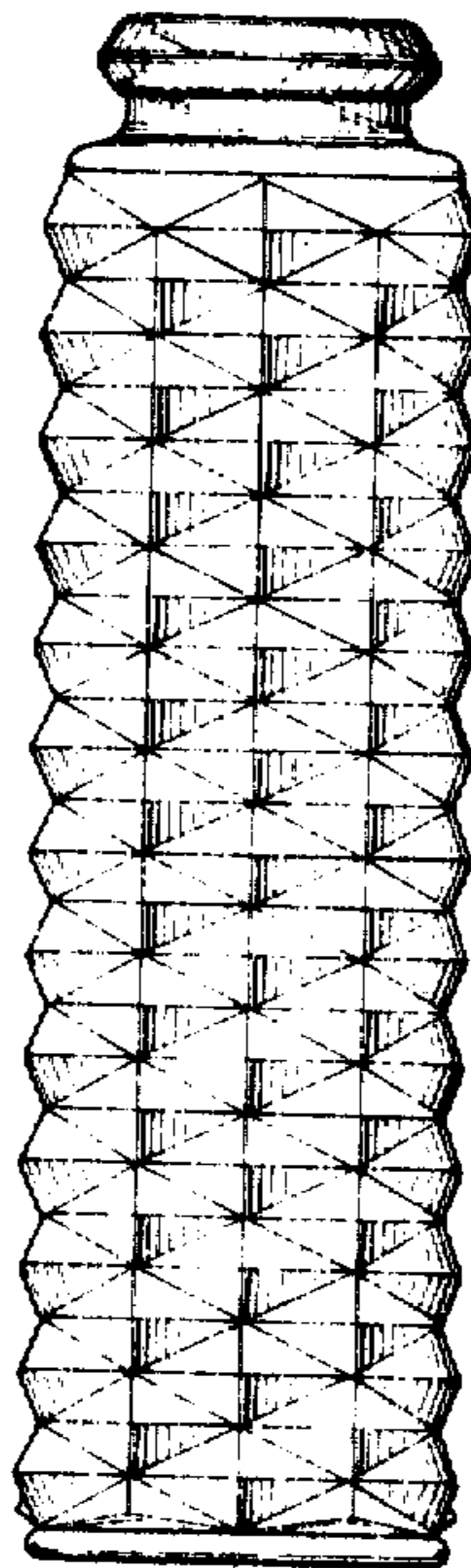
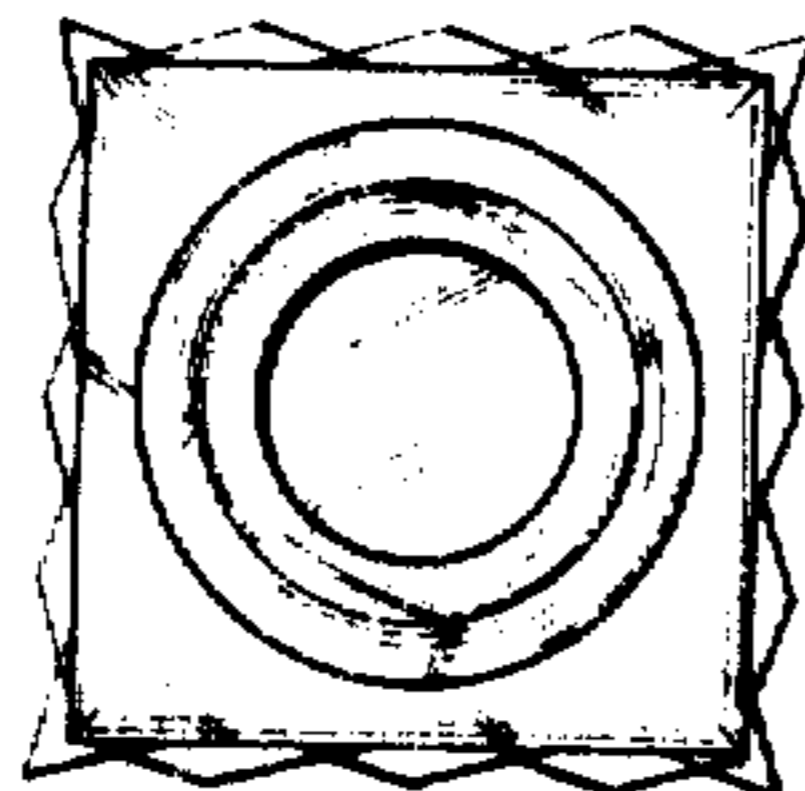
The ornamental design for a bud vase, substantially as

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.



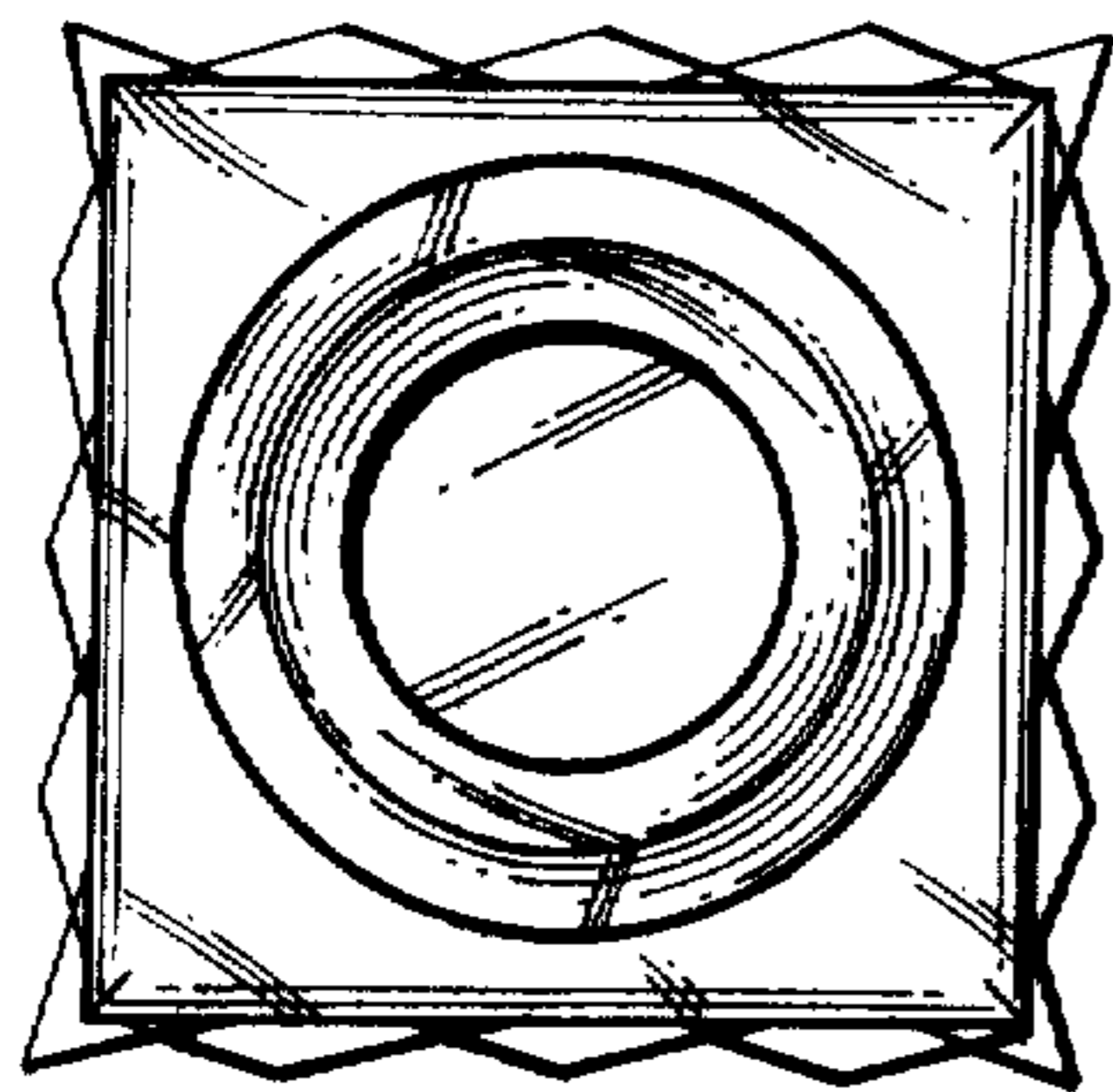

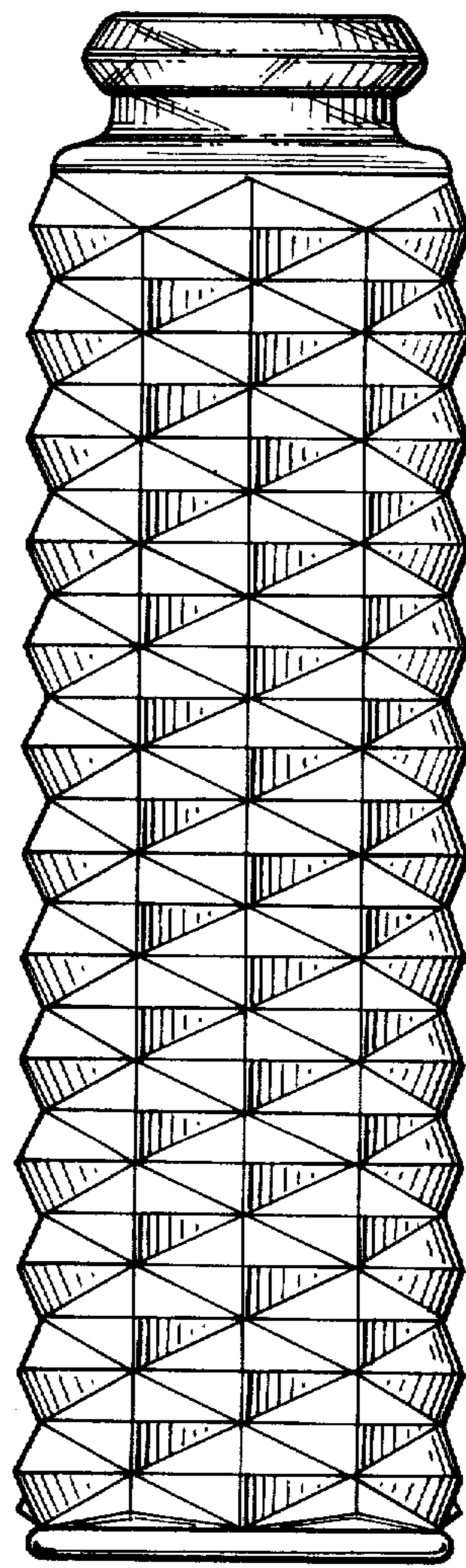

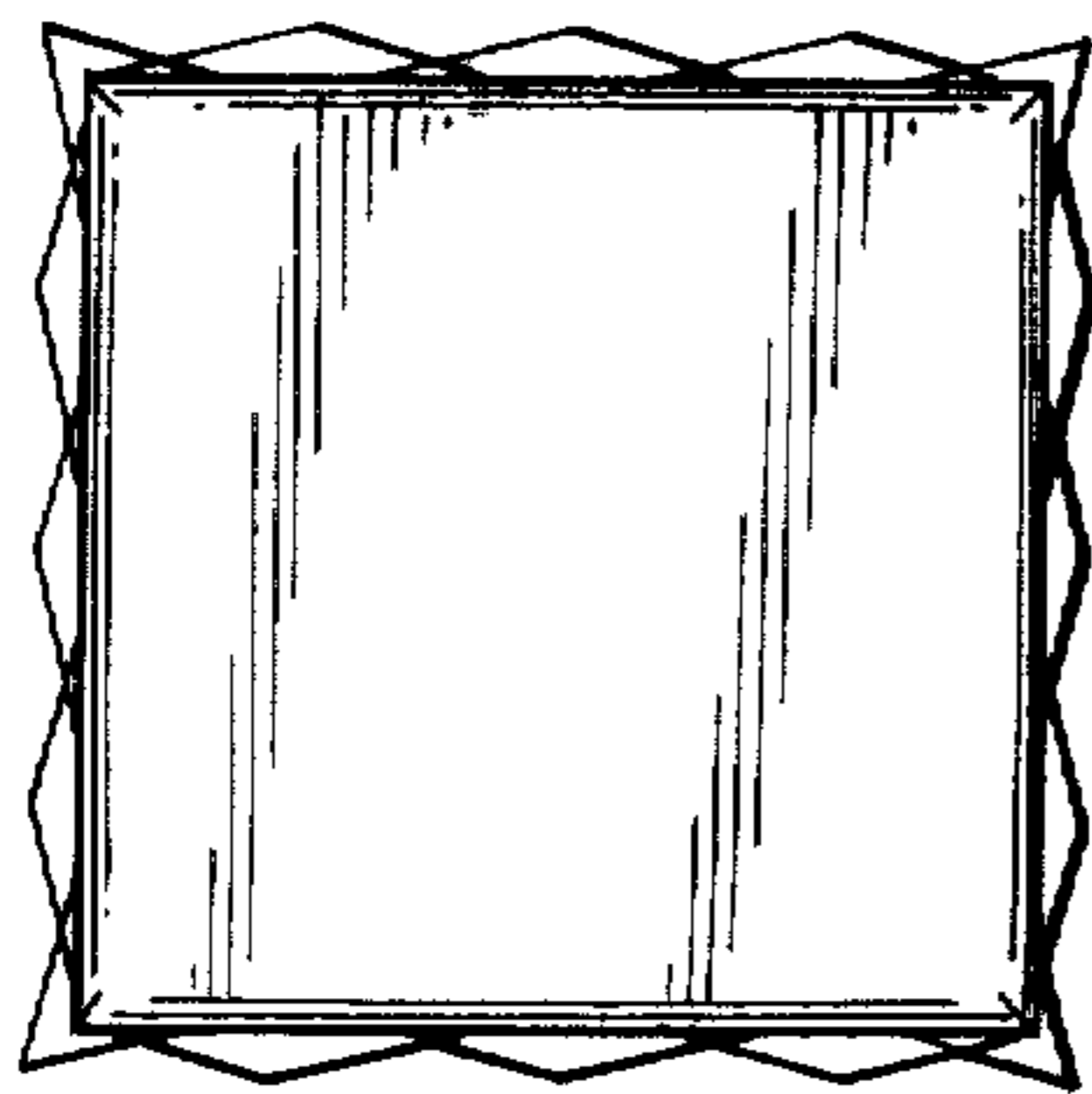
