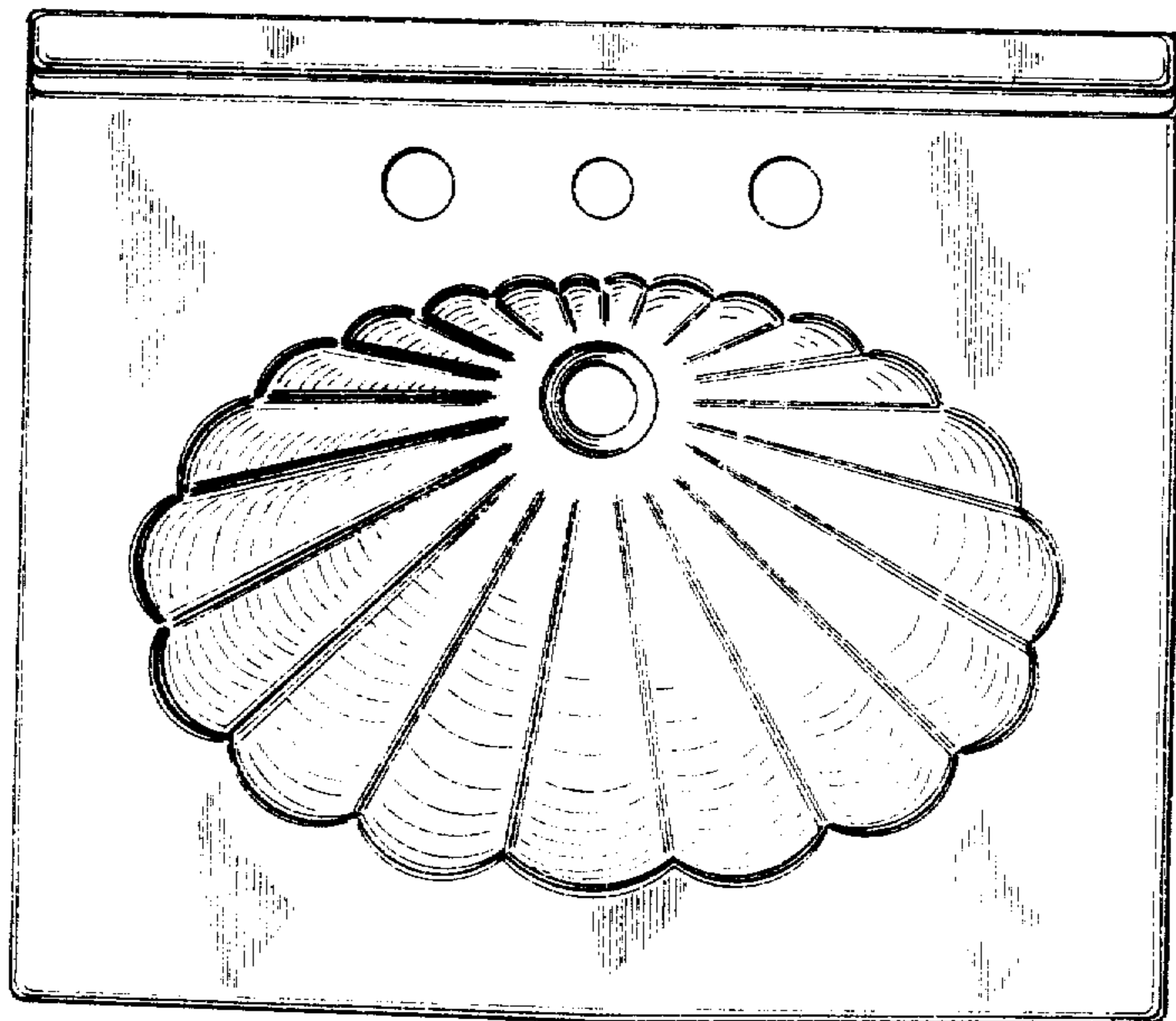

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lavatory or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lavatory or similar article embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is an elevational view in section taken along line 5-5 of FIG. 3.



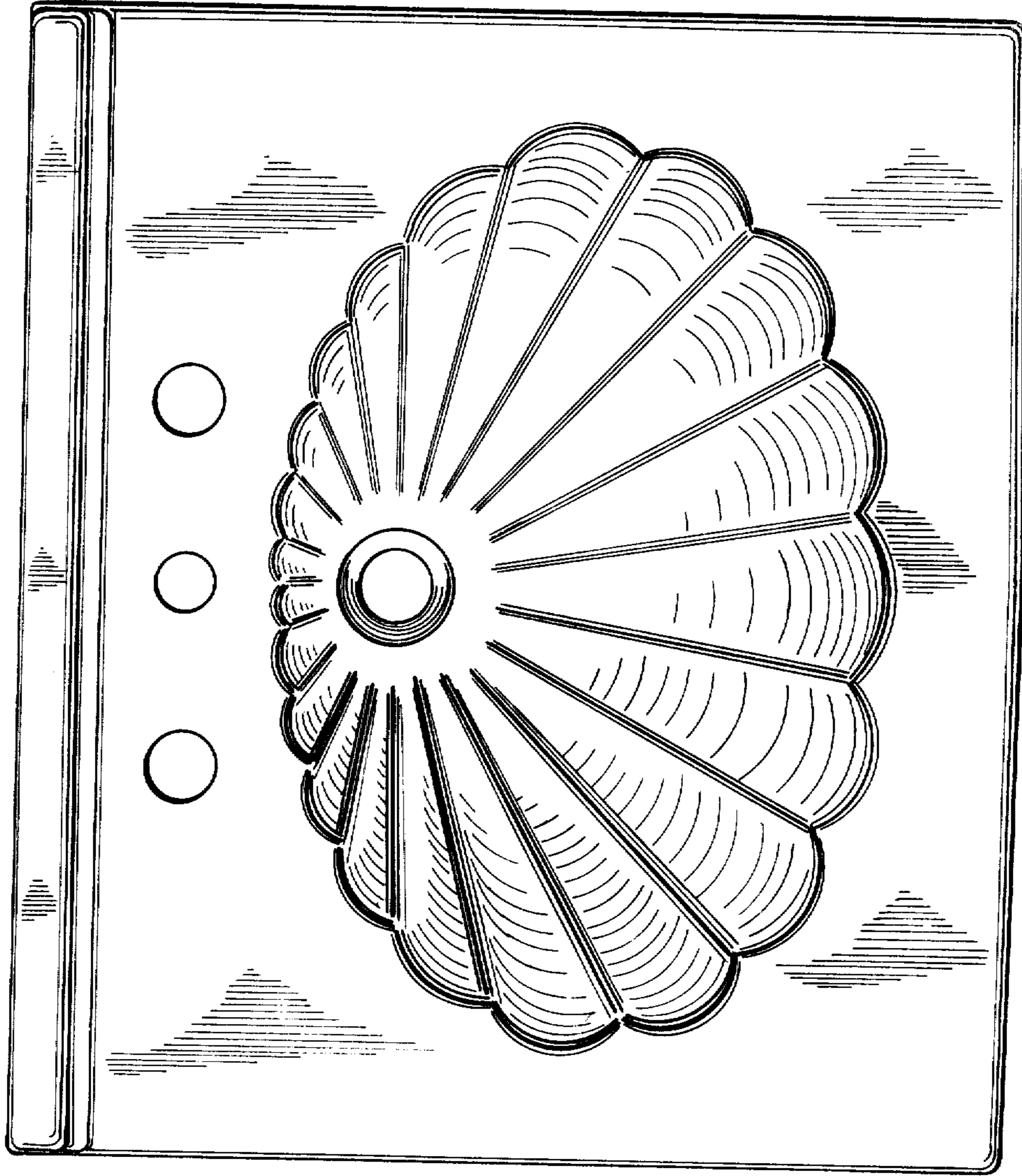

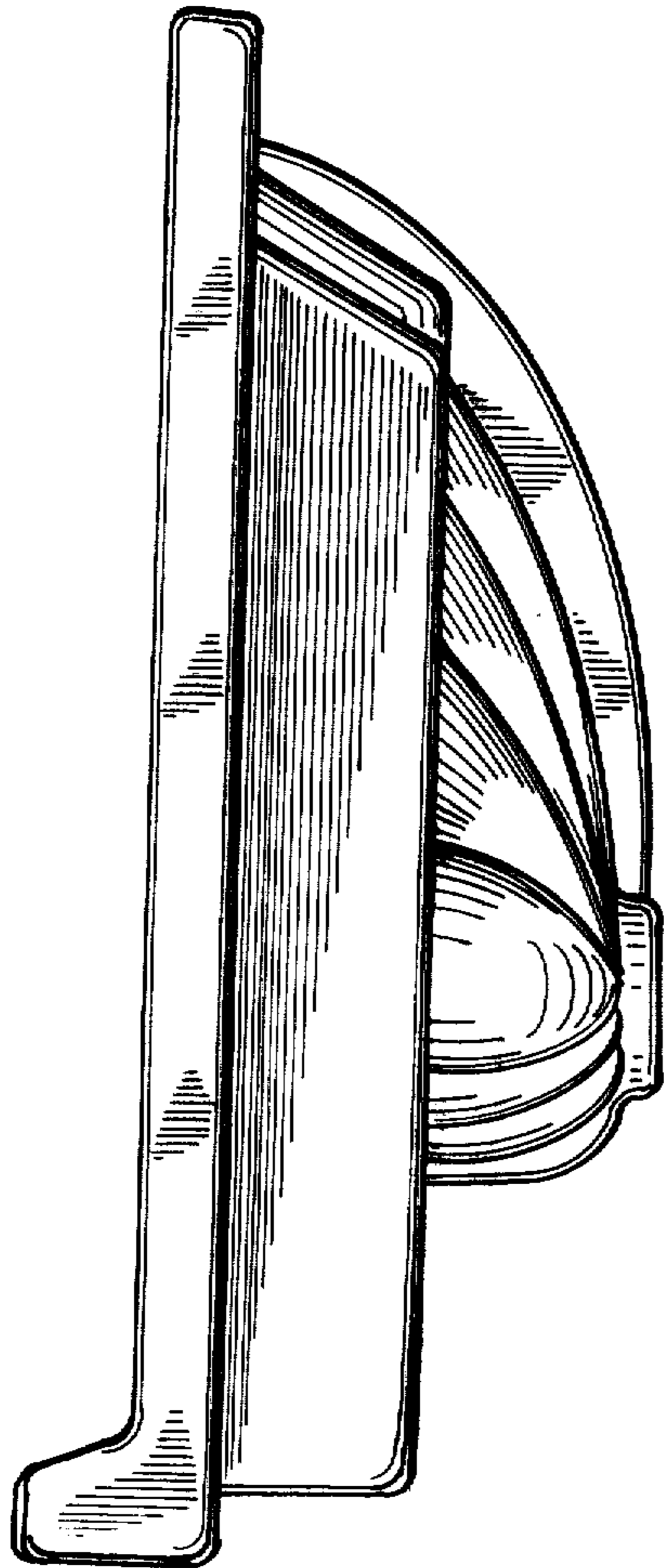

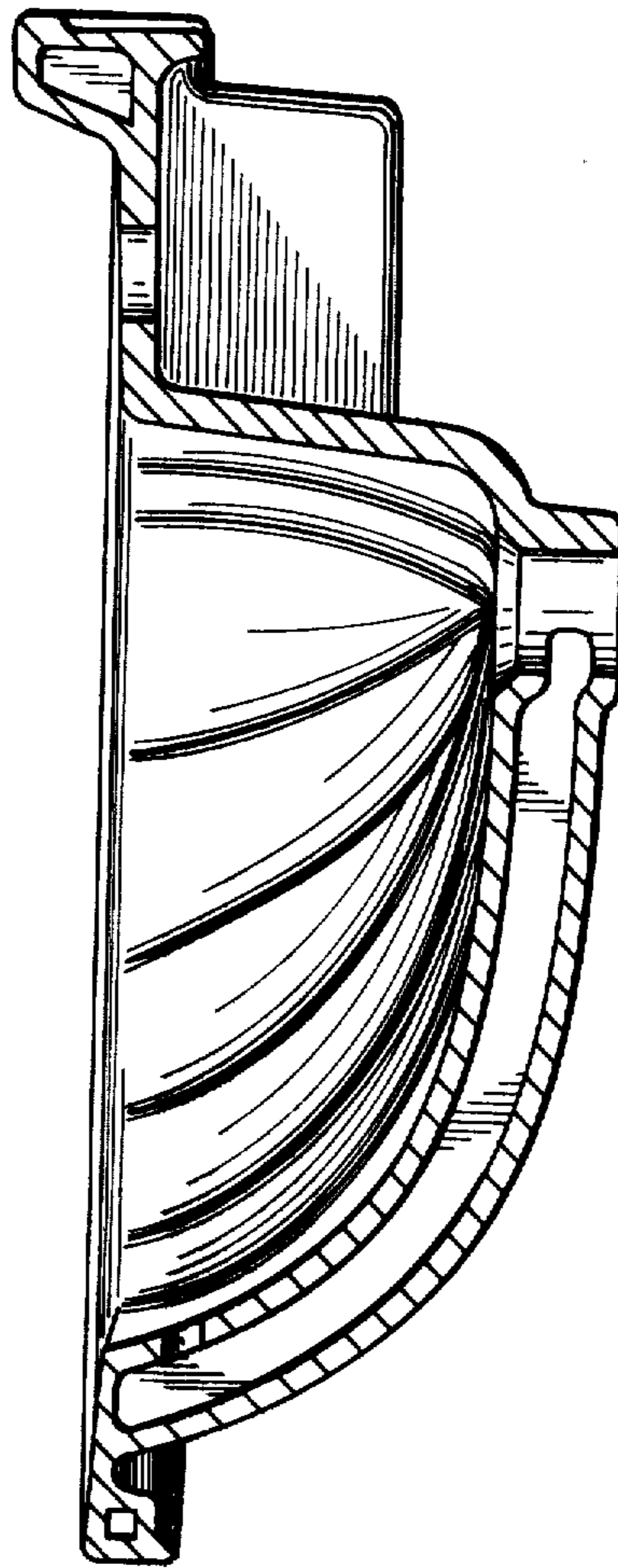
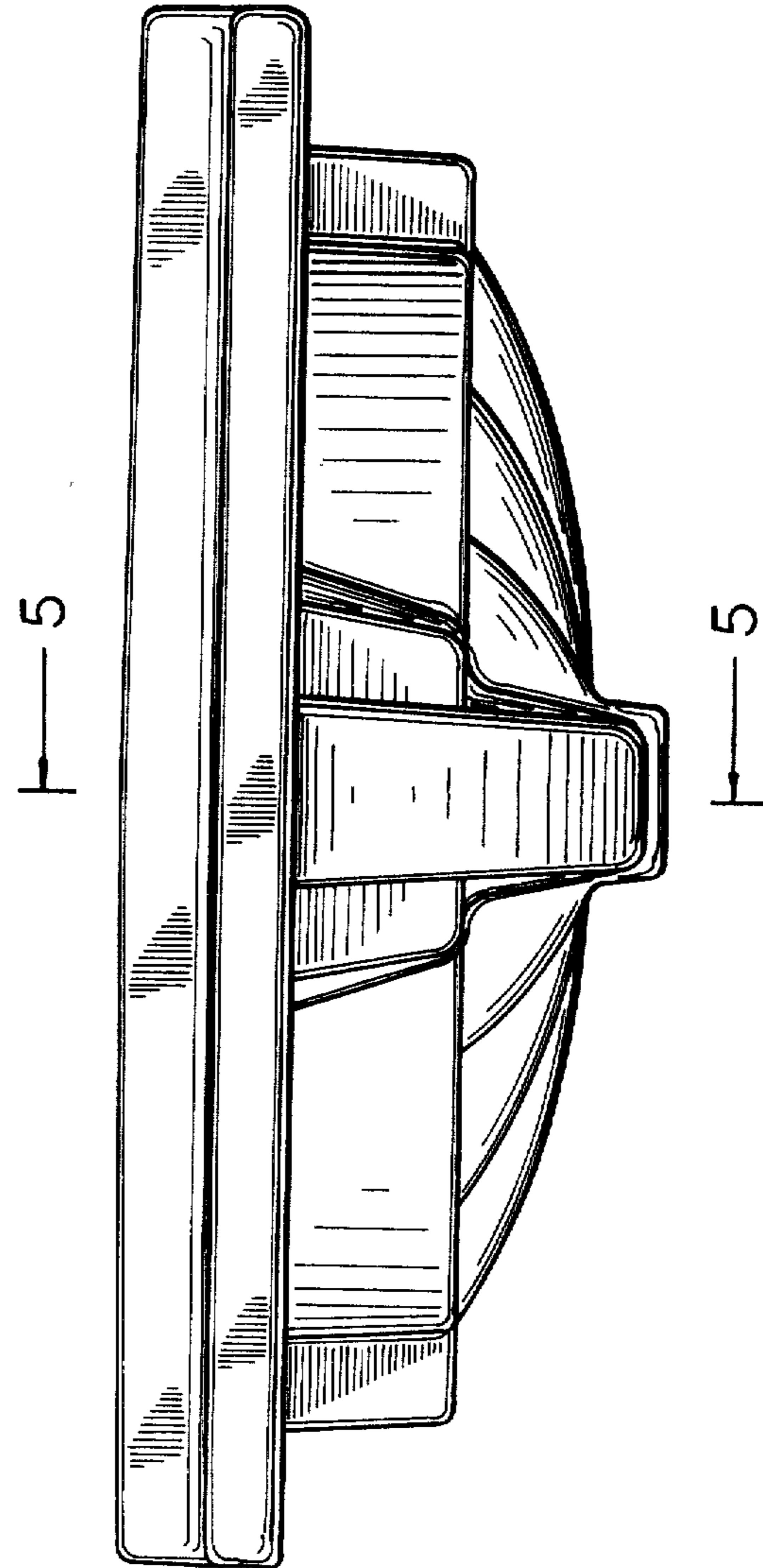

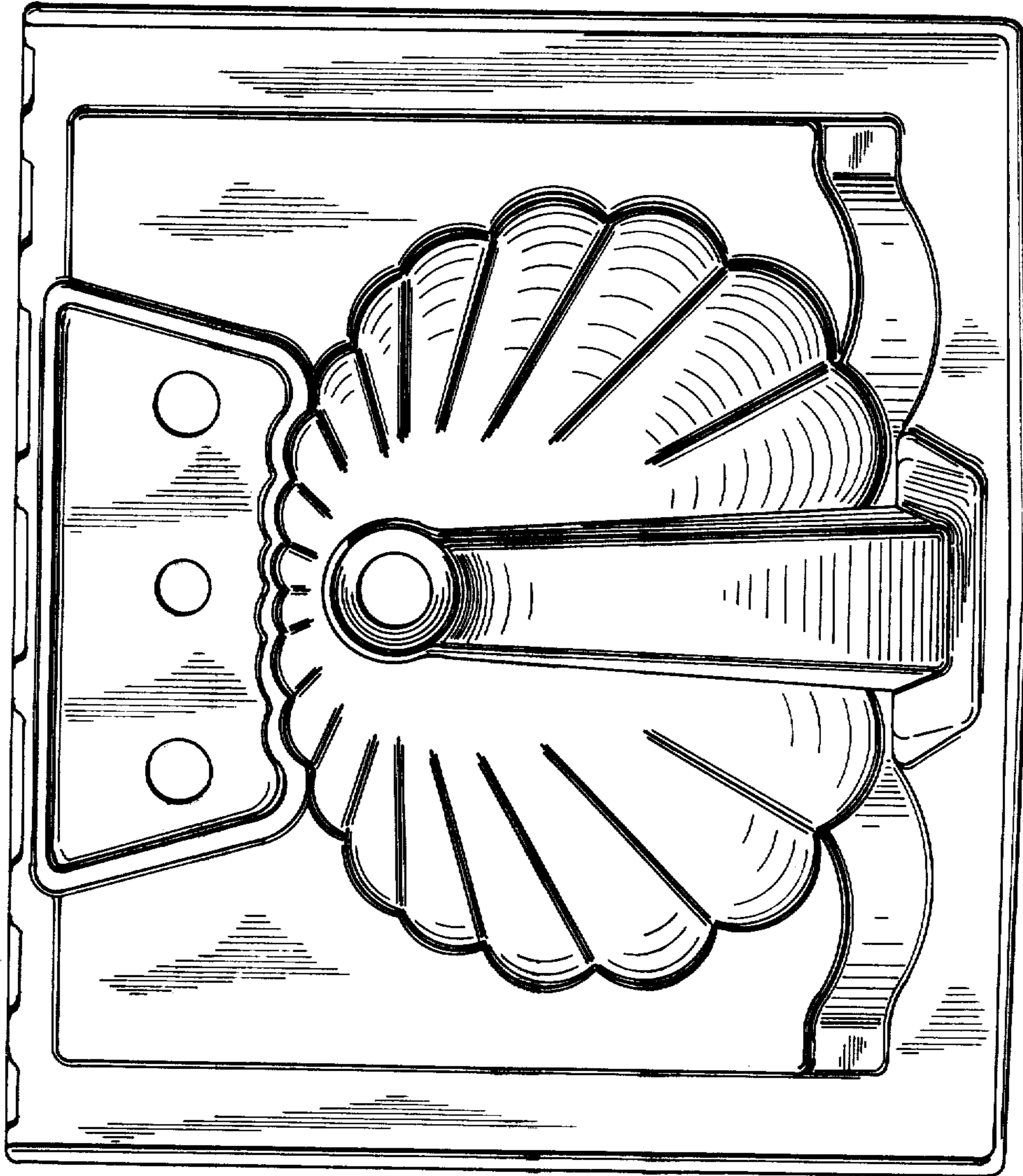
