[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a selective finger nail buffer, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a selective finger nail buffer showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is an end view, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a transverse section taken in the plane indicated by lines 6—6 in FIG. 2.

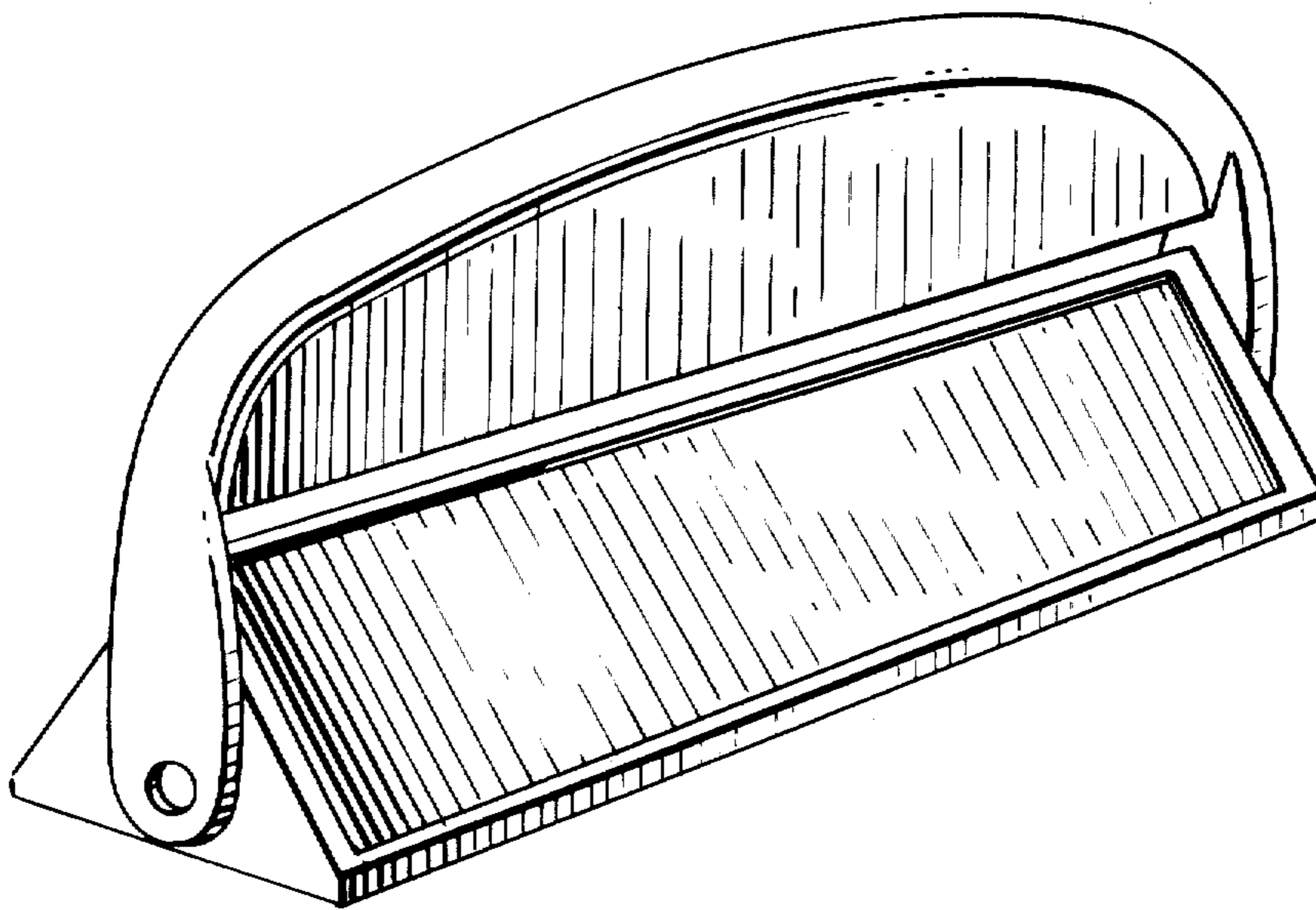

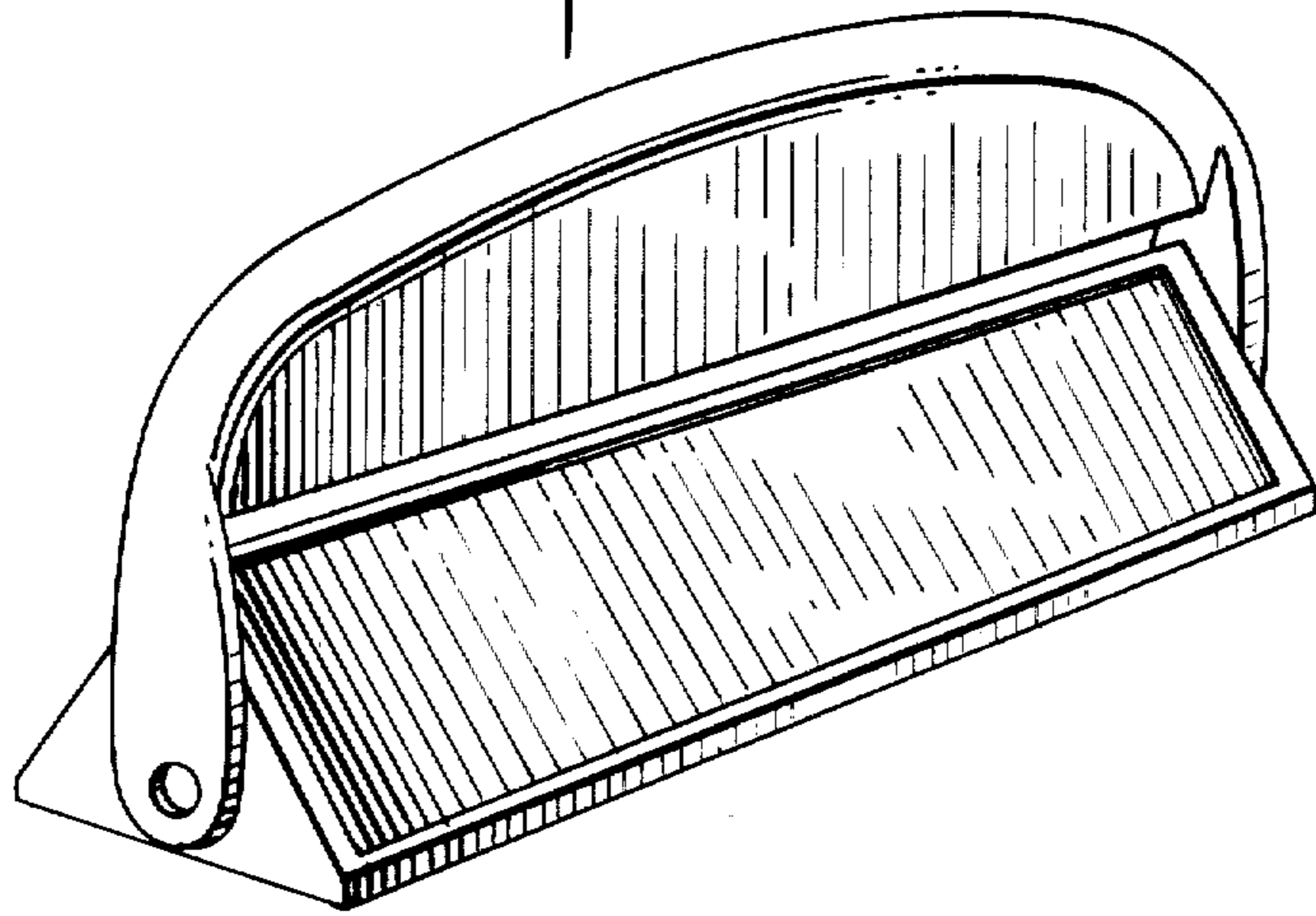

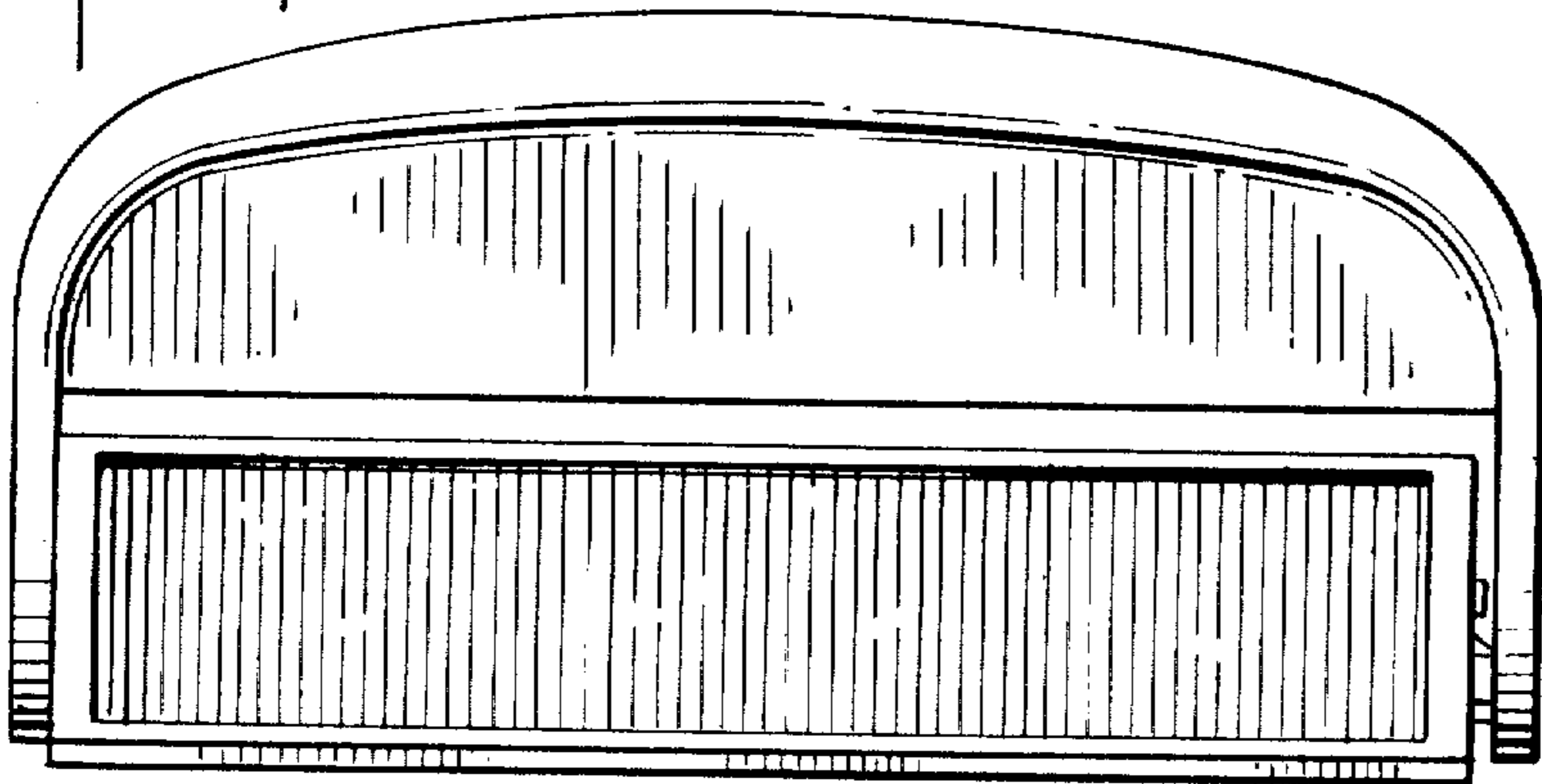

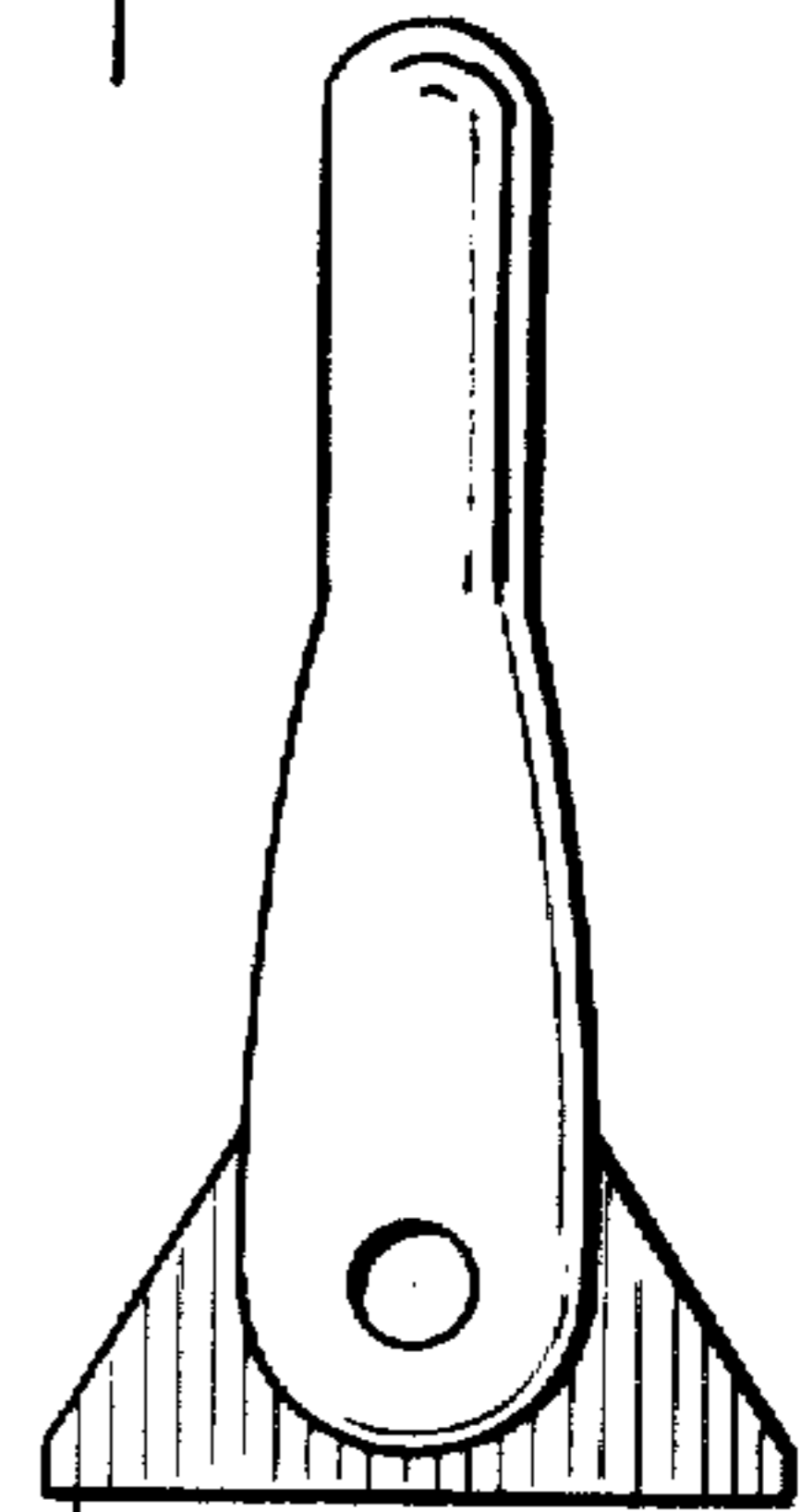

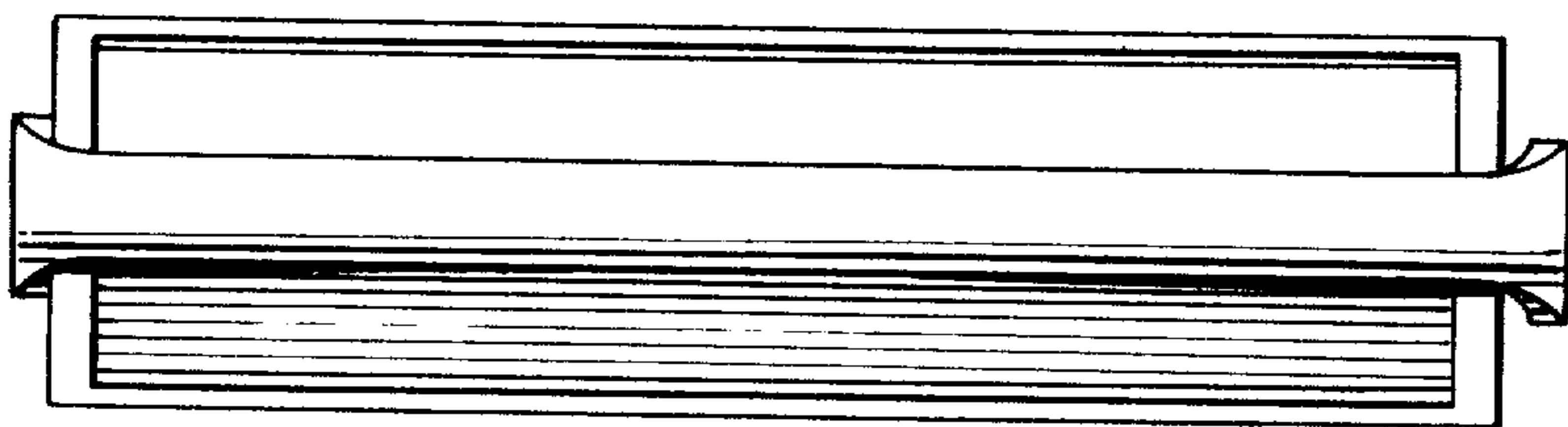

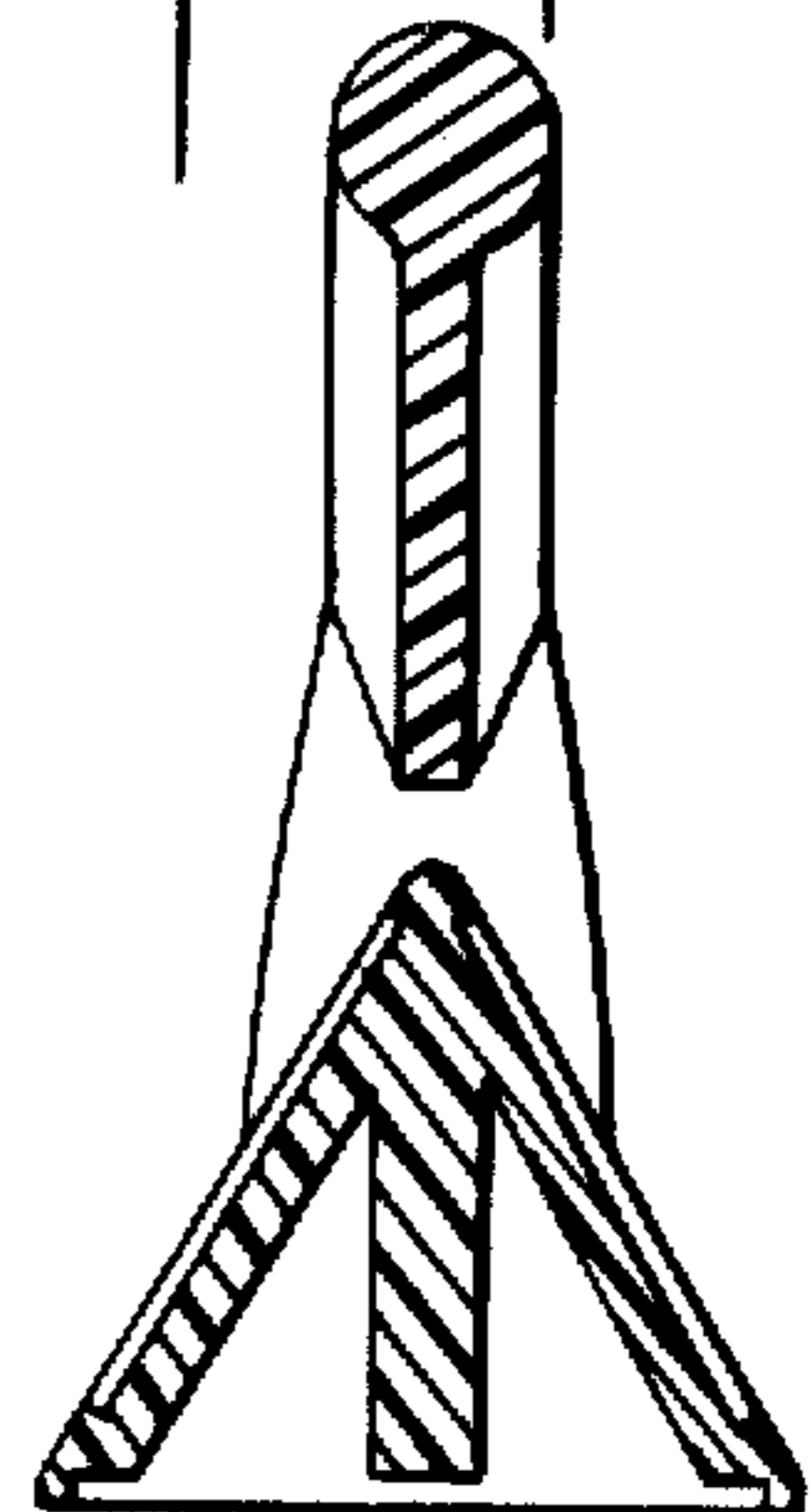
