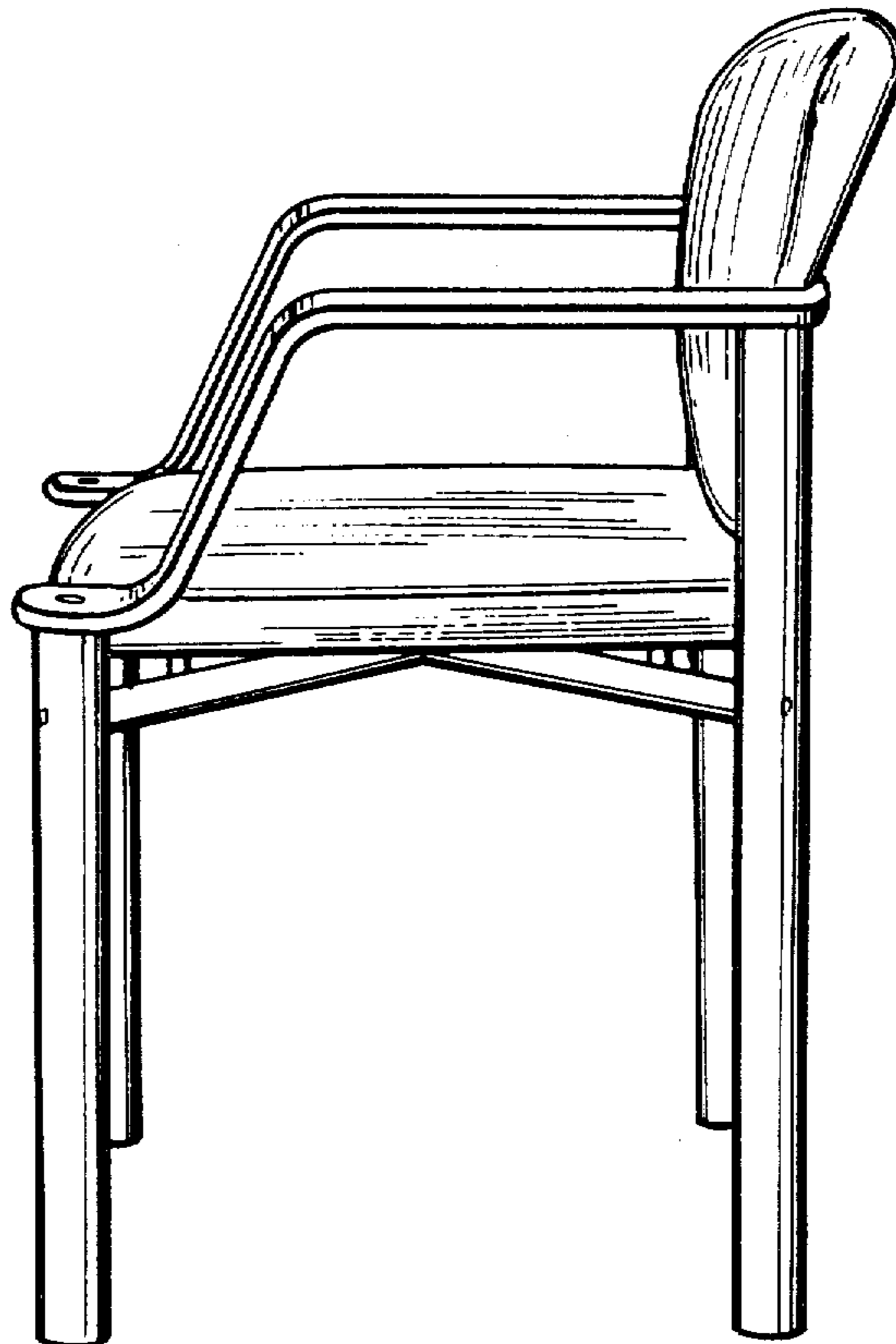

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an armchair showing my design;
 FIG. 2 is a side perspective view;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side disclosed in FIG. 2.



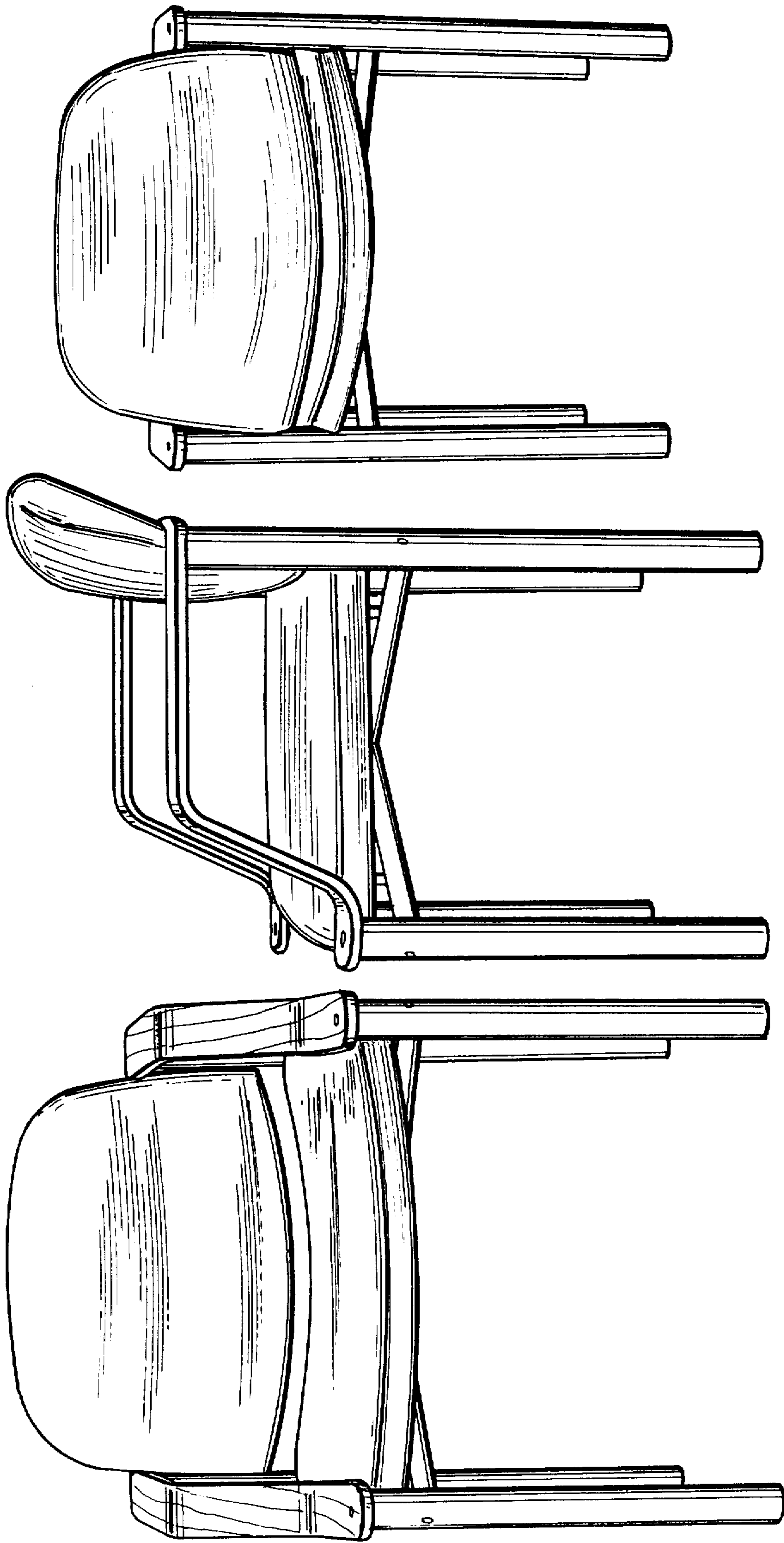

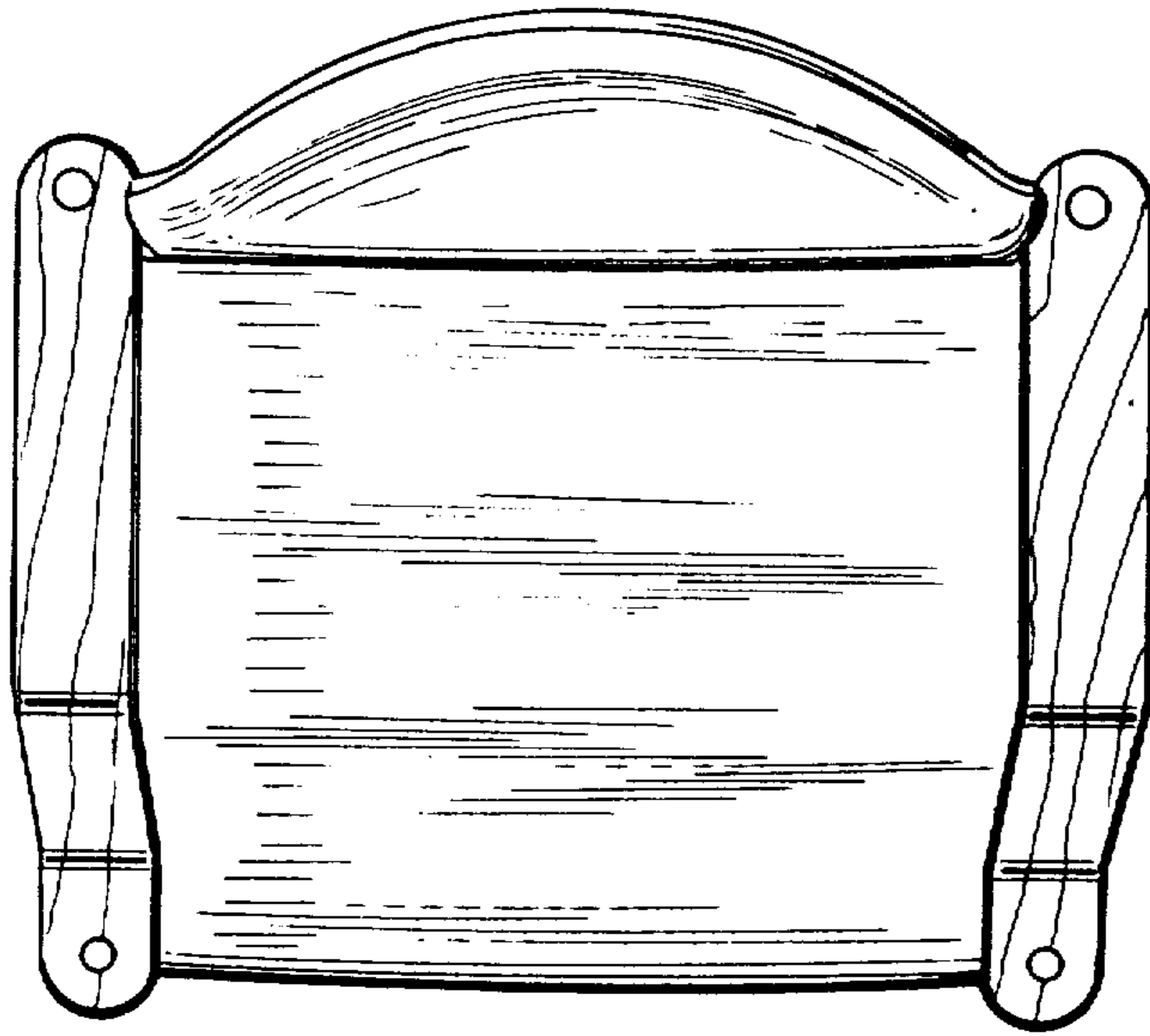

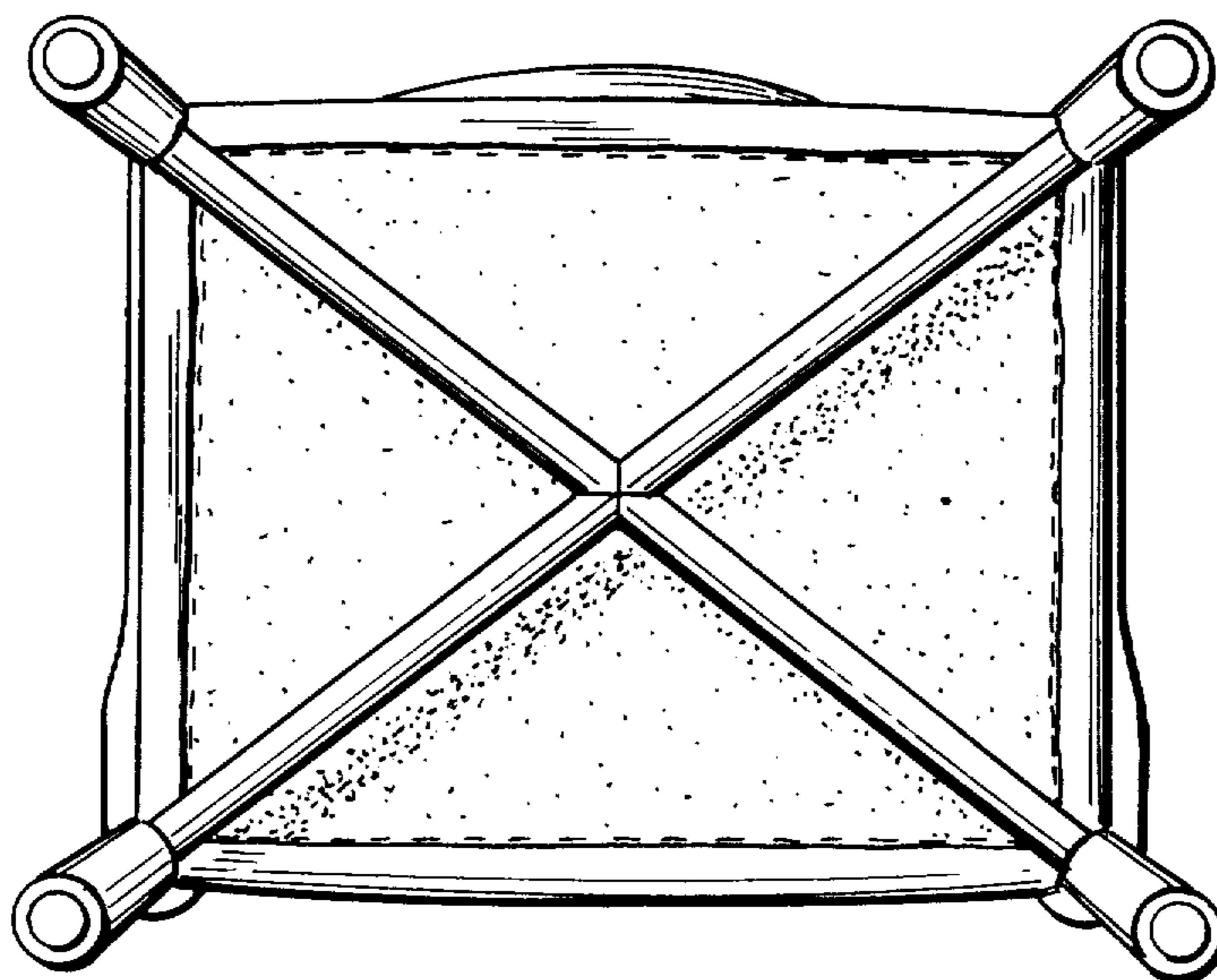
