FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a view similar to FIG. 1 with the cover in raised position.




