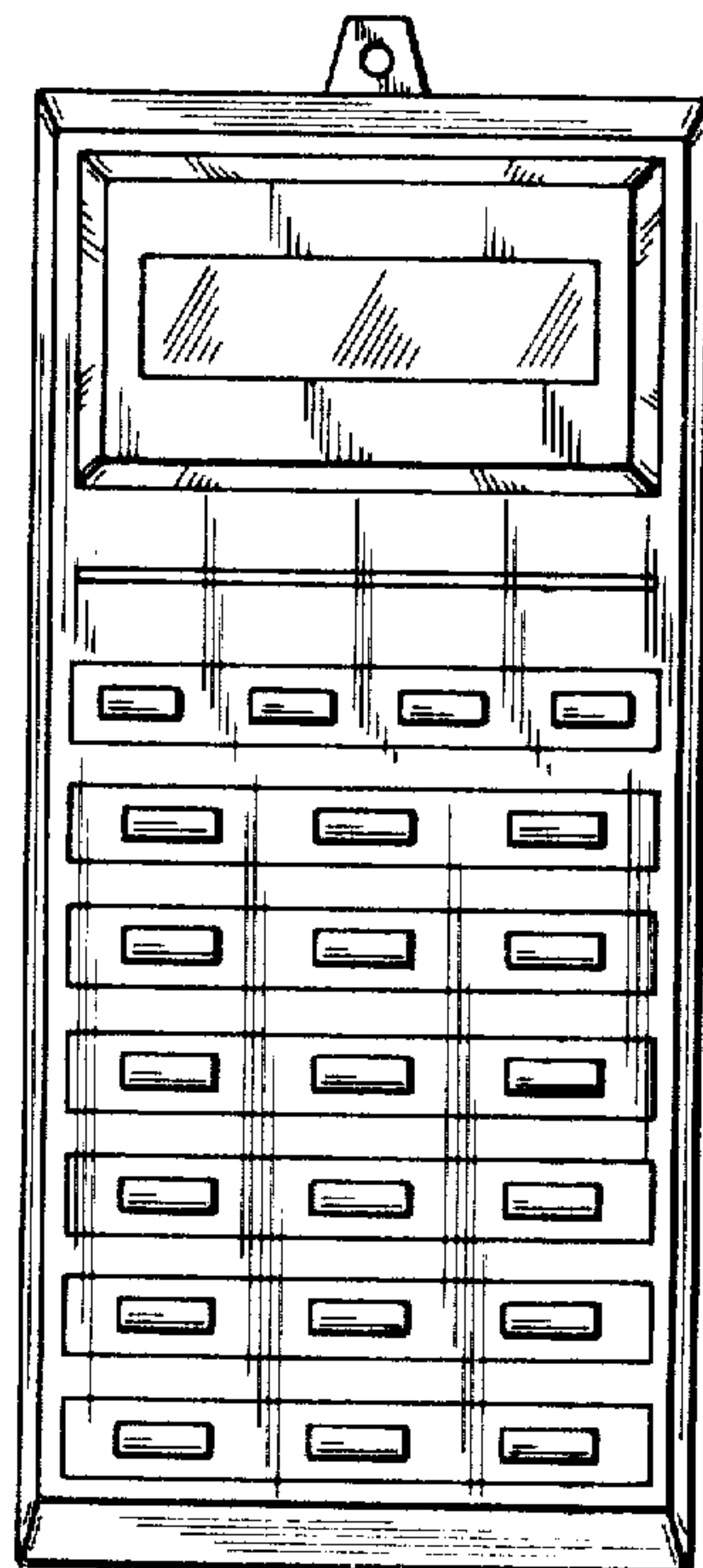

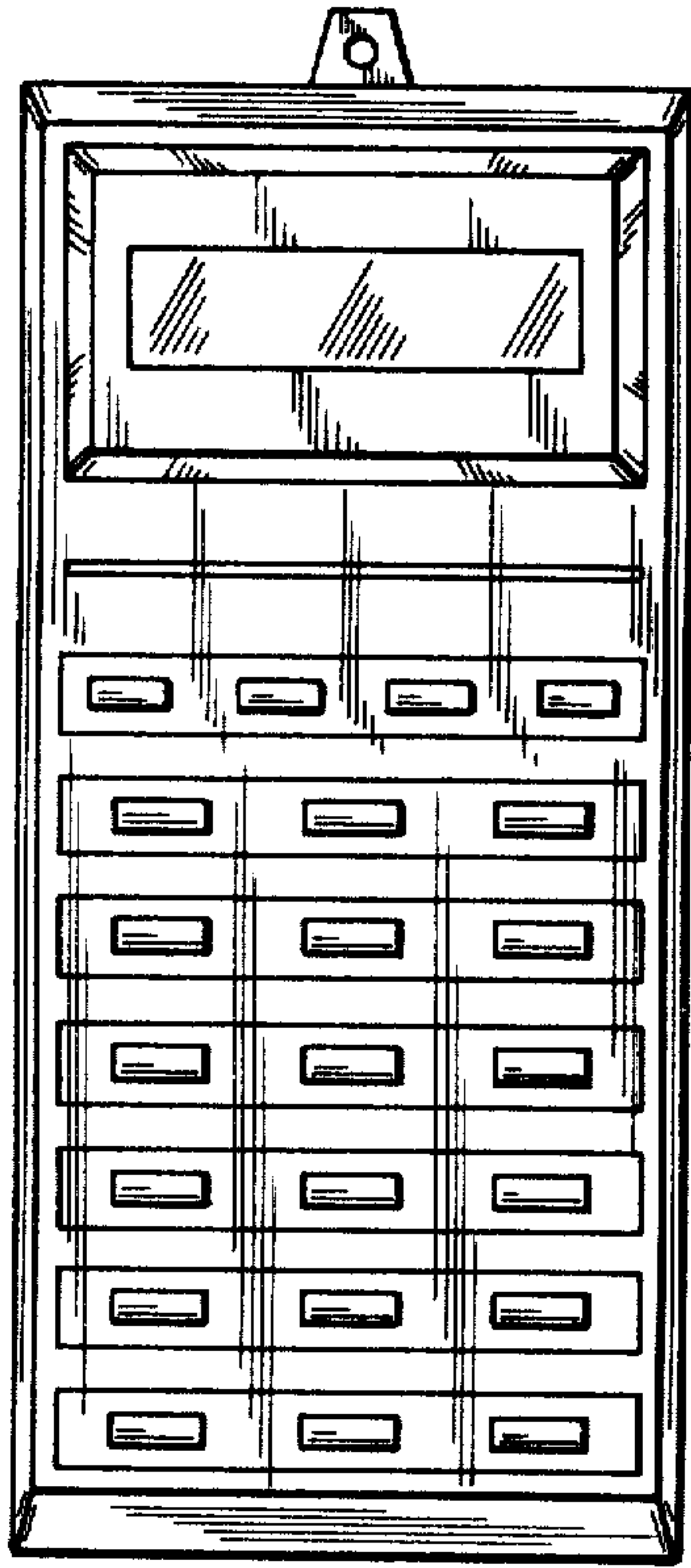
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic calculating machine, as shown and described.

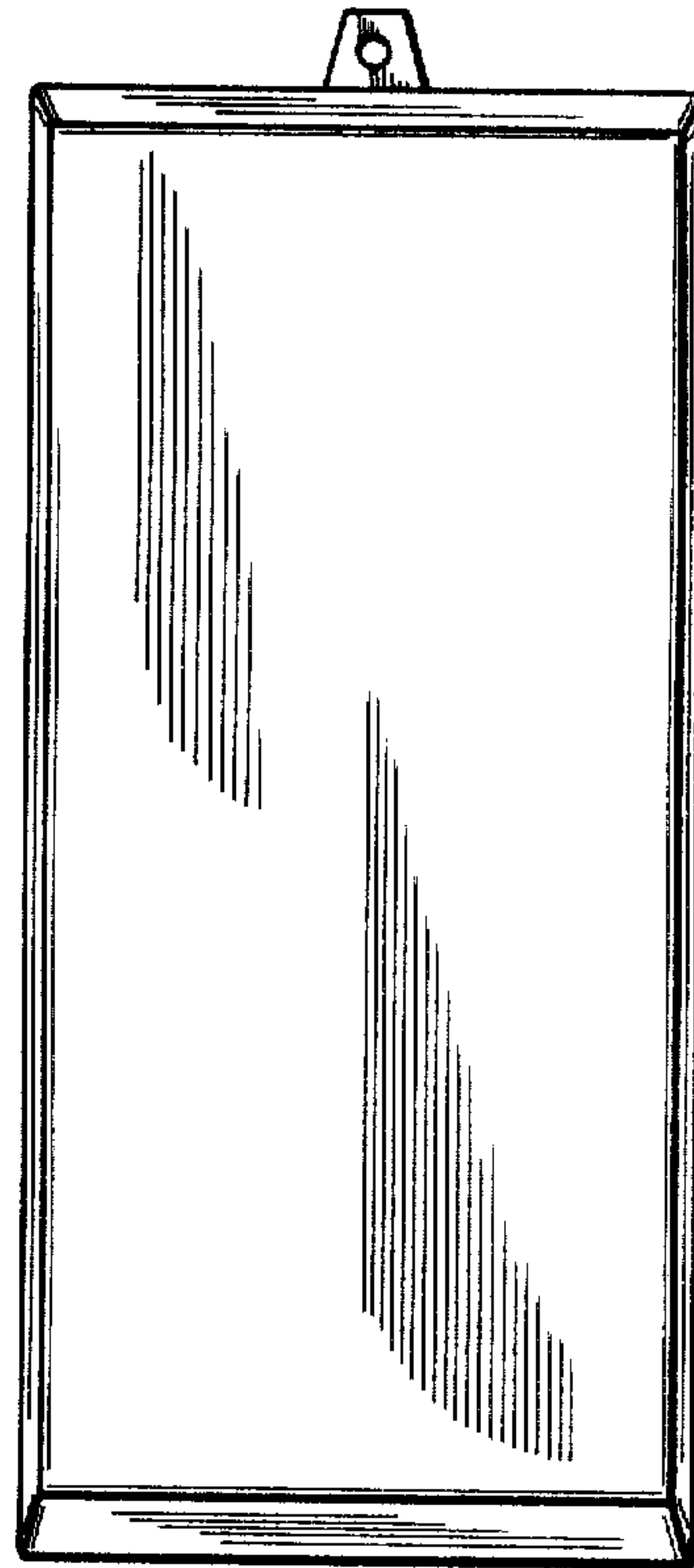
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof.

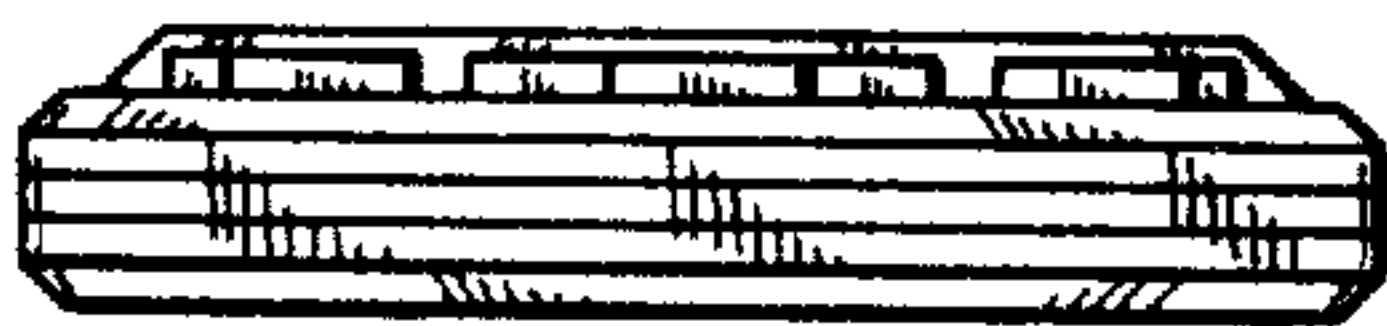




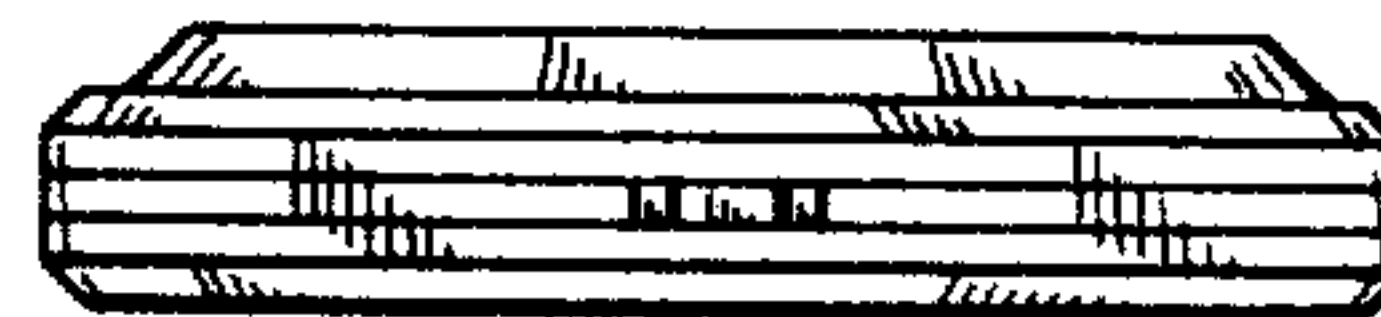
