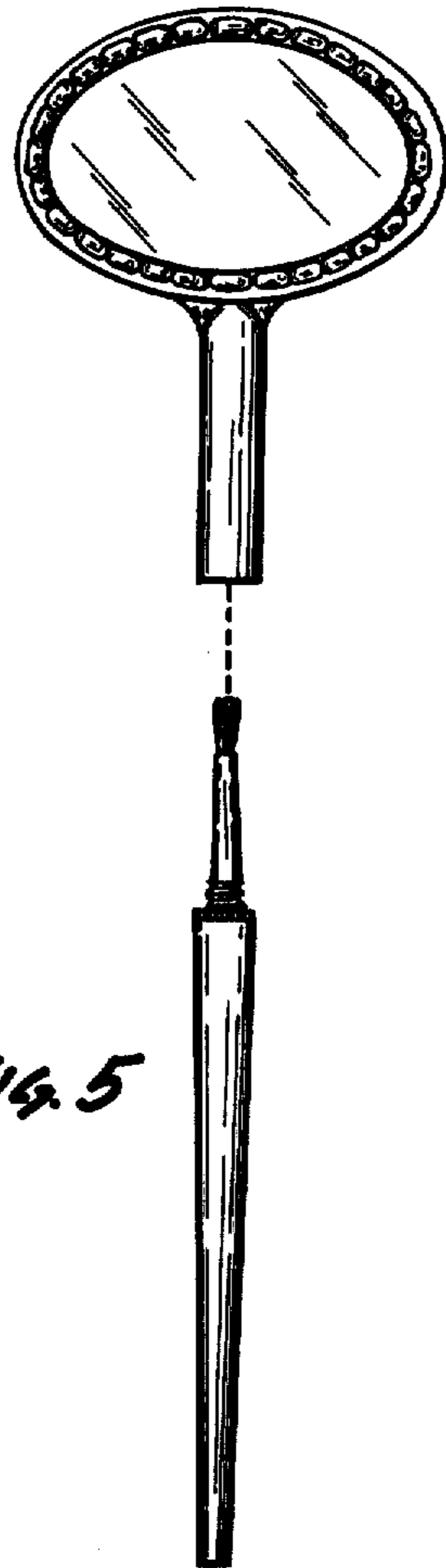
