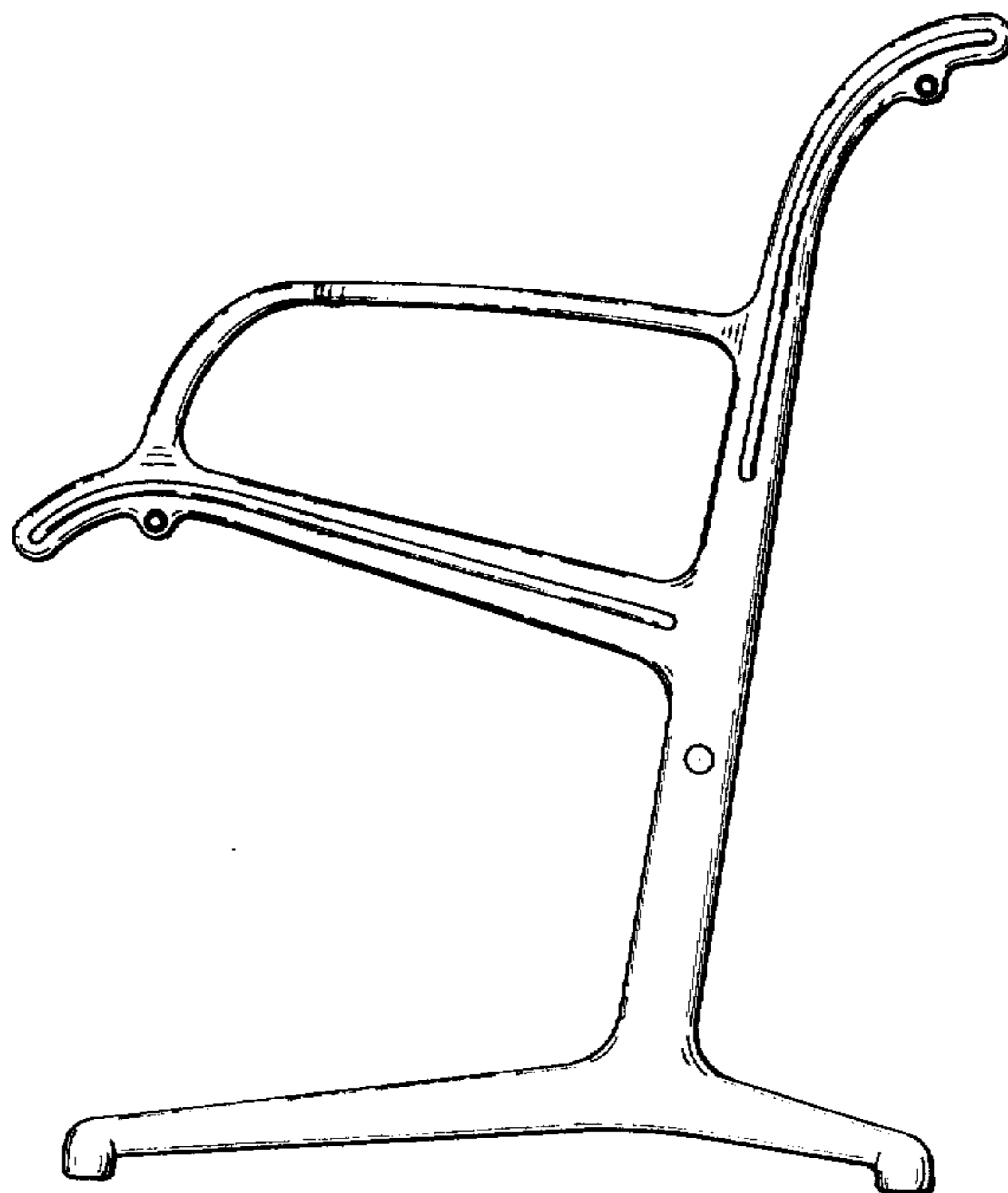

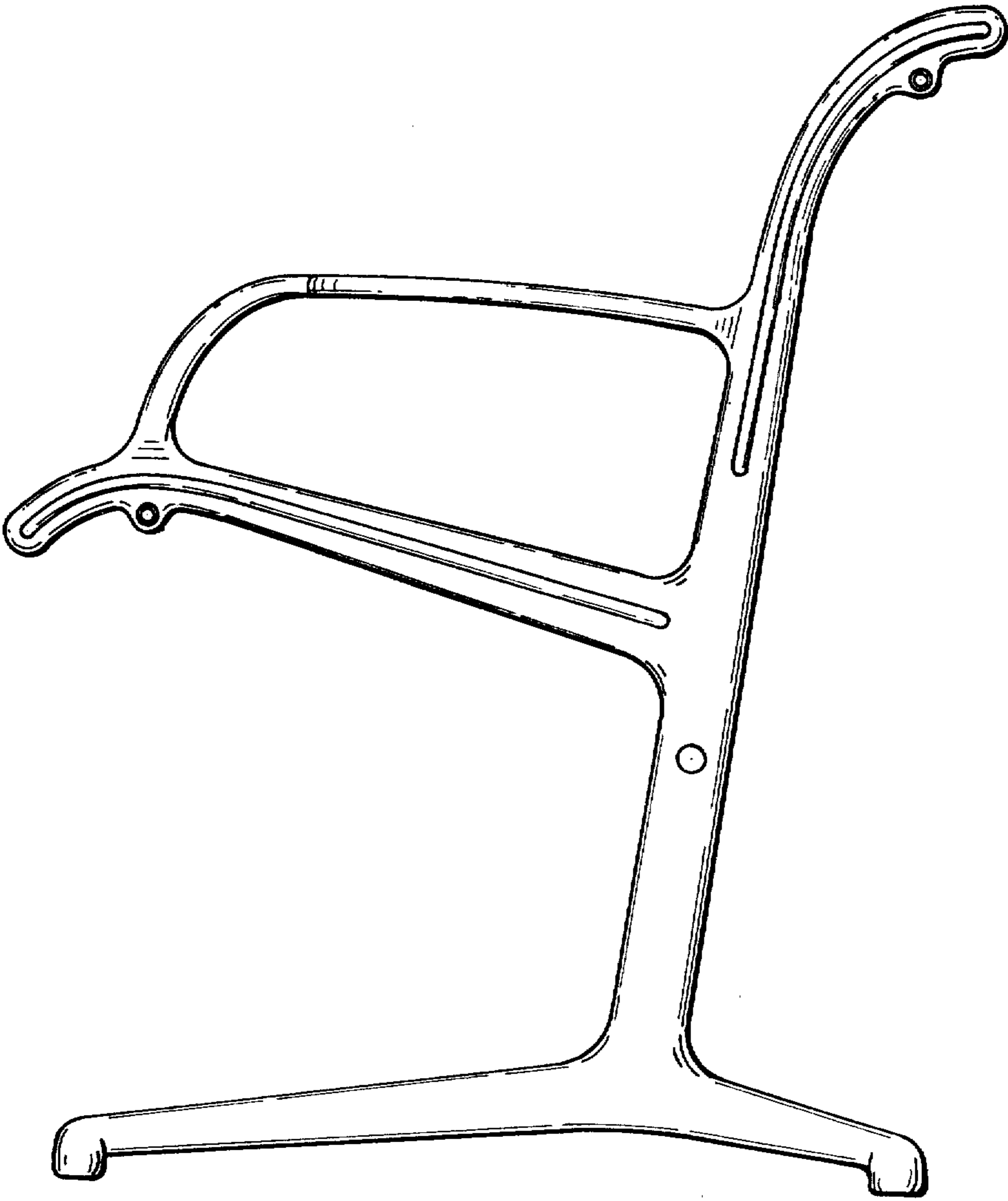
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a side frame for a chair showing my design;  
FIG. 2 is an elevation view showing the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;

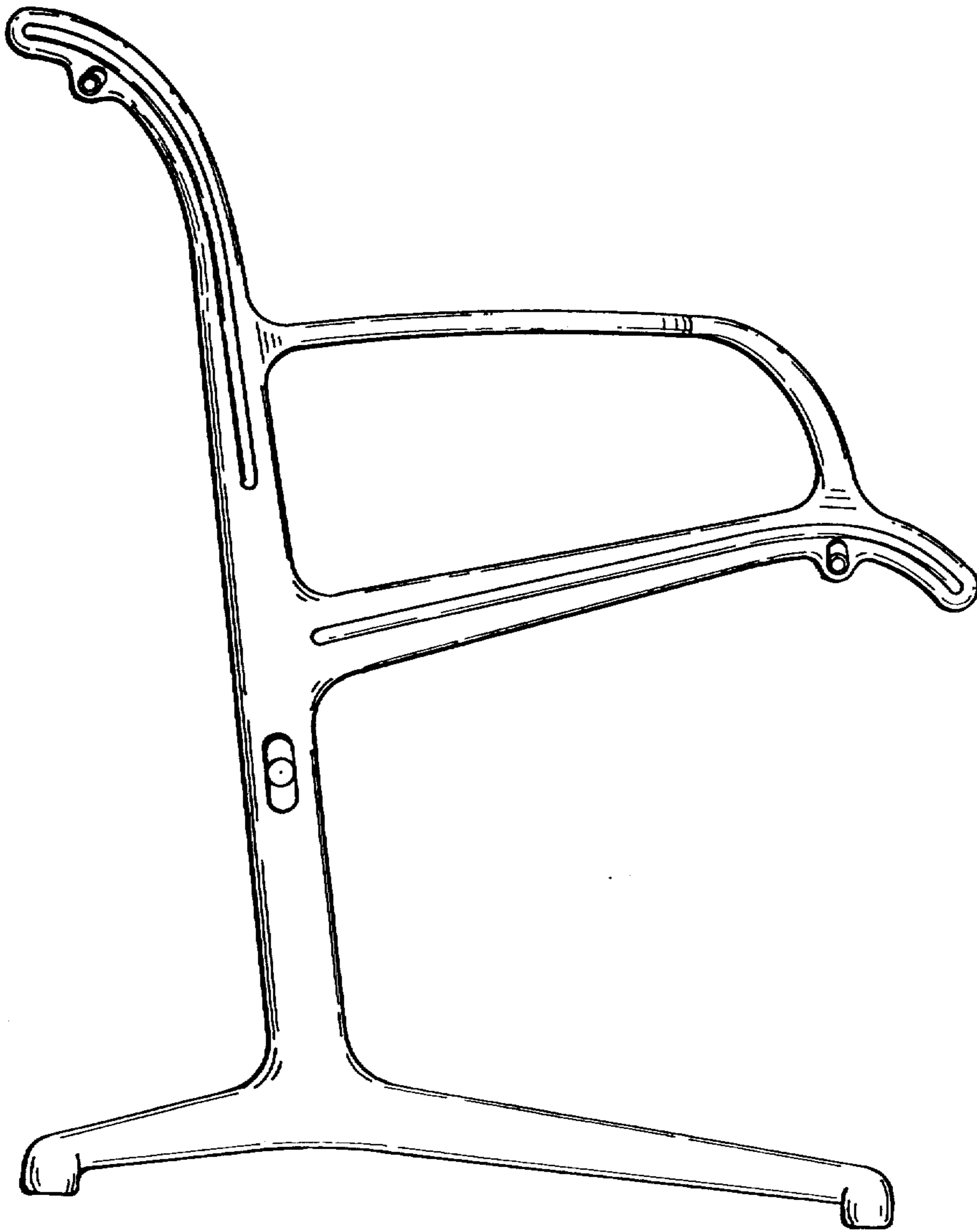

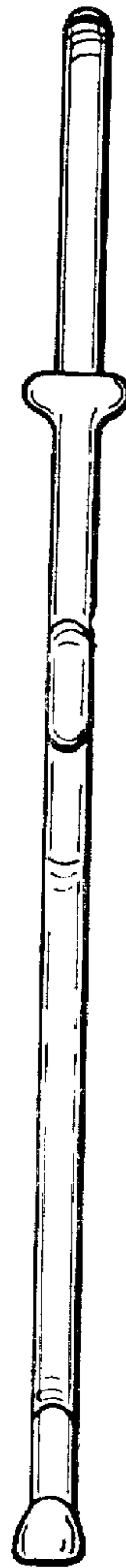
