[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a triple dresser or similar article, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a triple dresser or similar article showing my new design;

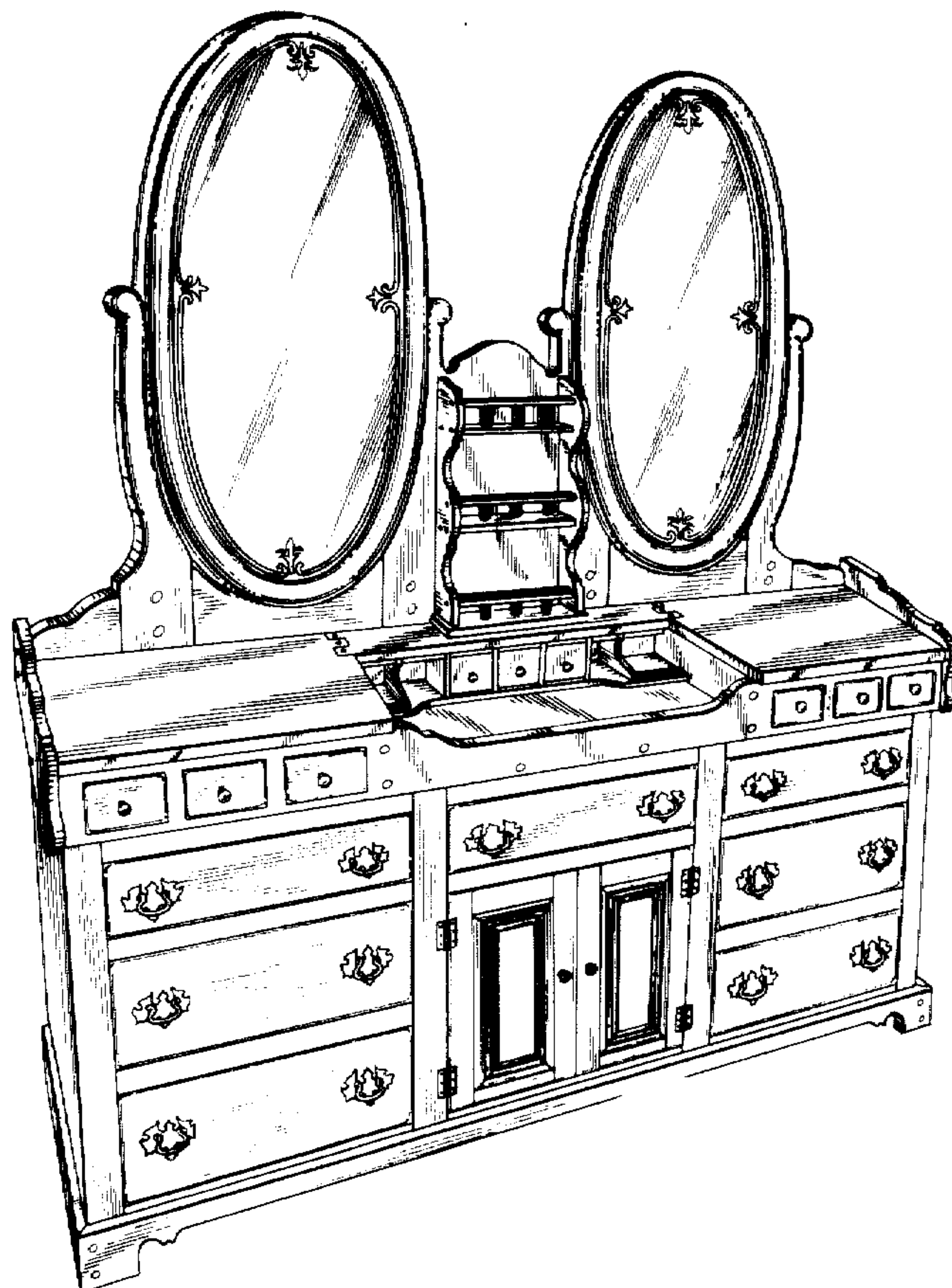
FIG. 2 is a top elevational view of the design of FIG. 1, drawn to a reduced scale;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the design of FIG. 1, drawn to a reduced scale.



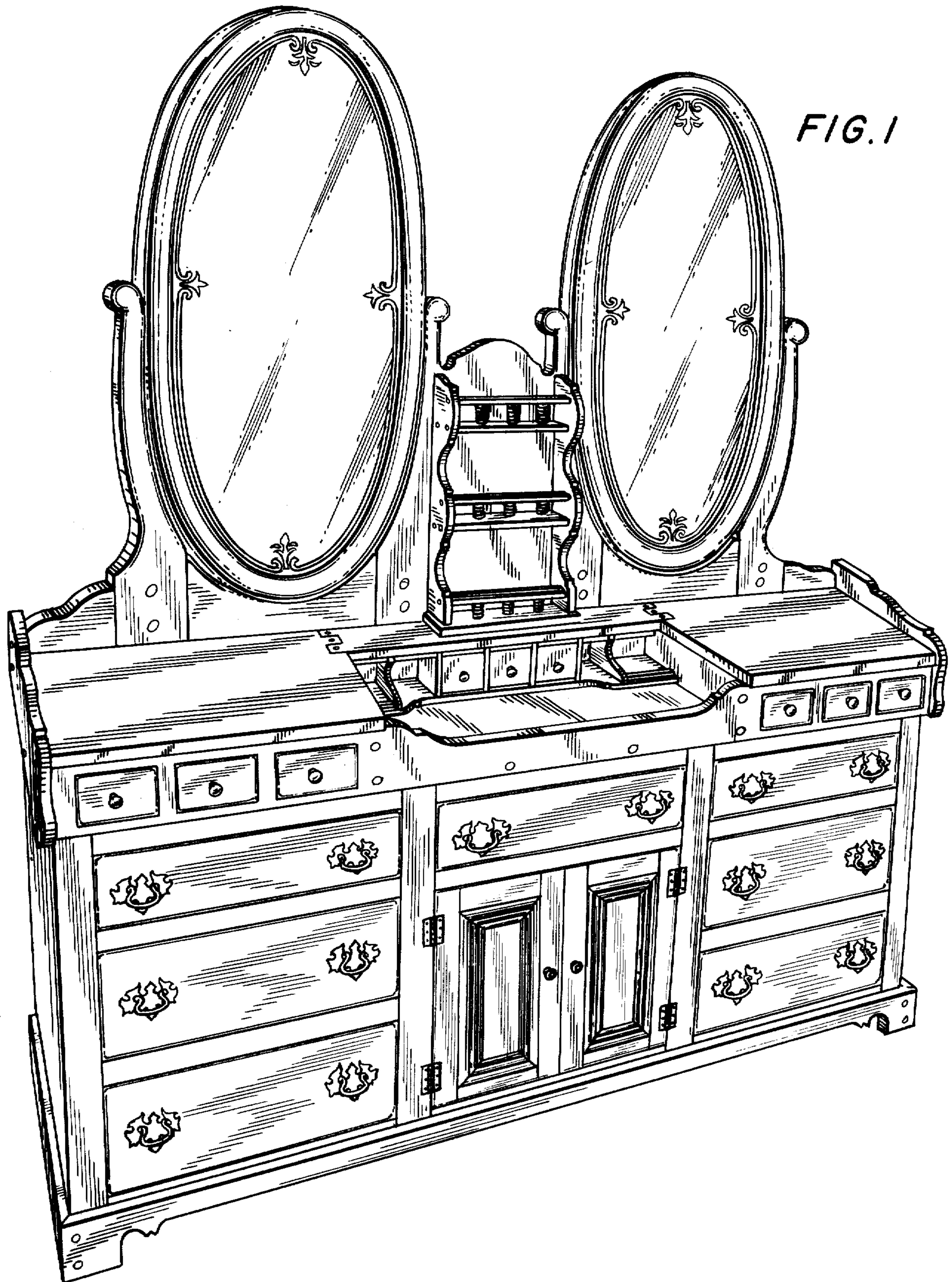

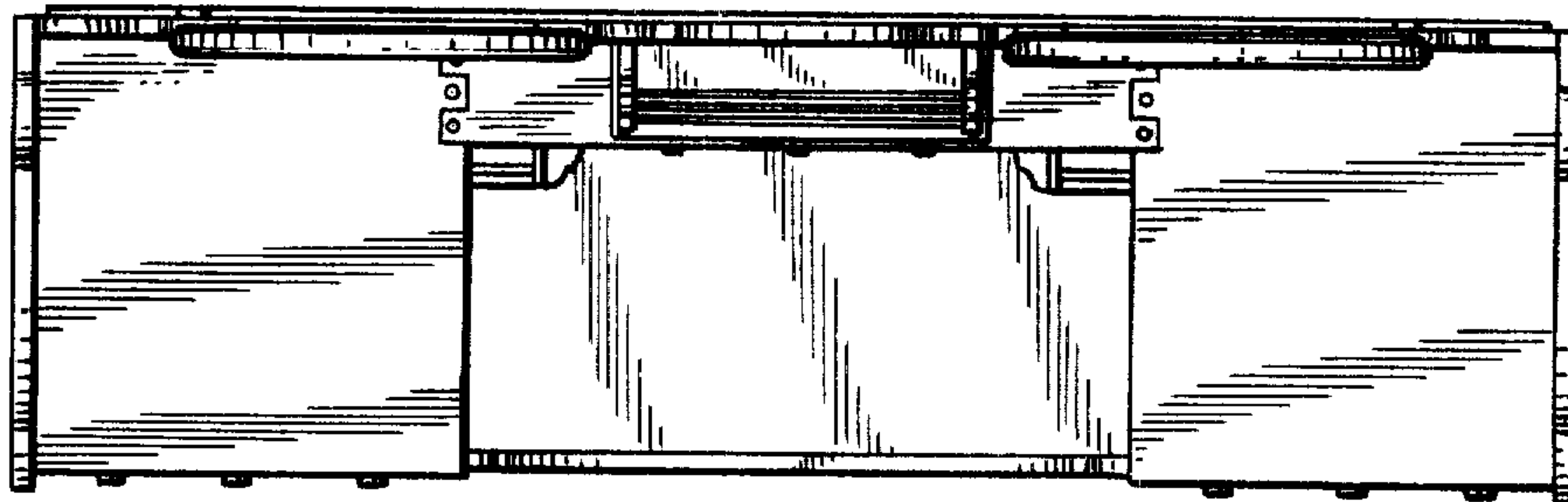
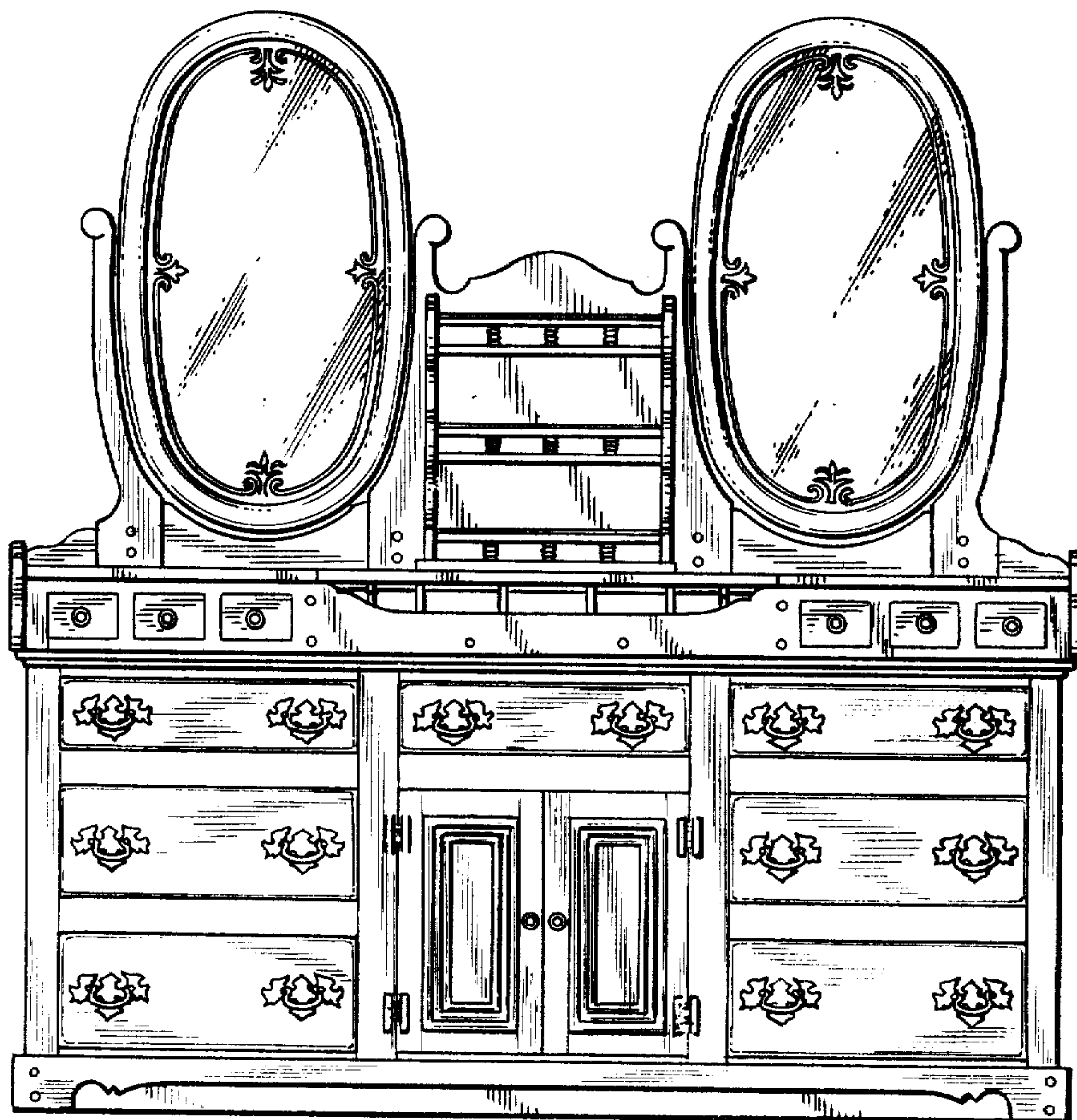

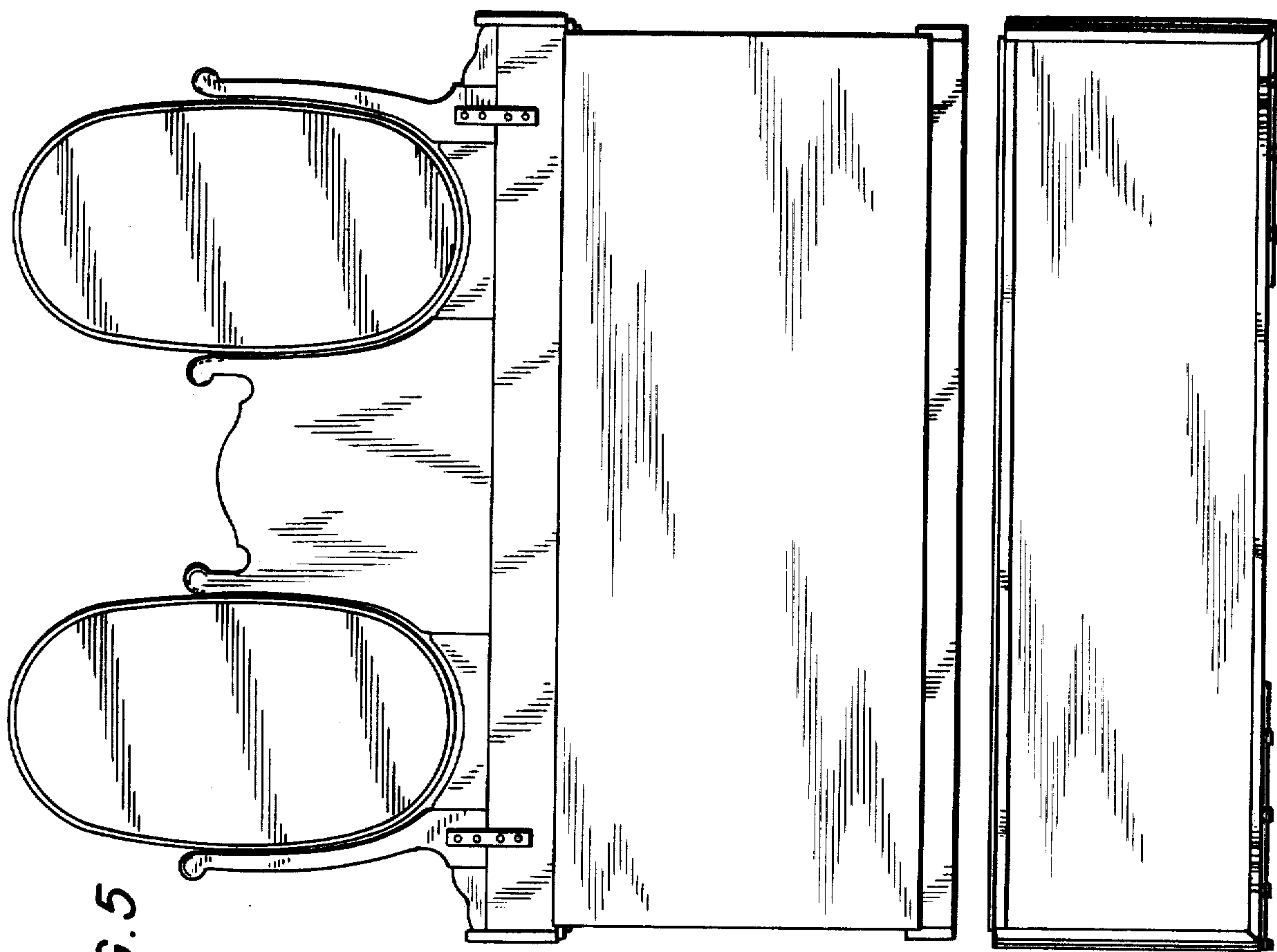

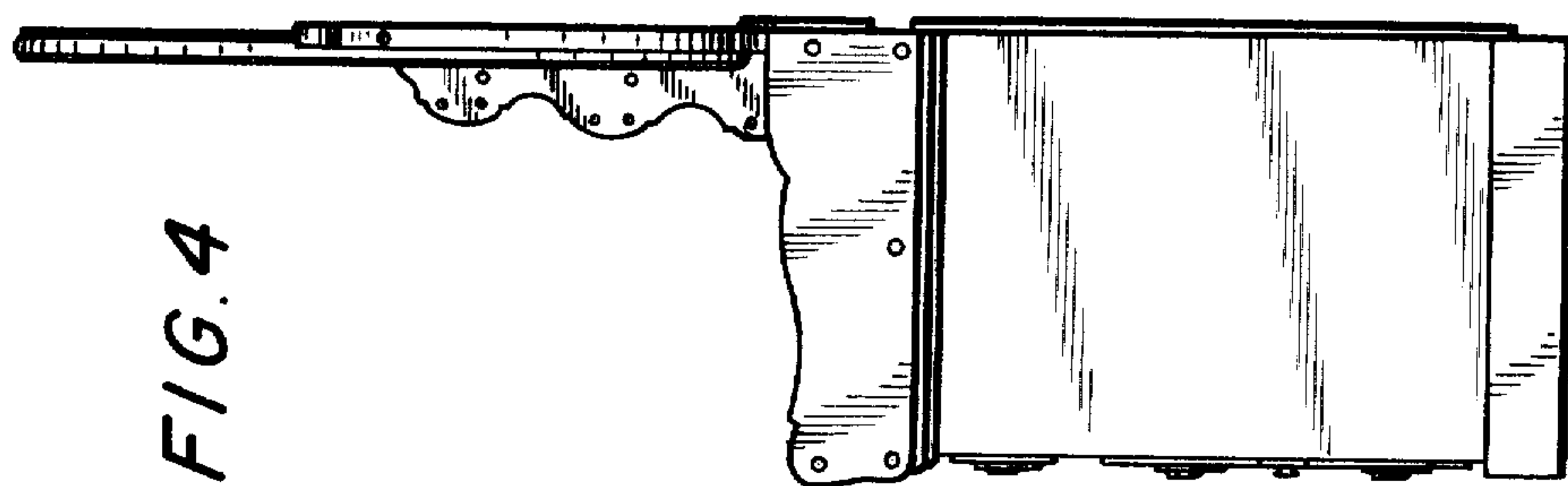
