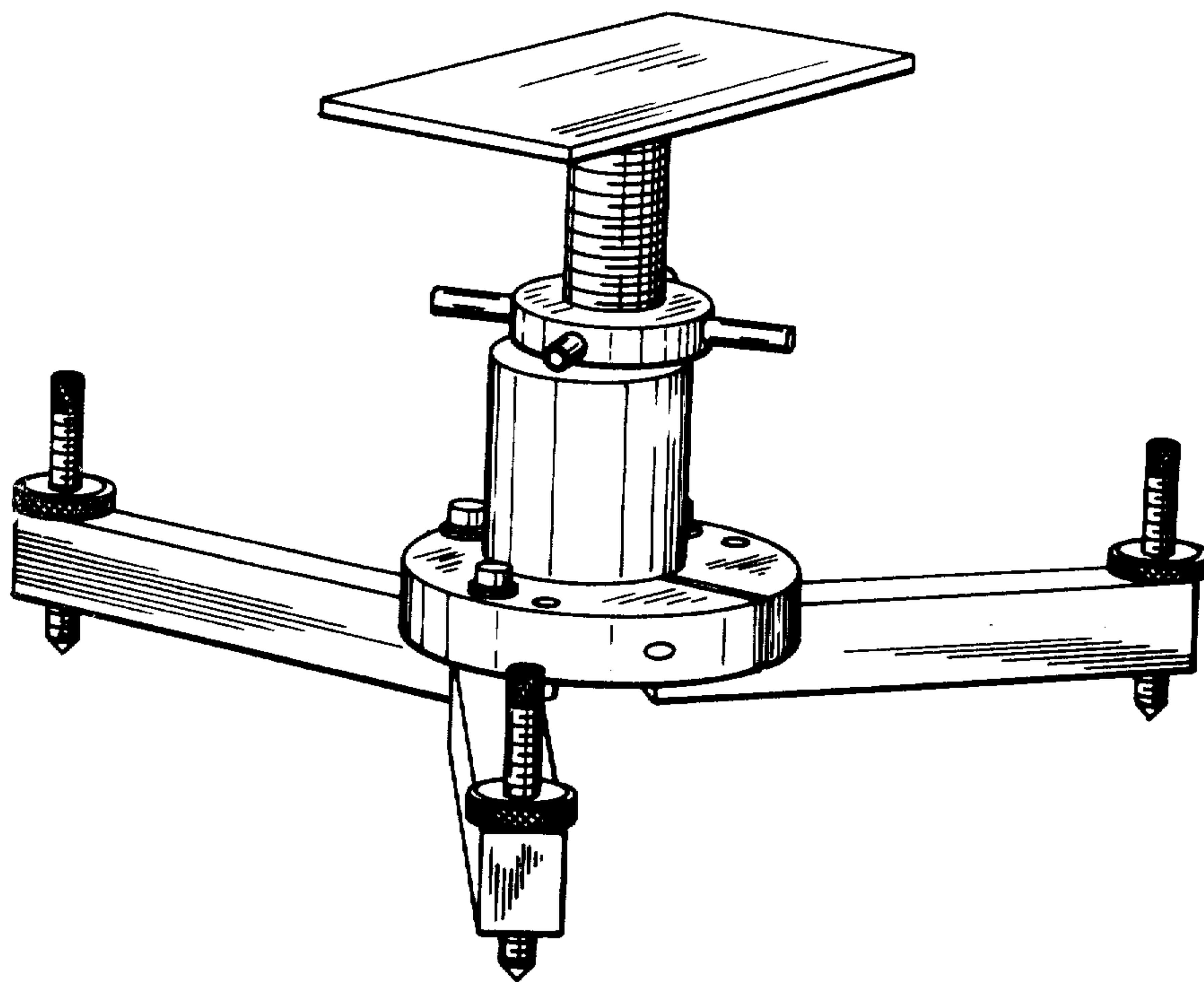

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the rifle pedestal—for
shooting ranges and the like, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.



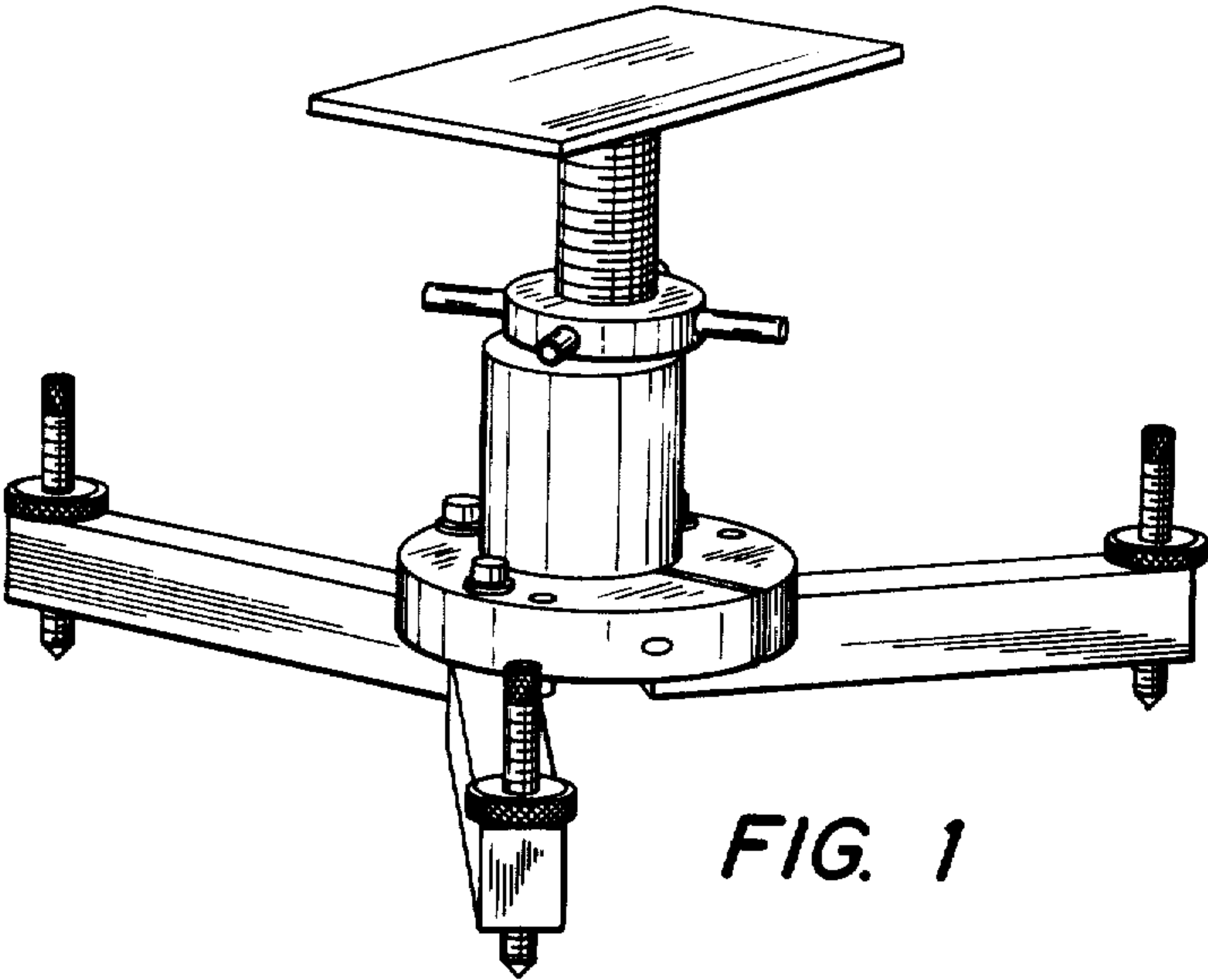

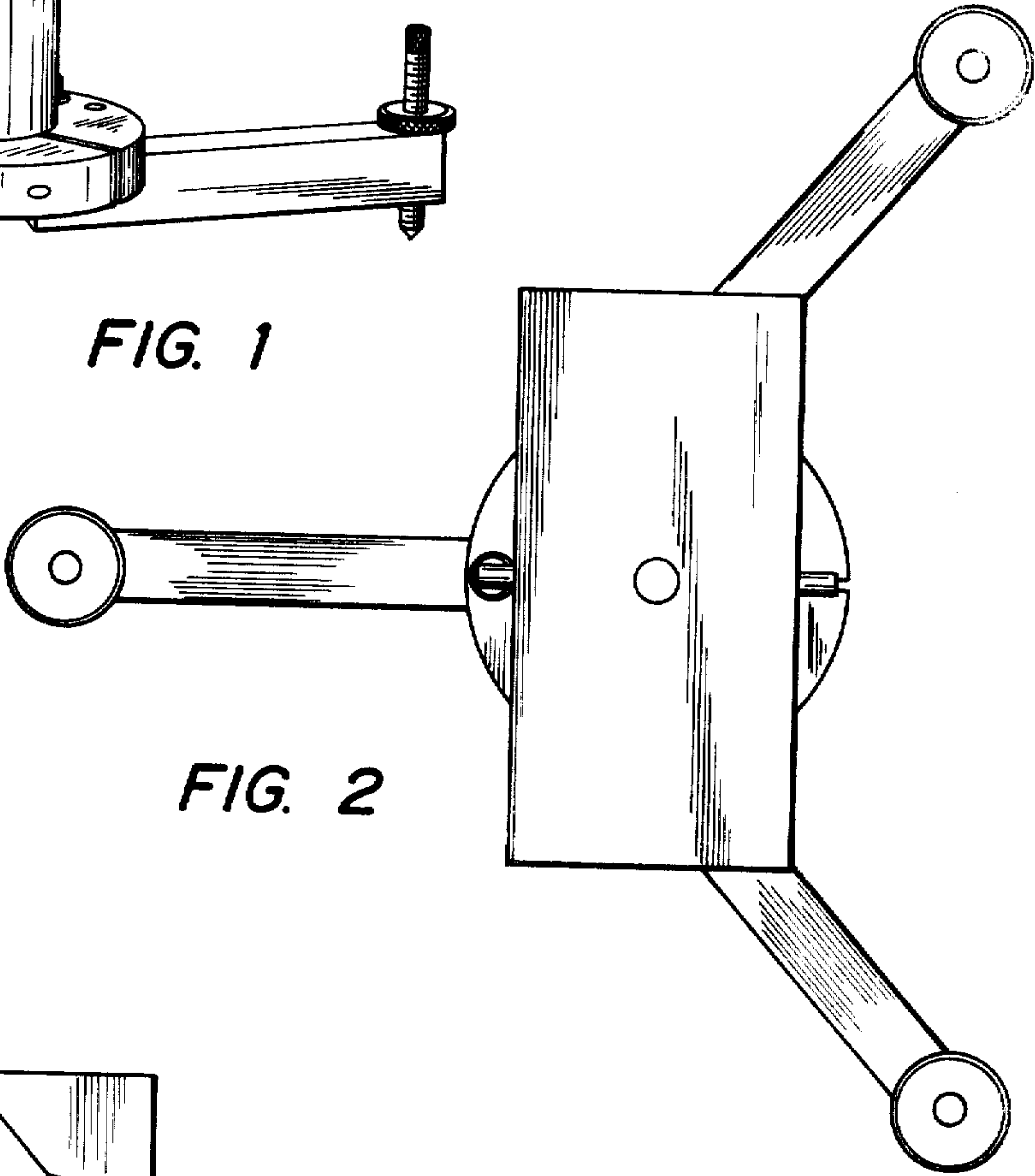

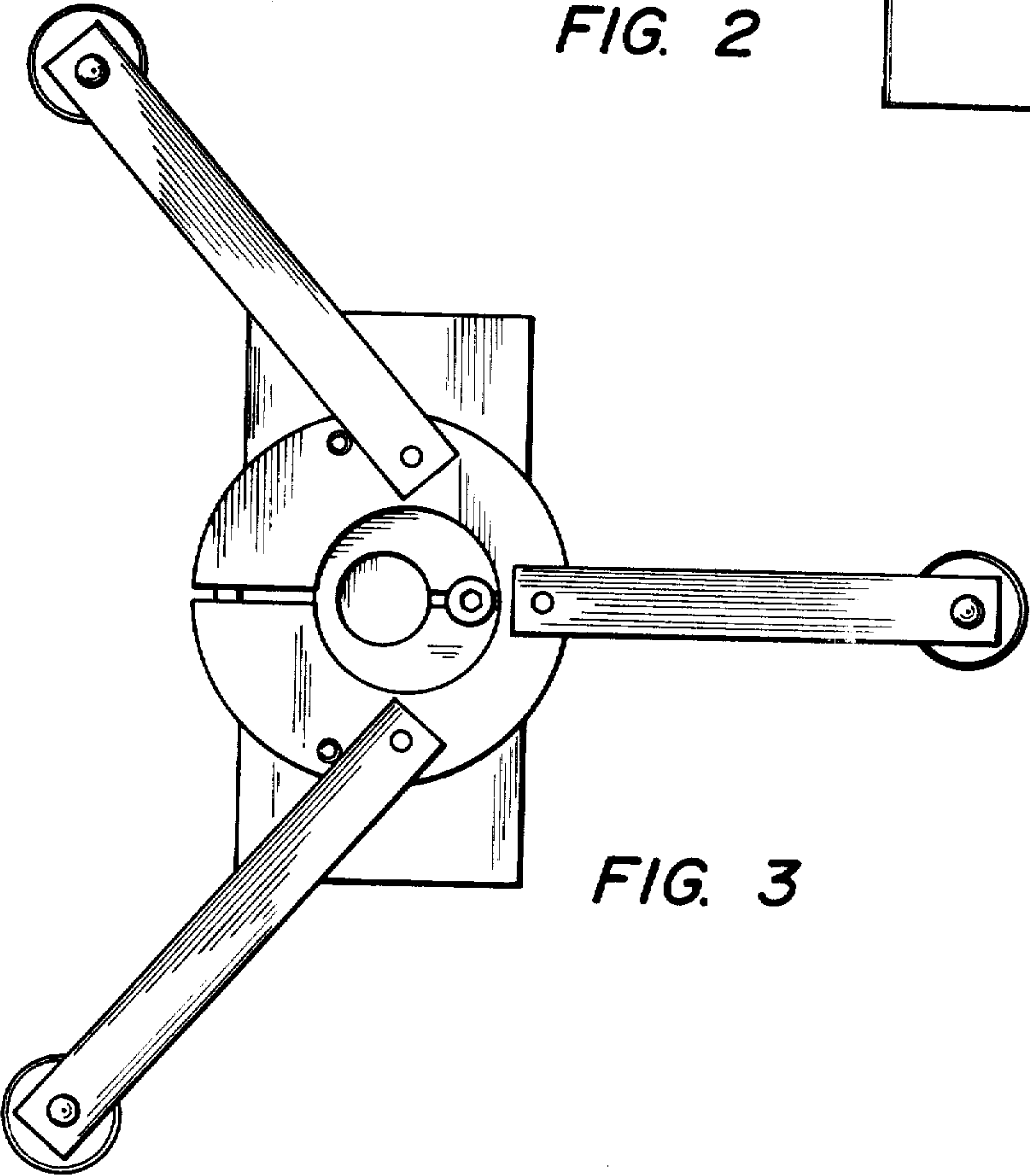

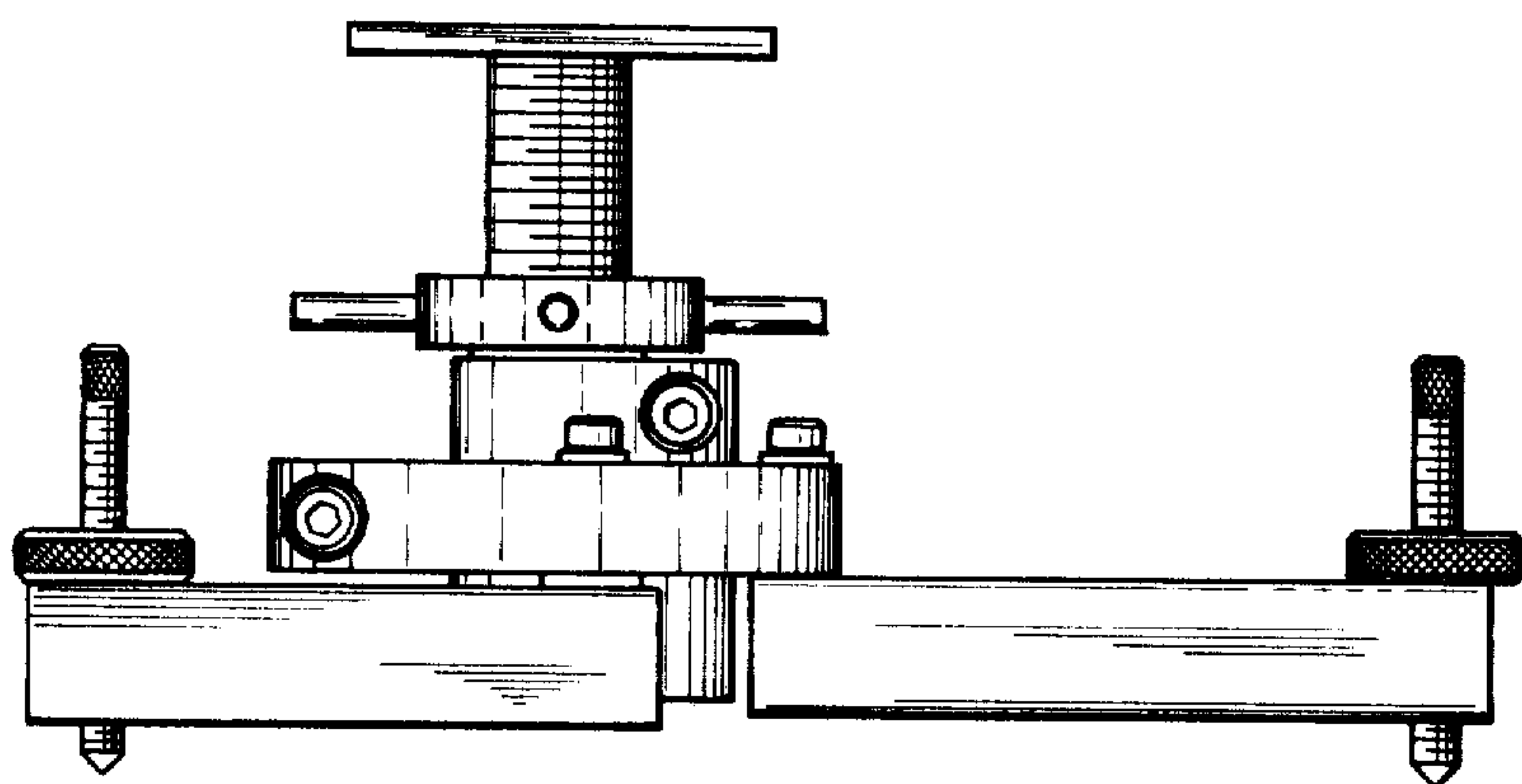

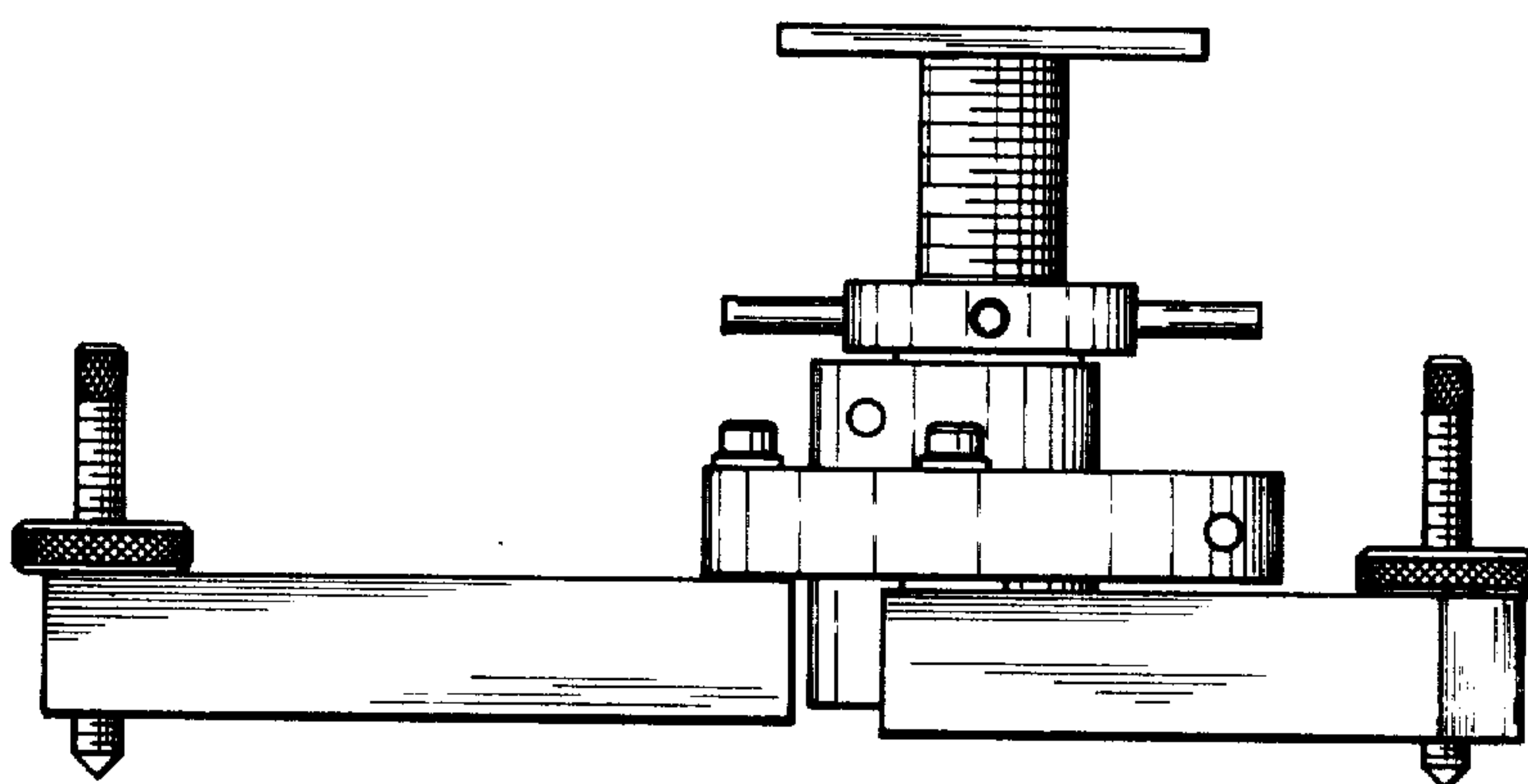

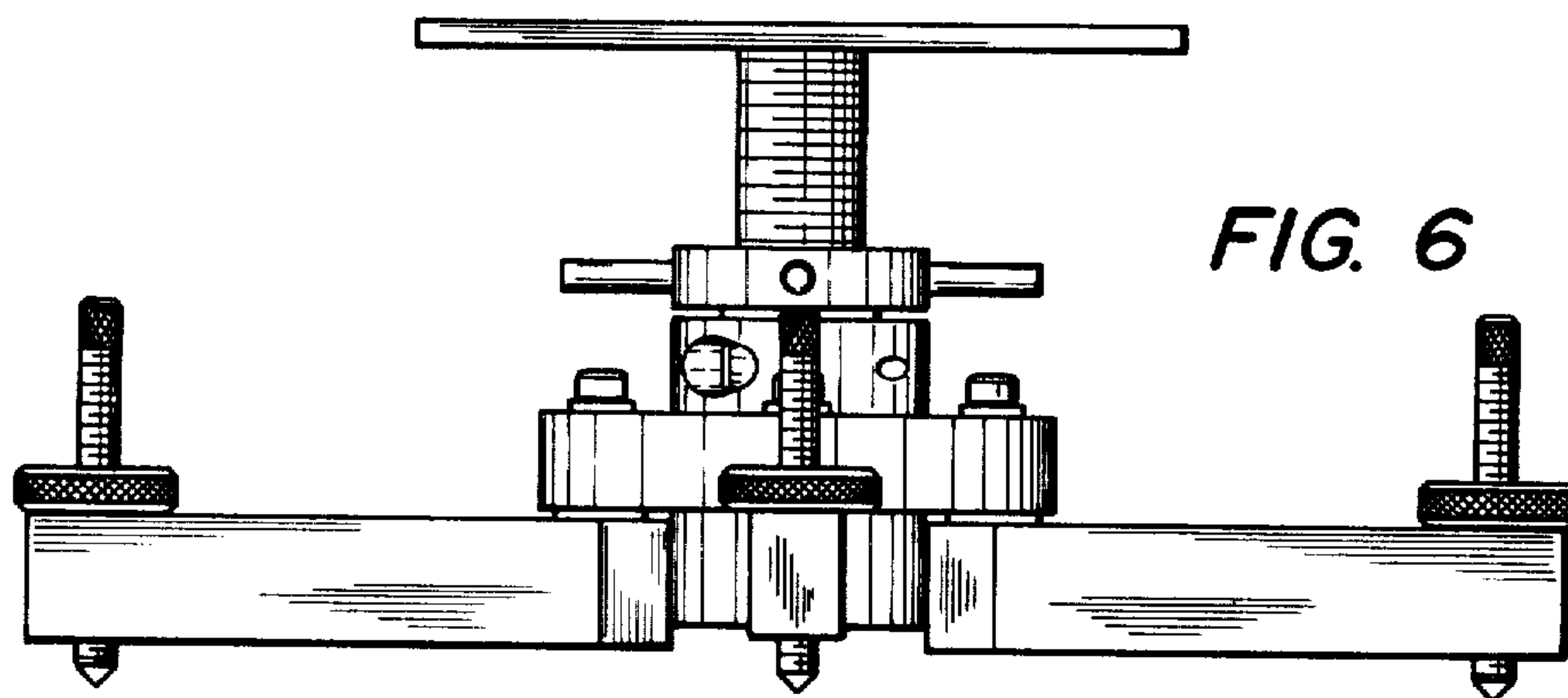

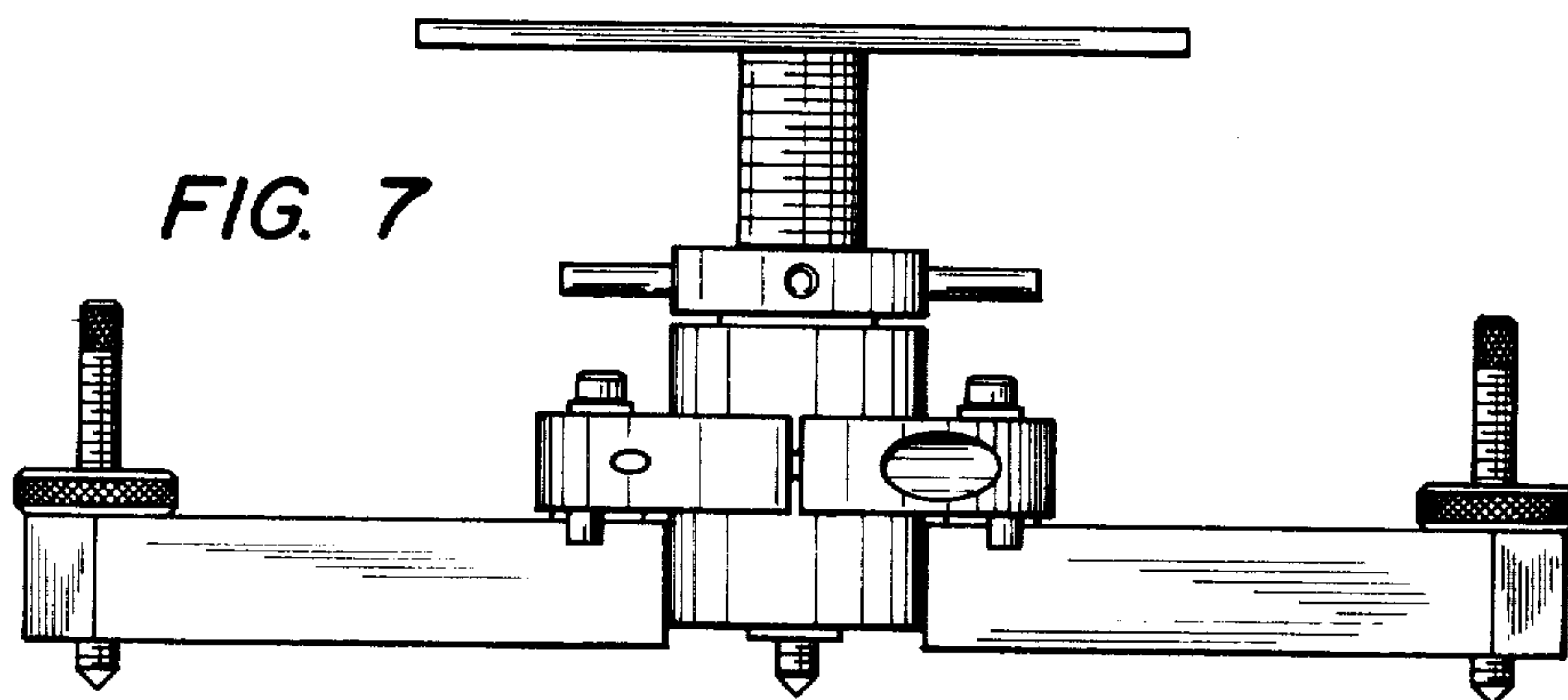
