DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a simulative toy projector showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, a side elevational view of the other side constituting a mirror image of what is shown in FIG. 2;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

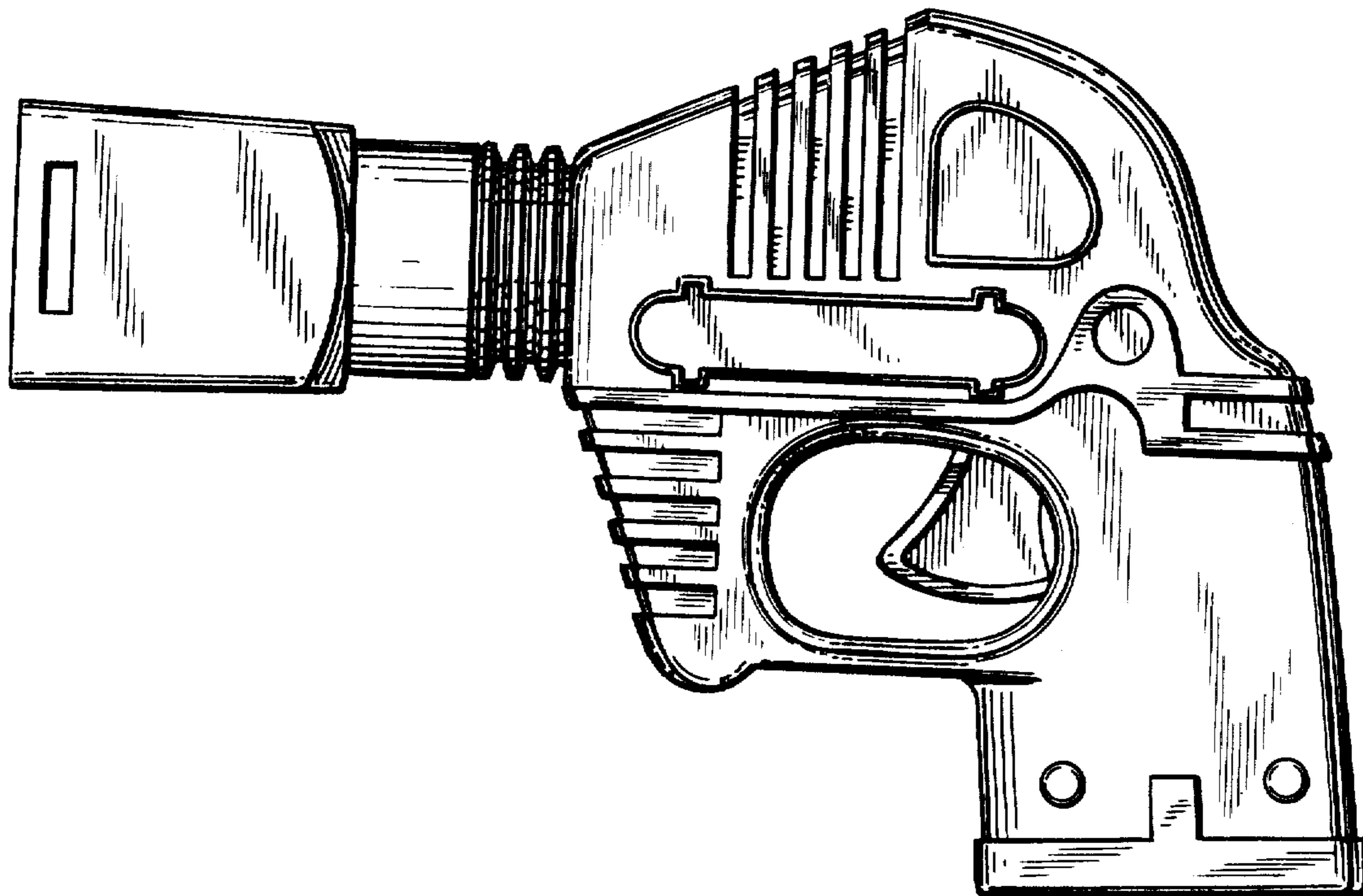

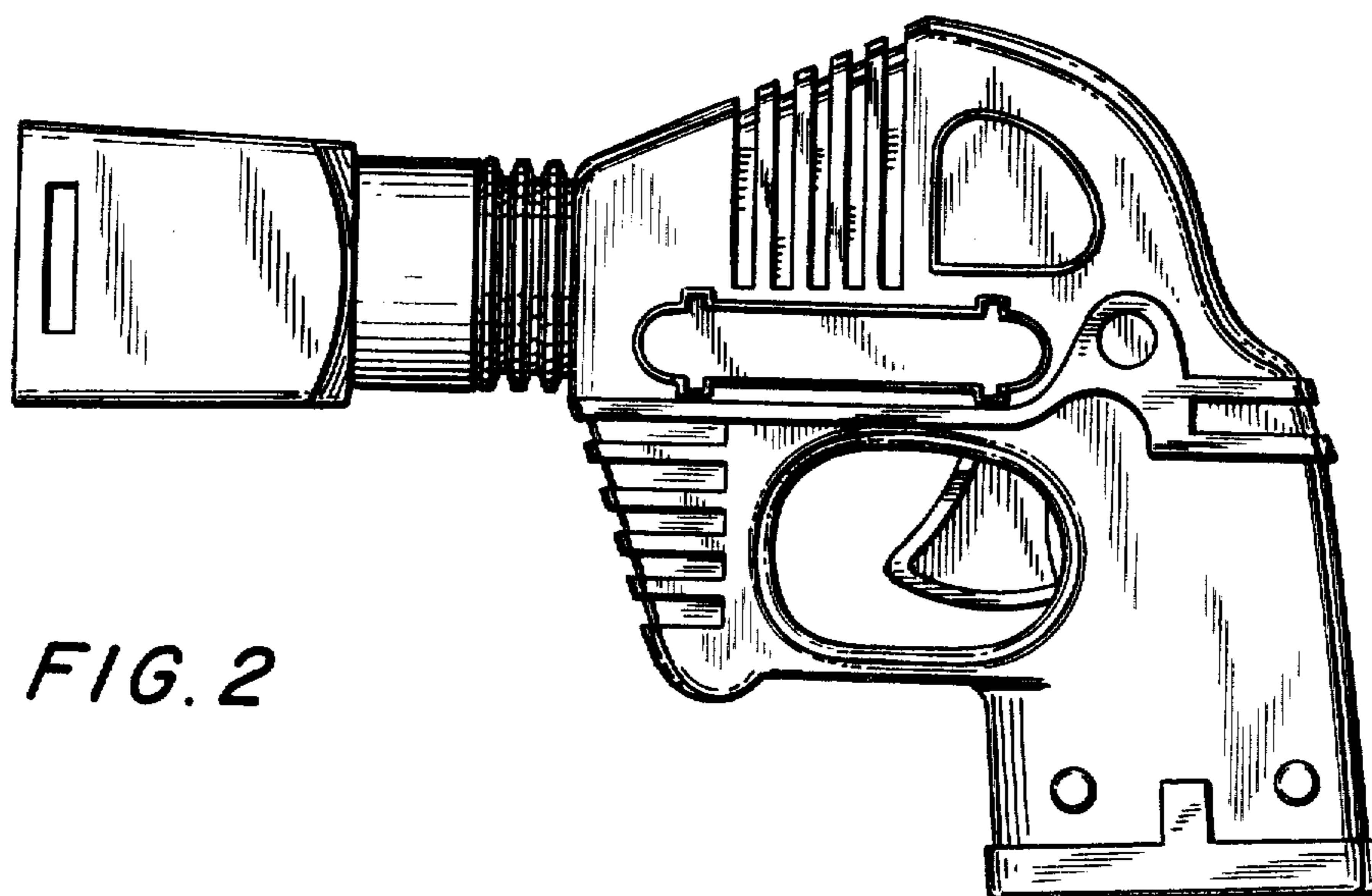
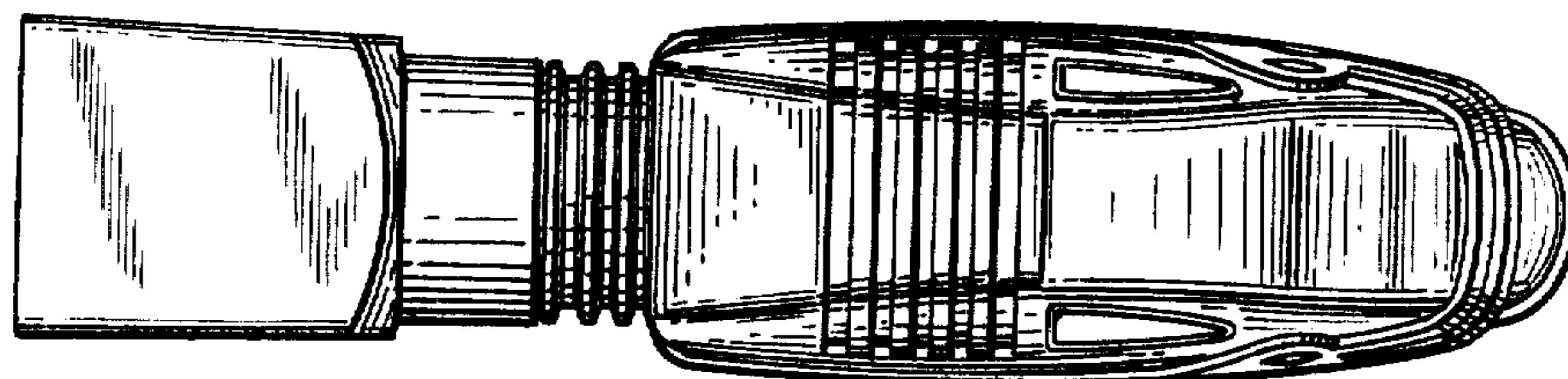

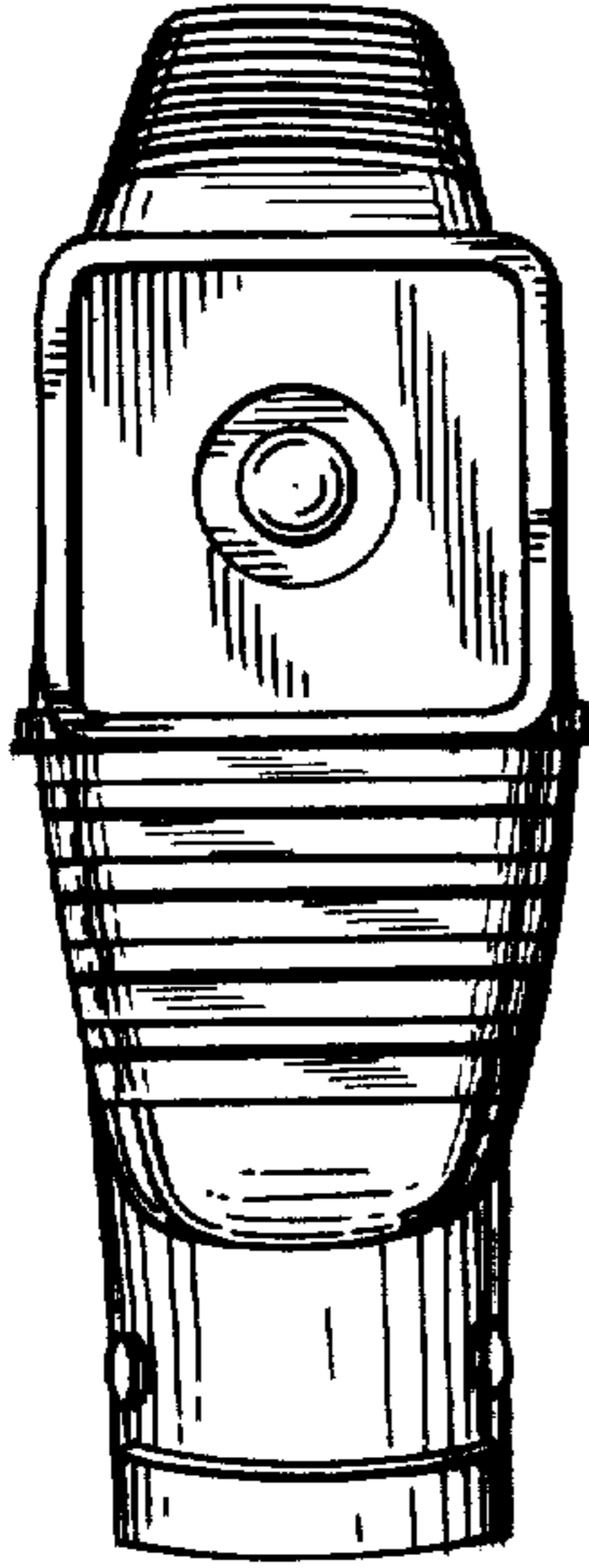

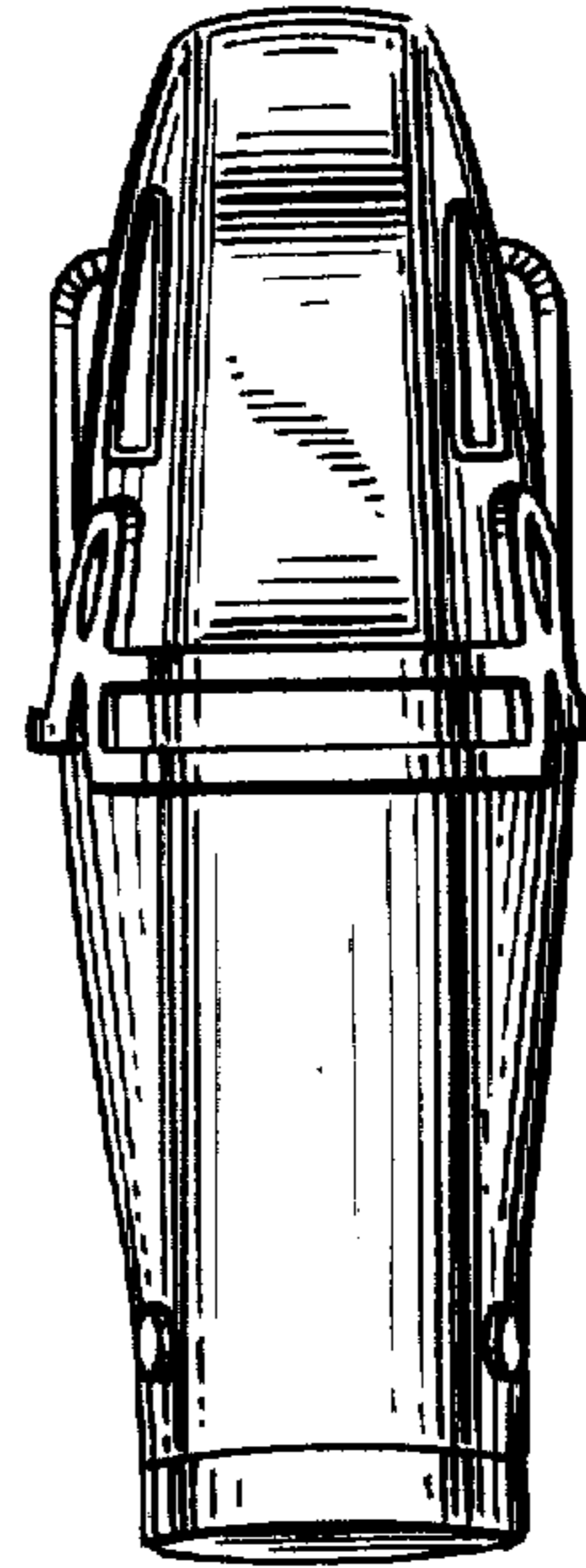
