FIG. 5 is a perspective view with respect to right side of the rear elevation view of said loudspeaker.

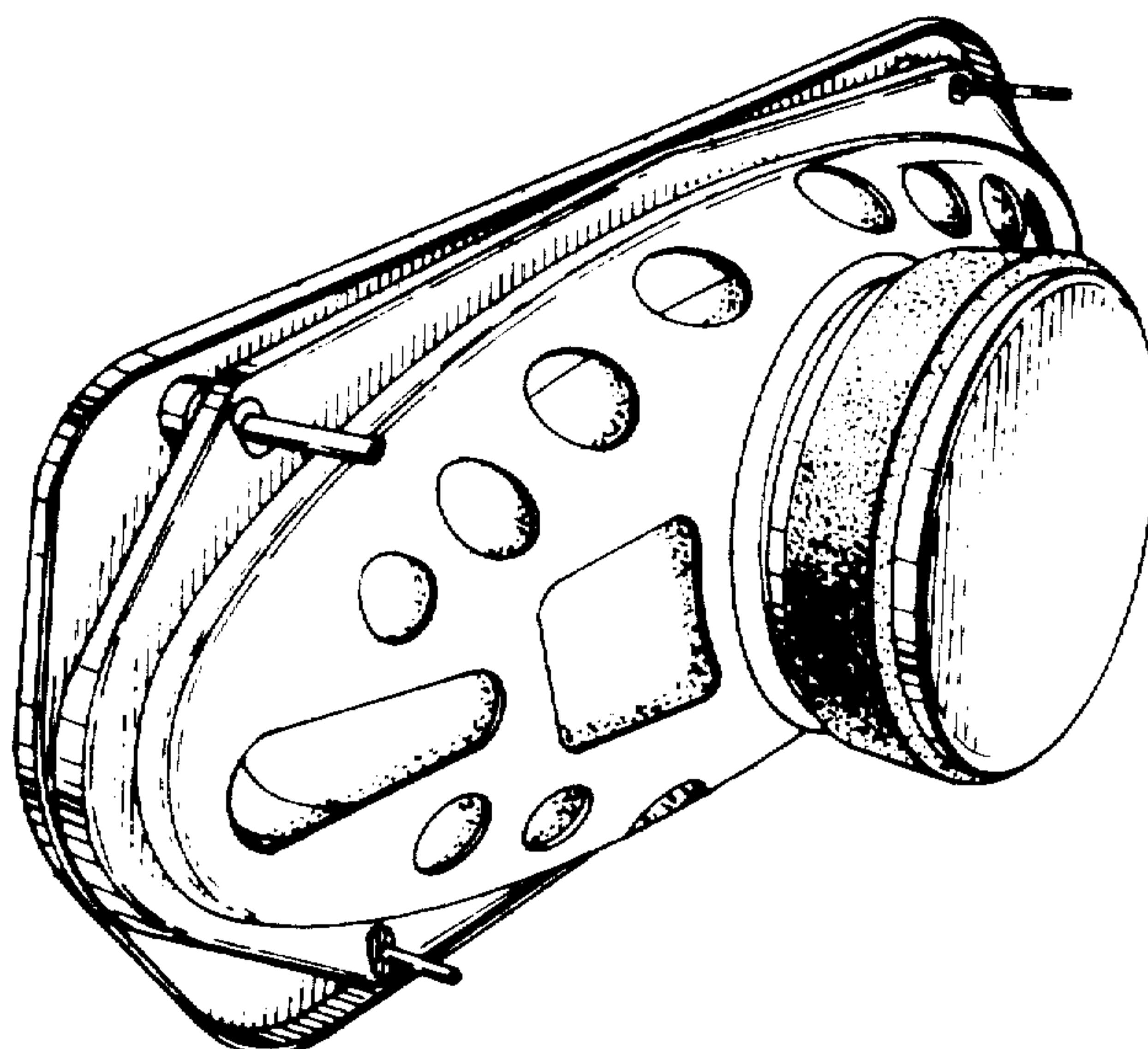
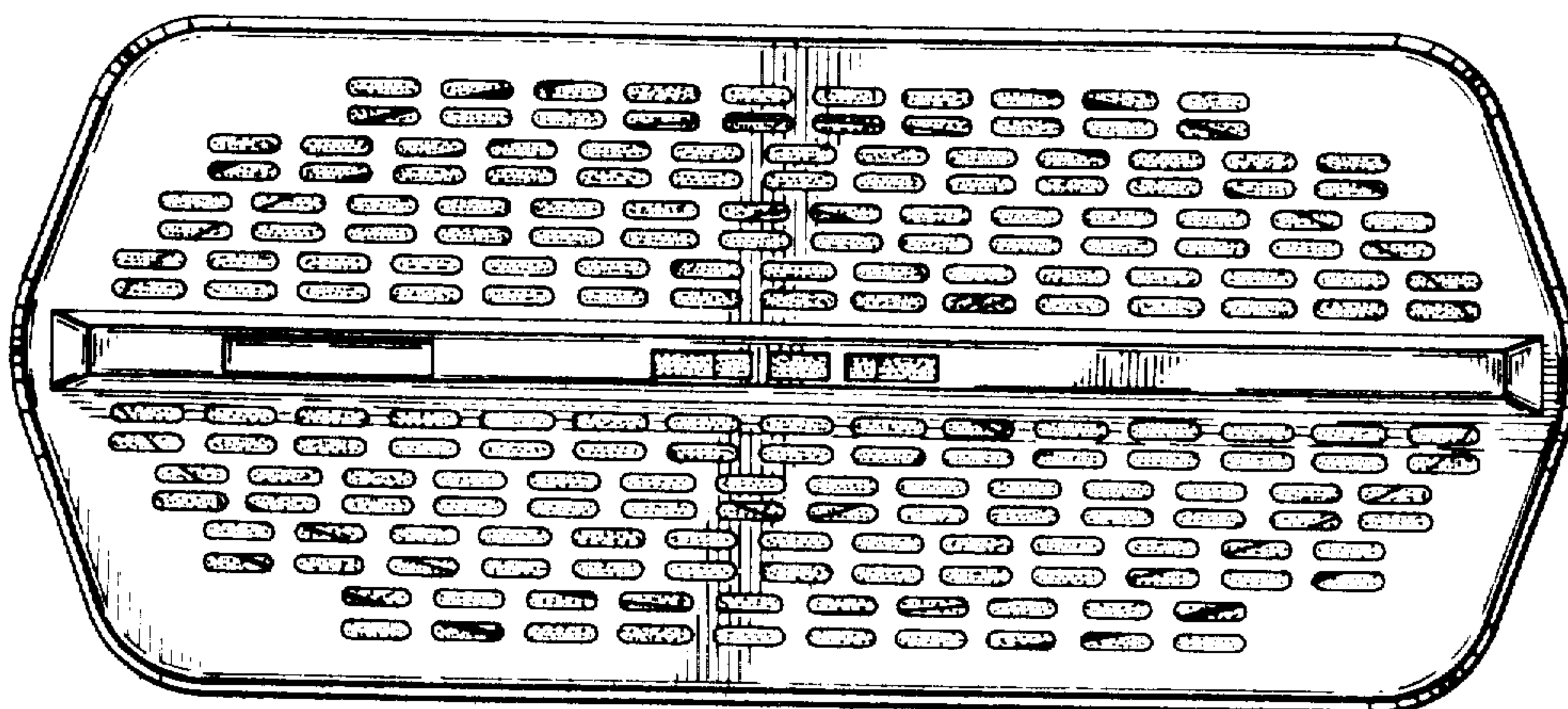

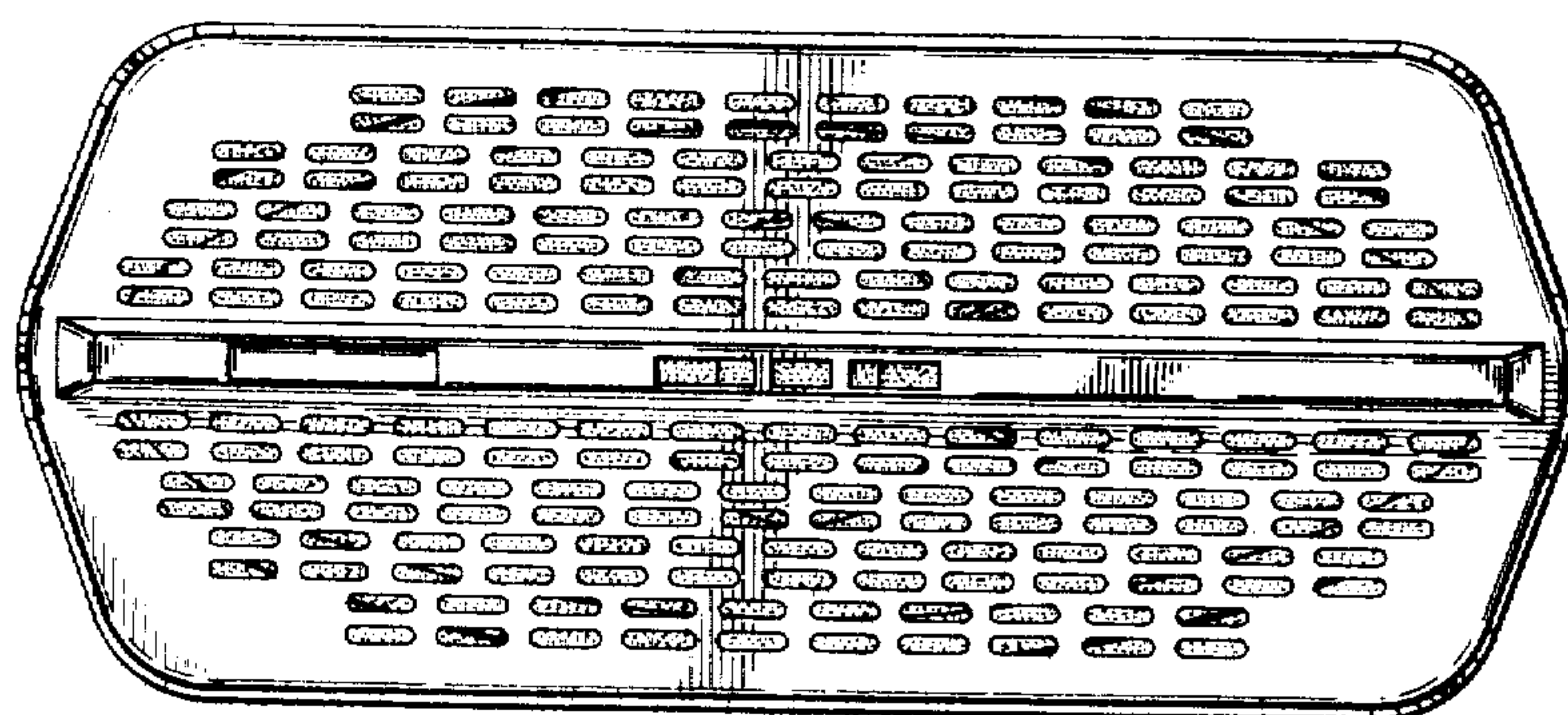

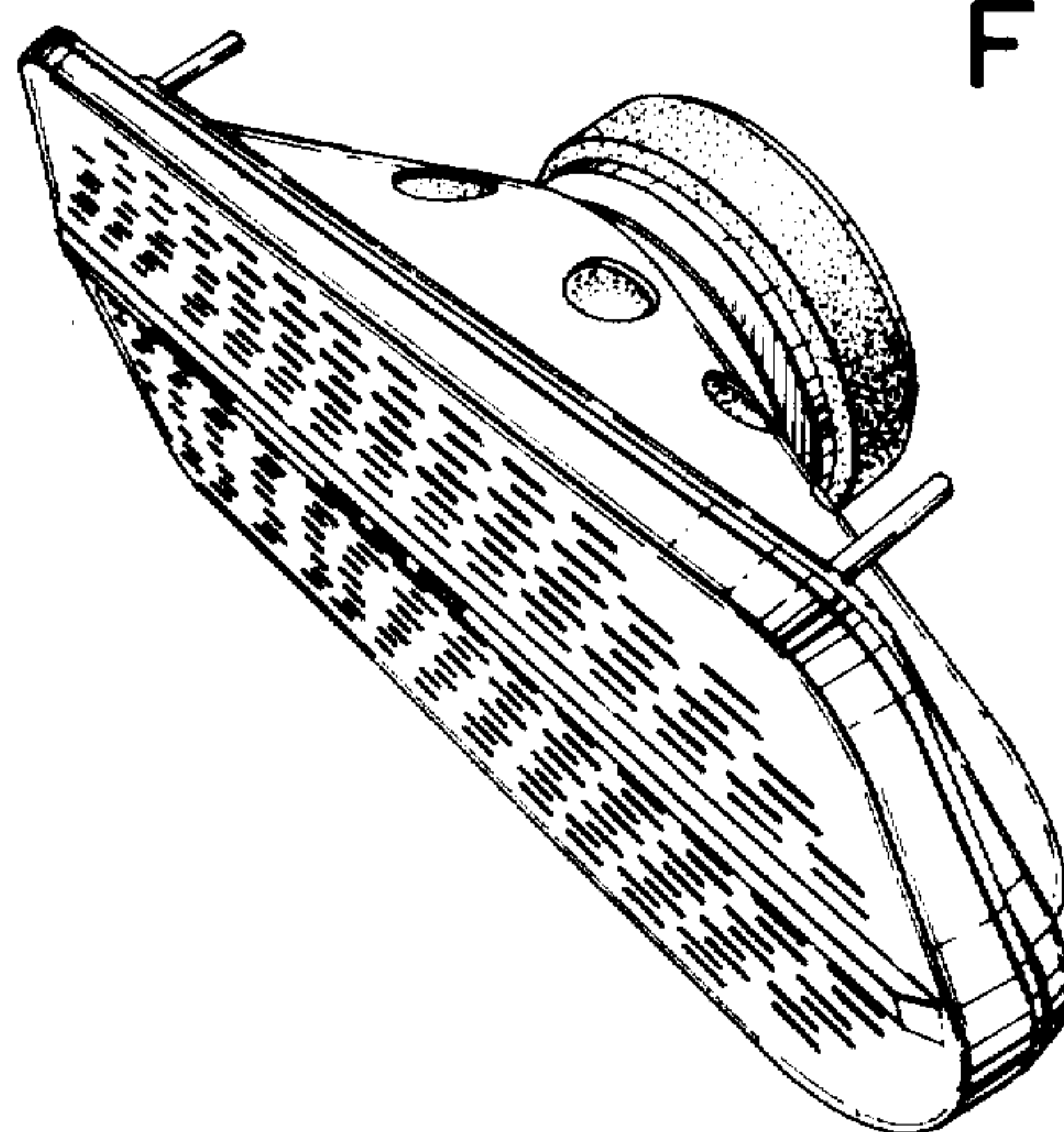

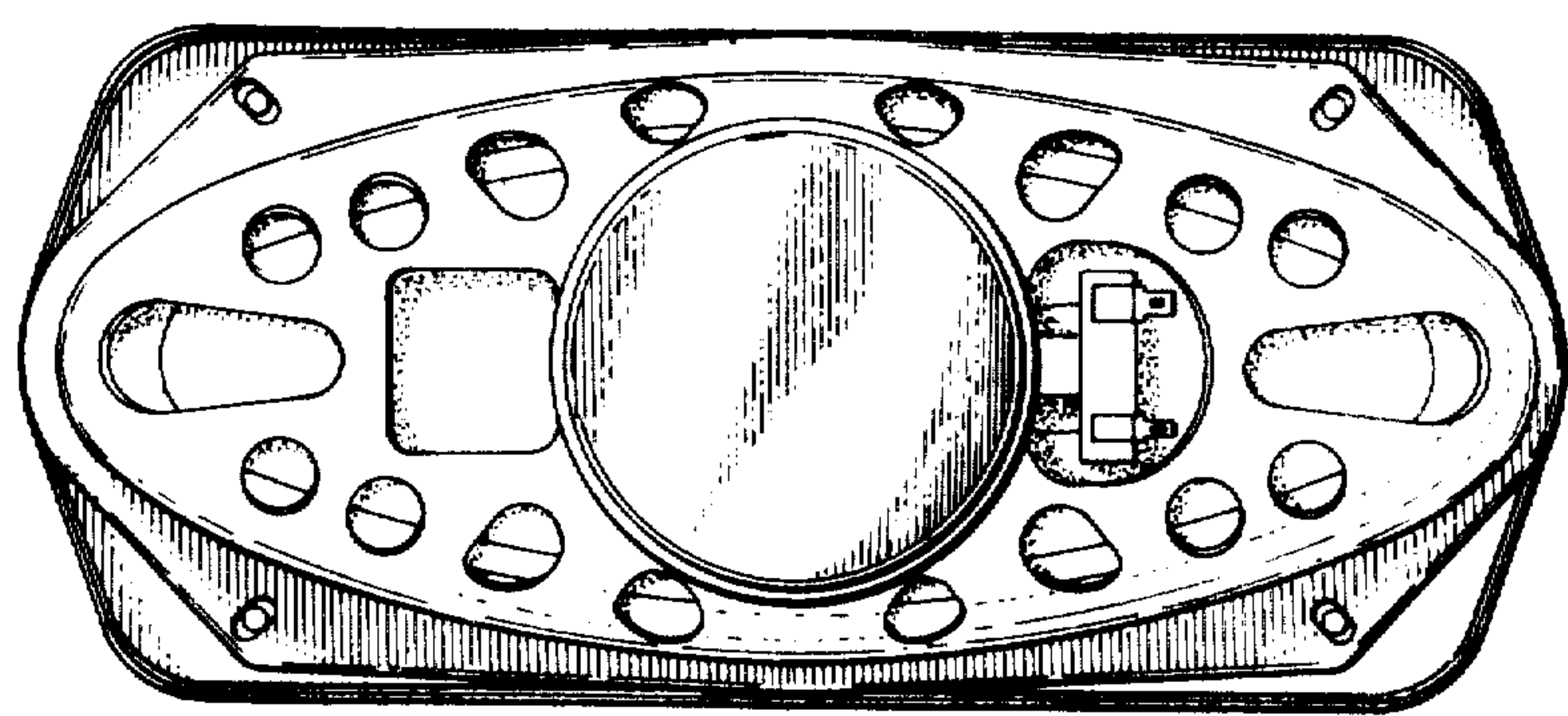

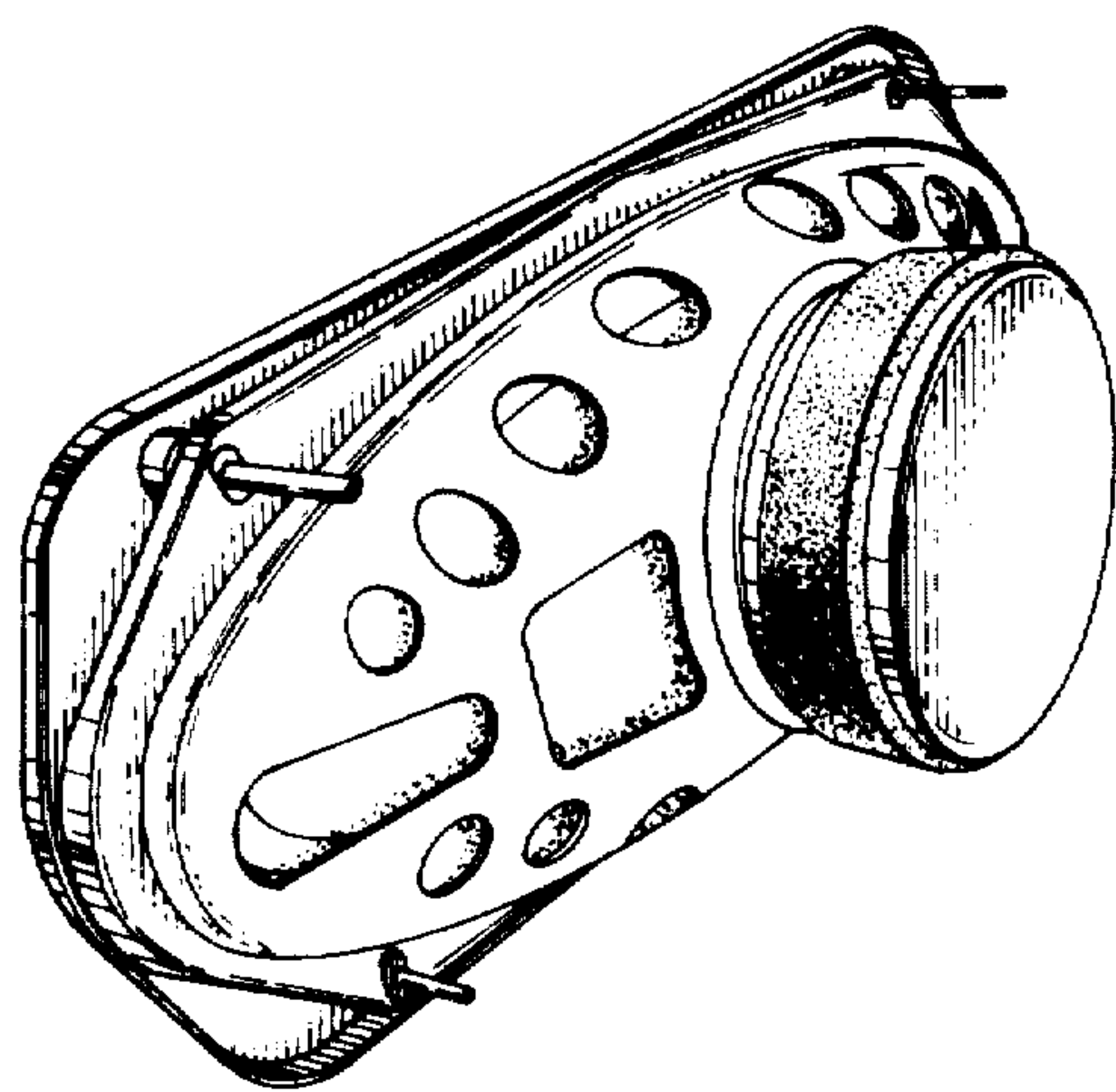
