DESCRIPTION

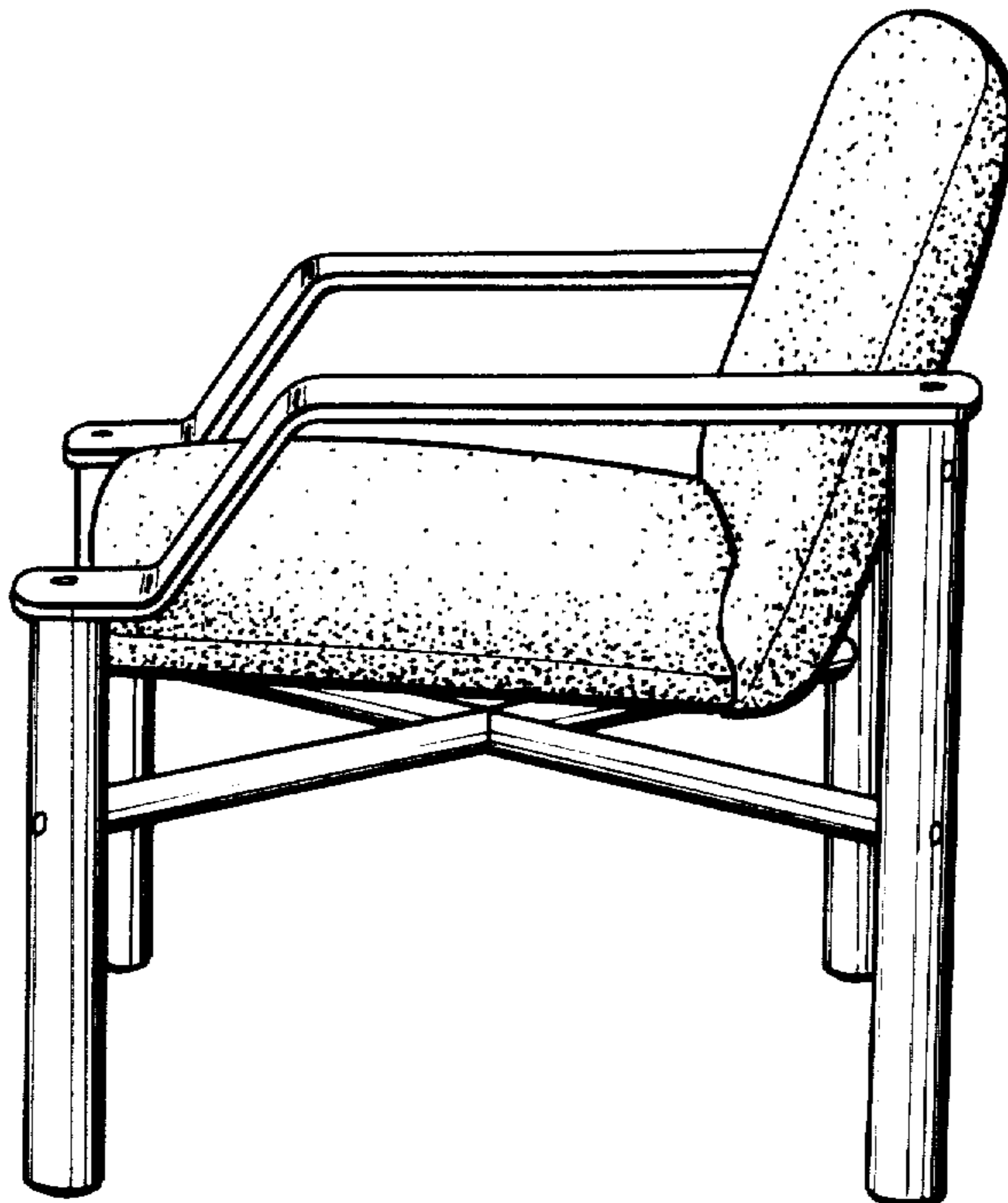
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an armchair showing my design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the armchair.



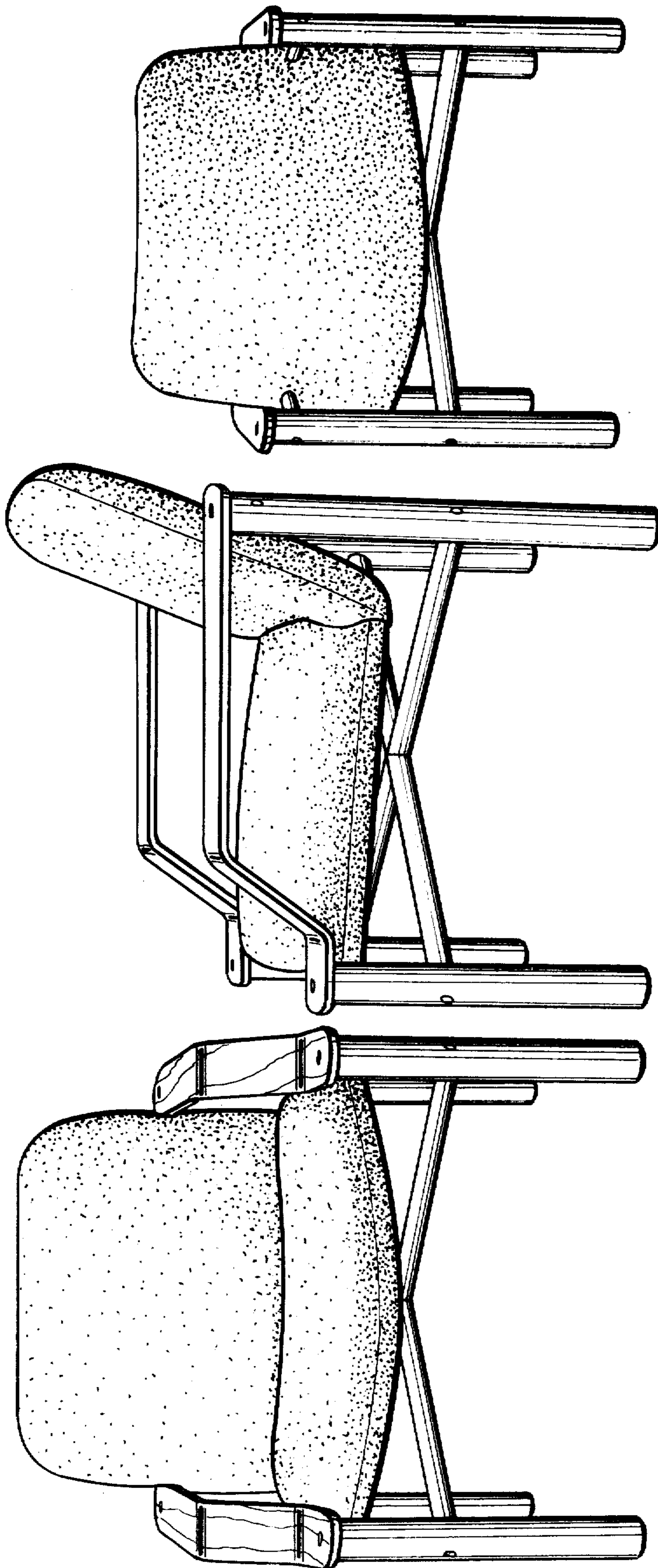

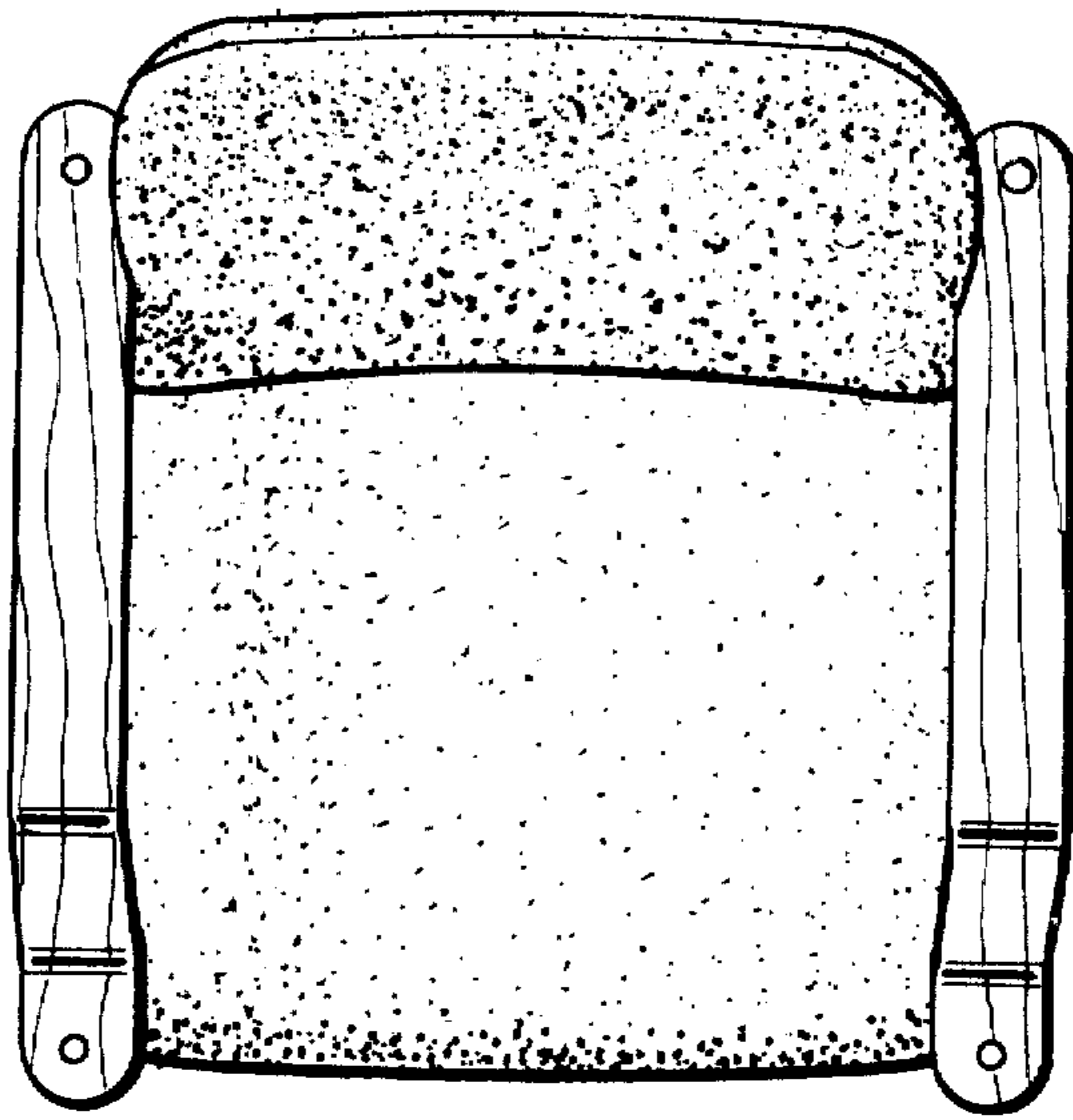

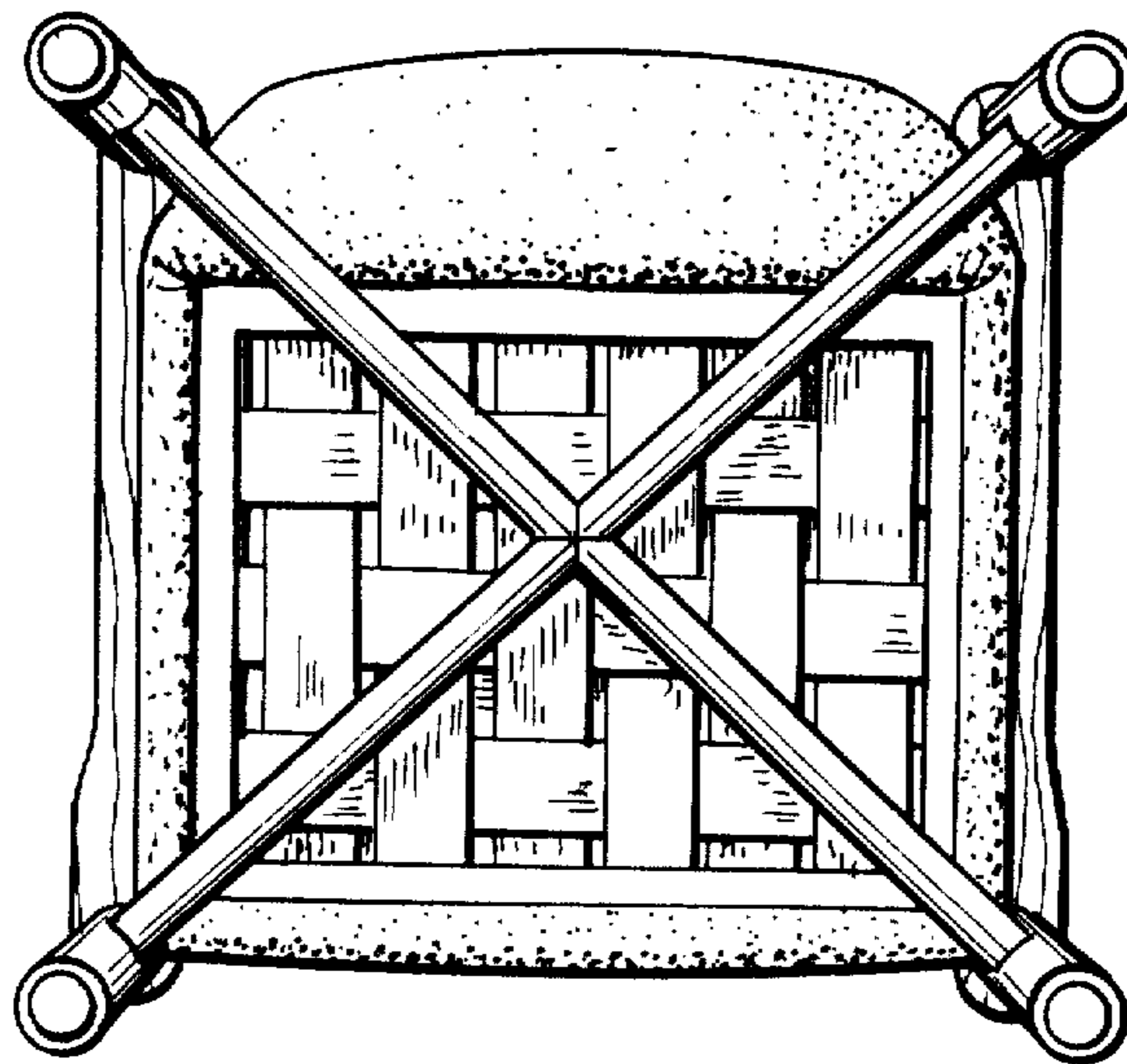
