The bottom of the boat shown in broken lines is unornamented and does not form part of the claimed design.

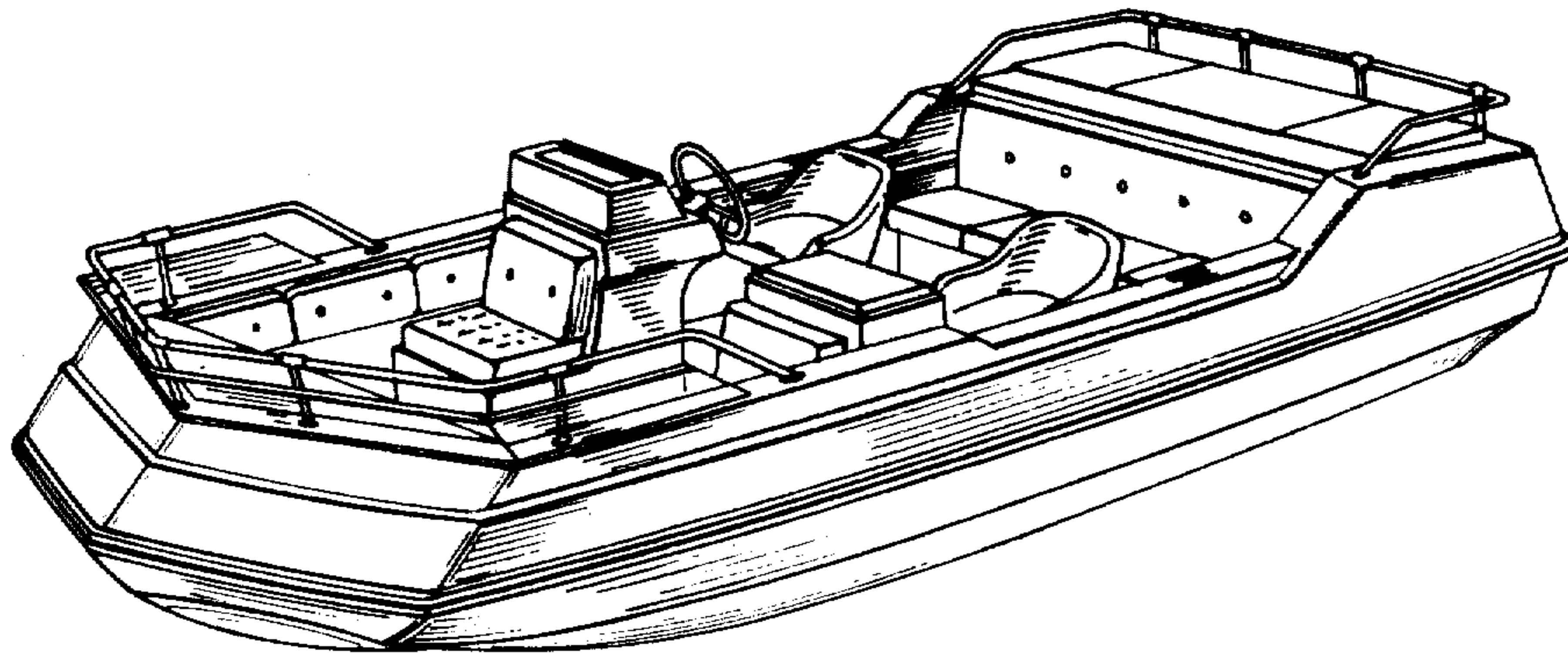

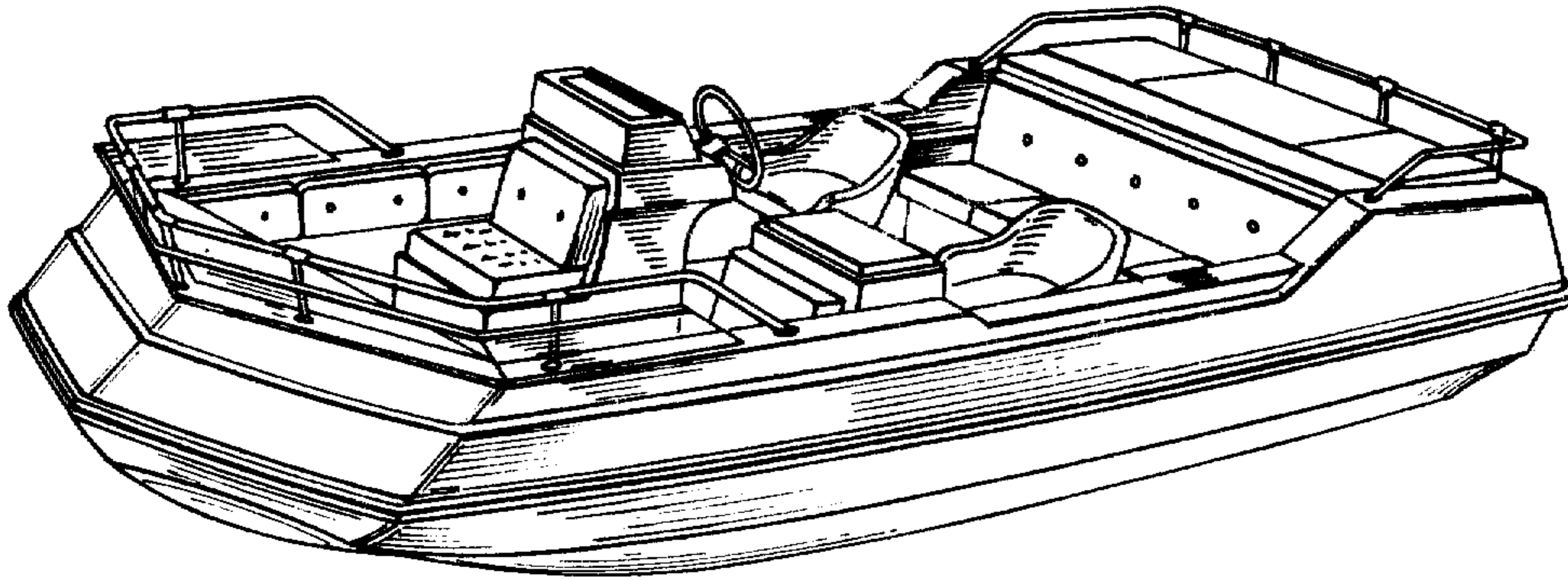

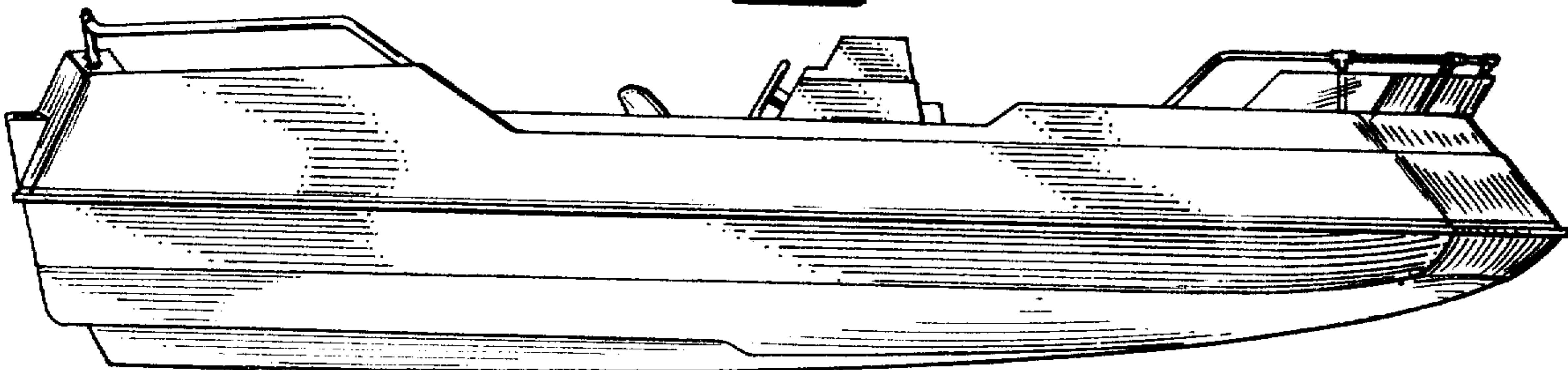

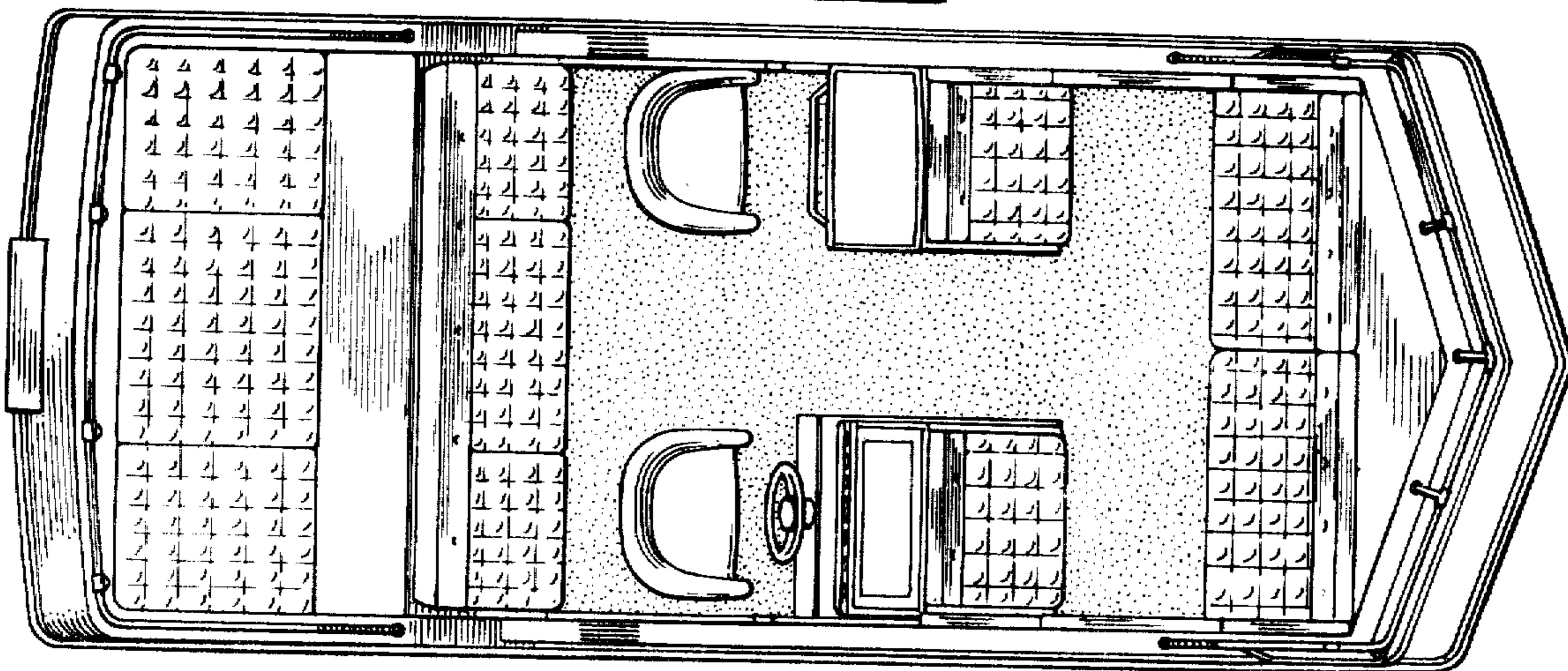

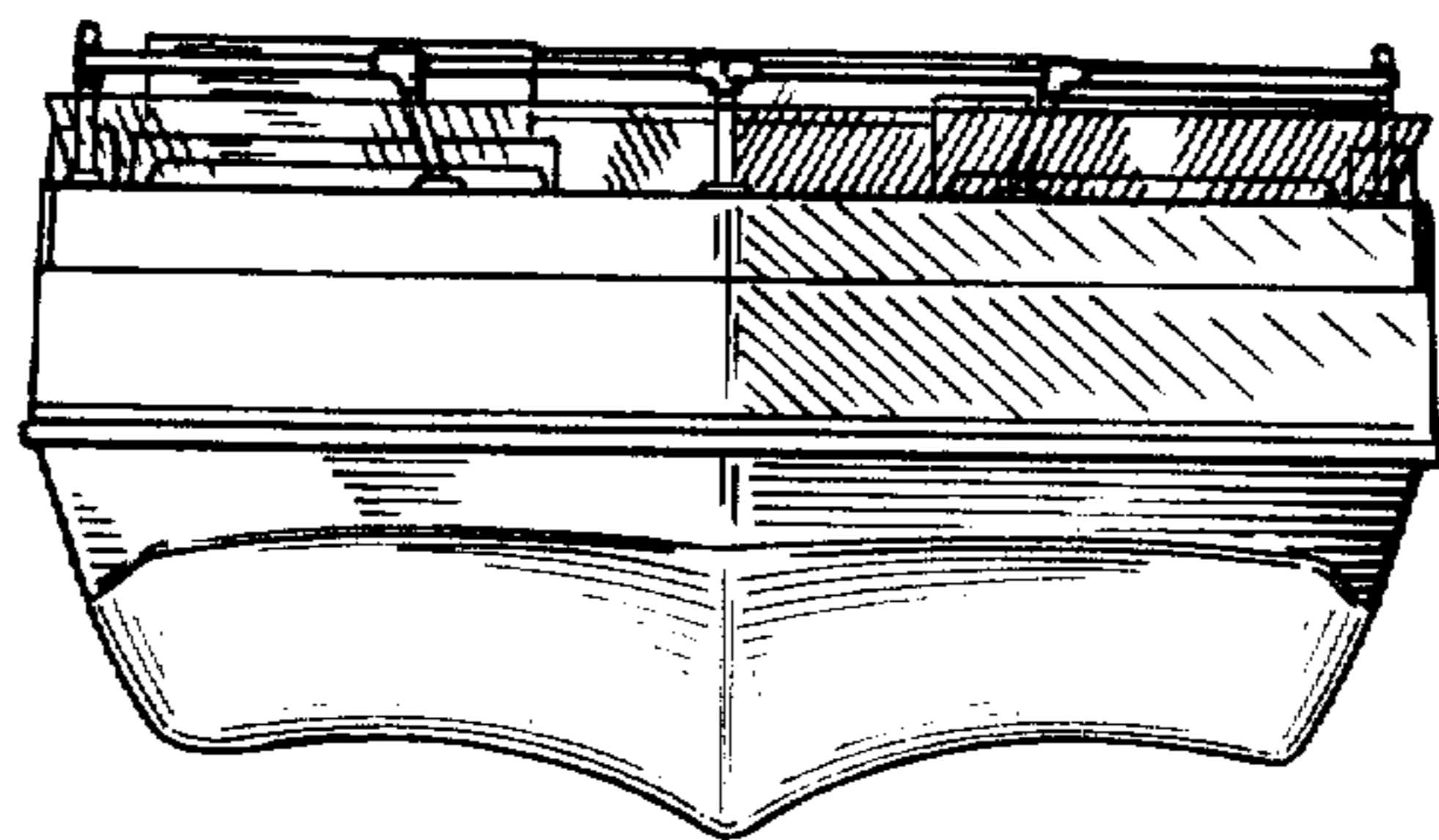
