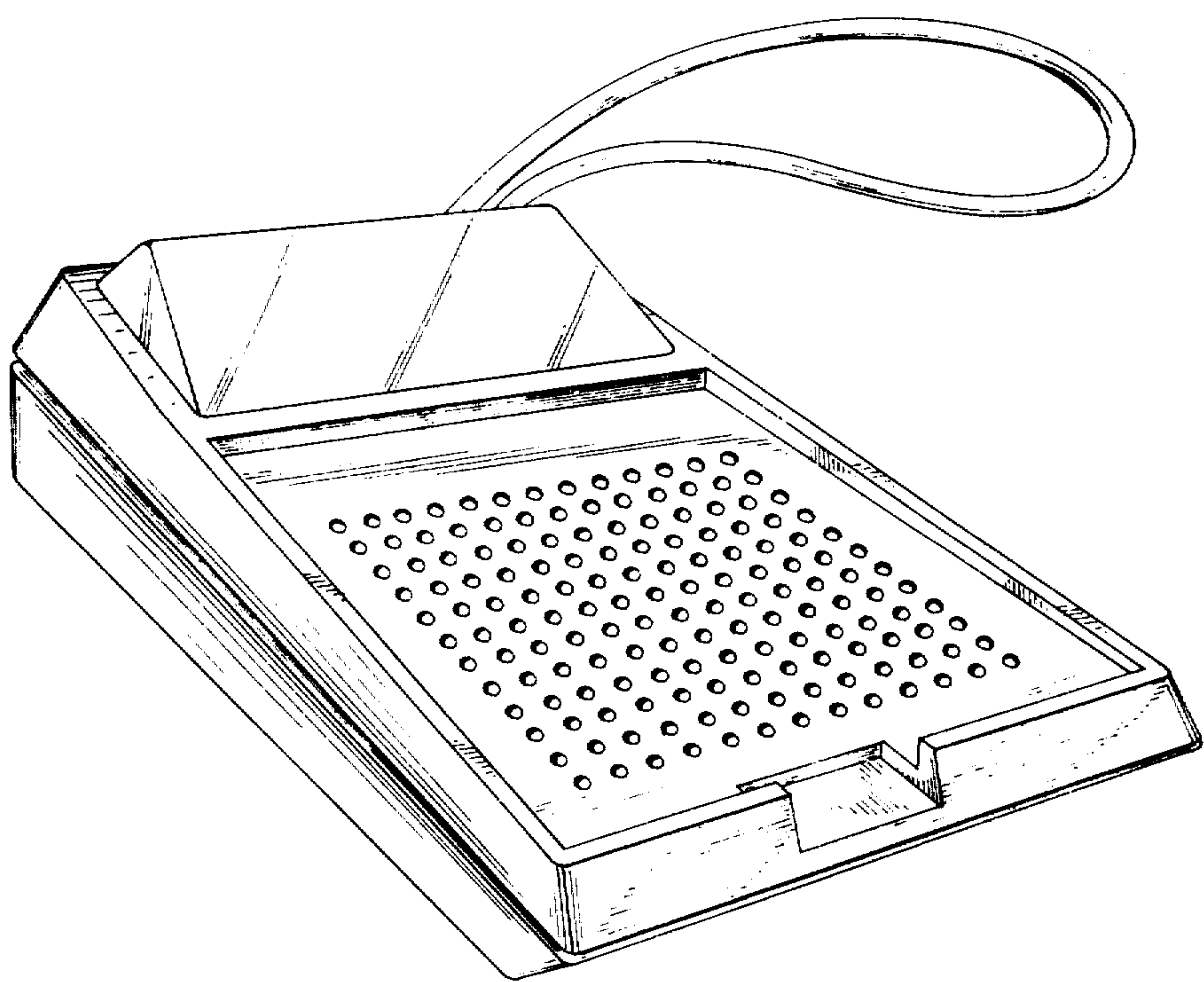
The ornamental design for an electronic teaching unit as shown.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.



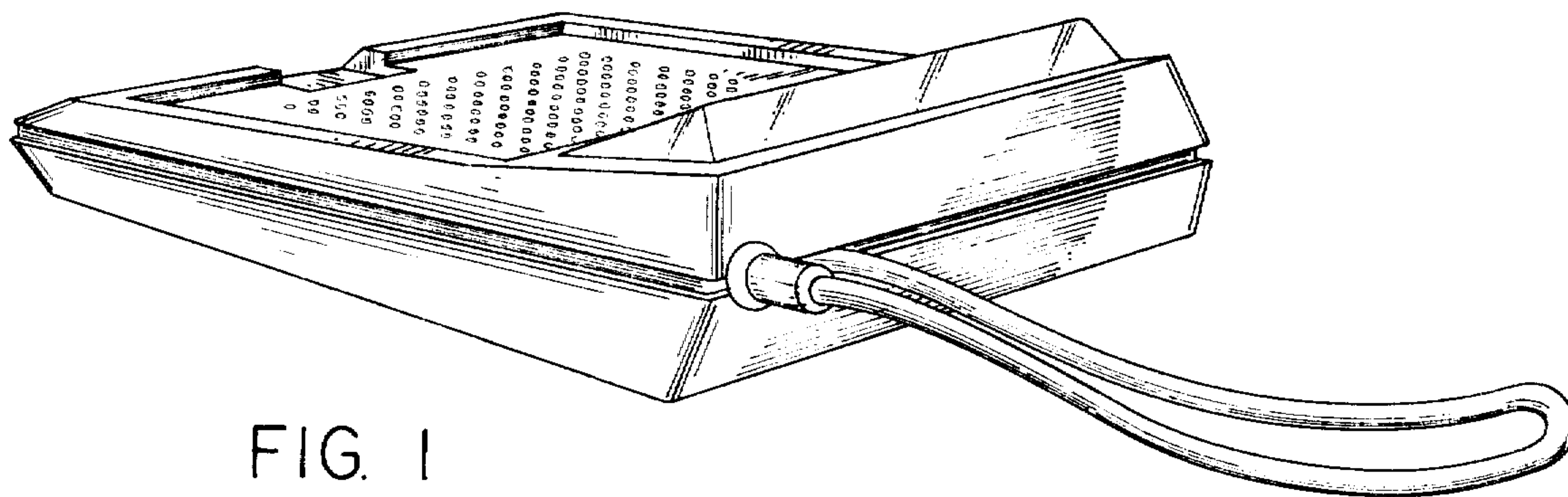

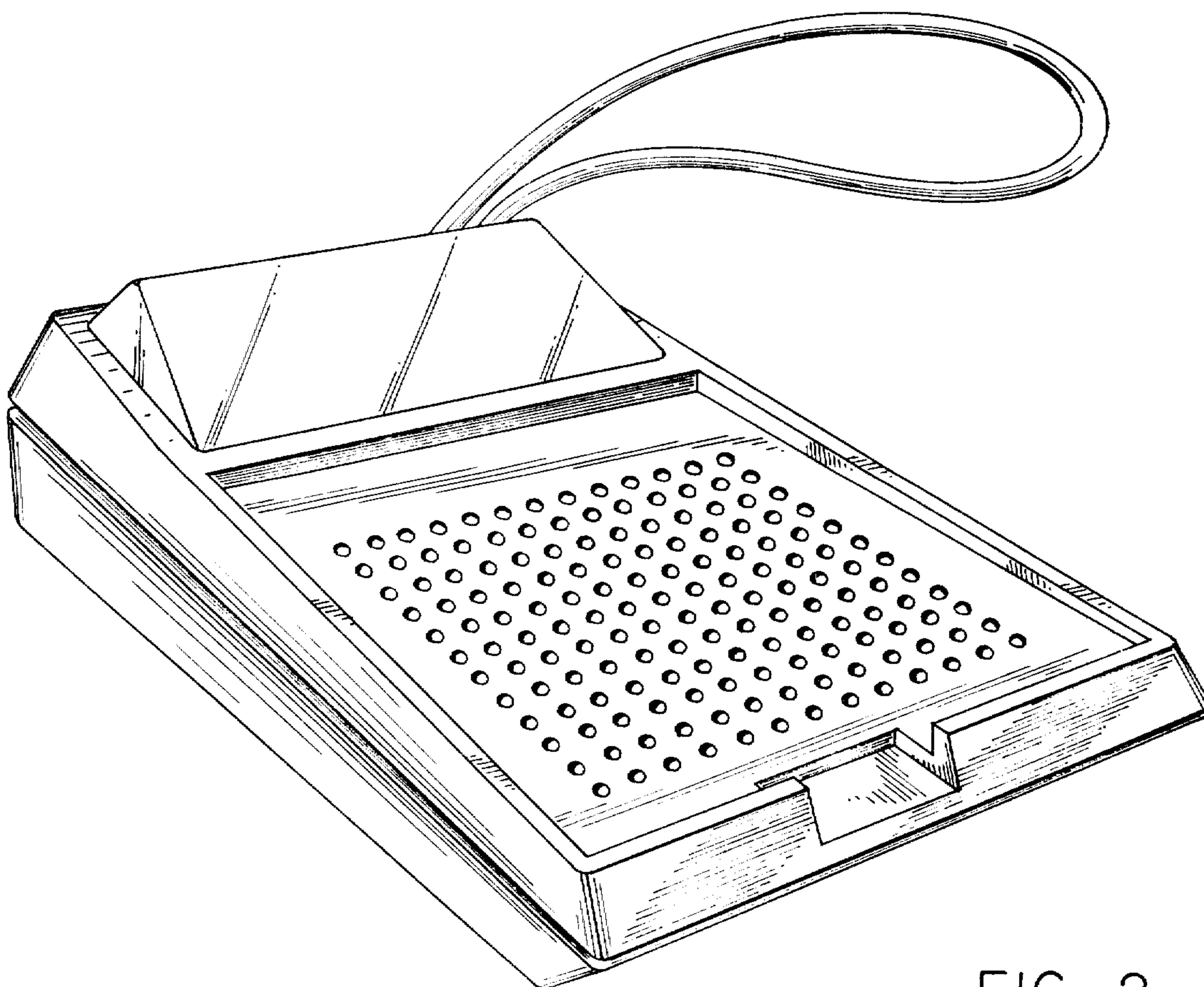

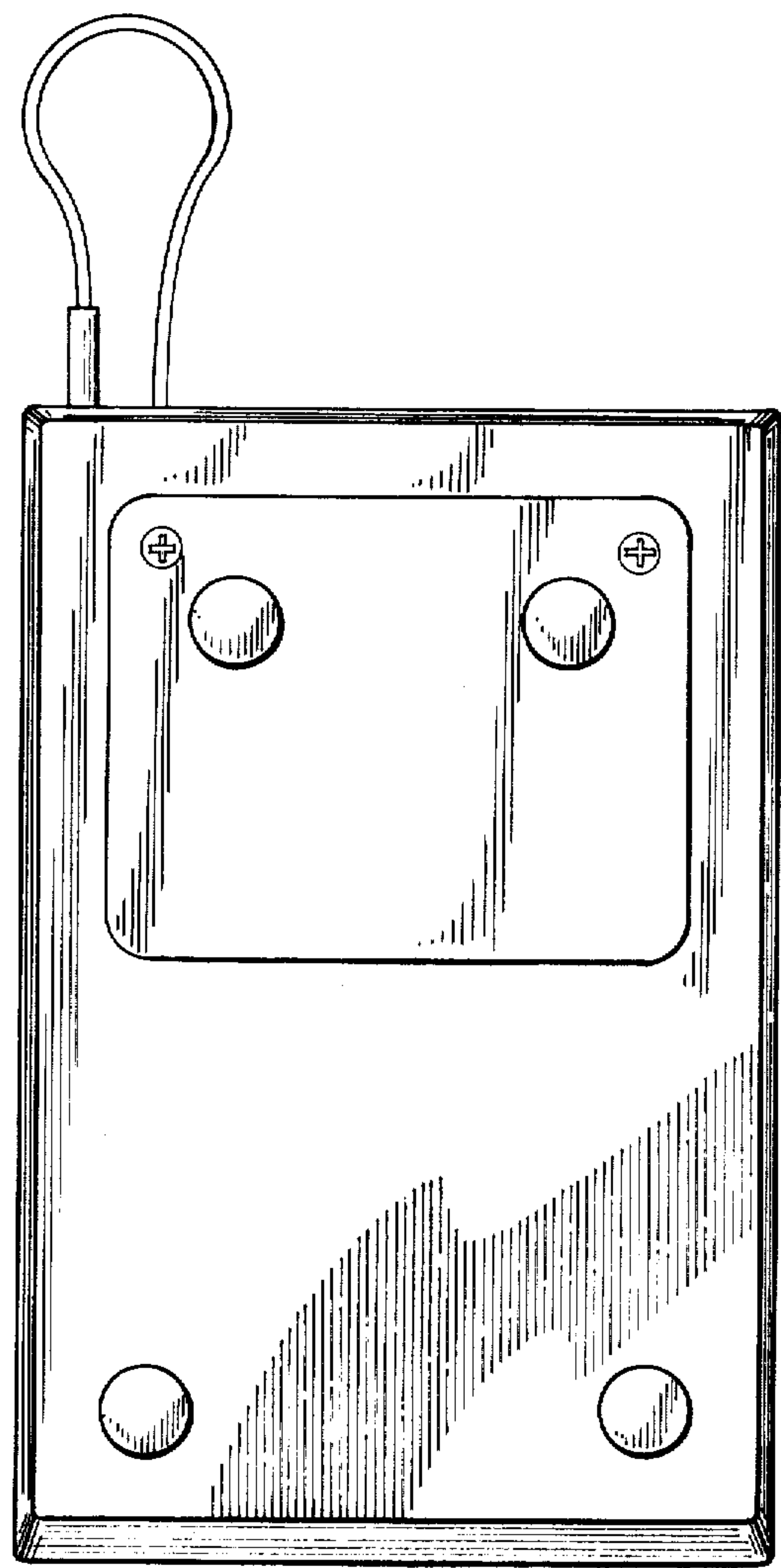
