FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a triple dresser or similar article showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a top elevational view of the design of FIG. 1, drawn to a reduced scale;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the design of FIG. 1, drawn to a reduced scale;


FIG. 4 is a side elevation of the design of FIG. 1, drawn to a reduced scale;

FIG. 5 is a back view of the design of FIG. 1, drawn to a reduced scale; and


FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the design of FIG. 1, drawn to a reduced scale.
