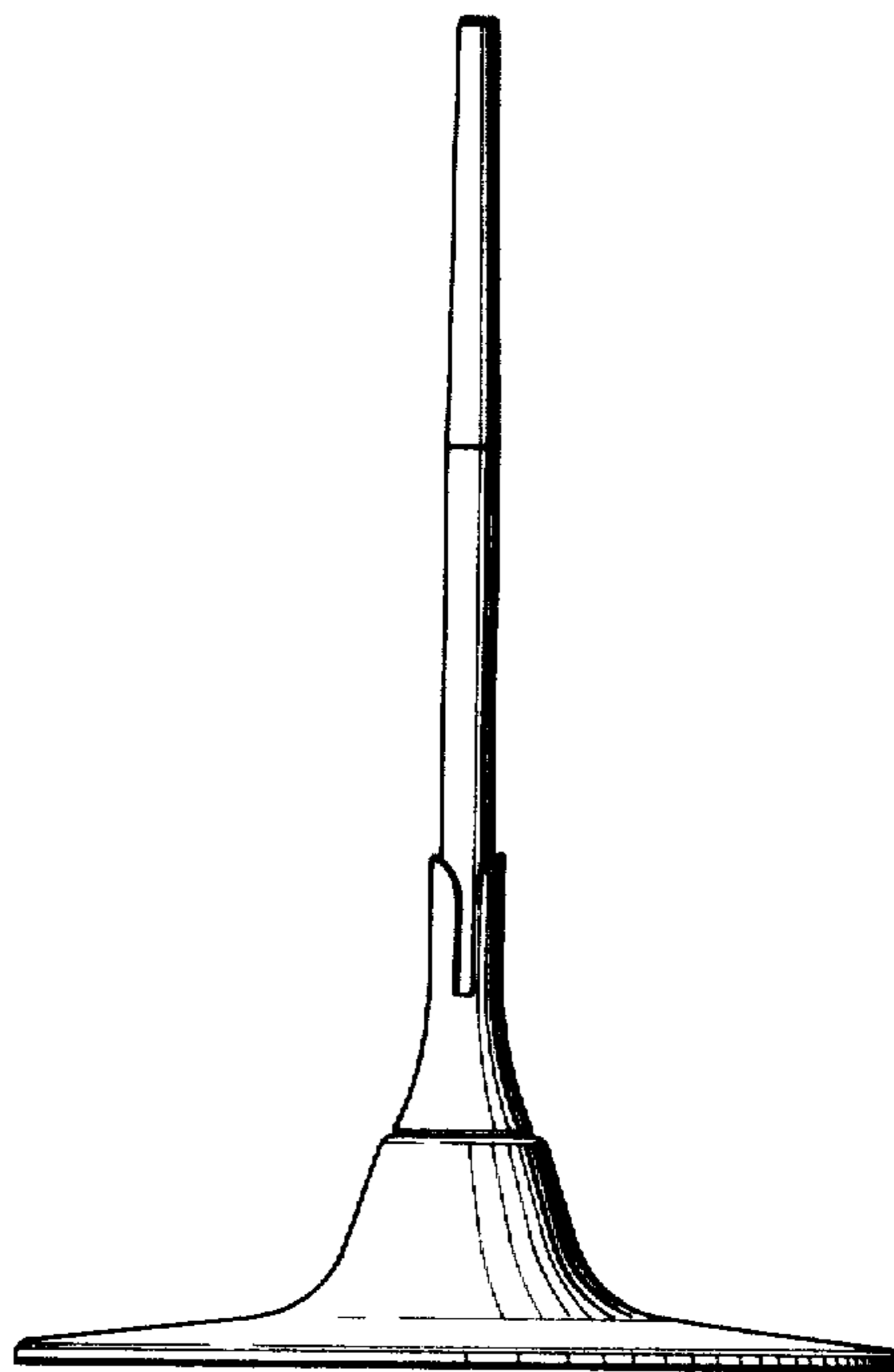

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a desk set showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is an exploded rear elevational view of the desk set; and  
 FIG. 5 is an exploded rear elevational view thereof with the holder removed from the writing instrument.



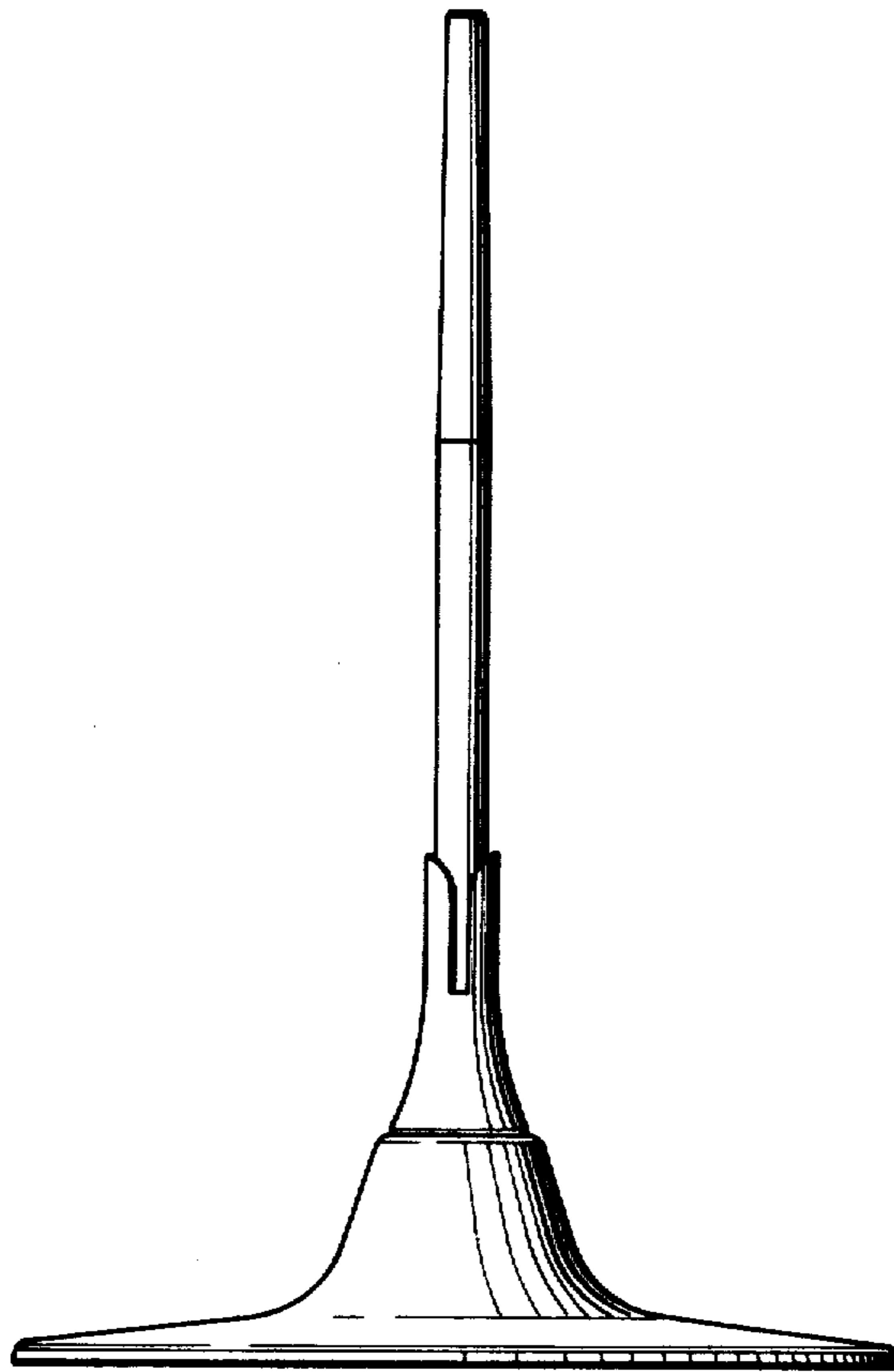

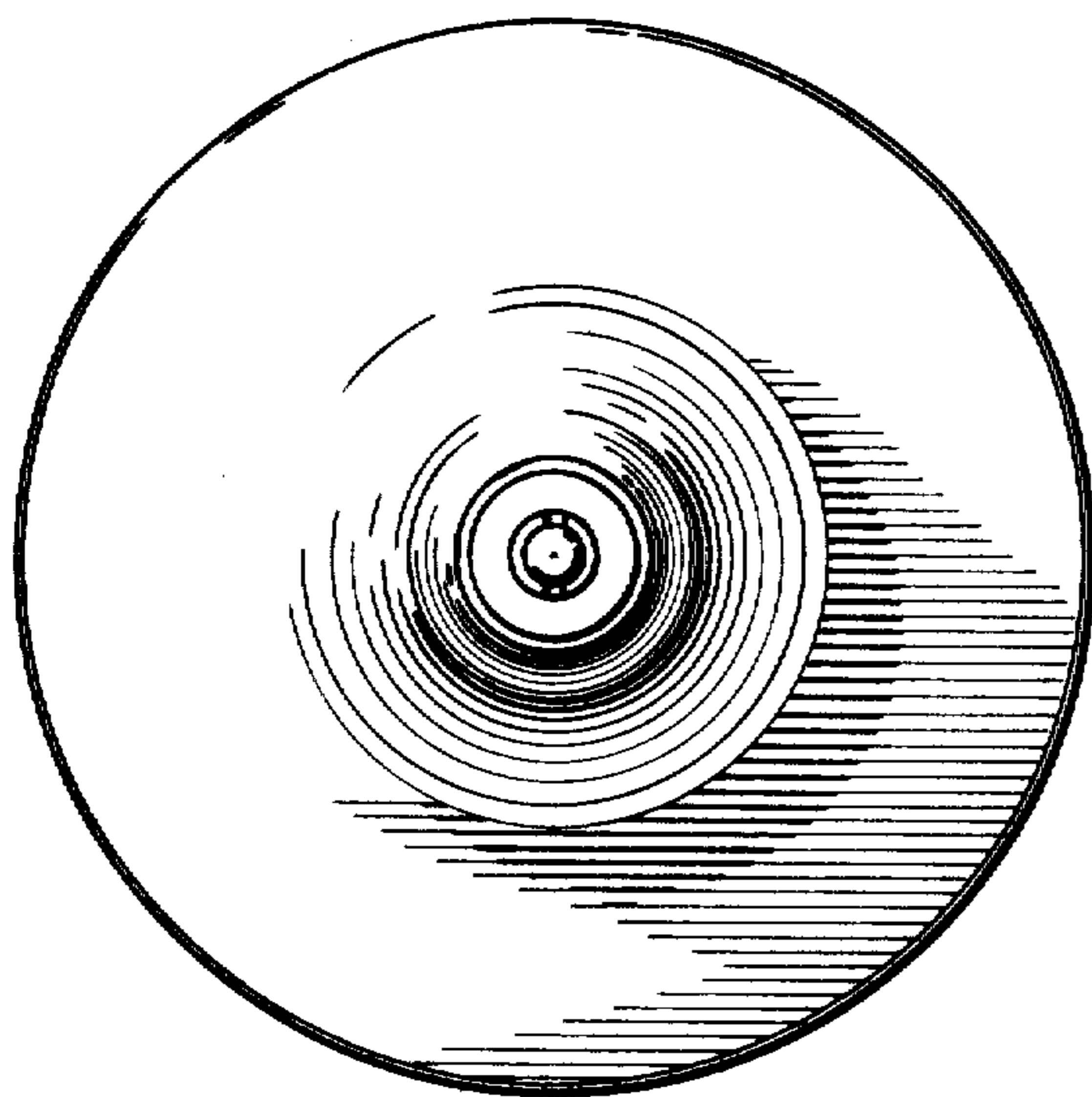

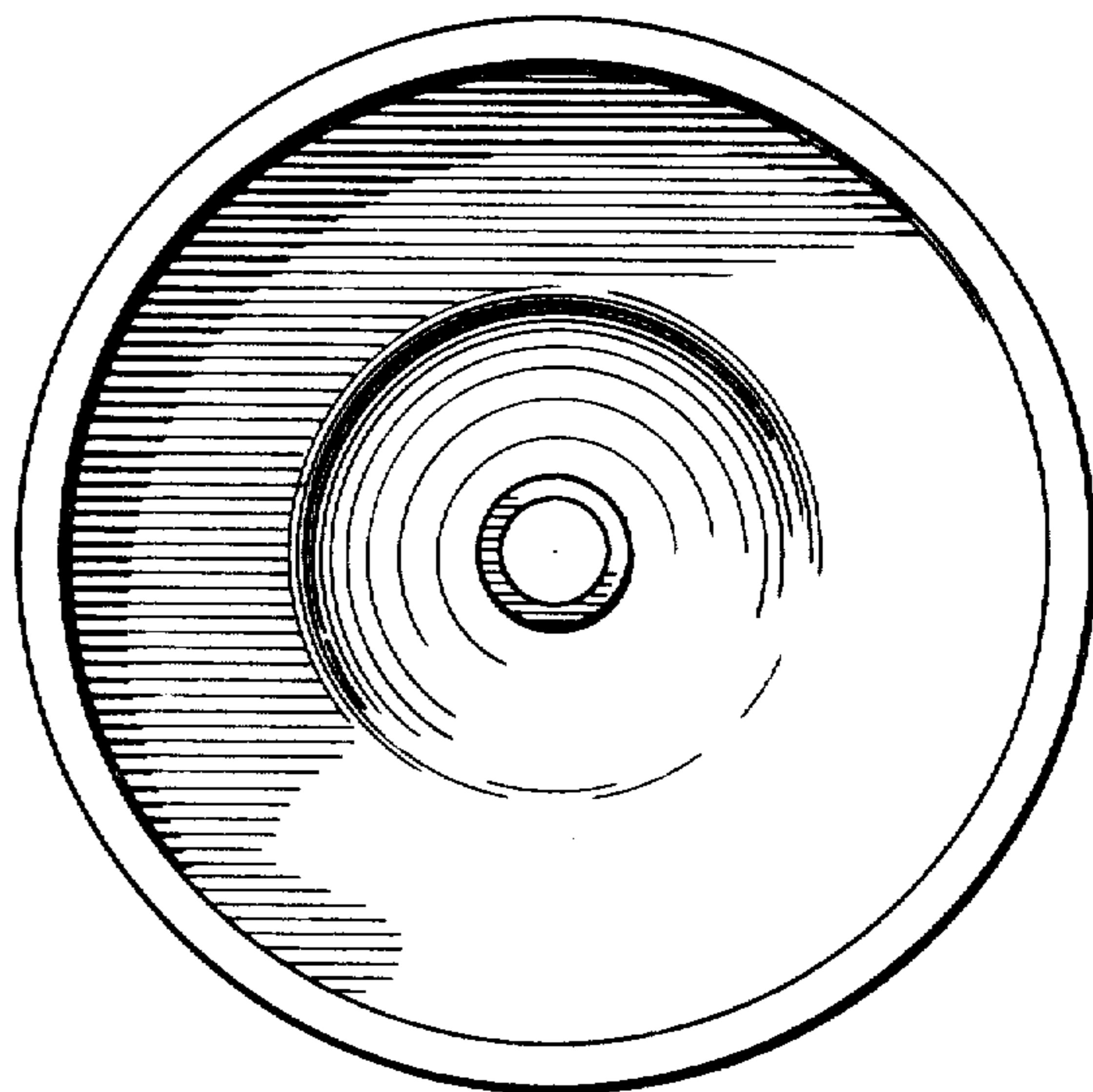

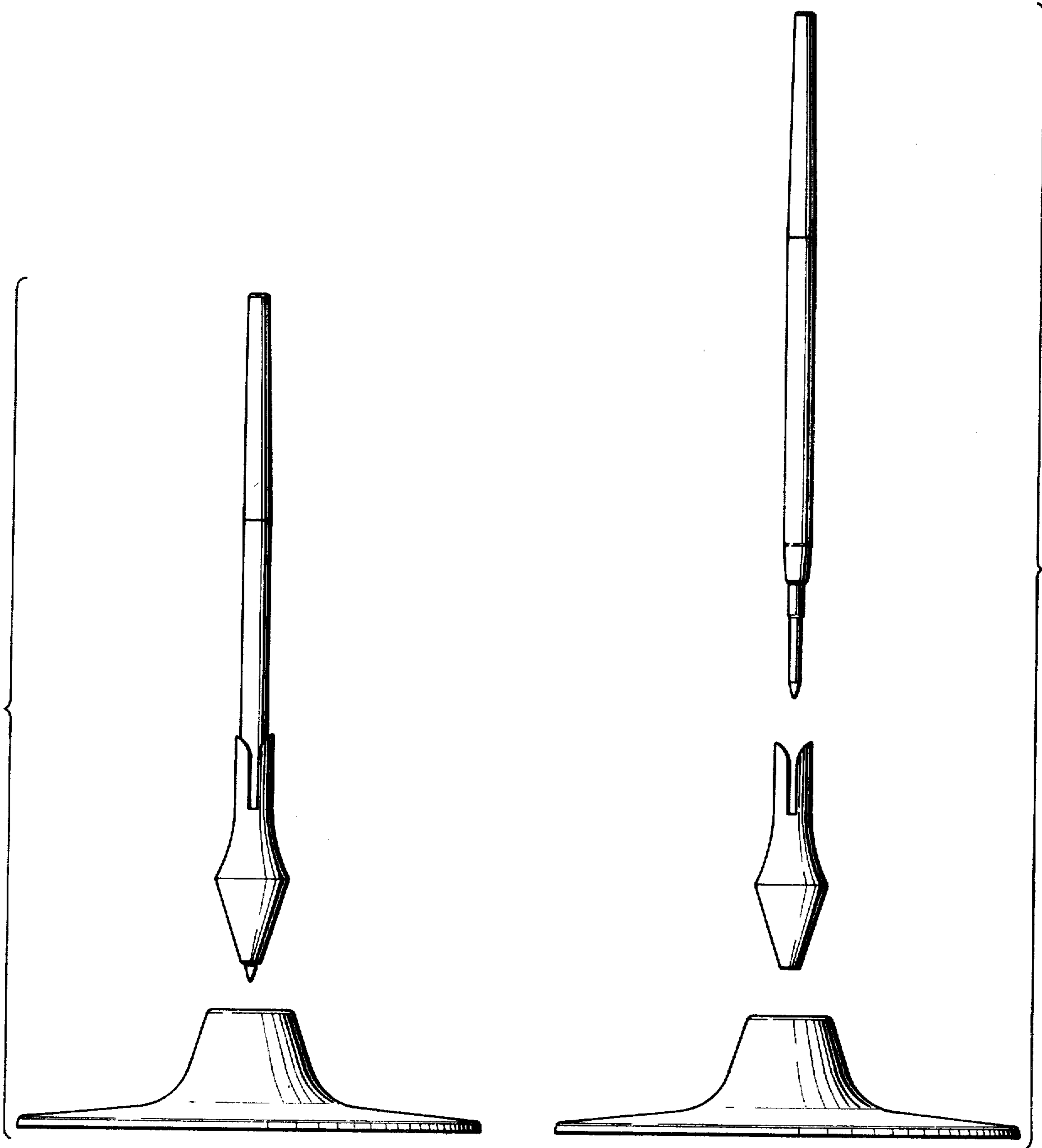
