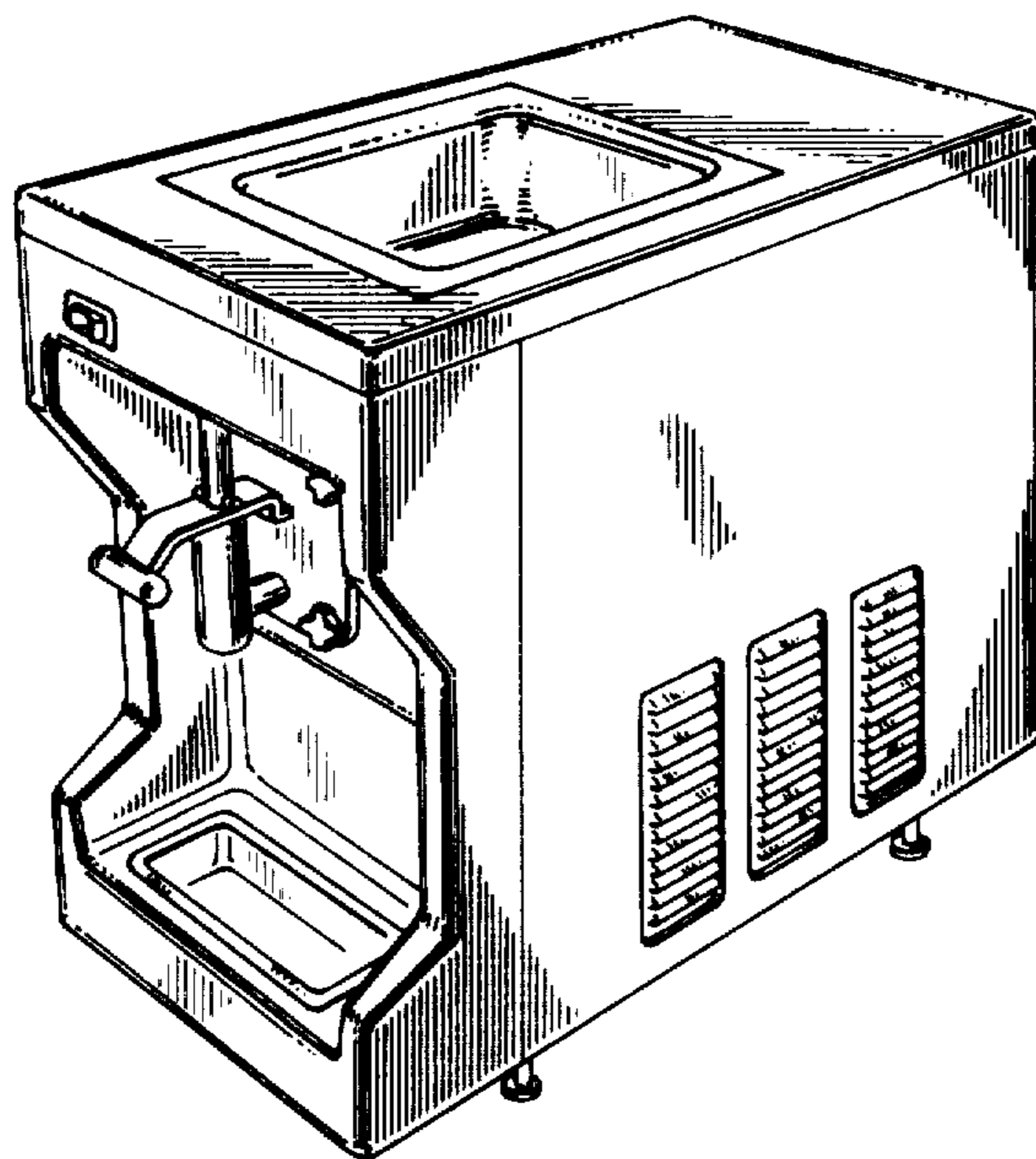

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a housing for a soft ice cream machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a housing for a soft ice cream machine showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view; the right side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



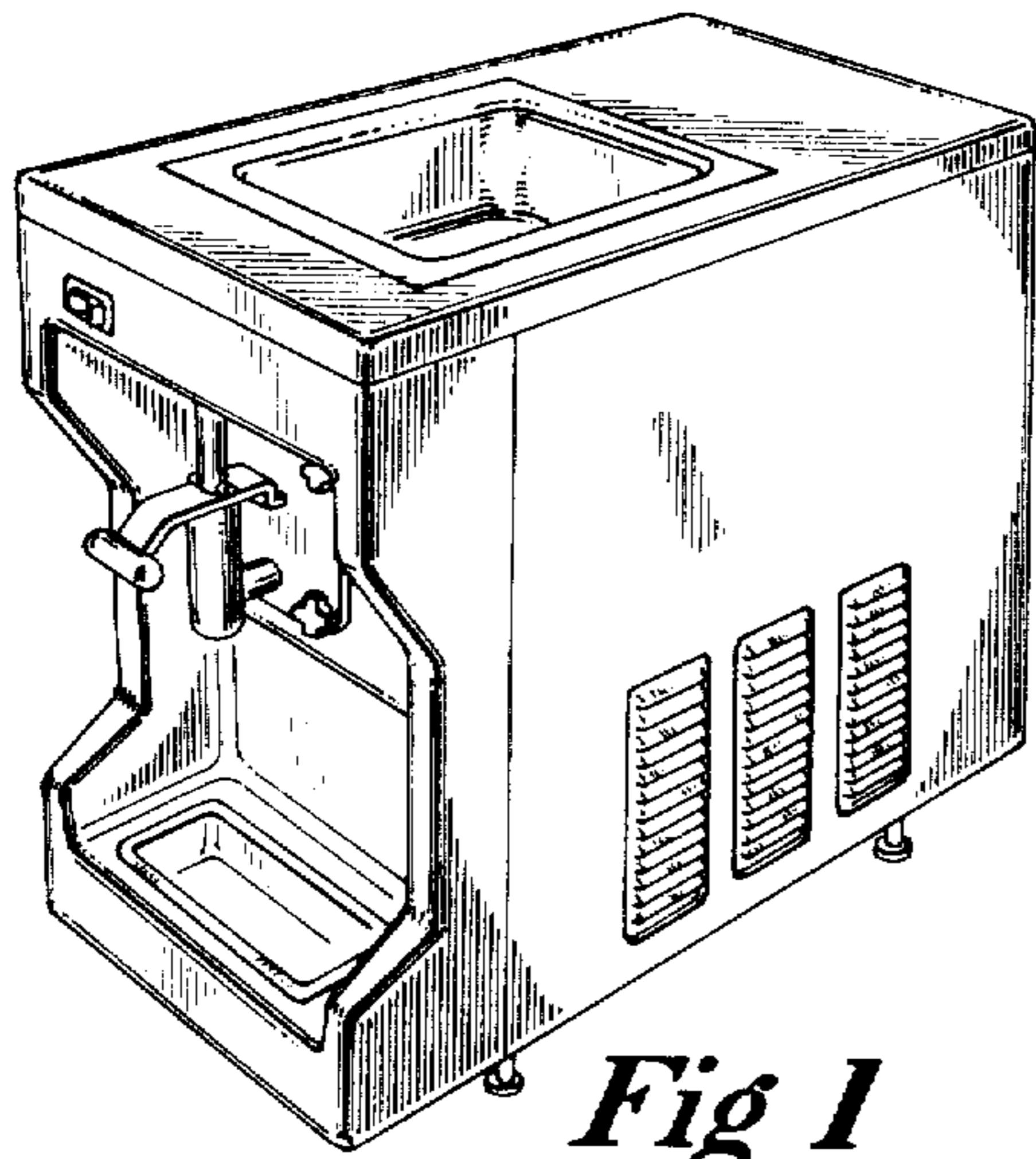

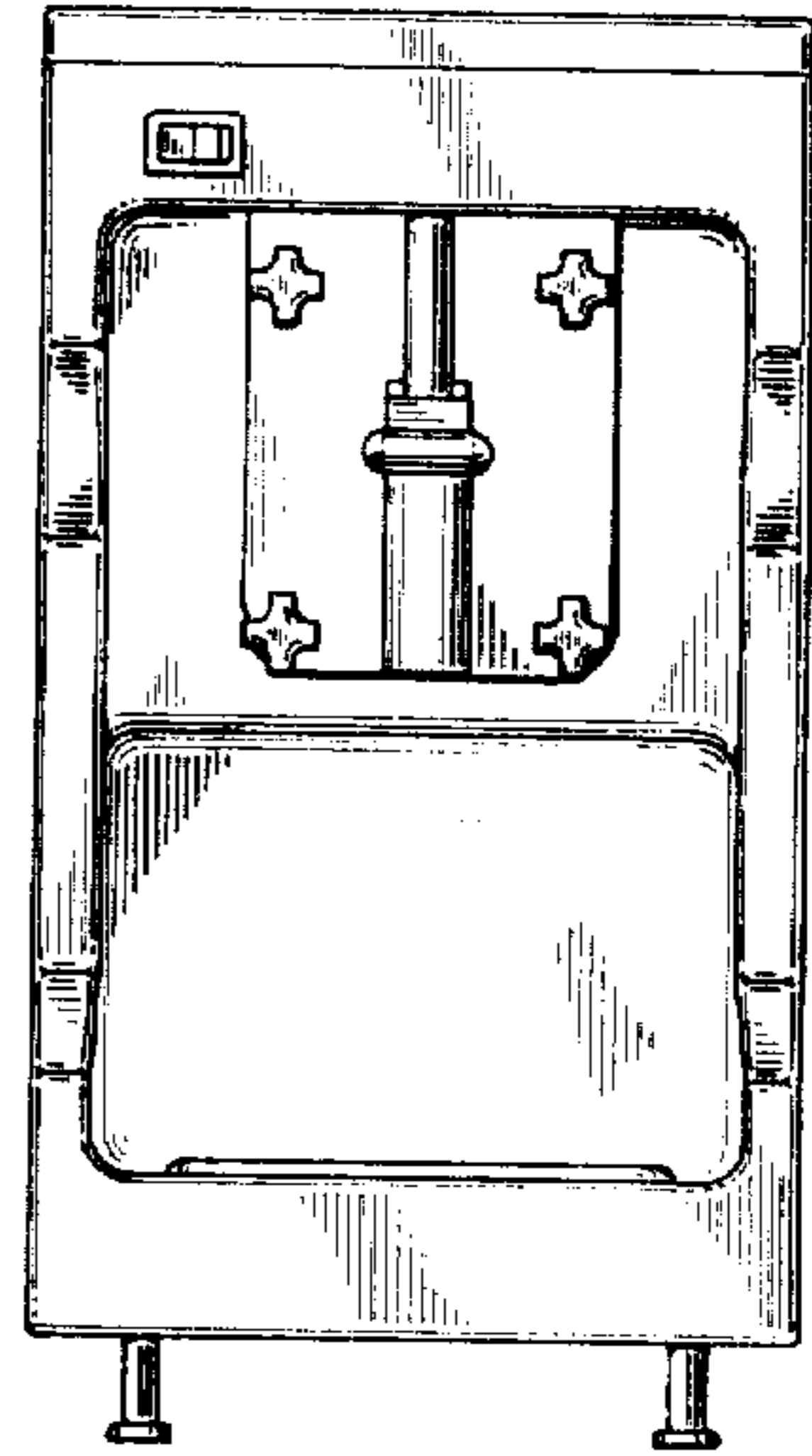

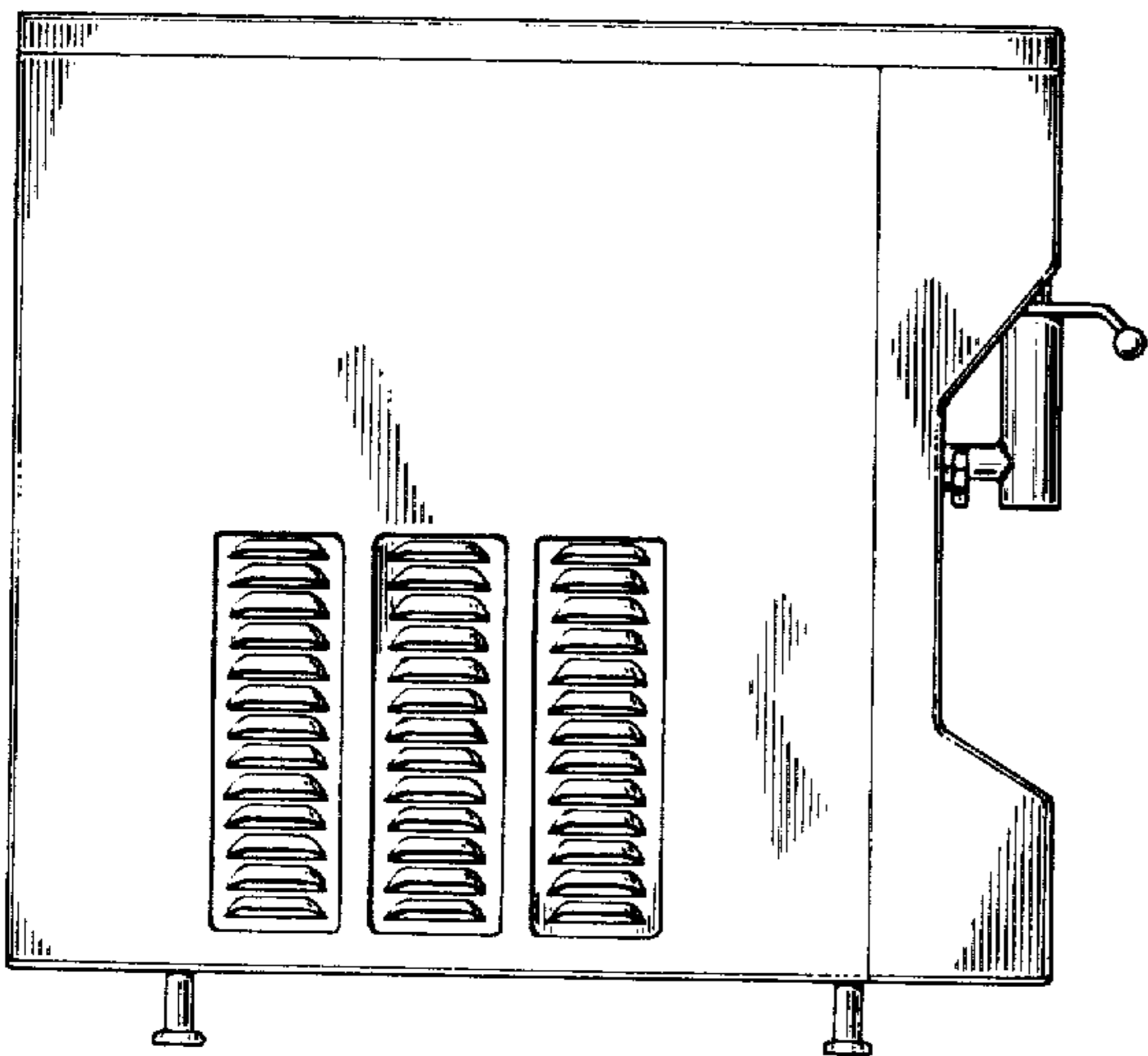

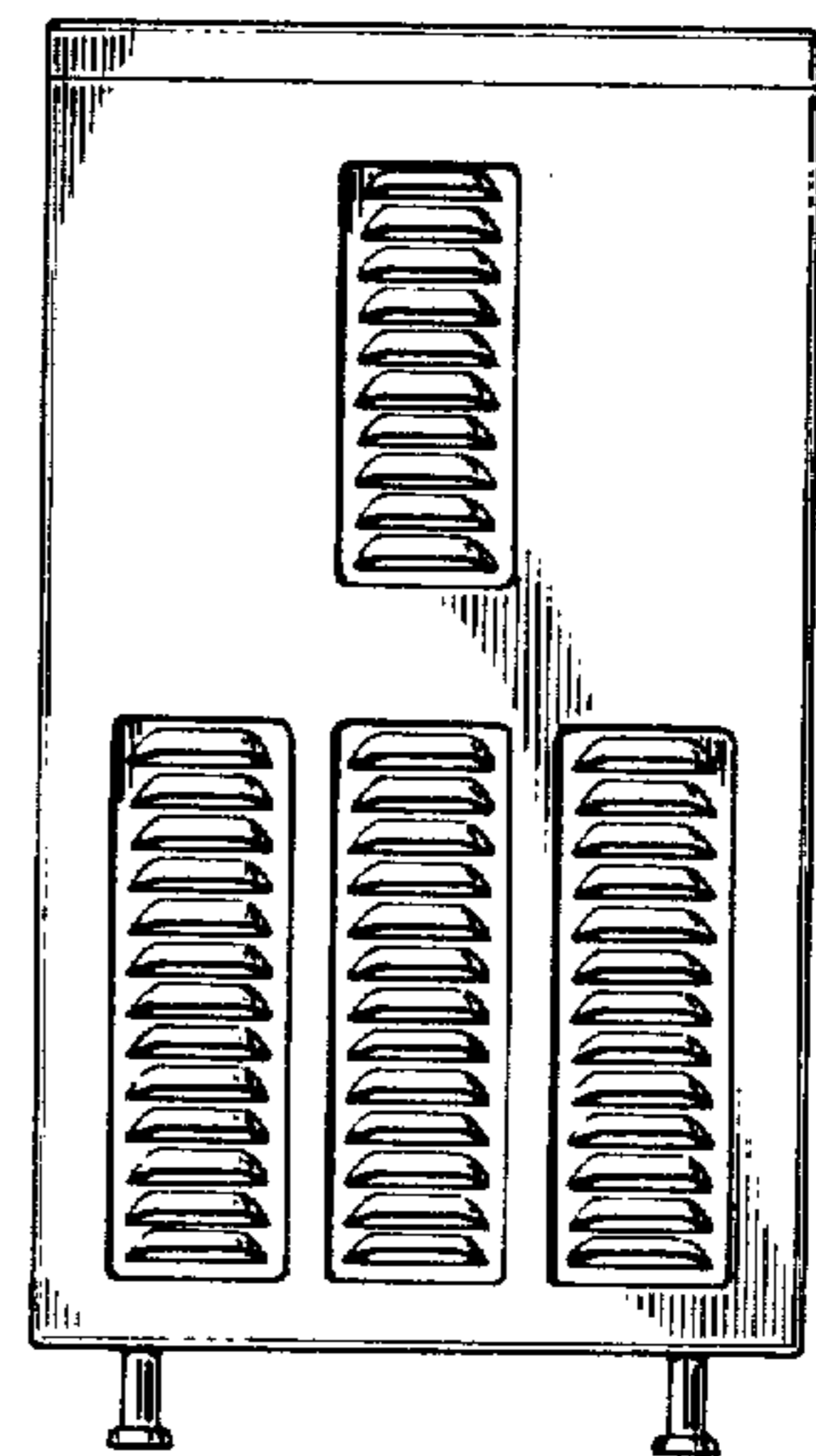

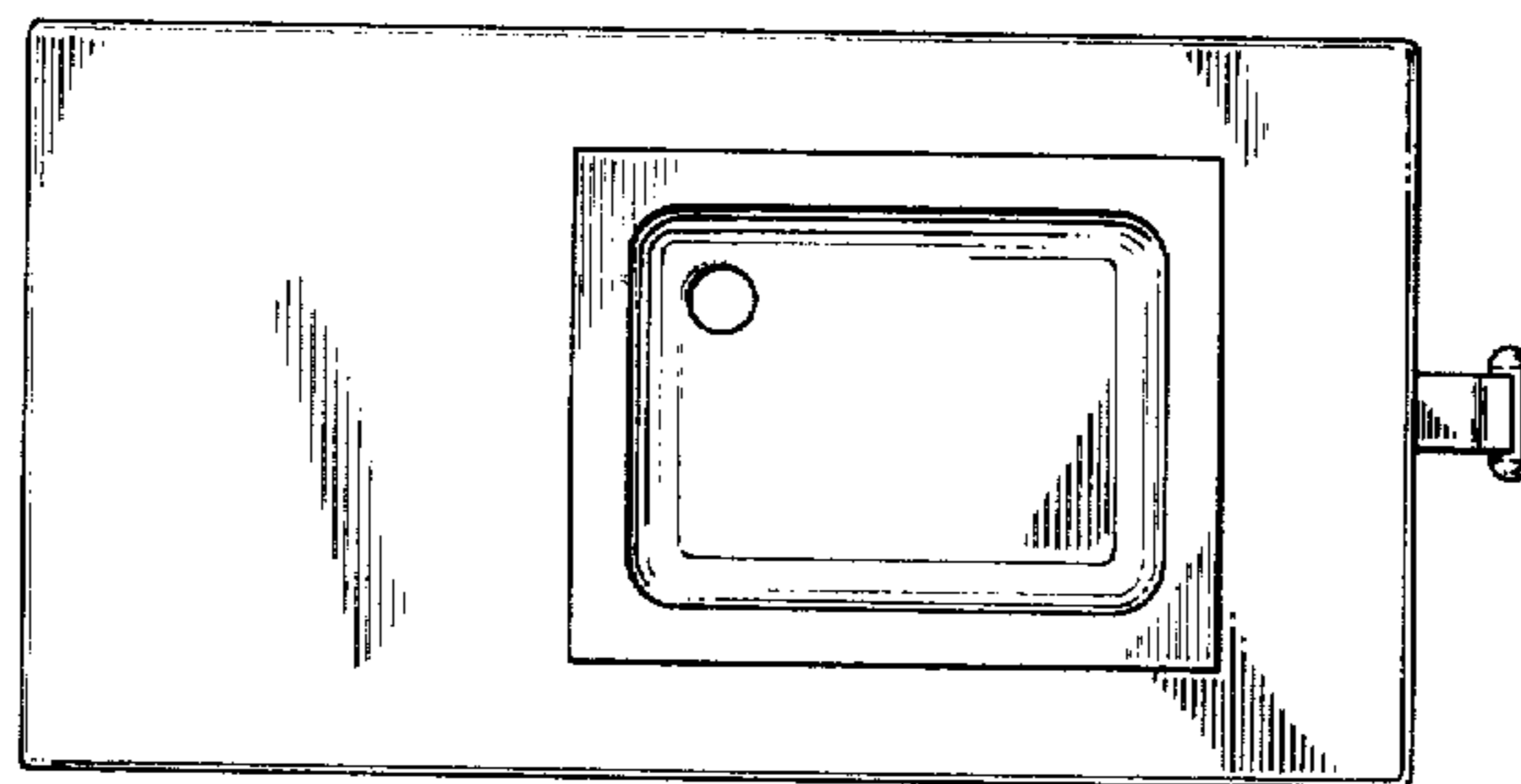
