FIG. 4 is an elevation view from the right end of FIG. 2.

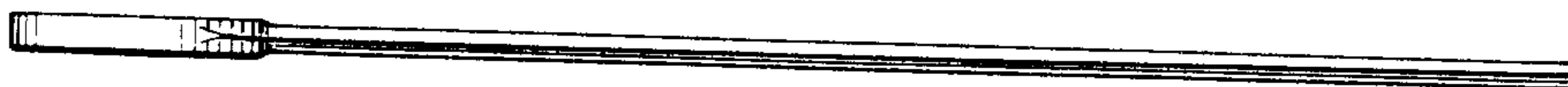
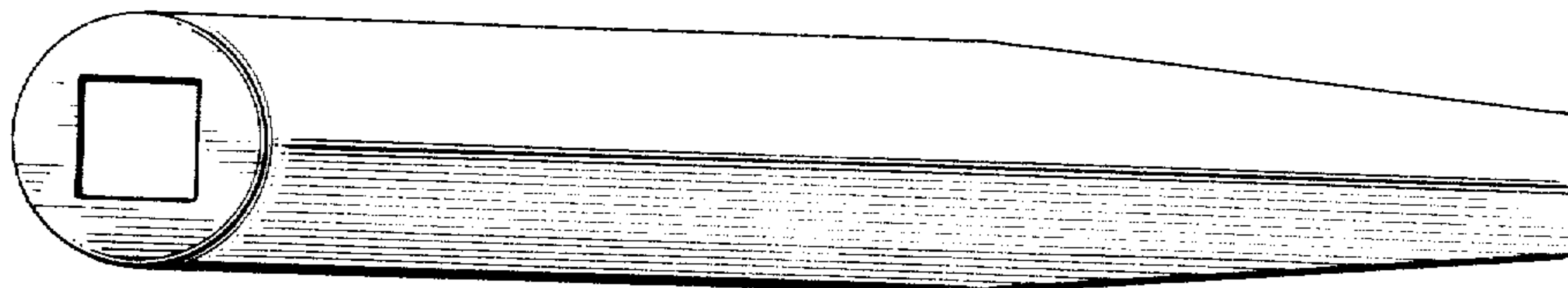

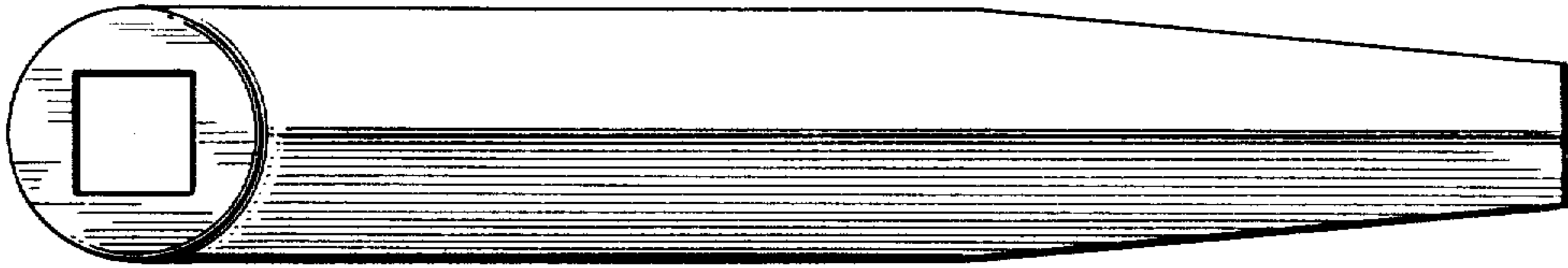

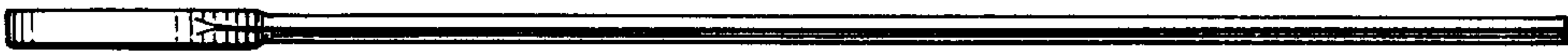

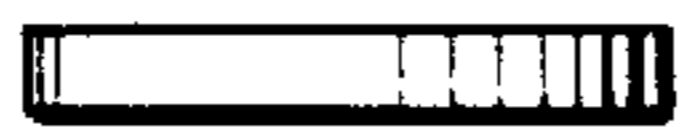
