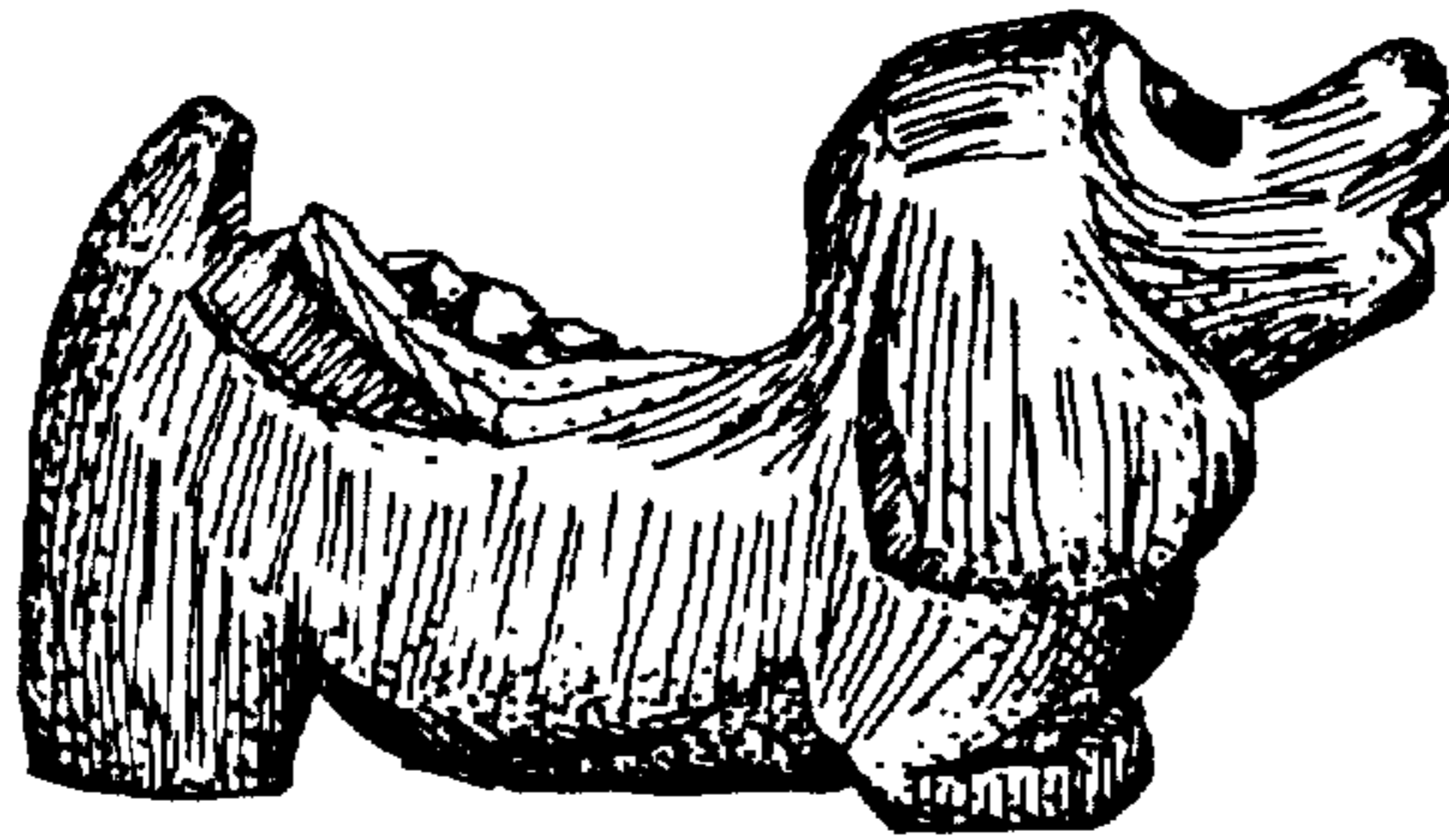

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a figurine of a dachshund pup, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front end perspective view of the figurine showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear end perspective view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1 with the other side being identical thereto; and
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.



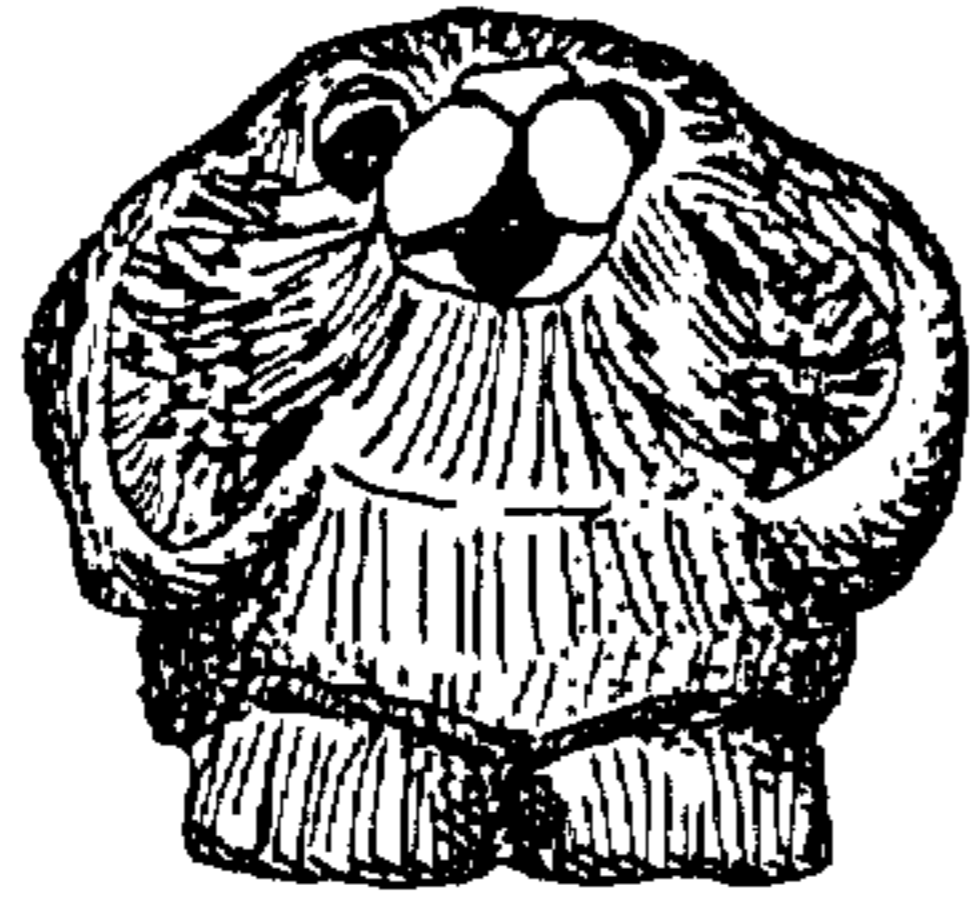

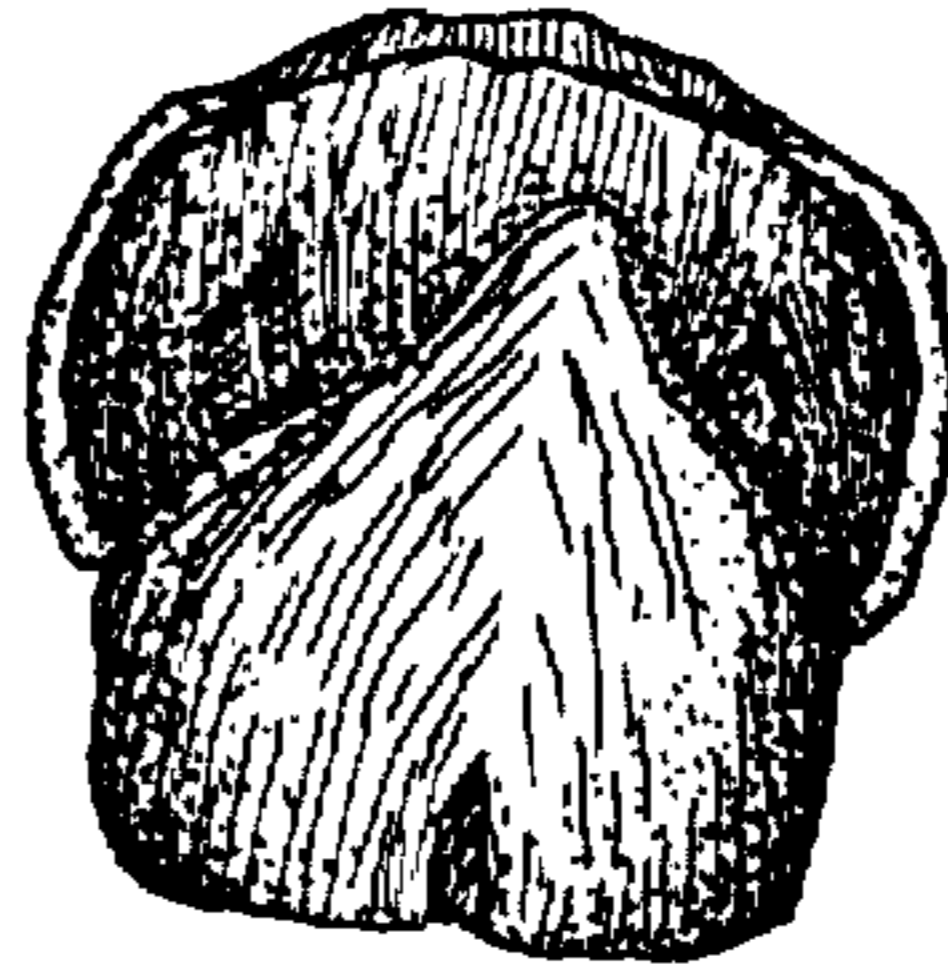

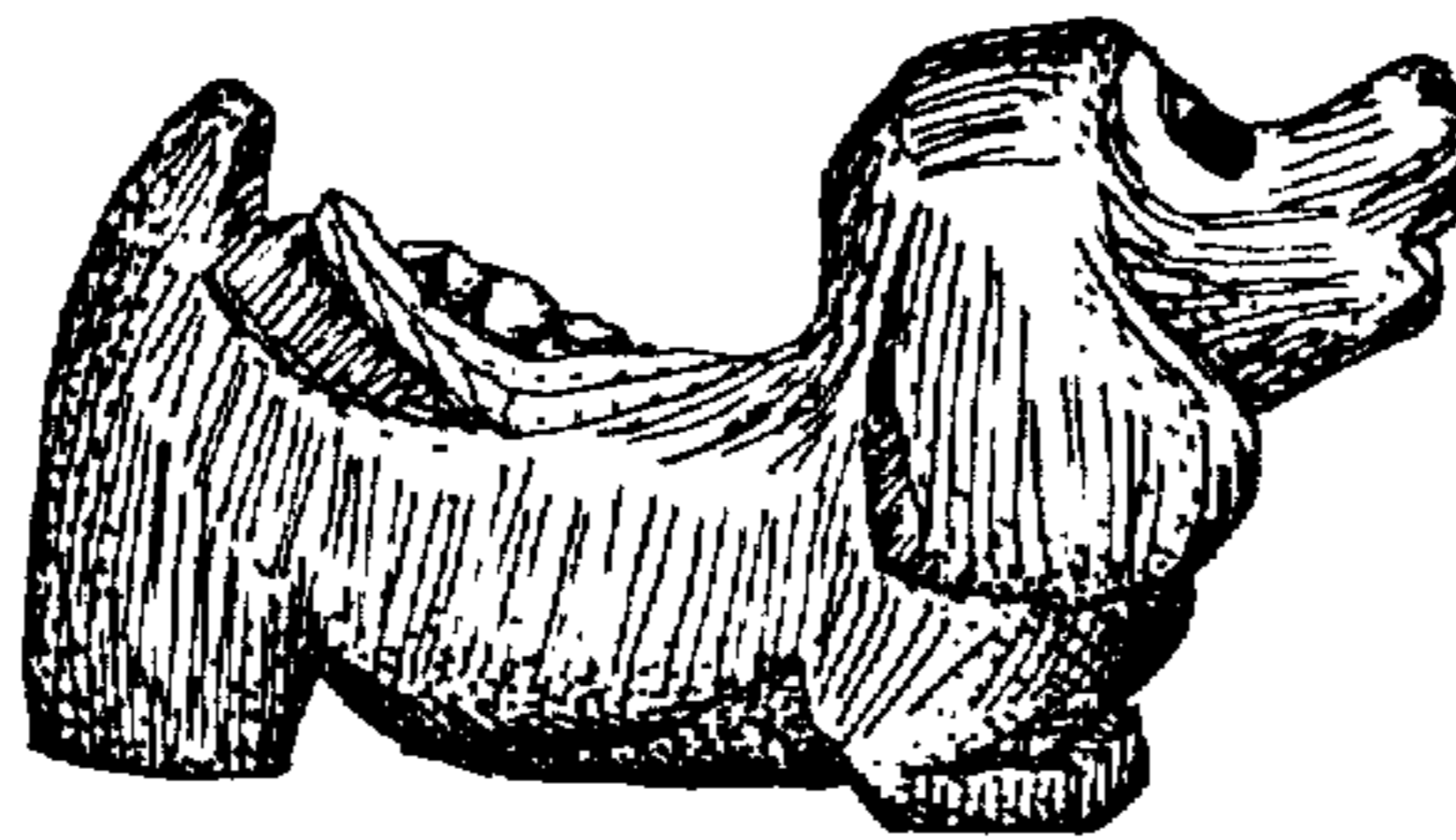

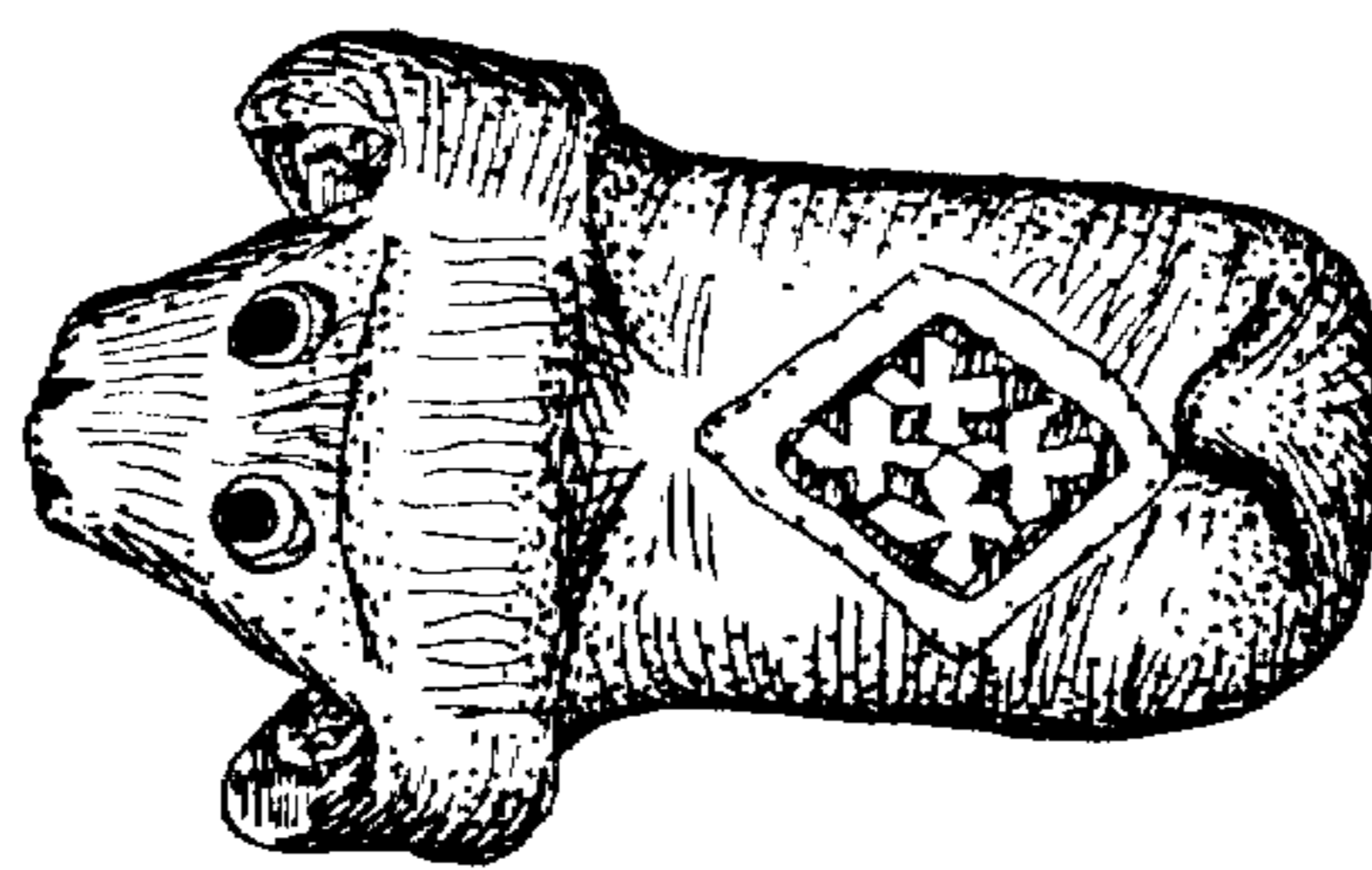
